Agriculture Fact Sheet Sweet Potatoes 2023



- Mississippi ranks #3 in the U.S. in sweet potato production, producing 4.3 million hundredweight annually.
- In 2023, Mississippi harvested 29,500 acres of sweet potatoes on 172 farms.
- The production value of sweet potatoes in 2023 was \$92 million.
- Beauregard is the most popular sweet potato variety in the state based on acres planted, following it the most popular is the Hernandez and Nancy Hall.
- It takes approximately 90 to 120 days to grow a sweet potato.





Sweet Potato Fast Facts

- Planting takes place in late May and June. Harvesting runs from late August through November.
- Mississippi hosts the National Sweet Potato Festival each November in Vardaman, which is the sweet potato capital of the world.



• Sweet potatoes are an excellent source of vitamin A, vitamin C and vitamin B6. They are also low in sodium.
