- 1. Demonstrate competency by passing a written examination administered by the Department; or submit proof of competency from another state. (Pilots who have taken and passed the certification examination in Mississippi can meet the requirement by attending an approved training session). Indicate the method you plan to use to meet the requirement by checking the proper block in Section B of the application.
- 2. Hold a current commercial or airline transport pilot certificate from FAA, and be properly rated by FAA for the aircraft to be used.
- 3. Be recommended by a licensed applicator.

The application should be signed by a licensed applicator, and submitted to the Department with the required license fee.

All licenses will expire on the 31st of March of the year following their issuance or renewal.
