STATE FAIRGROUNDS, Miss. – Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson invites everyone to attend the 59th annual Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo and announces the schedule of events taking place tomorrow Thursday, February 8 and Friday, February 9. All events take place on the Mississippi State Fairgrounds.

The Sale of Junior Champions taking place tomorrow February 8 at 11:00 a.m. is one of the highlight events of the Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo. During the livestock auction, 4-H and FFA youth livestock exhibitors winning Champion and Reserve Champion in the Junior Round-Up sell their animals through an auction. In 2023, 1,257 Mississippi 4-H and FFA youth exhibited 2,153 head of livestock during the Dixie National Junior Livestock Round-up. Forty-eight of the animals were sold during the Sale of Junior Champions grossing a total of \$456,285.

The Dixie National North Ride Wagon Train will arrive at 1:00 p.m. at the Trade Mart tomorrow.
