- 2. Describe your experience with agriculture
- 3. Why you are interested in learning more about agriculture
- 4. What you hope to gain from this experience if selected

WHAT IS THE AGRICULTURE YOUTH COUNCIL AND WHAT DOES IT DO?

This council was created in 2021 by the Mississippi Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce, Andy Gipson, in order to provide future leaders of the agriculture industry an experience that cultivates leadership and career development and broadens horizons while developing the potential workforce for Mississippi. Council members will visit Mississippi agricultural companies and organizations, learn about the legislative process and how it affects the agriculture industry, shadow industry professionals and hone professional skills. Members will serve a one-year term on the council.

MISSION STATEMENT:

To develop future leaders in Mississippi through leadership and career development, industry exposure and experiential learning.

OUR GOAL:

To provide an opportunity for Mississippi's young agricultural leaders to develop leadership, advocacy and employability skills through professional development, industry exposure and experiential learning in a variety of agriculture careers.

WHAT IS THE SELECTION PROCESS AND HOW MANY ARE CHOSEN?

The Agriculture Youth Council is chosen by representatives in the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce. Applications are due **April 15, 2024**. The electronic application can be found at **https://www.mdac.ms.gov/mayc/**. Final interviews will be held virtually and 12-15 youth leaders will be announced by May 20, 2024.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BE A MEMBER OF THE AGRICULTURE YOUTH

- High school juniors in school year 2024 to serve their senior year, August 2024-June 2025.
- · Any public, private or homeschool students may apply
- Student must exhibit an interest, passion and/ or experiences in agriculture



REQUIREMENTS UPON SELECTION:

- Students will be required to dress professionally for all Youth Council events.
- All travel to and from the MDAC office in Jackson will be the responsibility of students and/or parents.
- Commit to four council meetings from August 2024-June 2025.
