Placing third representing Hinds County was Lucy Haskins, serving up a strawberry cream cheese crêpe. Tying for fourth place were Raylee Reed and Joshua Hancock representing Rankin County, and Amoury Austin representing Noxubee County. Best of Beef was awarded to Passion Terrell of Humphreys County, Heidi Hood of Forrest County, and Williow and Robert Cox-Osbourne of DeSoto County.

The contestants placing first, second and third were awarded cash prizes by the Mississippi Poultry Association in amounts of \$75, \$50 and \$25, respectively. Fourth place was awarded \$25 by Cal-Maine Foods, and Best Beef winners each won \$50 awarded by the Mississippi Beef Council. All contestants received a home cooking toolkit that included an apron, skillet, whisk and spatula sponsored by the Mississippi Egg Marketing Board.
