

Agriculture Fact Sheet

Catfish 2024



- Mississippi ranks #1 in the United States for farm raised-catfish production, producing more than 65 percent of the nation's farm-raised catfish.
- In 2024, Mississippi had 142 catfish operations covering 29,900 water acres.
- The production value of catfish in 2024 was \$214 million.
- The typical annual production of catfish per acre is 5,000 pounds.
- The top three catfish producing counties include: Leflore, Sunflower and Noxubee.
- It takes about 18 months to two years to grow a 1-pound fish.
- A full-grown fish averages between 1 and 2 pounds.
