Schedule of 61st Annual Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo Events Taking Place Tomorrow, Tuesday, February 10, and Wednesday, February 11

STATE FAIRGROUNDS, Miss. – Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson invites everyone to attend the 61st annual Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo and announces the schedule of events taking place tomorrow, Tuesday, February 10, and Wednesday, February 11. All events take place on the Mississippi State Fairgrounds.

Over 1,000 4-H and FFA exhibitors from across the state are competing in this year's Dixie National Junior Round-Up as they vie for Grand and Reserve Champion in their respective fields, and the chance to participate in the Sale of Champions. The annual Sale of Junior Champions will be held Thursday, February 12, in the Trade Mart following a press conference previewing the auction and the Dixie National Rodeo.

Tuesday is the start of the two-day Equestrians with Disabilities Horse Show. This unique show gives people with cognitive or physical challenges the opportunity to compete in showing an American Quarter Horse. Competitors range in age from teenagers to adults over 50.

In conjunction with the nationwide America250 celebrations, this year's Dixie National will take on a special patriotic focus. Events of the 61st Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo run through Sunday, February 22, 2026. The Dixie National Rodeo, the largest rodeo east of the Mississippi River, takes place Friday, February 13, through Saturday, February 21, inside the Mississippi Coliseum at the State Fairgrounds.

MEDIA NOTE:

A designated Media Room will be available to local/state newspapers, tv stations and print and broadcasting media for the Dixie National Rodeo, which takes place February 13-15 and 18-21. Media will have access to live updates/stats from each rodeo performance, current leaderboard information

and exclusive one-on-one interviews with rodeo competitors and entertainers. The media room, or Gray Room, is located on the south side of the Coliseum. To enter the Coliseum, simply show your work ID badge at the doors. Enter the Coliseum through the glass doors on the south side and take an immediate right. The media room will be on your right. The room is easily visible and will be labeled MEDIA ROOM.

Media passes will be distributed in the Media Room for those who want to get b-roll footage inside the Coliseum arena. You will be directed to the reserved section designated for your camera crews. We will bring cowboys/clowns/queens/etc. to the media room for interviews. If there are specific people that you would like to interview for a story, let us know ahead of time and we will work to make those happen.

Immediately following each rodeo performance, a rodeo announcer will be in the Media Room to provide a Rodeo Recap to the media.
