### **Ag Commissioner Gipson Applauds Passage of Farm Bill by U.S. House of Representatives**

**JACKSON, Miss.** – Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson issued the following statement following the U.S. House of Representative’s passage of H.R. 7567, the Farm, Food, and National Security Act of 2026.

“I applaud the U.S. House of Representatives for passing a Farm Bill today. This action comes at a crucial time for our farmers and ranchers as they continue to face significant challenges, including rising input costs, market uncertainty, labor shortages, and the need for a stronger domestic food supply chain.
