Dixie National kicks off on February 2 and runs through February 17. A complete schedule can be found on pages 14 and 15.


One of the most time-honored gatherings each year is the Junior

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# From Our Kitchen To Yours Trail Riding and Campfire Favorites

### **Chuck Wagon Casserole**

1 pound ground beef

- 1 15.5-ounce can chili beans in sauce
- 1 11-ounce can Mexican style corn

3/4 cup BBQ sauce

- 1 8.5-ounce package corn muffin mix
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/2 cup chopped green bell pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Heat Dutch oven to 350 degrees for frying. Brown ground beef, onions and peppers in the Dutch oven. Add chili beans, BBQ sauce and salt; bring to a boil. Drain corn. Prepare corn muffin mix according to package directions; add corn and mix well. Pour corn muffin mixture into Dutch oven, spreading it over the meat mixture. Close Dutch oven and stew for 30 minutes or until inserted knife pulls out clean.

### **Campfire Chicken**

Split chicken breasts
Red potatoes, cut in half
Carrots, cut in half
Onion, cut in half
Plum tomatoes, cut in half
Italian dressing or other seasonings

Place all ingredients together into one large foil sheet and make into a pocket, or you can make individual foil packets for each person. Bake in the oven or over a campfire for about an hour. If over the fire, turn the foil packets frequently. You can also add a small piece of corn on the cob, if desired.

### **Walking Tacos**

1 pound hamburger meat

1 package taco seasoning

1 small onion, chopped

Chopped lettuce

Shredded cheese

Black olives, sliced

Chopped tomato

Sour cream or dressing of your choice

Salsa

1-ounce bags of Doritos

Brown hamburger and onion, drain. Add taco seasoning and mix well. Let the mixture simmer until taco seasoning is absorbed. Take the Dorito bag and press together smashing the chips. Turn the bag on its side and cut the top off with a pair of scissors. Add the hamburger meat mixture along with all or any of the toppings you desire. Take a plastic fork and enjoy straight from the bag.

### **Breakfast Sandwiches**

Non-stick vegetable spray

1 English muffin

2 slices Canadian bacon

2 slices cheese

2 eggs

Butter

Salt and pepper

Aluminum foil

Spray non-stick on each sheet of aluminum foil. Make a tight basket or pocket out of the foil, so it will not leak. For each sandwich, lay the muffin in the foil, open face. Butter the muffin, and place the Canadian bacon and cheese on each side of the muffin. Crack the eggs over the muffins. Salt and pepper eggs to taste. Close or continue to fold the aluminum into a tightly sealed pocket and cook until done.

### Pineapple Rings

1 can pineapple slices (in syrup or juice) Marshmallows Sticks for skewers

Skewer the pineapple slices, working a marshmallow into the center hole. Toast over a low fire or on a grill until the pineapple gets hot and the marshmallow gets as brown as you like it.

### **Campfire Pizza**

1 package large pita bread

1 can pizza sauce

3 slices salami

2 slices bacon, cut into small pieces

1 package shredded mozzarella cheese

Sliced vegetables (onions, peppers, mushrooms, zucchini)

Spread pitas with sauce and sprinkle cheese on top. Place meat and vegetables on top; place on aluminum foil over campfire grill, making sure the flame is not too high. Barbeque for about 10 minutes or until cheese is melted and bacon is cooked through.





Taylor a former Mississippi Junior Cattlemen member was also active in 4-H showing cattle. She has also been awarded several scholarships while as a undergraduate at Mississippi State University from the Mississippi Cattlemen's Foundation.

Taylor earned a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture Business with a concentration on Policy and Law from MSU. While at Mississippi State she was on the Equestrian and Rodeo Team.

# Pesticide Applicator Certification Required for Dicamba Training

An additional certification requirement from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is now in place for individuals who plan to apply dicamba in Xtend cropping systems.

Individuals working under the direct supervision of a certified applicator may no longer make applications of legal dicamba products during the growing season.

Agricultural professionals must secure a commercial or private pesticide applicator certification and take the additional applicator training required for application of approved dicamba herbicide products in Xtend cropping systems.

The Mississippi State University Extension Service will offer an increased number of training opportunities around the state to help Mississippians comply with this new requirement.

Darrin Dodds, Extension cotton specialist, said the purpose of the requirement is to increase the safe and effective use of these herbicides that are being used more commonly each year since their introduction.

"These products have seen increased usage over the past two growing seasons, but this has not come without setbacks, including off-target movement onto susceptible plant species," Dodds said. "The



goal of these training programs is to educate those who purchase and apply these products about proper application procedures and reduce the number of off-target damage incidents. Education is critical to ensuring these products remain within the bounds of where they are applied."

The online mandatory training modules are being revised to reflect new federal EPA guidelines. The modules will be available at http://www.auxintraining.com as soon as they are complete.

Face-to-face training workshops are being planned for additional opportunities to access the online auxin training information.

# Dixie National Junior Round-Up Livestock Shows

Every year, for one week in early February, youth who raise livestock and participate in the 4-H & FFA livestock programs in Mississippi head to Jackson for the annual Dixie National Junior Round-Up Livestock Shows. These youth bring show entries from their junior livestock projects to compete for champions of their individual categories.

The Dixie National is the show-case for the 4-H & FFA livestock programs and livestock industry; it is also the site of the largest junior market livestock shows in Mississippi. The Champion and Reserve Champion of the Junior Steer Show, Junior Market Lamb Show, Junior Market Swine Show, Junior Market Goat Show, and Overall Champion Mississippi Bred steer, lamb, and hog are singled out for a special tribute at the Dixie National. The exhibitors purchased many of these animals last spring, and these young exhibi-



tors with champions have worked long and hard to raise their outstanding animals.

First, boys and girls exhibit their animals at one of the five district shows within the State. If they receive a blue ribbon on their animal at the district show, they can then participate in the Dixie National. There were over 1,600 market ani-

mals at the five district shows and over 1,100 ended up at the Dixie National Junior Round-Up, from which the champions were selected. These champion animals were sold to the highest bidder at the Sale of Junior Champions auction.
