## Sale of Champions Breaks \$7M Mark

The Dixie National Sale of Junior Champions began in 1969 as a conversation between two Mississippi State University livestock specialists dedicated to building better youth through livestock programs.

Duane Tucker, then a 4-H livestock specialist and later associate director of the MSU Extension Service, approached R.O. Buckley, another livestock specialist and executive vice president of the Mississippi Cattlemen's Association, with the idea of forming a committee with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce to organize the event.

On February 7, the Dixie National Sale observed its golden anniversary and passed the \$7 million mark in total generated sales during its 50-year run. This year's edition produced a preliminary sale total of \$382,775, breaking the previous record.

The annual event provides exhibitors like Forrest County 4-H'ers Julia and Ruslan Saucier an opportunity to compete against peer exhibitors who are showing the best animals in the state. The siblings had three steers advance from the Dixie National Junior Round-Up earlier in the week to the sale.

"It takes a lot of time and effort to raise a competitive animal. You don't just walk in with one," Julia Saucier said. "You've got to work on their feet and make sure they're not

scared of noises. You've got to get them used to you. You really have to work with them every day."

While Julia Saucier had competed in the Junior Round-Up before and had a steer in a previous sale, this year was her brother's first appearance.

"I've had a great first experience here, and it felt really good to make it to the sale," Ruslan Saucier said. "We show at a lot of places, but I enjoy the competition we have here, and I think this is a top-class show."

Dean Jousan, MSU Extension 4-H livestock specialist, said 1,635 4-H and FFA members competed in the Junior Round-Up throughout the week. They exhibited 2,263 head of livestock.

"You typically see a few exhibitors with two animals in the sale each year, but three is more of a feat,



especially in one species. The Sauciers' success is a product of an entire year of feeding, raising and training their animals for competition," Jousan said. "While the sale features the champions from the Dixie National Junior Round-Up, everyone who advances here is a winner and deserves praise for their dedication and hard work."

The sale included 45 champion market animals, including 15 hogs, 10 steers, 10 lambs and 10 goats. Preliminary total proceeds for hogs reached \$116,675; steers, \$104,450; goats, \$86,600; and lambs, \$75,050. MSU Extension Director Gary Jackson expressed his appreciation for the team effort among all the organizations and agencies that help make the event possible.

"It takes all of us to be able to have this livestock show and to cel-

ebate it at the end with the annual Sale of Junior Champions. When I think about the Dixie National Junior Round-Up, I think about all the groups who come together to do this -- the volunteers, the Extension 4-H agents and FFA advisors -- who have brought their young people here," Jackson said. "We also have many businesses and industries who strongly support this event. At the end of the day, these people are supporting our youth. That's what this is really about."

A program associated with the sale has awarded \$832,700 in scholarship money to 4-H and FFA members since it began in 1993. This year, it will award a total of \$58,500 in scholarships. This amount includes six \$2,000 scholarships to six premier exhibitors, six \$1,500 scholarships to exhibitors of supreme champion livestock and 25 \$1,500 scholarships to high school seniors.

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## From Our Kitchen To Yours

Delicious Grilled Sandwiches and Paninis

### Waffle Iron Turkey Melt Panini

4 center-cut bacon slices  
3 tablespoons canola mayonnaise  
1 teaspoon Dijon mustard  
8 (1-ounce) slices whole-grain or whole-wheat bread  
8 ounces unsalted sliced deli turkey  
8 (1/8-inch-thick) slices tart apple such as Granny Smith  
4 (1-ounce) slices reduced-fat Colby-jack cheese  
Cooking spray

Preheat a waffle iron with four compartments to high heat. Place a paper towel on a microwave-safe plate. Arrange bacon on paper towel; cover with an additional paper towel. Microwave bacon on high for four minutes or until done. Combine mayonnaise and mustard in a small bowl. Spread about 1 1/4 teaspoons mayonnaise mixture over each bread slice. Divide bacon, turkey, apple slices and cheese evenly among four bread slices; top with remaining bread slices, spread side down. Lightly coat both sides of sandwiches with cooking spray. Place one sandwich in each compartment of waffle iron; close waffle iron firmly on sandwiches. Place a heavy skillet on top of waffle iron to help flatten sandwiches evenly. Cook three to four minutes or until golden brown and cheese melts.

### Prosciutto and Smoked Gouda Panini

20 (1-ounce) slices Italian bread  
Cooking spray  
6 ounces smoked Gouda cheese, thinly sliced  
6 ounces thinly sliced prosciutto

Coat one side of each bread slice with cooking spray. Place 10 bread slices, coated sides down, on a work surface. Divide cheese and prosciutto evenly among the 10 bread slices. Top with remaining bread slices, coated sides up. Heat a large non-stick skillet over medium heat. Grill panini five minutes on each side or until lightly browned and cheese melts, pressing with a spatula to flatten. Serve immediately.

### Strawberry-Turkey-Brie Panini

1 (8-ounce) Brie round  
8 Italian bread slices  
8 ounces thinly sliced smoked turkey  
8 fresh basil leaves  
1/2 cup sliced fresh strawberries  
2 tablespoons red pepper jelly  
2 tablespoons butter, melted  
Strawberry halves for garnish

Trim and discard rind from Brie. Cut Brie into 1/2 -inch-thick slices. Layer four bread slices evenly with turkey, basil leaves, strawberries and Brie. Spread 1 1/2 teaspoons pepper jelly on one side of each remaining four bread slices; place bread slices, jelly sides down, on top of Brie. Brush sandwiches with melted butter. Cook sandwiches, in batches, in a preheated panini press two to three minutes on each side or until golden. Garnish with strawberry halves, if desired.

### Buffalo Chicken Panini

1/4 cup fat-free sour cream  
2 ounces crumbled blue cheese (about 1/2 cup)  
2 tablespoons hot sauce  
1 tablespoon butter, melted  
1 teaspoon red wine vinegar  
Cooking spray  
1 pound skinless, boneless chicken breast halves, pounded to 1/2 -inch thickness  
1/3 cup thinly sliced celery  
8 (1-ounce) whole-wheat sourdough bread slices

Combine sour cream and blue cheese in a small bowl, mashing with a fork until smooth. Mix hot sauce, melted butter and vinegar in a large bowl. Heat a grill pan over medium-high heat. Coat pan with cooking spray. Add chicken; cook three minutes on each side or until done. Add cooked chicken to hot sauce mixture; toss to coat. Stir in celery. Spread one side of each bread slice with blue cheese mixture. Place one chicken breast half on each of four bread slices; spoon remaining hot sauce mixture evenly over chicken. Top chicken with remaining bread slices. Heat grill pan over medium heat. Coat with cooking spray. Arrange sandwiches in pan; top with a heavy skillet, pressing down slightly. Grill sandwiches three minutes on each side or until toasted. Cut sandwiches in half crosswise.

### Grilled Apple and Cheddar Sandwiches

2 tablespoons Dijon mustard  
2 tablespoons apricot preserves  
1 tablespoon olive oil  
2 teaspoons lemon juice  
8 slices sandwich bread  
8 thin slices sharp Cheddar  
1 crisp apple, cored, thinly sliced  
2 tablespoons unsalted butter

Combine mustard, preserves, oil and lemon juice in a small bowl. Whisk together well. Spread one side of four bread slices with mustard mixture. Top each with a cheese slice. Top each cheese slice with an equal portion of apple slices; add another cheese slice and remaining slice of bread. Melt one tablespoon butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Working with two at a time, arrange sandwiches in skillet. Lay a piece of aluminum foil on top of sandwiches, and then place another heavy skillet on top to press them. Grill until cheese begins to melt and sandwiches are toasted, two to three minutes per side. Check often during grilling to avoid burning. Wipe out skillet and repeat with remaining butter and sandwiches. Cut each sandwich in half and serve warm.

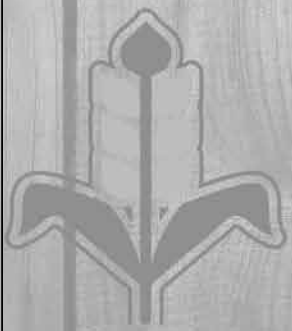

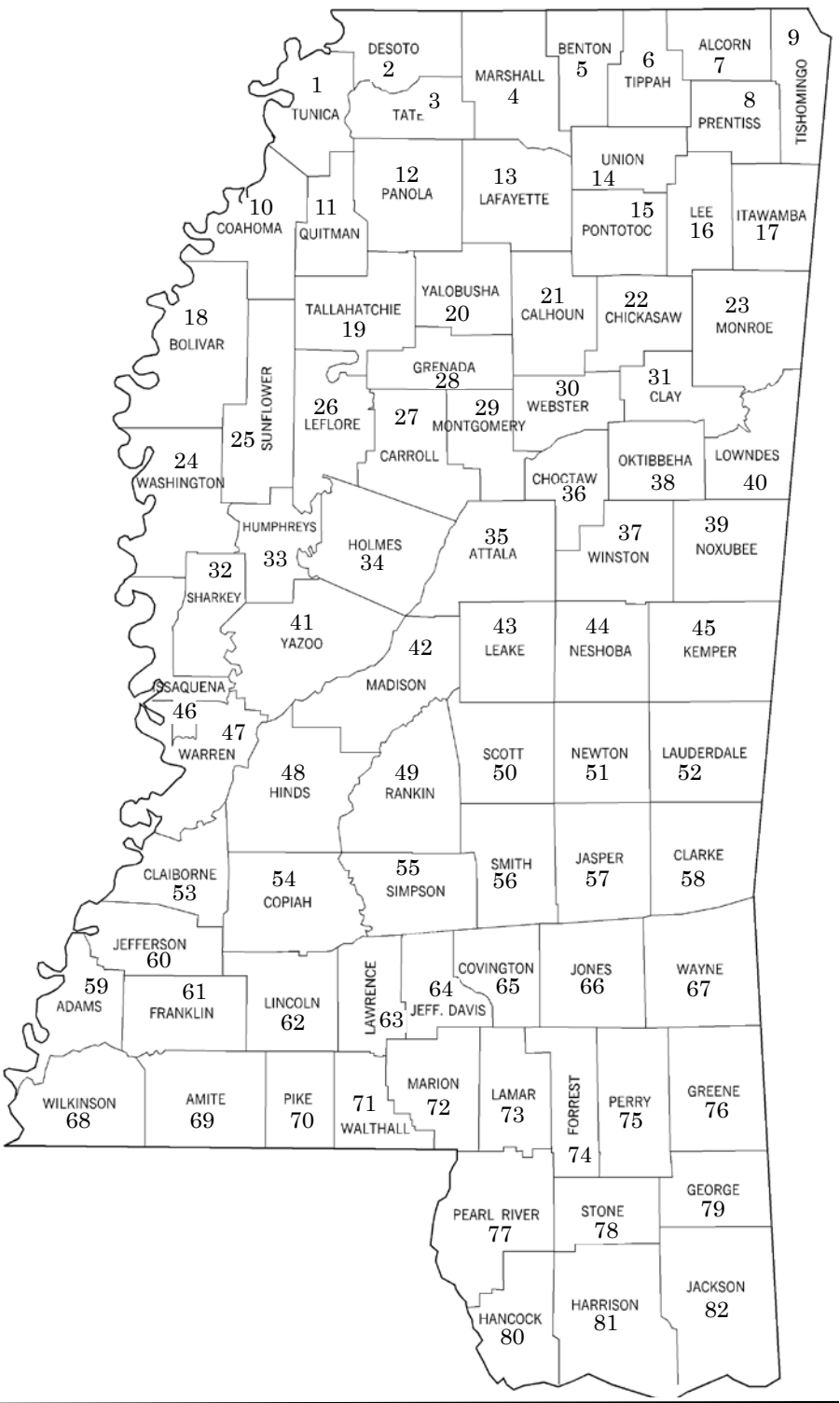



## 2019 Dixie National Rodeo Breaks Record in Ticket Sales

Following the conclusion of the 2019 Dixie National Rodeo, Agriculture and Commerce Commissioner Andy Gipson announced that ticket sales for the rodeo grossed \$926,000, setting an all-time record and beating the prior record by 7.5 percent. This amount does not include Dixie National Rodeo sponsorships of over \$200,000, putting total gross revenues well above \$1.1 million dollars.

"I want to thank Mississippi Fair Commission executive director Steve Hutton and all the Fairgrounds and MDAC staff for a job well done. We are setting records even in the midst of our major Trade Mart construc-



tion and parking challenges. The Harper Morgan Rodeo officials are ecstatic, and we are already working to make next year's Dixie National Rodeo and musical entertainment even better," said Commissioner Gipson. "These increased revenues will help us continue making improvements throughout the livestock and equine facilities, bringing them to the level all Mississippians deserve," Gipson added.



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
