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Tips to Prepare for Spring Calving Season

Calving season can be a very intense time for cow-calf producers. It is important to understand the nutritional needs of cows and heifers and be prepared to handle newborn calves properly. Adequate planning and preparation can reduce calf loss, which ultimately means more profit for the producer. Using proven management techniques helps ensure a successful calving season.

Manage Nutrition

Adequate nutrition is critical during the last two months of gestation, because most of the fetal growth occurs then. Keep heifers separate from the mature cow herd for best nutritional and breeding management. Heifers are still growing and

have higher nutrient requirements than mature cows. Cattle nutrient needs are also impacted by body weight.

A cow or heifer that has just calved requires additional nutrients for the first few months after calving. Separate cows and heifers that have calved from their counterparts that have not calved to implement nutritional programs that match the needs of each group.

Manage cattle for proper body condition at calving to impact rebreeding rates positively. The ideal body condition score (BCS) for a spring calving brood cow is 5 (on a 10 point scale). A BCS of 5 allows the cow to deliver the nutrition needed by the fetus to develop without "robbing" the cow herself of key nutrients

Cows and heifers in thin body condition at calving time are slower to rebreed, produce less colostrum, and are less likely to wean a live calf. Effective nutritional programs match forage and feed resources to animal nutrient requirements.

The time to try to improve your brood cow's BCS is prior to calving. Once she calves, it will be difficult to improve her score as nutrient needs during lactation are very high. Remember a good BCS not only makes calving easier, but it also helps your cow return to estrus sooner and breed back within an acceptable time period of less than 90 days post-calving.

Avoid Calving Difficulty

Calf losses associated with calving difficulty can be economically devastating for a herd of any size. In addition to calf losses, weak calves and longer postpartum intervals (the time between calving and return to cycling) can result from difficult calving. Avoiding calving difficulty starts long before the calving season with proper bull selection, proper



heifer development, and culling females with extremely small pelvic

Place cows and heifers ready to calve in a pasture where they can be easily viewed and checked often. Cows and heifers often become uneasy and seek a quiet place as calving approaches. Complete dilation of the cervix, serious straining and calf delivery normally take 60 to 90 minutes for heifers and 30 to 60 minutes for cows.

Be ready to assist in calf delivery if reasonable progress stops after the feet or water bag appear. In a normal calf presentation, the front feet are presented first, with the bottom of the hooves facing downward and with the head following on top of the knees. Calves presenting abnormally may require repositioning or other delivery assistance. Contact a veterinarian if a calf cannot be safely delivered without help.

Nursing and Colostrum

Once a calf is breathing properly, allow it time to stand and start to nurse. Observe the calf during its first hours of life, because it is critical for it to get needed colostrum during this time. Calves need to receive colostrum from the dam as soon as possible (preferably within the first 30 minutes) after birth. With each passing hour, the amount of colostrum in the dam's milk declines along with the calf's ability to absorb colostrum. Newborn calves have limited immune function.

Colostrum is important for building calf immunity and resistance to diseases such as scours and pneumonia. It is preferable that a calf receive colostrum by nursing its dam. However, a calf that has undergone a difficult birth or has not had an opportunity to nurse within one to two hours after birth should be fed colostrum.

Calf Processing Supplies

Make sure calf processing supplies are on hand before entering the pasture or pen to process newborn calves. Every cattle farmer needs the following supplies on hand during calving season: disposable obstetrical sleeves, obstetrical chains and handles, mechanical calf pullers, injectable antibiotics, lubricant, and disinfectant. Other helpful items to have around are flashlights, old towels and even a bucket of non detergent soap and warm water. If possible, make up a portable kit so you can quickly move your supplies to wherever your cow is calving.

Spending a little time preparing for calving now can pay dividends later. Now is the time to do a precalving walk-through of your pens, chutes and calving stalls if you use them. All equipment and calving areas should be clean and ready to use. It's always better to prepare these items in the light of day rather than scrambling to make them right at night when the first calf in on its way out.

Beef - It's What's For Pinner!



Classic Beef Sloppy Joes

1 pound ground beef (93% or leaner)

1 cup minced sweet onion

1 cup minced green bell pepper

1 14.5-ounce can unsalted tomato sauce

1/4 cup barbecue sauce

1/4 cup ketchup

1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

2 teaspoons packed brown sugar

1 teaspoon dry mustard

4 whole wheat hamburger buns or 8 slider buns

Toppings (optional)

Dill pickle slices, coleslaw, American or Cheddar cheese slices

Heat large nonstick skillet over medium heat until hot. Add onion, cook for three to five minutes until golden brown. Add ground beef and bell pepper; cook eight to ten minutes, breaking beef into 1/2-inch crumbles and stirring occasionally. Stir in tomato sauce, barbecue sauce, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce, brown sugar and mustard; increase heat to medium-high. Bring to a boil; cook five to ten minutes or until sauce is thickened, stirring occasionally. Season with salt, as desired. Divide beef mixture evenly among buns. Top with pickles, coleslaw and cheese, if desired. Close sandwiches and enjoy.

Salisbury Steak with Beef Gravy

1 pound ground beef (93% or leaner)

1/2 teaspoon pepper

1 teaspoon vegetable oil

1 tablespoon butter

8 ounces mushrooms, sliced

1/2 cup finely chopped onions

2 tablespoons cornstarch

2 cups reduced-sodium beef broth

 $1\ table spoon\ Worce stershire\ sauce$

1 teaspoon beef bouillon granules

Combine ground beef and pepper in medium bowl, mixing lightly but thoroughly. Lightly shape beef mixture unto four 1/2-inch thick oval patties. Heat oil in large nonstick skillet over medium heat until hot. Place patties in skillet; cook ten to twelve minutes or until instant-read thermometer inserted horizontally into centers registers 160 degrees, turning occasionally. Remove patties from skillet; keep them warm. Heat butter in same skillet. Add mushrooms and onions; cook and stir three to four minutes until tender. Dissolve cornstarch in broth. Add broth mixture to skillet; bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat; cook three to four minutes until thickened. Stir in Worcestershire sauce and bouillon granules; cook two minutes. Return patties to skillet; heat through. Serve Salisbury steaks with gravy and your favorite vegetables and mashed potatoes, if desired.

Beef Breakfast Waffles with Mango Syrup

12 ounces cooked beef steak, cut into thin slices

1 mango, finely diced

1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and diced

1/4 cup real maple syrup

2 teaspoons lime juice

4 frozen waffles, toasted

1 tablespoon chopped fresh mint

Additional real maple syrup

Combine beef, mango, jalapeno pepper, and maple syrup in small saucepan. Bring to a boil and cook five to seven minutes or until sauce is consistency of syrup and beef is heated through. Remove from heat and stir in lime juice. Evenly top each waffle with beef and mango syrup. Garnish with mint and drizzle with additional maple syrup as desired.

Smoked Beef Sausage and Potato Chowder

 $1\ \mathrm{pound}\ \mathrm{fully\text{-}cooked}$ smoked beef sausage, thinly sliced

15-ounce package cheesy scalloped potatoes

 $2 \ cups \ frozen \ mixed \ vegetables$

1 14.5-ounce can ready-to-serve onion-flavored beef broth

1 cup water

2 cups milk

2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

Fresh parsley sprigs

Heat stockpot over medium-high heat until hot. Add sausage; cook and stir five minutes or until browned. Pour off drippings. Add potatoes from package, mixed vegetables, broth and water; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; whisk in sauce mix until blended. Cover and simmer over low heat twelve minutes or until potatoes are tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in milk; cook uncovered, over medium heat one minute or just until heated through (do not boil). Remove from heat and stir in chopped parsley and pepper. Garnish with parsley sprigs.

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Farmer Feature - Commissioner of Insurance and State Fire Marshal Mike Chaney

When people think of the agricultural products grown in Mississippi, lemons are usually the last crop that comes to mind. Commissioner of Insurance and State Fire Marshal Mike Chaney is striving to change that perception by distributing his Mississippi grown Meyer lemons around the state capitol.

At his home in Vicksburg, Chaney tends to an 18 foot lemon tree that produces an average of 100 softball size lemons a year. He began growing lemons after a neighbor brought him two lemon trees from Florida more than 10 years ago.

The two trees lived in pots for several years before Chaney planted them in the ground eight years ago.

"The trees were two and a half feet tall when I planted them in the ground," he said.

After one tree died, he diligently cared for the other so that it would eventually produce fruit.

"Each year as the tree grows, the lemons grow higher up," Chaney said.

In addition to his lemon tree, Chaney also grows two and a half acres of blueberries every year.

Mississippi Longleaf Pine Initiative Continues

The United States Department of Agriculture/Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) has financial assistance available to qualified Mississippi landowners wanting to create or restore longleaf pine stands on their land. This Longleaf Pine Initiative (LLPI) is offered under the Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP) to qualified landowners and forest managers in Central and Southern Mississippi working to restore longleaf ecosystems.

Longleaf pine forests nearly vanished, but a coordinated conservation effort led by NRCS and other conservation partners is helping this unique ecosystem of the Southeast recover. Longleaf pines provide valuable forest products, pine straw production, scenic beauty, good wildlife habitat and harbor many threatened and endangered species. There are 29 threatened and endangered species that depend on these forests for survival. Two specific species are found in Mississippi, the gopher tortoise and the black pine snake.

"NRCS is committed to working with land managers to help restore and expand this critical ecosystem," stated Kevin Kennedy, acting NRCS state conservationist for Mississippi. "Longleaf pine forests provide vital habitat to a variety of species as well as valuable timber. We look forward to seeing what we can accomplish with our partners."

NRCS provides technical and financial assistance to help landown-



ers and land managers plant and manage longleaf forests. LLPI is in its eighth year and has helped restore more than 350,000 acres of longleaf forests.

Applications for all NRCS financial assistance programs are accepted on a continuous sign-up process with specific sign-up deadlines being established to rank, contract and fund qualified tracts of land. Applications for the Longleaf Pine Initiative received by **March 16, 2018** will be considered for funding in the first ranking period.
