Sensational Spring Salads



Mom's Green Bean Salad

1/2 pound fresh green beans, trimmed
2 tablespoons walnuts, chopped
2 tablespoons red onion, chopped
1 tablespoon olive oil
1 teaspoon red wine vinegar
1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
salt and pepper

Place a steamer basket in a large pot of water, and bring to a boil. Add green beans and steam for about 4 minutes. Transfer to a bowl. Add the walnuts and onion to the green beans. In a small mixing bowl, whisk together the oil, vinegar and mustard. Toss the dressing with the green beans. Season with salt and pepper.

Best Ever Egg Salad

6 large hard-boiled eggs, peeled and coarsely chopped
3 tablespoons celery, finely chopped
1 tablespoon red onion, finely chopped
1 tablespoon parsley, chopped
2 tablespoons pimento-stuffed green olives, chopped (optional)
1/3 cup mayonnaise
1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Combine chopped eggs, celery, onion, parsley and olives in a bowl. Mix in mayonnaise and mustard. Season with salt and pepper.

Tip & Notice: Add bacon to your egg salad sandwich for a savory twist.

Loaded Garden Salad

2 cups chopped romaine lettuce
1 small bell pepper, diced
1 avocado, diced
1 cup sliced button mushrooms
1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
1/2 cup alfalfa sprouts
1 clove garlic, minced
1/8 teaspoon salt
1/3 cup reduced-fat sour cream
1/3 cup buttermilk
1 tablespoon chopped fresh chives
1 tablespoon chopped fresh dill

Toss lettuce, bell pepper, avocado, mushrooms, tomatoes and sprouts in a large bowl. Mash garlic and salt together with a fork in a small bowl to make a coarse paste. Stir in sour cream, buttermilk, chives and dill until combined. Drizzle the dressing over the salad; gently toss to coat.

Summer Spinach Salad

1-2 cups strawberries
1-2 cups blueberries
1 package (5-6 ounces) baby spinach leaves

Dressing
1 cup mayonnaise
2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
1/4 cup sugar

Slice strawberries and combine with blueberries. Mix fruit into spinach and place in large salad bowl. Mix mayonnaise, vinegar and sugar in a small bowl. Pour dressing over salad just before serving.

Tip & Notes: For an easy-to-assemble salad, cut your fresh berries ahead of time, and mix and store the dressing.

Potato Salad

1 1/2 pounds round red or white potatoes (about 6 medium), peeled
1 1/2 cups mayonnaise or salad dressing
1 tablespoon white or cider vinegar
1 tablespoon yellow mustard
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
2 medium stalks celery, chopped (1 cup)
1 medium onion, chopped (1/2 cup)
4 hard-cooked eggs, chopped
Paprika, if desired

Place potatoes in 3-quart saucepan; add enough water to cover potatoes. Cover and heat to boiling; reduce heat to low. Cook covered 25 to 30 minutes or until potatoes are tender; drain. Let stand until cool enough to handle. Cut potatoes into cubes. Mix mayonnaise, vinegar, mustard, salt and pepper in large glass or plastic bowl. Add potatoes, celery and onion; toss. Stir in eggs. Sprinkle with paprika. Cover and refrigerate at least 4 hours to blend flavors and chill. Store covered in refrigerator.

Ham Salad

2 cups finely diced or ground ham (about 3/4 pound)
3 hard-boiled eggs, chopped
1/4 cup sweet pickle relish
1/4 cup mayonnaise
2 tablespoons minced green onion
2 tablespoons minced celery
2 tablespoons minced red bell pepper
1 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley
2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
1 tablespoon lemon juice
A large pinch of cayenne (optional)
Salt and black pepper to taste

Mix everything but the salt, pepper and cayenne in a large bowl. Taste and add cayenne, salt and black pepper to taste. Serve chilled. Serve straight, or mixed in with macaroni, or in a sandwich in a hamburger bun, slider roll, Kaiser roll, regular bread, in a pita or as a wrap. Good with lemonade on a hot day.

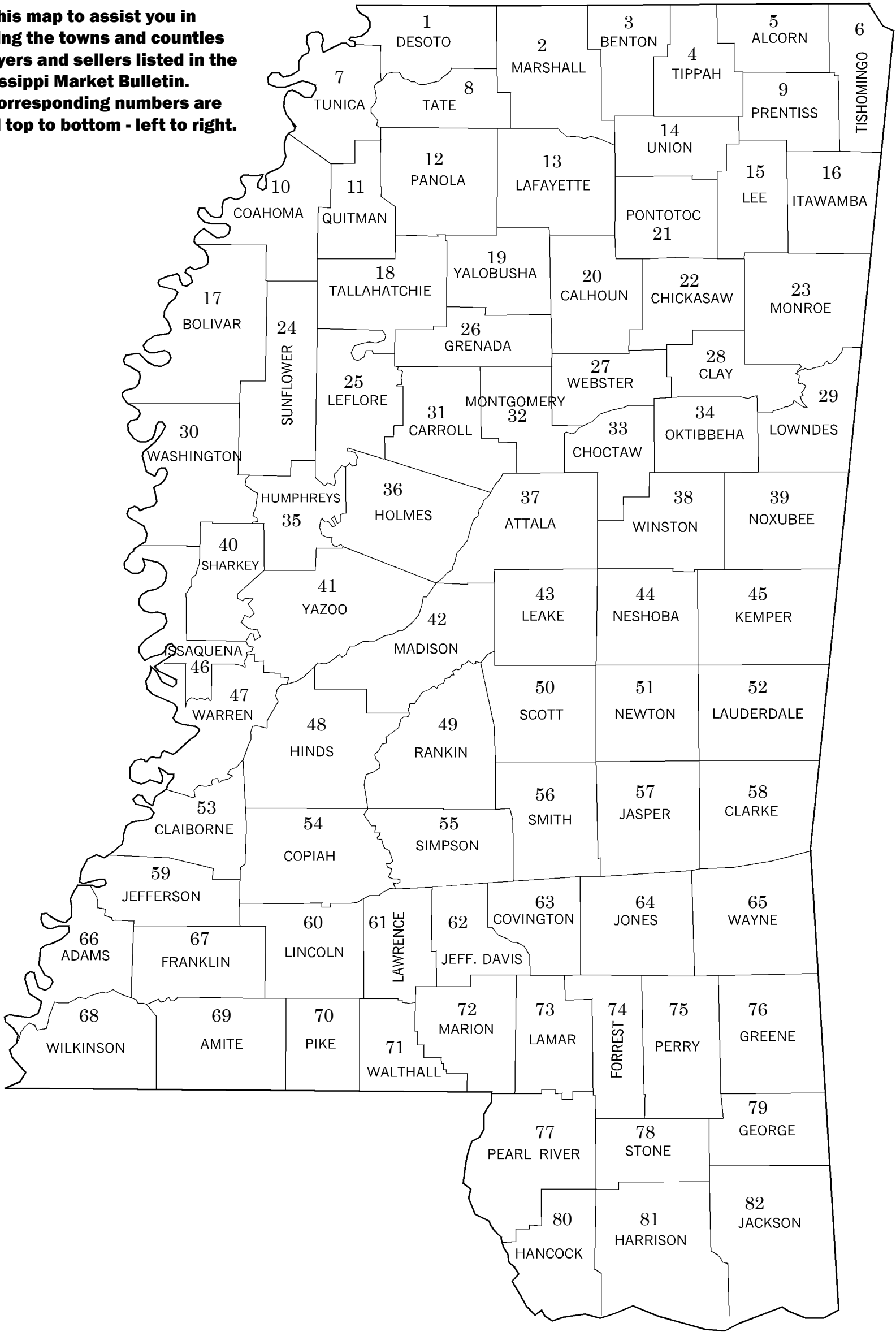

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Be Aware of Tractors, Equipment on Roads

Mississippi farmers are gearing up for the 2018 growing season, which means everyone needs to be prepared to share the road with tractors and other equipment.

Patrick Poindexter, Alcorn County coordinator with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said being aware and patient can keep everyone safe.

"If you have never driven a piece of farm equipment, you may not understand it's simply not as easy to maneuver as a regular truck or car," Poindexter said. "In addition to traveling at slower speeds, tractors and other pieces of machinery tend to have reduced visibility. Don't assume the driver can see you."

On Mississippi's rural roads, the danger increases.

"Drivers tend to get impatient and want to pass, but this can be a recipe for disaster, especially on two-lane roads," Poindexter said. "Some farmers travel with escort vehicles, which will require additional clearance. It's better to wait until the driver can pull over than to risk an accident."

Most equipment drivers are not going incredibly long distances, and they are aware of the need to accommodate other drivers when they can.

"Everyone getting to their destination safely is the goal, so take a deep breath, slow down, and instead



of being angry at the inconvenience, try to think about the hard work that goes into growing our food, fiber and fuel," Poindexter said.

Equipment operators have rules they must follow, too. Checking to be sure all equipment, including lighting systems, brakes, and tires, is in proper working order contributes to everyone's safety.

"Another key safety rule is one rider per seat at all times," said Charlie Stokes, Extension area agronomist based in Monroe County. "It's hard to say no to kids who want to ride

along with a parent or grandparent, but it's for their own safety."

Equipment should also display a slow-moving-vehicle sign.

"And when we say slow, we mean about 25 mph, compared to the 55-65 mph most people are traveling," Stokes said. "That is a big difference in speed when you come flying around a curve, talking on your phone or texting. So, stop driving with distractions, and put safety first. Your loved ones, or the loved ones of the other drivers on the road, will thank you."

Game Changer... Chronic Wasting Disease Found in Mississippi Deer

Shock. Disbelief. Denial. Anger. Acceptance. Get busy. This pretty much sums up my range of emotions after the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks released a statement that a 4-year-old buck tested positive for chronic wasting disease, or CWD, in Issaquena County in February.

I don't just study deer, I'm an active participant in the deer lifestyle. Delicious, free-range, organic venison is a staple on my family's supper table. Regrettably, I'm now facing all the questions my colleagues who live in infected states have been facing and wondering where we go from here.

CWD affects members of the deer family: white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, moose and caribou. It always kills the infected animal. CWD is in a class of diseases called "transmissible spongiform encephalopathies," that ultimately cause many holes to form in the brain -- hence, the name spongiform, or sponge. Infected deer lose weight and appear to just waste away.

A tiny misshapen protein called a prion causes the disease. This mutated protein actually causes other proteins to become misshapen, too, and that's how the disease grows in an animal. A deer can be infected with these prions for months or years without showing any symptoms. Most deer found with signs of CWD are adults over 2 years of age. It takes that long for the infectious prions to multiply to the extent that the brain suffers severe damage.

The disease is transmitted from deer to deer through the exchange of bodily fluids, most likely saliva. Therefore, officials with Mississippi

Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks immediately halted supplemental feeding in the containment zone (Claiborne, Hinds, Issaquena, Sharkey, Warren and Yazoo counties). Supplemental feeding doesn't cause CWD, but it certainly can facilitate its spread when deer eat from the same feeder.

Of course, we don't want any disease that hurts Mississippi's deer population, but there's another reason people are vested in understanding this disease. Scientists don't know for sure if humans can contract the disease from infected venison. Although there has never been a reported case of this problem, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend we exercise caution and never consume a deer that tests positive for CWD.

State wildlife officials don't know how the disease came to Mississippi and may never have an answer. They are implementing a CWD action plan that involves extensive sampling to get an estimate of the infection rate, as well as how far infected deer are found from the hot zone. We hope that very few deer will be infected and the spread of this disease will be slowed or stopped altogether. Some states effectively controlled the spread of the disease because they caught it early. But in other states, it had spread too much for effective containment.

Watch for many more articles in Extension Outdoors on CWD. In the meantime, we need to wait, learn and support the state officials as they implement their management plan.

To everyone who hunts deer, manages deer or is simply a deer enthusiast, remember Feb. 9, 2018. That's the day everything changed. In some way, CWD will be a part of our lives from now on. And so it begins.
