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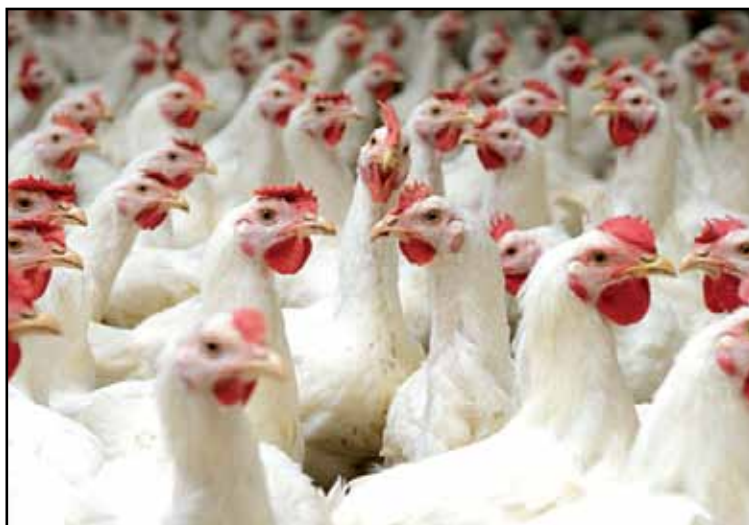
Production Costs, Demand Give Poultry a Strong Start

With low feed prices and healthy demand for broilers and eggs, the Mississippi poultry industry is poised for another productive year.

"Prices for feed grains have remained in line throughout the winter period, keeping production costs down," said Tom Tabler, Mississippi State University Extension Service poultry specialist. "This has helped keep chicken prices in the grocery store very favorable for consumers compared to beef and pork, chicken's two biggest competitors."

Corn and soybeans provide the bulk of grains used to feed chickens, and harvests in 2017 have kept prices



reasonable. Feed costs account for 70 percent of producers' input expenses.

Mississippi poultry integrators are looking to add production capacity to the state by building more broiler houses, Tabler said.

"Additionally, Laurel-based Sanderson Farms is constructing a new poultry complex in Tyler, Texas, while Tyson Foods is planning to construct a new complex in Humboldt, Tennessee," he said. "All these factors indicate that the poultry industry feels pretty good about its overall health, not only now, but into the future as well."

While broiler prices have risen slightly at the grocery store, egg prices have soared in the last year. An American Farm Bureau Federation survey conducted around Easter indicated egg prices were 37 percent higher than at the same time in 2017, Tabler said.

"Within the United States, 2017 saw a 20-year record in egg consumption at an average of 275.2 eggs per person," he said. "The increase in foreign demand was driven mostly by a 2017 avian influenza outbreak in South Korea that led to a 663 percent increase in American

egg exports to that country from 2016 and 2017."

Josh Maples, an Extension agricultural economist, said the national average for whole broilers was \$1.02 per pound for the month of March, an 8 percent increase from a year ago.

The average wholesale price for large Grade A table eggs in the 12-metro area is \$2.23 per dozen. The 12-metro area includes Jackson, New York, Philadelphia, Chicago, Detroit, Houston, Los Angeles, Atlanta, northern California, and major cities in Louisiana, Ohio and Wisconsin.

"Broiler prices have been above 2017 levels for each month during the first quarter of 2018," Maples said. "But egg prices are significantly higher than the 69 cents per dozen during March 2017. However, prices during 2017 were very low due to a surplus of eggs. Demand for eggs usually increases ahead of Easter, and a large increase in demand and relatively flat production have led to the strong rise in retail prices."

While the outlook is optimistic at this time, several factors can impact the trajectory of the industry's upcoming year, including weather and

collapsing trade deals.

"A cold, wet spring that keeps U.S. farmers out of the fields can dramatically shift the number of acres planted in corn or soybeans," Tabler said. "A drought in the Corn Belt this summer could drastically change feed grain prices by harvest time. Likewise, a crop failure in South America would have dramatic effects on feed grain prices in the U.S. So, weather is not only a challenge, it's a challenge we have no control over."

"If political tensions cause problems with trade with China, and exported agricultural commodities such as chicken, feed grains, chicken paws, and other poultry products become entangled in the situation, that could prove to be a challenge to the industry," he said.

However, producers are concen-

trating on the present with a sharp focus on managing risk.

"On the bright side, domestic demand for chicken and eggs is strong. Foreign demand for chicken and chicken products is also strong," Tabler said. "So far, the disease situation has been another bright spot, with no reports of highly pathogenic avian influenza in the U.S. this past winter. We aren't out of the woods yet, but every day we get closer to temperatures of 85 degrees on a consistent basis, and that will minimize the threat."

"Credit goes out to the poultry industry and commercial producers for implementing and following strict biosecurity practices that help protect poultry flocks," he said.

India Opens Market to U.S. Poultry



The U.S. Poultry & Egg Export Council (USAPEEC) recently reported India has opened its market to U.S. poultry. Mississippi broiler production is the number one agriculture commodity in the state. In 2017, Mississippi's 1,430 poultry farms produced 746 million broilers valuing \$2.5 billion. Mississippi ranks fifth in the nation for broiler production.

When Chicken and Eggs Come to Roost!



Chipotle Chicken and Egg Breakfast Burrito

3 cups prepared salsa Verde
3 cups diced avocado
2 tablespoons canned chipotle chilies in adobo sauce, minced
24 large eggs, beaten
12 (10-inch) flour tortillas, warm
1 1/2 pounds roasted, diced skinless chicken, heated through
4 cups seeded and diced tomato
3/4 cup canned, or diced green chilies (or jalapeno)
Cilantro sprigs as needed, for garnish

To prepare sauce, blend salsa, avocado and chilies (or jalapeno) in adobo sauce in small bowl. Cook and scramble eggs in spray-coated nonstick pan or on griddle until firm throughout with no visible liquid egg remaining. Portion onto center of each warm tortilla 2/3 cup eggs, two ounces chicken, 1/3 cup tomatoes and one tablespoon chilies. Sprinkle one ounce of cheese on each tortilla. Roll up tortilla, envelope-style. Serve with 1/2 cup salsa and garnish with cilantro, if desired.

Spring Chicken Frittata

4 cups cooked, diced chicken
8 eggs
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon black pepper
1/2 cup ricotta cheese
2 tablespoons butter
1/2 cup shallots
1 red bell pepper, diced (about 1 cup)
1 bag (5 ounces) baby arugula
1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a medium bowl, whisk eggs; season with salt and pepper. Add ricotta cheese and stir, leaving cheese in small chunks. In a 12-inch non-stick frying pan, melt butter over medium heat. Add shallots and sauté four to five minutes until softened. Add red peppers and sauté four minutes. Add one half of arugula and cook to wilt, turning with tongs. Add remaining arugula and wilt in the same manner. Stir in chicken to combine with vegetables. Pour egg mixture into pan with vegetables and chicken. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Cook over medium heat for about 10 minutes, or until edges of frittata are set. Place pan in oven and bake for 20 minutes. Remove frittata and allow to rest for five minutes before slicing and serving.

Grilled Chicken and Peach Kabobs

4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves
2 small zucchini, cut into 1/2-inch rounds
16 cremini mushrooms
3 ripe peaches, cut into eighths (may use frozen if fresh not available)
8 wooden or metal skewers

Marinade

1/4 cup olive oil
1/4 cup coarse grainy mustard
2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
2 teaspoons chopped fresh thyme
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
1 tablespoon orange zest

If using wooden skewers, place in water and soak for at least one hour. Cut chicken into one-inch dice. In a small bowl, whisk together mustard, vinegar, thyme, salt, pepper and zest. Slowly whisk in olive oil to combine. Thread chicken, zucchini rounds, mushrooms, and peach slices onto skewers, alternating ingredients. Be sure to leave enough space at bottom of skewer to hold and turn. Place skewers in a single layer on a sheet pan or baking dish and pour marinade over, turning skewers to distribute marinade. Cover with plastic wrap or aluminum foil and refrigerate. Marinate, turning skewers occasionally, for at least 30 minutes or overnight. Heat grill on high heat. Place skewers on grill and cook, turning, for about 10 minutes. Serve over rice.

Harvest Egg Salad

1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup finely chopped red onion
1/4 cup plain yogurt
1 tablespoon curry powder
1/2 tablespoon lemon juice
8 large eggs, hard boiled, peeled and coarsely chopped
6 ounces chicken, roasted and diced
1 apple, diced
Salt and pepper, to taste
4 pita bread, toasted
4 cups arugula
1/2 cup toasted pecans
1/4 cup pomegranate seeds
2 tablespoons chopped scallions

Stir together mayonnaise, onion, yogurt, curry powder and lemon juice until well combined. Gently stir in eggs, chicken and apple. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Cut each pita bread into four wedges, top with arugula and egg salad. Garnish with pecans, pomegranate seeds and scallions.

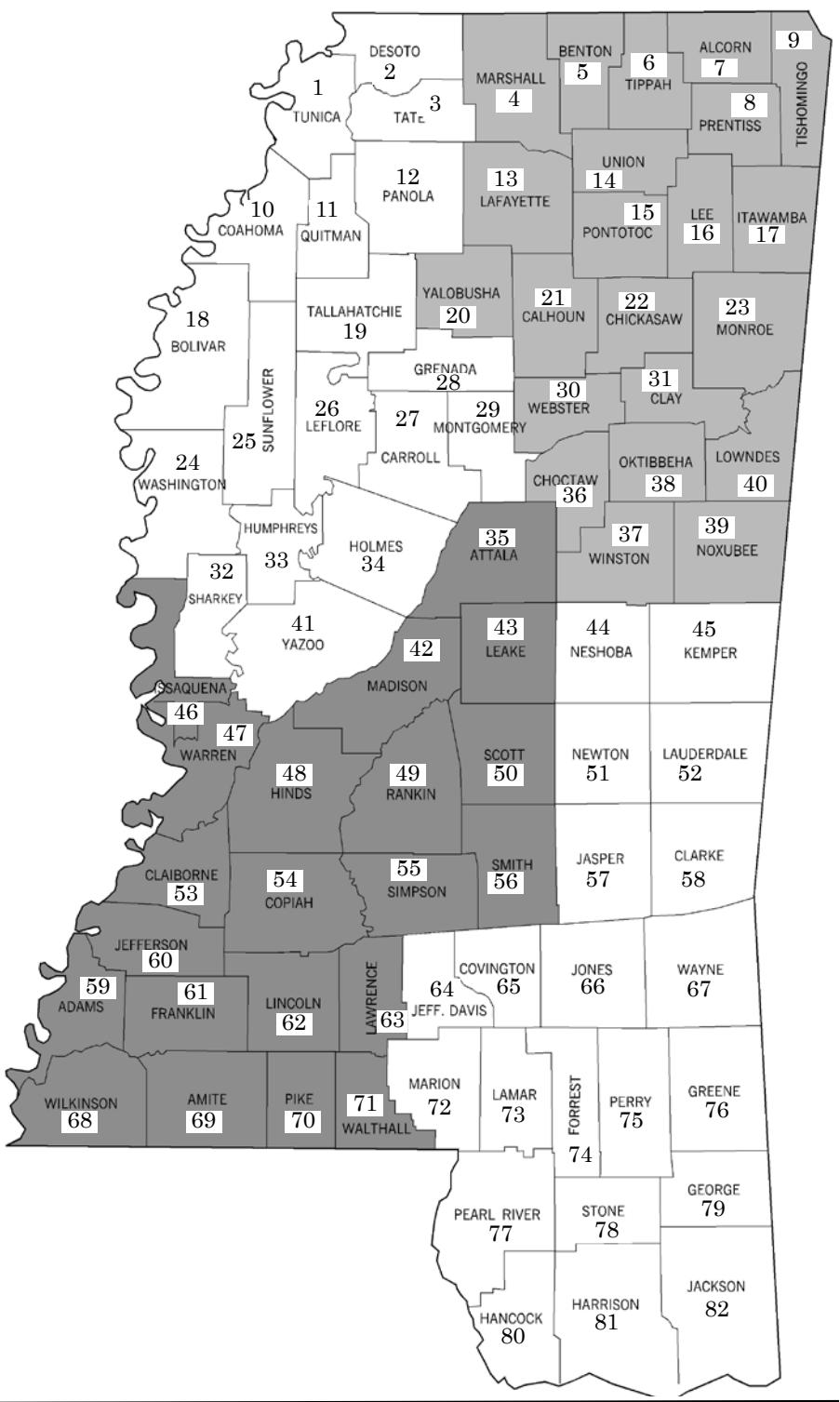



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Corn Planting, Progress Hindered By Cold, Rain

More than half of Mississippi's expected corn crop has been planted and is emerging, although cool and wet weather have made progress difficult.

Erick Larson, grain crops agronomist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said planting began in late March but has been hindered by frequent rains.

"Planting primarily began about midway through the third week of March, and every week after that, we've tried to plant as soils dry in between rain showers," Larson said.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture estimated 64 percent of the state's corn crop was planted by April 15. While on track with the five-year average, this amount is well behind 2017's early-planting season.

"Last year, we had nearly the entire crop planted from March 15 to April 20, but we're lagging behind that this year," Larson said.

The south and central Delta have made the most progress, while areas in northeastern Mississippi are further behind.

Larson said frost on April 8 and 16 may have burned some of the corn tissue above ground, but since the

plant's growing point is protected below ground, the plants will survive. A bigger problem has been continued cool weather in April.

"The crop is not making as much progress as it sometimes does because growth is dependent on heat unit accumulation, and we've not gotten the heat units that we typically do at this time of year," he said.

Warm weather in early May could allow the crop to catch up a bit. A crop that starts slowly reaches reproductive stages later in the sum-

mer when temperatures are higher, which can hinder good ear development.

In addition to frequent rains breaking up the planting season and cool air slowing plant emergence and growth, bird predation has been a big problem in some Delta cornfields.

"Too much predation can require a replant," Larson said. "Corn is planted at a relatively low population and doesn't compensate well for variance in the stand."

Mississippi growers are expected to plant about 500,000 acres of corn this year, just slightly below the 560,000 acres planted in 2017.

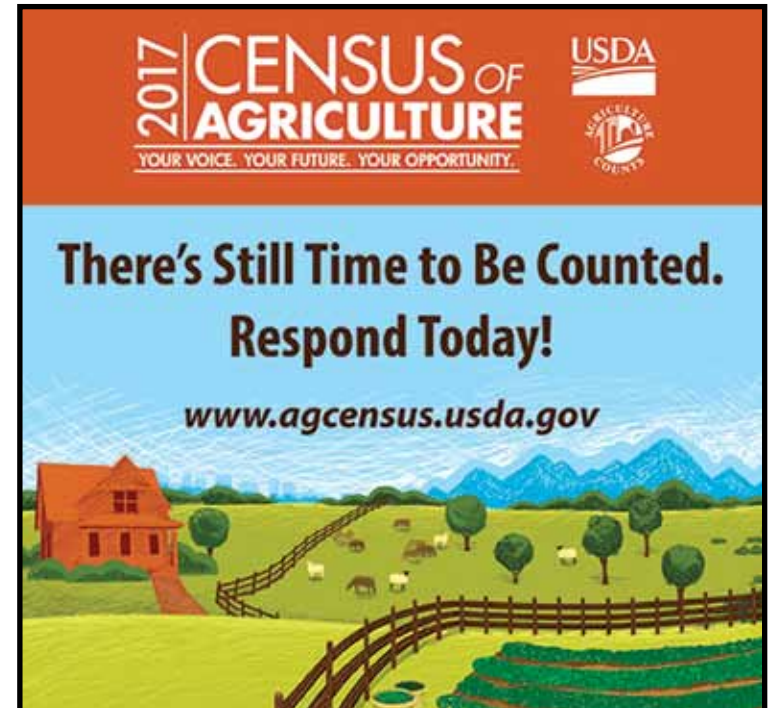
Brian Williams, Extension agricultural economist, said the two factors that drive corn acreage decisions are the price of corn relative to other crops and the costs of growing corn.

"The corn-to-soybean and the corn-to-cotton price ratios have both been working against corn for much of this year," Williams said. "The general fundamentals are much more supportive of soybeans and cotton, while the fundamentals

for corn have been much weaker, particularly with such large supplies of corn in storage."

December corn futures mostly trended up since January and are now trading at \$4.07 a bushel, which is about the same as prices at this time in 2017.

"The large stocks of corn in storage are keeping a lid on prices, but traders are watching the export situation closely as negotiations with NAFTA and China continue," Williams said. "For now, there hasn't been much of a long-term impact on the markets, but it has increased their volatility to a certain degree."
