## Sweet Potato Harvests Progress, Yields 'Fair'

Mississippi sweet potato fields that missed needed rains in June and July are experiencing favorable harvest conditions in October.

Jamie Earp, president of the Mississippi Sweet Potato Council, said yields are "fair, at best" at the halfway point in the 2018 harvest season.

"We just didn't get any rains when we needed them this summer," he said. "After North Carolina was hit by a hurricane, we thought it would help our prices more than it has."

While fresh sweet potato prices

have benefitted some from Hurricane Florence, Earp said processing-grade potatoes are not doing very well because of a supply surplus.

"Many of the processing-grade potatoes are not being removed from the fields and are going to waste," he said.

Stephen Meyers, sweet potato specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said prices and yields can be difficult to pin down.

"Hurricane Florence made landfall in the Carolinas at the beginning of the harvest season. Since North Carolina is the national leader in sweet potato production, much of what happens there impacts prices across the rest of the Southeast," Meyers said. "We don't fully know the extent of their in-field losses or the effect flooding rains will have on the crop post-harvest, but if the national supply is decreased and consumer demand remains constant, hopefully the unit price will tick upward."

Meyers said Mississippi producers planted about 25,000 acres, a slight decrease from the 28,100 acres planted in 2017.

"The decrease in acreage was in large part due to the slow movement and low price of the 2017 crop," he said.

Meyers said sweet potato transplanting operations, which began in May, tended to be ahead of historical norms. However, various fields transplanted in early June experienced poor plant stands or delayed development from heat stress.

"The Guava root-knot nematode is an emerging pest that has been present in North Carolina sweet potatoes for the last several seasons," Meyers said. "Missis-

sippi growers who import certified sweet potato seed roots from North Carolina are concerned and asking officials with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce to consider regulations to protect our crop."

Efforts to reduce the state's dependence on certified seed from other states are underway at the Pontotoc Ridge-Flatwoods Branch Experiment Station.

Meyers said the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station has developed a three-year transition plan for the Foundation Sweet Potato Program to increase availability of foundational material, reduce dependence on interstate transport of certified seed, mitigate risk and increase varietal selection.

## Mississippi Sweet Potatoes

\*\*\*\*\*



### Sweet Potato Bread

2 cups sweet potatoes, baked and mashed  
3 cups sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon  
1 cup chopped pecans  
1 cup margarine  
3 eggs  
3 cups flour  
1 teaspoon baking powder  
1 teaspoon baking soda  
1 teaspoon cloves  
1 cup white raisins (optional)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cream margarine with sugar; beat in eggs and vanilla. Add sweet potatoes. Sift together the flour, salt, baking powder, baking soda and spices. Blend with sweet potato mixture. Add pecans and raisins; mix well. Bake in two greased and floured loaf pans for 60 minutes. Remove and cool on racks. Wrap and store overnight.

### Sweet Potatoes Southern Style

2 cups mashed freshly cooked sweet potatoes  
2 tablespoons grated orange peel  
1/2 cup orange juice  
1/2 stick butter or margarine, melted  
1 cup white corn syrup  
4 egg yolks, slightly beaten  
4 egg whites  
3 tablespoons sugar  
Marshmallows (optional)

Mix potatoes, butter, grated orange peel, orange juice, syrup and egg yolks. Stir until smooth. Beat egg whites until stiff. Add sugar; stir and fold into potato mixture. Pour into buttered one-quart casserole; bake at 400 degrees for 20 minutes. Reduce heat to 300 degrees and bake for 15 minutes. Top casserole with marshmallows, if desired, and return to the 300 degree oven until marshmallows are browned.

### Sweet Potato Croquettes

2 cups mashed sweet potatoes  
2 heaping tablespoons butter  
3/4 teaspoon salt  
1 tablespoon brown sugar  
2 eggs, well beaten  
1 cup bread crumbs


Bake sweet potatoes until tender, peel and put through a sieve. Add butter, salt and sugar to potatoes; beat thoroughly. Form mixture into croquettes, dip in beaten egg, then crumbs and fry in wire basket in deep hot fat until done. Note: It is a good idea to place croquettes in the freezer for several minutes before frying so the mixture will stay together.

### Sweet Potato Gooley Cake

**Cake:**  
1 box yellow cake mix  
1 egg  
1 stick melted butter

**Filling:**  
1 8-ounce package cream cheese, softened  
3 eggs  
1 teaspoon pure vanilla flavoring  
1 16-ounce box confectioners' sugar  
1 cup cooked sweet potatoes, drained and mashed  
1 stick melted butter

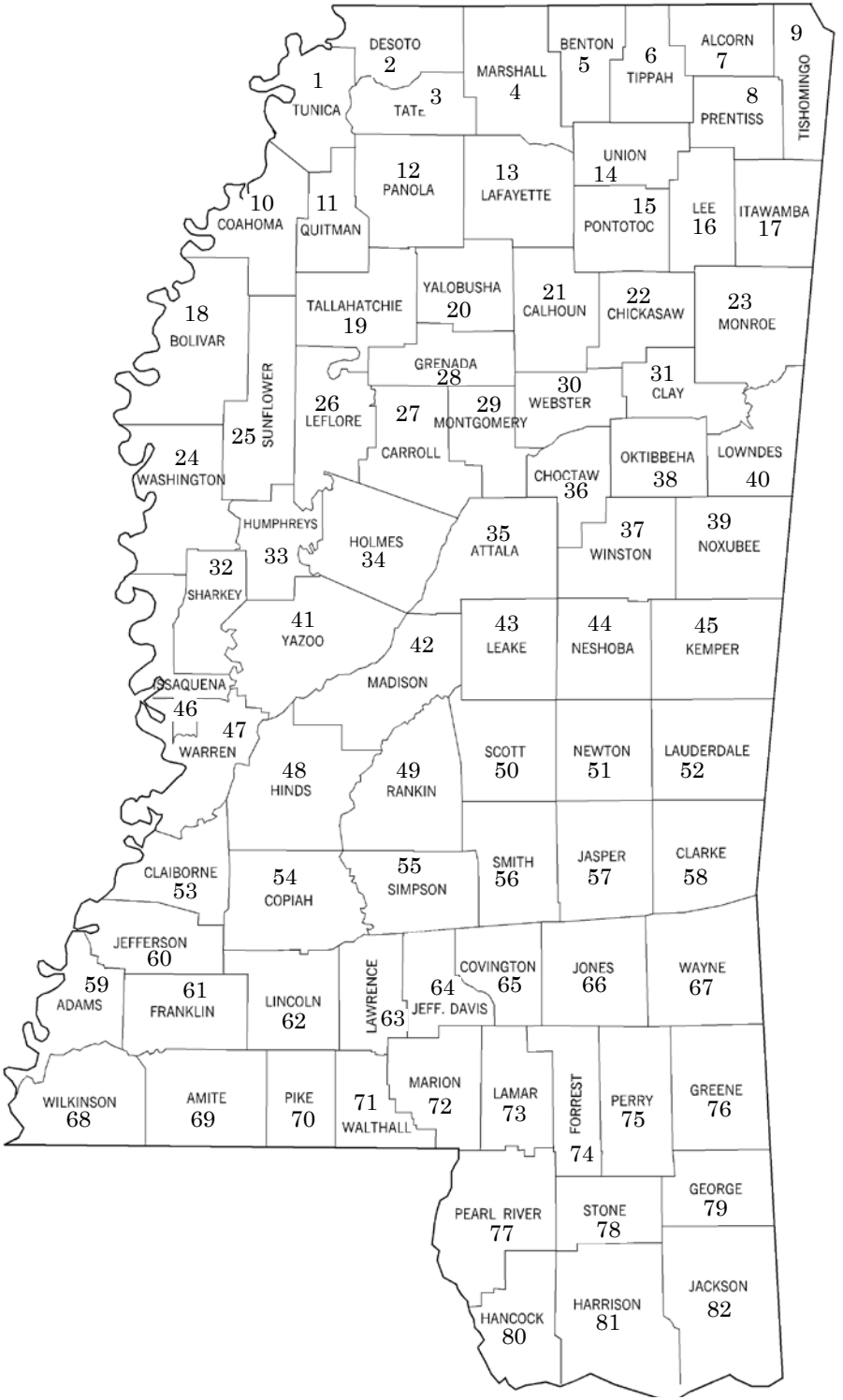



# Equestrian Team at Mississippi College Opens New Season at Texas State in October

Mississippi College's equestrian team riders face competitors like Tulane, Rice, LSU and Texas State in a new region as the Lady Choctaws saddle up for the 2018-19 season.

For MC senior Kaylyn Kimpel of Orlando, Florida it marks her final and fourth season in an amazing run.

"My story on the team has been a special set of circumstances that is a testament to how much the Lord has truly blessed me," Kimpel says.

Practically an inexperienced rider as a freshman, Kaylyn received a helping hand from upper class teammates from day one. "Whether it was tucking my hair into my helmet at show, giving pointers or cheering me on, they were there for me," Kimpel says. "That team molded me into the rider I am today and I will never forget all that they did for me."

At Fall practices, the riders train with swift horses. Capiche is among Kimpel's favorites. The horse "likes people, but isn't overly fond of other horses. He is one of the few around from my freshman year. We've definitely been through some fun show experiences."

During MC's first 11 seasons, other horses with names like Quint-essential, Hale Bopp, Mac, Quinn, and Laddie also helped the team shine as one of the South's premier squads. Head coach Mandi Powers and Ann Skogerboe, the equestrian program's new director, remain vital to the team's success.

Being a member of the equestrian team isn't for everybody. But Kimpel quickly discovered she belonged. "I love what I do, getting to go out to the barn and relaxing after a long day of classes."

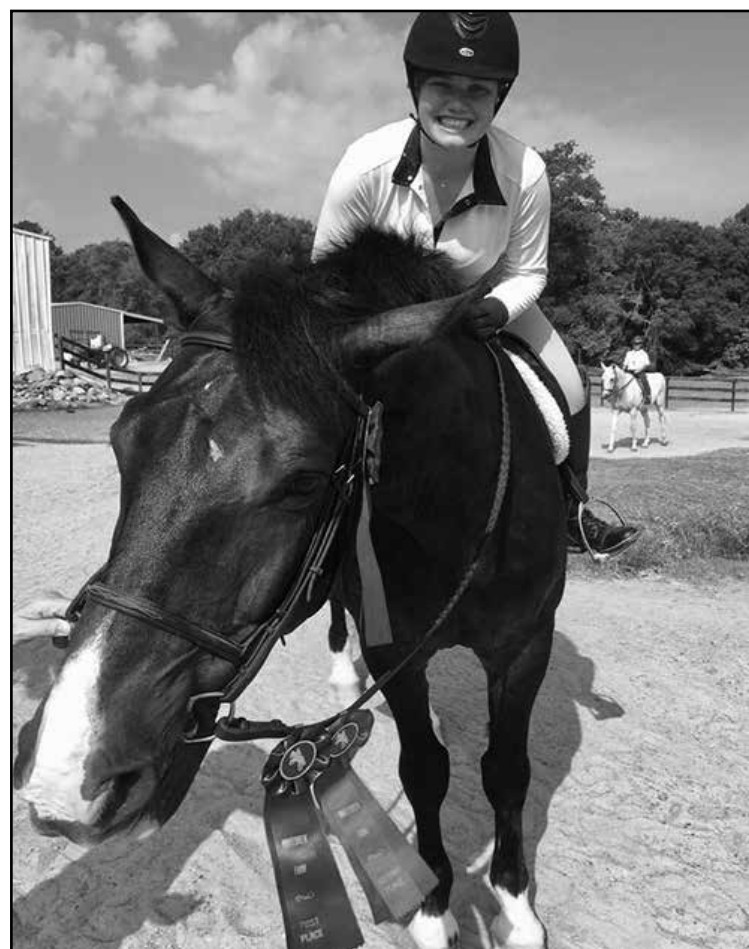
While hard work is involved all season, the Mississippi College riders are making progress. Winning ribbons helps. "Those ribbons make the blood (mostly bruises), sweat and tears totally worth it," Kaylyn said.

Senior Margaret Crigler is equally pumped about joining teammates for her final equestrian season. "My teammates, horses and coaches have become part of my family," Margaret says. "They encourage me not only in my pursuit to be a better rider, but also a better person."

Seniors like Kaylyn Kimpel and Margaret Crigler deserve credit for being team leaders, Skogerboe said. "We certainly appreciate the dedication and inspiration they have brought to the team."

Student-athletes on last year's team came from 10 states: Colorado, Michigan, Tennessee, Florida, Alabama, Louisiana, Tennessee, Illinois, Texas and Mississippi. The geographical makeup varies little for the MC equestrian squad's new season.

ens and goats.

Over the last 16 years, the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) have made successful efforts to increase the amount of Mississippi-grown fruits and vegetables served in cafeterias across the state through the DoD Farm to School Program.
