Poultry Growers Urged to Follow Biosecurity

All Mississippians who raise any species of poultry are being urged to follow strict biosecurity practices and review new requirements regarding sales and exhibitions.

Tom Tabler, poultry specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said that while bird flu is not a threat to human health or food safety, an outbreak would endanger backyard flocks and the state's nearly \$3 billion

commercial poultry industry.

"There have been some isolated cases of avian influenza in Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama and Georgia. Two cases in Tennessee were highly pathogenic, but all others were low pathogenic," Tabler said. "Regardless, we don't want any cases in Mississippi."

Tabler said biosecurity and avoiding birds that could be from infected areas are keys to keeping Mississippi flocks safe. Unfortunately, wild birds, especially migrating waterfowl, can also contribute to outbreaks. Avoiding them and their droppings is

critical to biosecurity.

"Anyone going near poultry should wear dedicated footwear or plastic boots. They should wash hands before entering and when leaving bird areas," he said. "People should even change clothes and boots after trips to any location where other poultry growers/keepers could have been, including farm supply stores, coffee shops and other locations."

Tabler discouraged growers from mixing new birds with existing flocks without quarantining the birds for 30 days.

"Purchase birds from National Poultry Improvement Plan, or NPIP, certified

healthy flocks only," he said. "Locations where different bird species -- such as turkeys, ducks or peacocks -- from unknown original locations are comingled have an increased risk."

Dr. Jim Watson, state veterinarian with the Mississippi Board of Animal Health, said the state is enforcing existing regulations at poultry sales and exhibitions because of the outbreaks across the Southeast.

"No poultry -- including chickens, ducks, turkeys, quail, pheasants and pea fowl -- are allowed from Kentucky or Georgia because of their current outbreaks," Watson

said. "Only Mississippi birds that are part of the NPIP program and have paperwork to prove it are allowed to be shown or sold at public events."

Watson said birds from states other than those two Southeastern states must have proof they are from an NPIP-Avian Influenza Monitored Program or have a negative avian influenza test.

Help prevent avian influenza in Mississippi



Currently, avian influenza (AI) is not a threat to human health or food safety in Mississippi, but wild birds (especially migrating waterfowl) pose a risk to backyard flocks and the state's nearly \$3 billion commercial poultry industry.

- Biosecurity is the key to preventing the spread of the disease.
- Wash hands before entering and when leaving chicken areas.
- Wear dedicated footwear or plastic boots when working with chickens.
- Change clothes before caring for chickens after trips to any location where other poultry workers could have been.
- Don't mix new birds with existing flocks without quarantining them for 30 days.
- Purchase new birds only from known NPIP-certified healthy flocks instead of locations where different bird species of unknown origins are comingled together, increasing the disease risk.

Watch for the following symptoms in flocks:

- Sudden death without clinical signs
- Coughing
- Nasal discharge
- Watery or green diarrhea
- Swelling around the head and neck
- Lethargy
- Purple discoloration of wattles, combs and legs
- Decreased egg production
- Misshapen eggs
- Twisted neck
- >10% of flock showing disease symptoms all at once

Chicken and Eggs – A Tasty Combination



Hearty Healthy Chicken Salad

1 broiler-fryer chicken, cooked, skinned, boned and cut into chunks
1 cup small macaroni, cooked
3 tomatoes, cubed
1 cup sliced celery
1/2 cup chopped sweet pepper
3 tablespoons chopped spring onion greens
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/4 teaspoon oregano
1 cup chicken broth
1 clove garlic, split
1/4 cup wine vinegar

In a large bowl, mix together chicken (while still warm), macaroni, tomatoes, celery, red pepper and onion greens. Sprinkle salt, pepper and oregano over mixture. In a small saucepan, place chicken broth and garlic; bring to boil over high temperature and boil for 10 minutes or until broth is reduced to 1/2 cup. Add wine vinegar and pour over salad, mixing well. Chill until cold. Makes six servings.

Pulled Pork and Egg Wrap

1 tablespoon unsalted butter
1/2 jalapeno pepper, minced
6 eggs, beaten
1 1/2 cups fully-cooked shredded pork in BBQ sauce, warmed
6 Boston lettuce leaves

Heat butter in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat until hot. Add jalapeno; cook one minute. Pour in eggs. As eggs begin to set, gently pull the eggs across the pan with an inverted turner, forming large soft curds. Continue cooking – pulling, lifting and folding eggs – until thickened and no visible liquid egg remains. Do not stir constantly. Spoon barbecue pork and egg onto each lettuce leaf, dividing evenly. Serve immediately.

Tea Time Chicken Tartlets

1 egg
3 tablespoons mascarpone cheese
6 canned artichoke hearts, roughly diced
1 cup arugula, chopped
2 cups finely diced rotisserie chicken, skinned
Salt and pepper to taste
1 teaspoon dried tarragon
8 sheets phyllo dough 14 x 9-inches

Beat together egg and mascarpone. Combine with remaining ingredients, except phyllo, mixing well. Cut phyllo into small squares and place in mini-muffin tins. Place one teaspoon mascarpone-chicken mixture in each phyllo cup. Bake in preheated 375 degree oven for 10-15 minutes. Serve warm. Serves eight for appetizers.

Egg Bruschetta

1 mini French bread loaf (1/2 pound), cut into 16 slices
2 to 3 tablespoons olive oil
1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt
1 4-ounce package goat cheese
1 7-ounce jar roasted red peppers, cut into 1 1/2-inch pieces
1/4 cup chopped fresh basil
4 hard-cooked (boiled) eggs, each cut into 4 slices
Salt and pepper to taste, optional
Additional basil for garnish, optional
Carrot sticks, optional

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Place bread slices on an ungreased baking sheet. In small bowl, stir together olive oil and seasoned salt. Brush evenly on bread slices. Bake bread for five to seven minutes or until lightly toasted. Spread approximately one tablespoon goat cheese evenly on each slice. Top each with two pieces red pepper. Sprinkle each with about 3/4 teaspoon basil. Arrange one egg slice on each. Sprinkle with salt and pepper, if desired. Garnish with additional basil, if desired. Serve with carrot sticks, if desired.

Crunchy Chicken Nuggets

1 1/2 pounds chicken breast or thigh chunks (40-48 pieces)
1/4 cup milk
1 egg
1 1/2 cups crumbs, crushed sour cream and onion potato chips
1/4 teaspoon thyme
1/2 teaspoon pepper
2 tablespoons margarine, melted

In a small bowl, mix together the milk and egg with a fork by beating slightly. On a piece of wax paper, place potato chip crumbs and mix with thyme and pepper. Line a shallow baking pan with foil and spray with vegetable cooking spray. Dip each chunk of chicken in egg-milk mixture; roll in seasoned chip crumbs and arrange in a single layer on foil-lined baking pan. Repeat until all chunks are arranged in the pan, and let sit for 15 minutes. Drizzle melted margarine over chicken and place in oven with temperature set at 425 degrees F. Bake about 30 minutes or until chunks are brown and crisp and fork can be inserted in chicken with ease.

MALTB Needs Help Locating Missing/Stolen Bull

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB), the law enforcement division of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC), needs help locating a missing bull from Copiah County.

On Friday, March 24, a Charolais bull was reported as missing to the MALTB from his pasture located on Old Natchez Road in the Hazlehurst community.

The bull is two and a half years old and weighs 1,200 pounds. It has short horns and is branded on the right hip with a "J bar" brand as shown in the photo to the right.

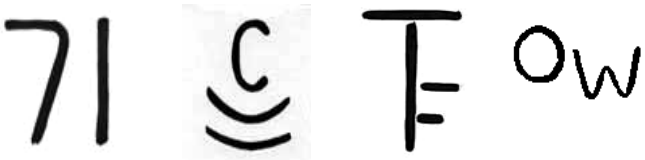
Livestock Brand Renewal Notice

Livestock Brand renewal notices were mailed in April 2017. All livestock brands which are registered within the state **must be re-registered by June 30, 2017**, in order to be a valid brand. Anyone who has not received a Livestock Brand renewal notice should call Jessica Spears, the State Brands Registrar, at 601-359-1159 or 1-800-678-2660. The registration fee for a five year period is \$5.00.

Mississippi Code 69-29-105 outlines the process for registering or transferring a livestock brand and the penalty for branding livestock with a brand which has not been registered.

Anyone interested in obtaining a NEW livestock brand should go online to msagtheft.org to download the brand registration form and send it to the Brands Registrar or call the phone number listed above. In order to transfer a brand to a different name, mail a letter requesting the transfer to:

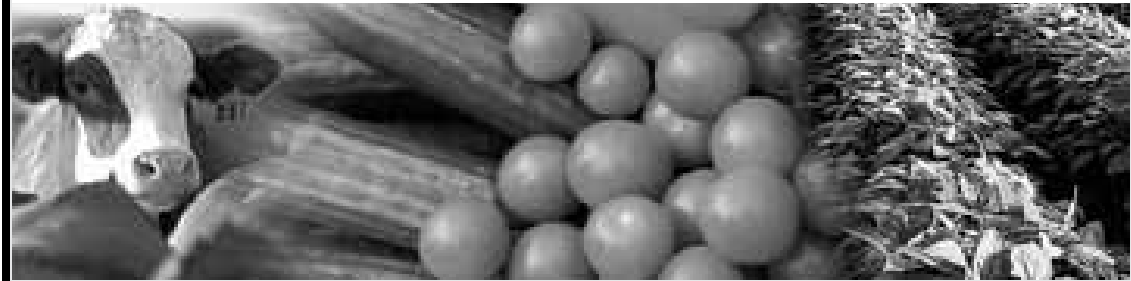
