#### **Grilled Cheese Harvest Sandwich**

2 slices multigrain bread

2 slices white Cheddar cheese

2 slices yellow Cheddar cheese

2 slices Black Forest ham, thinly sliced

10-12 apple slices, very thinly sliced (about 1/4 of a medium apple)

1 teaspoon Dijon mustard, divided

1 tablespoon butter, softened

Heat a nonstick or cast-iron skillet over medium heat. Spread Dijon mustard evenly on each slice of bread, then place two slices of white Cheddar on one slice. Place ham on top of cheese, distributing evenly. Add apple slices on top of ham layer, and then finish with yellow Cheddar and remaining slice of bread. Spread top of bread with softened butter and place that side down in heated pan. Cook for approximately four minutes (if necessary, turn the heat down so the bread doesn't burn). While sandwich is cooking, spread remaining softened butter on top of bread. Flip sandwich over and cook another three to four minutes or until lightly browned.

#### **Easy Skillet Creamed Corn**

2 tablespoons oil

1/2 medium onion, chopped

3 cups fresh, frozen or drained, canned whole-kernel corn

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour

2 tablespoons cornmeal

1 1/2 cups regular milk

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

Crumbled cooked bacon (optional)

Heat oil in a large skillet on medium heat; add onion and cook five minutes or until tender. Stir in corn and cook five more minutes. Sprinkle in flour and cornmeal, stir and cook one minute. Stir in milk, salt and pepper; keep stirring and cook an additional three minutes or until thick. Top with cooked bacon, if desired. Yield: Six servings.

#### Tangy Apple Cooler

16 ounces low-fat Greek yogurt 1 medium Granny Smith apple

1/2 cup orange juice

1/4 cup raw almonds

1 tablespoon honey

1 cup ice cubes

Peel and dice apple. Combine yogurt, apple, orange juice, almonds and honey in a blender; blend until smooth. Add ice and blend again until smooth and frothy. Serve in a chilled glass immediately. Yield: Two 10 ounce servings.

#### Homemade Peach Ice Cream

3 cups peeled, chopped peaches

1 1/2 cups granulated sugar, divided

1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice

2 cups whole milk

1 1/2 cups heavy cream

1 1/2 tablespoons pure vanilla

1/2 teaspoon salt

Peel, core and roughly chop peaches; place in a large mixing bowl. Add 1/2 cup sugar and lemon juice to peaches, stirring until well combined. Set aside for about an hour. Combine milk, cream, remaining one cup of sugar, vanilla and salt in a medium bowl and stir until sugar is mostly dissolved, about two minutes. Add milk mixture to peaches and stir well. Pour mixture into freezer canister of ice cream maker and follow manufacturer's instructions. If peaches are not in season, frozen unsweetened peaches work great in this recipe. Yield: 14 (1/2 cup) servings.

#### Grits Breakfast Bowl

1/4 cup dry quick grits

3/4 cup reduced-fat or skim milk

Salt to taste

1 egg, scrambled

1/2 teaspoon butter

Black pepper to taste

2 table spoons Cheddar cheese (2%), shredded

1/2 piece bacon, cooked, chopped

Combine grits and milk in a microwave-safe bowl. Mix until completely blended. Microwave on high three to four minutes or until thickened, stirring occasionally. Season with salt as desired. In a small skillet, scramble egg with butter over medium heat until cooked. Season with a pinch of salt and pepper, if desired. Place grits at bottom of a bowl, top grits with scrambled egg and sprinkle cheese and bacon over the top. Yield: One serving.







## Value, Volume of State Milk Production Falling

Fewer dairy cows than last year roam Mississippi pastures, so the state's milk production continues to steadily decline.

In the first quarter of 2017, milk production was down 7 percent from that time a year ago. From January to March of 2016, producers collected 42 million pounds of milk compared to 39 million pounds this year.

"This was primarily due to a lower number of dairy cows," said Mississippi State University Extension Service livestock economist Josh Maples. "There are approximately 9,500 dairy cows in Mississippi -down from 10,000 in the first quarter of 2016."

The value of Mississippi milk production is also falling. Last year, that value was an estimated \$25 million, down from \$32 million in 2015. As of 2016, the state had 83 dairy herds. There were 85 in 2015.

For those staying in the industry, there is promising news. Producers received \$17.97 per hundredweight of milk in April, which is an upswing from \$16.34 a year before. The U.S. Department of Agriculture forecasts higher demand and exports will drive the nationwide average price per hundredweight into the \$17.55\$18.55 range in 2018, an increase from this year's \$17.35-\$17.85 projection.

With dwindling interest from future generations in dairy production, however, fewer people are actu-

ally staying. Infrastructure -- including milking equipment companies, industry field specialists, dairy-focused veterinarians and nutritionists -- is also disappearing.

"The biggest long-term challenges dairy producers face right now are not having a next generation to take over the farm and not having infrastructure to support their industry," said Extension dairy specialist Amanda Stone. "The average dairy producer in the U.S. is about 55 years old. If no one is there to take over the farms in the future, there will be a rapid decline in smaller family dairy farms and an increase in herd size on larger ones that can add more cows to compensate for the lost herds.

"Dairy producers work 365 days a year because cows need to be milked multiple times per day every single day," she added. "They work hard and often see dairying as a way of life instead of a profession because it really does encompass everything they do."

Milk prices are still relatively low, Stone added, because nationwide production is up. Expected U.S. milk production this year is 216.9 billion pounds, which would be 4.5 billion more than in 2016. High feed costs and maintaining consumer markets are also challenges in Mississippi.

"Milk cooperatives have a harder time making money from small farms as well as when farms are spaced far apart and trucking costs increase," she said. "Dairies in Mississippi are small and spread out, making it difficult to maintain a market here and to find milk cooperatives that want to purchase their milk."

Mississippi dairy producers have the added challenge of oppressive summer heat and humidity -- two factors that cause stress and decrease milk production per cow. The average dairy cow in Mississippi produced 14,769 pounds of milk in 2016. The national average was 22,775 pounds per cow.

"Dairy cows start feeling the effects at a temperature humidity index of 68, which hits this state early in spring and often lasts through late fall," Stone said. "Cows housed inside are often provided with shade and sprinklers to keep them cool through evaporative cooling. Pastured animals are often cooled with shade, either from trees, portable shade structures or permanent shade structures."

Last year, that heat came with a dearth of rain in late summer and early fall, leading to a drought and forage issue.

"We are in drought conditions currently, but things are not as bad right now as they were last year," Stone said. "Last fall, producers weren't able to get their cows on ryegrass until almost winter. Luckily, we have gotten some rain, so producers are at least able to get out into the fields now."
