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Rice Harvest Totals May Eclipse Early Forecasts

Combines began rolling in Mississippi Delta rice fields as soon as growers marked the beginning of August, but wet weather soon shut down early harvest attempts.

Bobby Golden, a rice and soil fertility agronomist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said yields are expected to be favorable when fields are dry enough for harvest, though overall acreage will be

down this year.

"Our early crop, most of which was planted in late March and early April, looks good so far," he said. "Most rice was planted between April 15 and May 1, and that crop may be especially good with the low nighttime temperatures we saw in early August."

Golden, who is based at the MSU Delta Research and Extension Center in Stoneville, said the three-year average rice yield is about 159 bushels per acre. He said he expects producers will harvest that much or a little more.

"Most of the crop was planted on time, but we had a lot of early-season weather issues that delayed preparatory work such as levee construction and fertilizer application," Golden said. "We had enough good weather in the weeks leading up to the early

August rains to make up for the issues we had early on."

Mississippi producers grew 194,000 acres of rice last year. They planted an average of 180,700 acres from 2010-15, according to data from the U.S. Department of Agriculture National Agricultural Statistics Service. Golden said this year's harvest will be in the range of 100,000 to 115,000 acres.

The Aug. 7 USDA Crop Progress and Condition Report indicated that 91 percent of the rice crop was headed, with 20 percent mature. According to the report, 64 percent of the state's crop was either in good or excellent condition, with 35 percent classified as fair.

The rice market outlook is also sunnier now than three months ago, as futures have climbed steadily since they were trading



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for less than \$10 per hundredweight in May.

"September rice futures are currently trading for around \$12.20 per hundredweight, which is quite a bit higher than a year ago when they were trading for around \$9.65 per hundredweight," said Extension agricultural economist Brian Williams. "The most recent estimates are expecting national rice production of around 186 million hundredweight this year compared to 224 million hundredweight a year ago."

While the 2017 U.S. rice harvest will be down from 2016, global production is up, which could keep prices from increasing for the rest of the year. The value of last year's production in Mississippi was \$139 million.

"A big part of what is driving

markets higher is a significant reduction in acres due to spring flooding in Arkansas and Missouri," Williams said. "Harvested acres were reduced by 123,000 acres as a result. With that being said, global production is expected to be at near-record levels this year."

September is National Rice Month, and Delta Rice Promotions Inc. will mark the occasion with a rice tasting luncheon September 15 at the Delta State University Walter Sillers Coliseum in Cleveland. Praline Pumpkin Rice Pudding

1 12-ounce can evaporated milk, divided

3 cups cooked short or medium grain white rice

1 cup canned pumpkin

3/4 cup dark brown sugar, divided

1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 tablespoon butter

2/3 cup pecans, coarsely chopped

Reserve two tablespoons evaporated milk; set aside for praline topping. In heavy saucepan over medium heat, combine remaining evaporated milk, cooked rice, pumpkin, 1/2 cup brown sugar, pumpkin pie spice and salt. Stirring occasionally, cook eight to ten minutes, or until pudding begins to thicken. Pour into two-quart serving dish or individual dessert dishes. To make the praline topping melt butter in heavy skillet over low heat. Add remaining 2 tablespoons evaporated milk and 1/4 cup brown sugar; cook one to two minutes, or until mixture is smooth. Stir in nuts to coat. Spoon pecan mixture over pudding; serve at room temperature.

Tuscany Rice and Bean Tomato Soup

8 ounces mild or hot Italian turkey sausage, removed from casing 2 14.5-ounce cans diced tomatoes with basil, garlic, and oreganono salt added

3 16-ounce cans low-sodium chicken broth

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon fresh black pepper

1/4 teaspoon dried oregano

1 cup uncooked rice

1 15-ounce can Great Northern beans- no salt added, undrained

Brown sausage in three-to-four quart saucepan over mediumhigh heat, about six minutes; drain fat. Stir in broth, tomatoes, salt, pepper and oregano; bring to boil. Stir in rice and beans. Cover and simmer 15 to 20 minutes, or until rice is cooked.

Smoked Gouda and Spinach Rice Casserole

3 tablespoons oil

1/2 cup shallots, finely chopped

2 cups mushrooms, sliced

3 cups hot cooked long grain white rice

1 10-ounce package frozen chopped spinach, thawed and drained 2 cups smoked Gouda cheese, shredded, divided

1/2 cup whipping cream

Salt and pepper, to taste

Preheat broiler. Heat oil in large skillet over medium-high heat. Add shallots and mushrooms; sauté about six to eight minutes or until tender. Add hot rice, spinach, 1 1/4 cups cheese and whipping cream; stir until cheese melts and mixture is heated through. Spoon mixture into lightly greased two-quart casserole. Sprinkle remaining 3/4 cup cheese over top. Broil about two minutes or until cheese melts.

Mandarin Orange Rice and Shrimp Lettuce Wraps

1 11-ounce can mandarin oranges, drained, juice reserved

1 tablespoon vegetable oil, divided

3/4 teaspoon salt

1 cup brown rice

2 tablespoons bottled Thai sweet chili sauce

12 ounces medium shrimp, peeled and deveined

12 whole large lettuce leaves, bibb or iceberg lettuce

1 cup carrots, shredded

Combine reserved mandarin orange juice with enough water to equal two cups liquid. Bring juice mixture, one teaspoon oil and salt to boil in medium saucepan over medium-high heat. Stir in rice; cover and reduce heat to simmer. Cook rice according to package instructions. Stir mandarin oranges and sweet chili sauce into cooked rice. Meanwhile, heat remaining oil in large skillet over medium heat. Add shrimp and sauté just until cooked through, about four to five minutes. Arrange lettuce leaves on large platter. Spoon rice mixture into center of each lettuce leaf. Top with carrots and shrimp.

Rice Salad with Prosciutto, Figs, Gorgonzola and Walnuts

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 cup walnut halves

1 teaspoon ground black pepper

1/2 teaspoon salt

3 ounces prosciutto, thinly sliced

3 cups cooked medium grain brown rice, cooled to room temperature 1/2 to 3/4 cup good-quality Italian olive-oil & vinegar salad dressing 3/4 cup dried figs, chopped

3/4 cup gorgonzola cheese, crumbled

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a pie pan, toss walnuts with olive oil, pepper and salt. Bake until toasted, stirring twice, 10 to 12 minutes. Line a large baking pan with parchment paper or sprayed foil. Place prosciutto slices in a single layer on pan (don't worry if they tear). Bake until browned and crisp, 8 to 10 minutes, removing pieces as they are done; crumble into small pieces. Toss rice with desired amount of salad dressing. Stir in figs, gorgonzola cheese, walnuts and prosciutto.

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Timber Market Lags Now, Shows Long-Term Promise

The combination of a middling timber market, a pine beetle infestation and wet weather is doing Mississippi tree farmers no favors this year.

Fortunately, a new sawmill in the state and the prospect of increased manufacturing gives reason for optimism long-term.

Biewer Sawmill began operations this year in Newton. Glenn Hughes, a forestry professor with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said this indicates an upswing for the state's forest product industry.

"We've got plenty of trees out there right now because the postrecession housing market has been slow to improve, so demand isn't high," said Hughes, who is based in the College of Forest Resources at the MSU Coastal Research and Extension Center in Biloxi. "The new operation in Newton is a positive sign for the future, and I think it's the first of potentially several more mills."

Landowners have to monitor their trees to protect their investment. So far, private and industrial timberland in the state has dodged what the U.S. Forest Service characterized in an early August press release as a "severe outbreak" of southern pine beetle infestations on public national forestland.

Forest Service representatives said data collected from surveys and flights found more than 4,000 southern pine beetle spots in Mississippi national forest districts, and the agency has directed efforts toward cutting infested trees before the beetles can colonize new areas.

The Mississippi Forest Commission, which provides forest management services to landowners, stated in an August 10 press release that only 242 southern pine beetle spots were identified on privately owned forestland during aerial flights conducted in July.

Marc Measells, research and Extension associate with the MSU Department of Forestry, said southern pine beetles are currently the largest threat to the state's pine forests.

"I believe the southern pine beetle outbreak across the state, depending on the severity, will have a slight im-

pact on prices in the future," Measells said.

What's affecting prices right now is excess supply. Though average stumpage prices for timber vary widely across the state, they are lower almost across the board than a year ago.

In the second quarter of 2017, pine sawtimber was \$22 per ton compared to \$25 per ton a year before. Mixed hardwood sawtimber was \$39 per ton in the second quarter of this year, a \$3 decrease from prices in the second quarter of 2016.

"Landowners should keep in mind that timber prices change from day to day and location to location," Measells said. "Mill inventories and capacity, hauling distance, logging costs, the number of mills and the condition and quality of the trees being harvested all affect stumpage prices. The amount landowners receive may vary widely from state averages."

Second-quarter stumpage prices for pulpwood, which is used for low-end forest products such as paper and cardboard, are also down. Pine pulpwood and hardwood pulpwood were both selling at \$7 per ton in this year's second quarter, compared to \$8 per ton of pine pulpwood and \$10 per ton of hardwood pulpwood in mid-2016.

"Pulpwood prices are down, especially in north Mississippi, because we don't have a lot of mills in that area," Measells said. "Pulpwood that is being sold must be delivered a long distance, which reduces stumpage prices.

Sawtimber prices are affected by housing starts, which have remained relatively flat this past year."

Pine chip-n-saw held steady in that same time frame at \$15 per ton.

In 2016, the production value of Mississippi's forestry industry was more than \$1.4 billion. Whether that will be matched this year is too early to forecast now, Hughes said, given the wet weather the state has seen at times.

"We've had a lot of rain, especially in the southern part of the state. This slows down logging activity because the soil holds water for a long time," he said. "The result is a reduction in acreage available for harvest."

Reduced outside competition could help Mississippi's timber industry rebound. Sawmills in Canada, Hughes added, have exported lumber to the southeastern U.S. in the past, but beetle infestations are also posing challenges there. Canada is also shifting more of its exported wood to China so that country can meet domestic demand.

"Companies go where they find potential, and they can see Mississippi becoming a great place to grow timber," he said. "Current growers and people who purchase land for timber now will have a good investment long-term, despite current market conditions."

Mississippi has 19.7 million forest acres and about 125,000 forest landowners.

Free Workshops Cater to Private Well Owners

Mississippi homeowners with private wells have three opportunities to learn how to enhance the quality of their drinking water sources.

The Mississippi Well Owner Network, a program of the Mississippi State University Extension Service, will hold workshops at the Extension offices in Wayne County September 26, Pearl River County October 24 and Tate County November 16. Each workshop begins at 6 p.m.

Well owners in Wayne County can pick up a sample bottle and collection instructions September 18-22 and September 25 at 810-A Chickasawhay Street in Waynesboro. Pearl River County private well owners can get these materials October 16-20 and October 23 at 417 Highway 11 North in Poplarville. Sample bottle pick-up dates for Tate County residents are November 6-10 and November 13-15 at No. 1 French's Alley in Senatobia.

Private well screenings for bacteria will cost \$25 per sample analysis. A water screening is not required to attend the workshop, nor is attendance required to have water screened. Anyone planning to attend the workshop can bring their water sample then. For best

results, use the sample bottles provided by the MSU Extension county office.

Screening results will be mailed to the well owner, along with a publication explaining how to interpret the results. Each participant will receive free MSU Extension publications with information on private wells and septic systems.
