Color Choices Give Poinsettias Variety

Besides the Christmas tree, the poinsettia is the plant most often associated with the Christmas season. In their native Mexico, the bright red flowers of poinsettia are known as Flores de la Noche Buena— or Flowers of the Holy Night – as they bloom each year during the Christmas season.

If you're a fan of poinsettias but like variety, you'll find the range of poinsettia colors available is truly remarkable. Poinsettia is no longer simply "that red Christmas plant." Colors range from red and white to even maroon, making it hard to choose. In addition to solid col-

ors, there are bicolor, speckled and marbled poinsettias. There are even rose-flowered selections.

And if that's not enough, growers are changing the colors even more by painting and adding sparkles. When shopping for poinsettias, be ready for the wide variety of options and take your time to select the very best. Bracts should be completely colored and fully expanded. If not, the plants were probably shipped before they were completely ready.

You can hardly go wrong with these colorful "flowers" brightening your decorations. However, what we think of as flowers are actually modified leaves called bracts. The true flowers are the yellow/green bead-like structures called cyathia. Your poinsettia will last longer if you select plants with unopened or only partially opened cyathia.

In recent years, growers and florists have been using poinsettias in combination containers. *Southern Gardening* has promoted combining poinsettia with the Mississippi Medallion winner Diamond Frost euphorbia. Both are in the euphor-

bia family and have similar growing and care characteristics. Another combination to try is snow-white chrysanthemum with a traditional

red poinsettia.

Follow a few care tips to help keep your poinsettia looking good long after the Christmas holidays. Poinsettias need at least six hours of indirect sunlight and comfortable room temperatures. When grown in the greenhouse, the temperatures are about 72 degrees during the day and 60 degrees at night. The closer you get to providing these same temperatures, the longer your poinsettia will last.

Don't let the leaves or bracts touch window glass, as the low outside temperatures are readily transferred through the glass. Also, keep poinsettias away from frequently opened doors. It might look great by the front door when guests arrive, but if you want the plant to look great later, avoid the sudden temperature changes.

Temperatures below 50 degrees can harm the foliage and colorful bracts. On the way home with your

new poinsettias, be sure to cover them carefully, taking care not to break any branches or stems. Poinsettias are fragile, and stems can break quite easily from mishandling. Not only can the paper or plastic shipping sleeves hide damage, but you should pay particular attention when removing these. Never try to slide one over the plant, but always tear or cut the sleeve off.

The absolute most important thing to remember is DO NOT over-water your poinsettia. Poinsettias are sensitive to wet feet, and root rot sets in quickly. Make sure the potting mix feels dry to the touch before you water it. Remove the decorative sleeve around the pot, and water the top of the container over the kitchen sink. Replace the decorative sleeve after the water has finished draining.

Whichever colors and combinations you choose, be sure to brighten your Christmas celebrations with your favorite poinsettias.

From Our Kitchen To Yours

Christmas Morning Brunch Ideas!



Brunch Eggs

12 thin Canadian bacon slices
3 (4-ounce) packages shredded Swiss cheese
12 large eggs
1 cup whipping cream
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
1 teaspoon paprika
1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley

Place Canadian bacon in a single layer of a lightly greased 13x9-inch baking dish; sprinkle with Swiss cheese. Cover and chill, if desired. Break eggs over cheese, spacing evenly. Pour whipping cream over eggs, and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Bake at 425 degrees for ten minutes. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and paprika. Bake eight to ten more minutes or until set. Remove from oven; sprinkle with parsley. Let stand ten minutes before serving. Casserole may be divided into twelve portions and served on English muffins.

Cornmeal-and-Brown Sugar Cruised Bacon

1/4 cup plain yellow cornmeal
3 tablespoons brown sugar
1 1/2 teaspoons freshly ground pepper
16 thick bacon slices

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Combine cornmeal, brown sugar and pepper in a shallow dish. Dredge bacon slices in cornmeal mixture, shaking off excess. Place half of the bacon in a single layer on a lightly greased wire rack in a jelly-roll pan. Repeat procedure with remaining bacon, placing on another lightly greased wire rack in a second jelly-roll pan. Bake at 400 degrees for 40 to 45 minutes or until browned and crisp. Let stand five minutes.

Festive Fresh Fruit Salad with Mint-Lime Simple Syrup

MINT-LIME SIMPLE SYRUP

1 cup sugar
1 cup loosely packed fresh mint leaves
1/4 cup fresh lime juice

FRUIT SALAD

2 (16-ounce) containers fresh strawberries, halved
1 (6-ounce) container fresh raspberries
2 cups seedless green grapes
2 kiwifruit, peeled and thinly sliced

To prepare syrup stir together sugar and mint leaves and 1 cup water in a saucepan over medium-high heat. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally, and boil one minute or until sugar dissolves. Remove from heat. Stir in lime juice, and cool thirty minutes. Pour mixture through a fine wire-mesh strainer into an airtight container. Cover and chill syrup four hours. To prepare the salad gently toss together strawberries, raspberries, grapes and kiwifruit in a large bowl. Add 1/2 cup of the mint-lime simple syrup, and gently stir to coat.

One-Dish Blackberry French Toast

1 cup blackberry jam
1 (12-ounce) French bread loaf, cut into 1 1/2-inch cubes
1 (8-ounce) package 1/3-less-fat cream cheese, cut into 1-inch cubes
4 large eggs
2 cups half-and-half
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar
Toppings: maple syrup, whipped cream

Cook jam in a small saucepan over medium heat one to two minutes or until melted and smooth, stirring once. Place half of bread cubes in bottom of a lightly greased 12x9-inch baking dish. Top with cream cheese cubes, and drizzle with melted jam. Top with remaining bread cubes. Whisk together eggs, half-and-half, cinnamon and vanilla extract. Pour over bread mixture. Sprinkle with brown sugar. Cover tightly, and chill eight to twenty-four hours. Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Bake, covered, twenty minutes. Uncover and bake ten to fifteen minutes or until bread is golden brown and mixture is set. Serve with desired toppings.

Smoky Sausage-and-Grits Casserole

1 1/2 pounds smoked sausage, chopped
1/2 teaspoon table salt
1 1/2 cups uncooked quick-cooking grits
2 (8-ounce) blocks sharp Cheddar cheese, shredded
1 cup milk
1 1/2 teaspoons chopped fresh thyme
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
1/4 teaspoon black pepper
4 large eggs, lightly beaten
Vegetable cooking spray

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Brown sausage in a large skillet over medium-high heat, stirring often, seven to nine minutes or until cooked; drain on paper towels. Bring salt and 4 1/2 cups water to a boil in a large Dutch oven over high heat. Whisk in grits, and return to a boil. Cover, reduce heat to medium, and simmer five minutes or until thickened, whisking occasionally. Remove from heat; add cheese, stirring until completely melted. Stir in milk, thyme, garlic powder, black pepper and eggs. Stir in sausage. Spoon mixture into a lightly greased (with cooking spray) 13x9-inch baking dish. Bake for 50 minutes to one hour or until golden and cooked through. Let casserole stand for five minutes before serving.

FDA Produce Safety Rule

Rules affecting the production of produce for human consumption are around the bend. “Produce farmers in Mississippi need to be aware that a new federal rule establishing standards for the safe growing, harvesting, packing and holding of fruits and vegetables grown for human consumption goes into effect in January 2018,” said Commissioner Cindy Hyde-Smith.

The federal Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) was signed into law on January 4, 2011. FDA adopted the “Produce Safety Rule,” among other rules, pursuant to FSMA. The Produce Safety Rule applies to produce that is consumed raw. Produce that is not consumed raw, like sweet potatoes, is not affected by this rule.

“It is important that our farmers understand that these are mandatory federal requirements,” added Commissioner Hyde-Smith. “To help farmers achieve compliance with this rule, our Department has supported, through monetary grants, Produce Safety Rule training classes offered by produce safety specialists with Mississippi State University,” said Commissioner Hyde-Smith.

The rule sets standards in seven areas: 1) personnel qualifications and training, 2) health and hygiene; 3) agricultural water; 4) biological soil amendments; 5) domesticated and wild animals; 6) equipment, tools and buildings; and 7) sprouts. Refer to the chart for the compliance dates for most produce.



At the recent meeting of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture in New Orleans, FDA Commissioner Scott Gottlieb, M.D., made some new announcements regarding the Produce Safety Rule. Gottlieb told the commissioners of agriculture that, while large farming operations are expected to meet all produce safety requirements, except for agricultural water by the compliance date, FDA inspections to assess compliance with the non-water requirements will not begin until 2019. The FDA will focus on education during the first year of the compliance period.

Commissioner Gottlieb also announced that FDA has proposed extending the agricultural water compliance date for large farms to January 26, 2022. Small farms and

very small farms would have until January 26, 2023, and January 26, 2024, to meet the agricultural water requirements, respectively.

Animals Need Protection When Temperatures Drop

Although many pets and livestock grow heavy winter coats and have thick foot padding, they still need human protection when temperatures drop.

Here are some tips that pet owners and livestock producers can follow to keep their animals healthy and comfortable in extremely cold weather.

Dogs and cats, particularly those that live inside but often venture outdoors, are vulnerable when weather turns cold. They often need additional food and fresh water to maintain their body heat. Most large dogs can tolerate extremely cold temperatures if already acclimated to outside weather. Smaller-sized pets cannot.

Dogs that are kept outdoors should have a solid, protected doghouse or other shelter that keeps out wind, rain, snow and cold. The shelter should face south and have insulation, a blanket or hay for warmth. Keep bowls in an area that prevents water or food from freezing.

Protect your pet’s paws from salt. The salt and other chemicals used to melt snow and ice can irritate the pads of your pet’s feet. Wipe all paws with a damp towel before your pet licks them and irritates his/her mouth.

Keep pets off icy surfaces to prevent injuries from slipping. As sure-footed as they are, dogs can slip on icy steps and tear or strain ligaments or aggravate hip problems. They could even break a bone. If you would not feel safe walking in an area, the dog shouldn’t be doing it either.

Antifreeze and ice-melting chemicals often have a sweet taste. When these products accumulate in puddles on garage floors and sidewalks, the smell and taste often cause dogs and cats to lick these products.

Antifreeze ingestion is one of the most common and lethal poisonings seen in pets during winter. As little as one teaspoon is often fatal to dogs and cats that ingest this poison. Symptoms of antifreeze ingestion include drunkenness, listlessness, frequent urination and vomiting. If an owner suspects a pet has consumed antifreeze, take the pet to a veterinarian immediately for emergency treatment.

Animals that stay outdoors, such as horses, cows, goats and sheep, require additional feed, fresh water and adequate shelter to keep warm and maintain good health. At a minimum, producers should install a windbreak to prevent additional body heat loss.

As temperatures begin to fall in the winter months, livestock require additional energy to stay warm. This additional energy requirement usu-



ally calls for changes or alterations in feeding practices. This means that when the temperature drops below the critical temperature, the animals need to be fed better. It will be helpful to monitor weather forecasts to determine cold periods in advance and be able to increase the forage and additional supplements for the animals diet. Range meal, molasses tub products and protein blocks can help meet their energy requirements in extreme temperatures. Use caution when providing supplemental feed products to horses, and use products that are labeled for those animals.

Horses will better withstand winter weather if owners make sure their animals are prepared. The big thing is having the horse come into the winter months in tip-top shape. Horses should be up-to-date on vaccinations and on a good worming program throughout the winter months.

Regularly check horses feet, especially when the ground is muddy, because horses tend to get foot infections during wet months. While not all horses will need to be blanketed, blankets will help horses keep warm and dry, especially if there is any rain or snow. If you’ve body-clipped your horses, keep them blanketed throughout the winter. Horses that get blanketed can be susceptible to diseases and funguses that grow under the blanket, so remove the blanket regularly.

If horses spend a great deal of time in their stalls, make sure the area is safe, clean and free of mold and leaks. Buy quality hay and grain, and keep it covered. Feed your horses more forage, unlimited amounts if possible during extreme cold. This will help your horses create heat and regulate their body temperatures.

Extremely cold temperatures have a greater effect on livestock than humans, primarily because these animals live outdoors. Provide a healthy environment for your animals and use common sense to meet their needs during cold weather.
