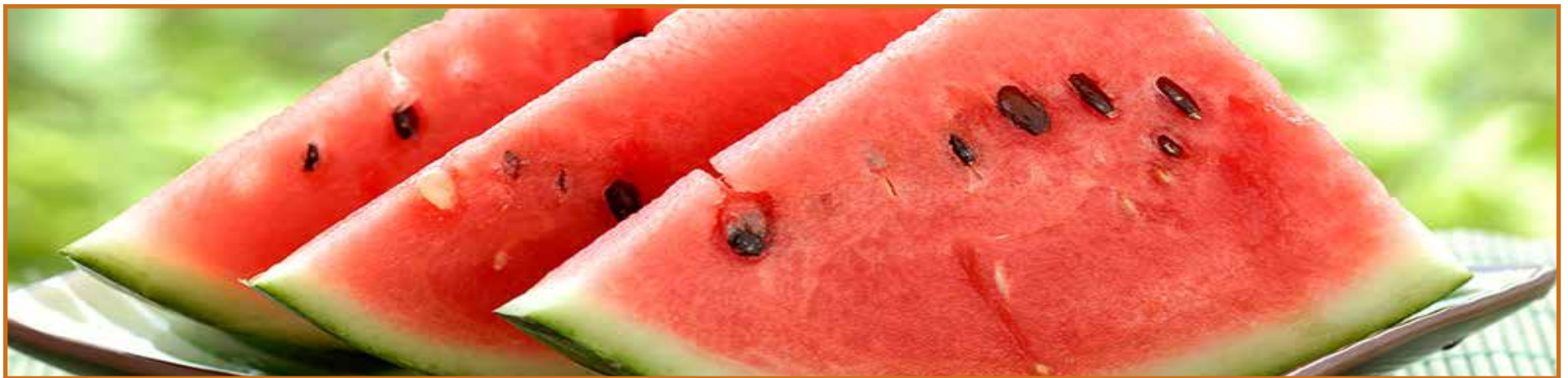

Watermelons Gain Ground as Soils Dry Out, Temps Increase

Some Mississippi watermelon producers lost crops or got a late start because of wet spring weather. But consumers should find the sweet, summer treats on shelves in time for the July 4 holiday.

"The crops in my county are a few days behind, but I have some growers who started harvesting last week and others who started this week," said Jeremy Maness, Mississippi State University Extension agent in Smith County.

According to the June 17 Mississippi Crop Progress and Condition Report by the U.S. Department

of Agriculture, 67 percent of the crop is in good condition, and 25 percent is in fair condition. Just 6 percent is rated poor.

Some producers in Smith County lost entire crops, while others are fine. Despite the wet weather, producers have not had to deal with disease yet, Maness said.

"We'll see an increase in the possibility for disease as temperatures rise," he said.

Kyle Jeffreys, Extension agent in Yalobusha County, expects 20 percent of the commercial crop in his county to be harvested by July 4. Producers were a few weeks late getting their watermelons planted, but improved conditions have fields looking good.

"The crop is doing well now that the soil is drying out and tempera-

tures are increasing," Jeffreys said. "Insect and disease pressure has been minimal at this stage of the crop. The only disease problem I have seen was gummy stem blight in seedlings in a greenhouse, and that was determined to be from an infected seed lot."

Growers have been fighting a few more weeds than usual because of excessive rain disrupting herbicide applications, Jeffreys said.

Seeded watermelons are wholesaling for 10 to 12 cents per pound, while wholesale prices for seedless watermelons are 20 to 25 cents per pound.

The 41st annual Mississippi Watermelon Festival will be held July 19-20, 2019 in Mize, a small town in southwest Smith County, which includes watermelon eating

contest, seed spitting contest, and the biggest watermelon contest. It's a time to eat all the watermelon you can handle, compete in watermelon games, contests,

Watermelon Facts

- Watermelon is 92% water
 - Watermelons are both a fruit and a vegetable
 - The United States currently ranks 6th in worldwide production of watermelon. Many states grow watermelons with Florida, Texas, California, Georgia and Arizona consistently leading the country in production
 - A watermelon's stripes are indicators of variety, but with over 1,200 varieties grown in 96 countries worldwide, there are many, many variations. In fact, some watermelons don't even have stripes
 - A watermelon takes about 90 days to grow, from planting to harvesting.
 - Once cut from the vine, a watermelon has about 3-4 weeks of shelf life.

Wondrous Watermelon

Watermelon Pie

Prepared pie crusts (graham cracker or vanilla wafer)
5 cups pureed, strained watermelon juice (approximately half of a large watermelon)
4 envelopes unflavored gelatin (1 ounce total)
1 lemon, zested and juiced
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup heavy cream

Separate two cups of watermelon juice into a microwave-safe container and pour the gelatin packets on top. Allow the gelatin to bloom for about two to three minutes. In a mixing bowl, combine the remaining three cups of watermelon juice with lemon zest, lemon juice, sugar and cream. Whisk until sugar is completely dissolved. Place the gelatin/juice mixture in the microwave and heat for two minutes on high, stirring midway to help dissolve the gelatin entirely. Slowly whisk the warm gelatin mix into the other mixture. Once combined, pour into the prepared pie crusts and refrigerate several hours or overnight. Serve chilled with whipped cream.

Watermelon Lemonade Jam

3 cups watermelon puree (juice and flesh)
1/4 cup apple cider vinegar
Juice from 1/2 lemon
1 cup sugar
3 tablespoons of low sugar pectin
3 8-ounce jelly jars with lids

Remove rinds and puree all watermelon flesh and juice in blender with apple cider vinegar and lemon juice, until fruit is smooth (consistent in texture). Add the pectin and blend quickly to evenly incorporate. In a large pan simmer mixture for five minutes on medium-low heat. Increase temperature to medium-high heat until mixture reaches a full boil (that can't be stopped when stirring) and hold it for a minute. Slowly incorporate sugar. Return to a full boiling and hold at hard boil for one minute. This mixture makes about three eight-ounce jars. Pour jam into small glass jars and place a lid on each. Be careful as the jam will be very hot. Allow jam to cool to room temperature and then keep in the refrigerator for up to two weeks.

Kids Watermelon Grape Fizz

1 cup seedless watermelon puree
1/4 cup grape juice
3/4 cup sparkling water
1 serving crushed ice

Mix together the watermelon puree and grape juice in an oversized tumbler. Add the sparkling water, and then the ice, which causes a nice fizz. Serve immediately.



Watermelon Crab Cups

8 watermelon cups (see below)
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup sweet pickle relish
1 teaspoon minced fresh dill
1/2 cup chopped celery
1/2 cup chopped scallions
2 eggs hard-boiled, chopped or grated
1 pound cooked crabmeat, rinsed and picked over for shells

Make the watermelon cups by cutting three-inch tall and three-inch wide cylinders of seedless watermelon. Hollow out the cylinders to form 'cups' reserving the watermelon from the center for another use or to snack on while cooking. Once the cups are made, keep them on a paper towel until ready to fill and serve. The cups can be made ahead of time, covered on a tray and refrigerated until ready. Make the filling by mixing together the mayonnaise, relish, dill, celery, scallions and hard-boiled eggs. Fold in the crabmeat. Fill the watermelon cups and enjoy.

Watermelon Prosciutto Brie Fingers

24 pinky finger sized seedless watermelon rectangles
24 thin Brie slices about the same dimensions as the watermelon fingers
24 slices prosciutto ham

Place a piece of Brie on top of each watermelon finger and wrap each with a slice of ham. Secure with a toothpick.

Watermelon Raspberry Vinaigrette

1 cup cubed seedless watermelon
1/2 cup fresh or frozen raspberries
2 tablespoons honey
1 tablespoon raspberry vinegar

In a blender or food processor, process watermelon and raspberries until the mixture is liquid. Add honey and vinegar, pulse until blended. Cover and store in refrigerator. Shake well before using.

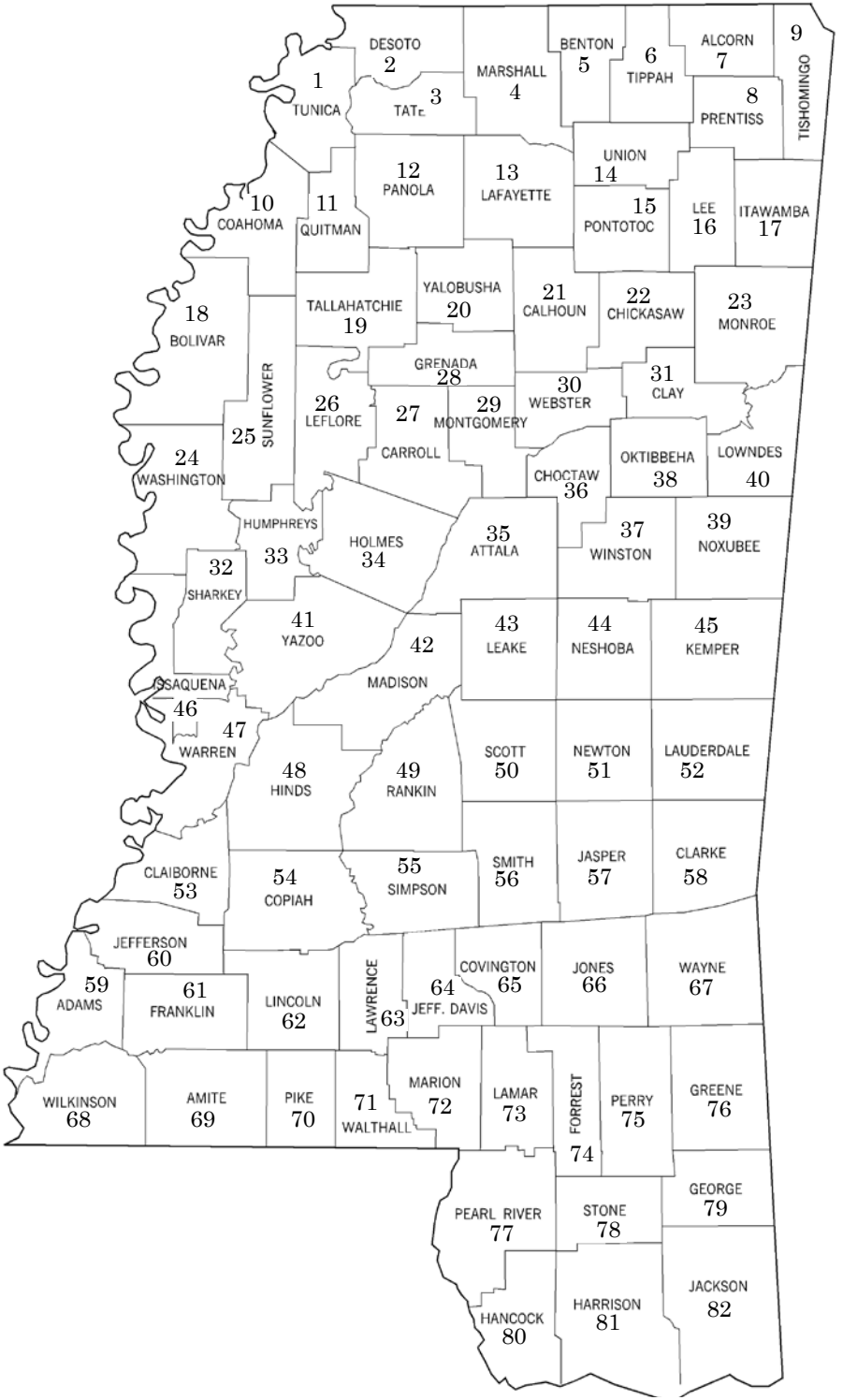

MDAC Seed Lab: Ensuring Seed Quality for Farmers

Farmers face many uncertainties each year as they plant crops—weather, market variability, and rising input costs. In addition, this year many farmers in the Delta are dealing with devastating floodwater hindering their ability to plant. The purchase of good quality seed is vital to a farmer’s production impacting their profitability. The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) Seed Testing Laboratory located at the Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) strives to help farmers alleviate some uncertainties by providing reliable information about the quality of seed being planted.

Early testing of soybean seeds at the Seed Testing Laboratory showed weaker germination percentages than in previous years due to the wet weather pattern in 2018. This wet weather pattern, which covered most of the seed production areas of the country, prolonged the 2018 soybean harvest. Seed stayed in the field longer than normal going through several cycles of drying and getting wet. This caused the seed to shrink and swell multiple times, which led to higher than normal amounts of damage to both the seed coat and to vital areas of the seed. Damage included cracked seed coats and weak shriveled seed, and some of the seed that appeared normal had internal cracking that wasn’t readily visible.



Damaged seeds, such as these, are not able to produce a viable plant when germinated.

As a result of the weaker germination percentages found during the early testing, BPI district inspectors sampled as many soybean lots as they could find to ensure that germination rates were properly labeled on the seed. Through this action, 1602 samples were submitted for testing from January 1 through

April 30 of this year. The data generated from the 1602 samples resulted in 71 Stop Sales being issued. Of the 71 lots that were issued a Stop Sale, 33 lots were relabeled, and 38 lots were removed from sale in Mississippi. Seeds with a germination rate below 60 percent can’t be sold.

The summary of the seed germination results compared to last year are in the table below.
