America Celebrates National Catfish Month!

August is National Catfish Month, as it has been each year since 1984, when President Reagan declared it as such. With the vast majority of the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish industry centered across the deep south states of Alabama, Arkansas and Mississippi, there is plenty of reason to celebrate.

The Catfish Institute (TCI), the Jackson-based marketing arm of the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish industry, works throughout the year to promote represents and the impact they have on local economy.

"The catfish industry is unique among agriculture industries with respect to its economic impact," said Roger Barlow, TCI president and executive vice-president of Catfish Farmers of America.

"Every element of our industry has an economic return that benefits the areas where the fish are grown, as well as the entire region," Barlow continued. "The fingerlings are hatched locally; the feed is produced and fed locally; they are processed and packaged locally; and they are sold locally to family-owned restaurants and grocery stores, as well as shipped to large markets across the country. This kind of economic multiplier is almost unprecedented."

As the national marketing organization for U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish, TCI works tirelessly to promote awareness and consumption of America's largest aquaculture product. One element of its annual marketing campaigns involves utilizing the industry's "Catfish Farmers of the Year" from Alabama, Arkansas and Mississippi.

"Each year, farmers from these three main producing states are asked to select from their membership a deserving producer to be named as their state's Catfish Farmer of the Year," said Barlow. "This

the good work of the farmers it honor is a great opportunity to give leading producers national recognition for their contributions to our industry, and we are proud to feature these outstanding American farmers in our annual lineup of industry promotions."

The 2019 Catfish Farmers of the Year are Ben Pentecost of Cleveland, Miss.; Willard Powe, of Browns, Ala.; and Rosemary Baxter of Watson, Ark.

"These farmers are chosen from a large field of many deserving catfish growers in the industry," said Jeremy Robbins, TCI vice president. "Although it is difficult to select just one farmer from each of these states, those who are selected embody the spirit of the American Farmer."


"All of the Catfish Farmers of the Year have made significant contributions to the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish Industry," said Barlow.







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Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force Holds First Meeting

The Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force convened on July 8, 2019, at the State Capitol. The Task Force, chaired by Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson, was established by the Mississippi Legislature to consider the potential of hemp cultivation, market potential, and potential job creation in Mississippi.

The Task Force and members of the public heard presentations on various topics regarding hemp including the regulation and cultivation of hemp, the University of Mississippi Cannabis Research Program, and law enforcement concerns related to hemp. Task Force members formed four committees as they move forward in focusing on various areas of hemp production: Regulations and Monitoring; Economics, Marketing, and Job Creation; Hemp Agronomy; and Law Enforcement Concerns. Each committee will report their findings at the next scheduled meeting.

'Today was the beginning of many thoughtful, evidence-based discussions that the members of the Task Force will be having as we examine all the issues surrounding the cultivation of hemp in Mississippi. We will be thoroughly exploring both the opportunities and the challenges of producing hemp in the state," said Commissioner Gipson. "In all our considerations, we will keep a keen focus on the interests of Mississippians, including our farmers, law enforcement and other stakeholders. as well as the general public."

The Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force was created by House Bill




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
