Christmas Tree Vendors Try To Keep Up With Demand

Mississippians pondering ideas for a side business could consider investing in land and planting stem cuttings of Leyland and Murray cypress trees.

These two varieties, trees that can grow well in a humid climate, are popular choices for live Christmas trees in the state. Each year, Christmas tree growers struggle to meet high demand.

Kenneth and Lea Barkley of Tylertown will begin featuring these varieties in 2020 when they open their Christmas tree farm for business. They planted 500 trees that will be ready for choose-and-cut sales next year.

"A friend of my husband had a father-in-law with a Christmas tree farm. He was talking about how good it was and could be something to do on the side, so we got into it that way," Lea Barkley said. "We had family land that we planted everything on by hand. We probably could have sold some this year but decided to wait until they were bigger."

John Kushla, professor and forestry specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said more growers are getting on board, with Barkley Farms expected to open for its first season next year and another farm slated to open in 2021.

He expects prices for a 6- to 7-foot, choose-and-cut tree to run in the \$80 to \$85 range across the state this year. According to data collected from surveys of more than 20 growers across Mississippi in the Southern Christmas Tree Association, 31,500 to 32,000 Christmas trees

will be sold in the state this year.

"Overall, prices for a real Christmas tree have been rising," he said. "In some markets, there is strong demand for tall trees, which are considerably more per foot in price. These trees take longer to grow and may require specialized equipment to cultivate."

Many of the species grown in Mississippi for Christmas trees are adapted to drier soil and climatic conditions, so extremes in weather patterns experienced this year, including a dearth of rain earlier this fall, did little to hamper production. Some growers have drip irrigation installed to water trees through droughts.

Disease in Christmas tree farms is one problem made worse by hot weather. Trees become infected in the spring.

"The Leyland cypress is particularly susceptible to several foliar fungal diseases. These manifest themselves

during the summer months," Kushla said. "There is a long gestation for these diseases to show symptoms in the host. Our growers spend a considerable amount of money establishing a spray schedule for fungicides and insecticides to prevent disease or insect outbreak during the growing season. This adds costs to the trees sold."

All the species grown in Mississippi are also known for their strong needle retention when kept in water after cutting. Leyland cypress, Murray cypress and Virginia pine last three to four weeks, while the Eastern redcedar and Arizona cypress retain needles for two to three weeks.

"Once the customer has the tree at home, it should be put in water right away," Kushla said. "It is important to have a properly sized tree stand for the tree. A cut real tree needs at least 1 quart of water per inch of diameter. About 1 inch should be removed from the base of

the tree before mounting in the tree stand. Keeping the tree cool inside will prolong holiday use for the tree. Avoid displaying the tree near a fireplace, heater vents, or a south-facing window. When decorating, use LED or mini-lights."

Fraser Fir trees are known as the premier Christmas tree in the South but are imported to Mississippi from the southern Appalachian Mountains. Customers who buy pre-cut Fraser firs should consider a couple of tips for choosing a fresh tree.

"Bend a twig to check for flexibility. If it snaps, the tree is dried out. Also, gently run your fingers along a branch. If the needles come out in your hand, the tree is dried out," Kushla said. "Fraser fir has well-spaced, sturdy branches for hanging large ornaments and lights. It also has a wonderful fragrance and excellent needle retention."

Cashew Caramel Corn

5 quarts popped popcorn
2 cups unsalted cashews
2 cups packed brown sugar
1/2 cup light corn syrup
1 cup unsalted butter
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar

Mix popcorn and cashews together in a large roasting pan. Combine brown sugar, corn syrup, butter, salt, and cream of tartar in a large saucepan. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly, until a candy thermometer inserted into the middle of the syrup, reads 260°, about 6-8 minutes. Remove syrup from heat; stir in baking soda. Pour over popcorn and cashews; stir to coat. Bake at 200°, stirring every 20 minutes, until sugar mixture has baked and caramelized onto popcorn and cashews, about 1 hour. Spread cashew caramel corn onto a baking sheet to cool. If desired, form into balls while still warm. *Source: Allrecipes.com.*

Effortless Eggnog

1/2 gallon cold milk, divided
1 package instant French vanilla pudding mix
1/4 cup sugar
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

In a large bowl, whisk 3/4 cup milk and pudding mix until smooth. Whisk in the sugar, vanilla, cinnamon and nutmeg. Stir in the remaining milk. Refrigerate until serving. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

Apple Butter-N-Cheddar Puffs

1 package frozen puff pastry sheets, thawed
2 egg whites, lightly beaten
1/2 cup easy apple butter
1 1/2 tablespoons fresh thyme leaves
1 1/4 cups shredded sharp Cheddar cheese, divided

Unfold 1 pastry sheet and roll to a rectangle on a lightly floured surface. Cut pastry into 9 little rectangles. Brush edges of rectangles with a small amount of egg whites. Stir together apple butter and thyme leaves. Spoon about 1 tsp. apple butter mixture into center of each rectangle. Sprinkle each with about 1 tbsp. cheese. Fold 2 opposite corners together, and pinch to seal. Gently transfer to a baking sheet. Brush pastries with egg whites, reserving remaining egg whites for second batch; sprinkle each pastry with about 1/2 tbsp. cheese. Bake at 400° for 20-25 minutes or until puffed and golden brown. While first batch bakes, repeat procedure with remaining ingredients. Serve immediately. *Source: SouthernLiving.com.*

Caramel Apple Cider

8 cups apple cider or juice
1 cup caramel flavoring syrup
1/4 cup lemon juice
1 vanilla bean
2 cinnamon sticks
1 tablespoon whole allspice
Whipped cream, hot caramel topping and cinnamon sticks (for toppings - optional)

In a slow cooker, combine the apple cider, caramel syrup and lemon juice. Split vanilla bean and scrape seeds; add seeds to cider mixture. Place the bean, cinnamon sticks and allspice on a double thickness of cheesecloth; bring up corners of cloth and tie with string to form a bag. Add to cider mixture. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours or until heated through. Discard spice bag. Pour cider into mugs; garnish with whipped cream, caramel topping and additional cinnamon sticks if desired. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

Bacon-Wrapped Potatoes with Queso Dip

2 red potatoes, cut into 8 wedges each
1/2 teaspoon salt
16 bacon slices
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/2 cup diced red onion
1 tablespoon canola oil
1 garlic clove, minced
12 ounces queso blanco cheese, cubed
1 block pepper Jack cheese, shredded
1/2 cup half-and-half
1 can chopped green chiles
1 plum tomato, seeded and diced

Sprinkle potato wedges with salt. Wrap each with 1 bacon slice. Arrange potato wedges in a single layer in prepared pan. Sprinkle with pepper. Bake at 425° for 40-45 minutes or until bacon is crisp and browned. Meanwhile, sauté onion in hot oil in a small nonstick skillet over medium-high heat 5 minutes or until tender. Add garlic, and sauté 1 minute. Remove from heat. Combine queso blanco, next 3 ingredients, and onion mixture in a large microwave-safe glass bowl. Microwave at HIGH 2 1/2 minutes; stir and microwave 2 1/2 more minutes or until cheese is melted and mixture is smooth, stirring at 1-minute intervals. Stir diced tomato into queso blanco mixture. Serve dip with potato wedges. *Source: SouthernLiving.com.*

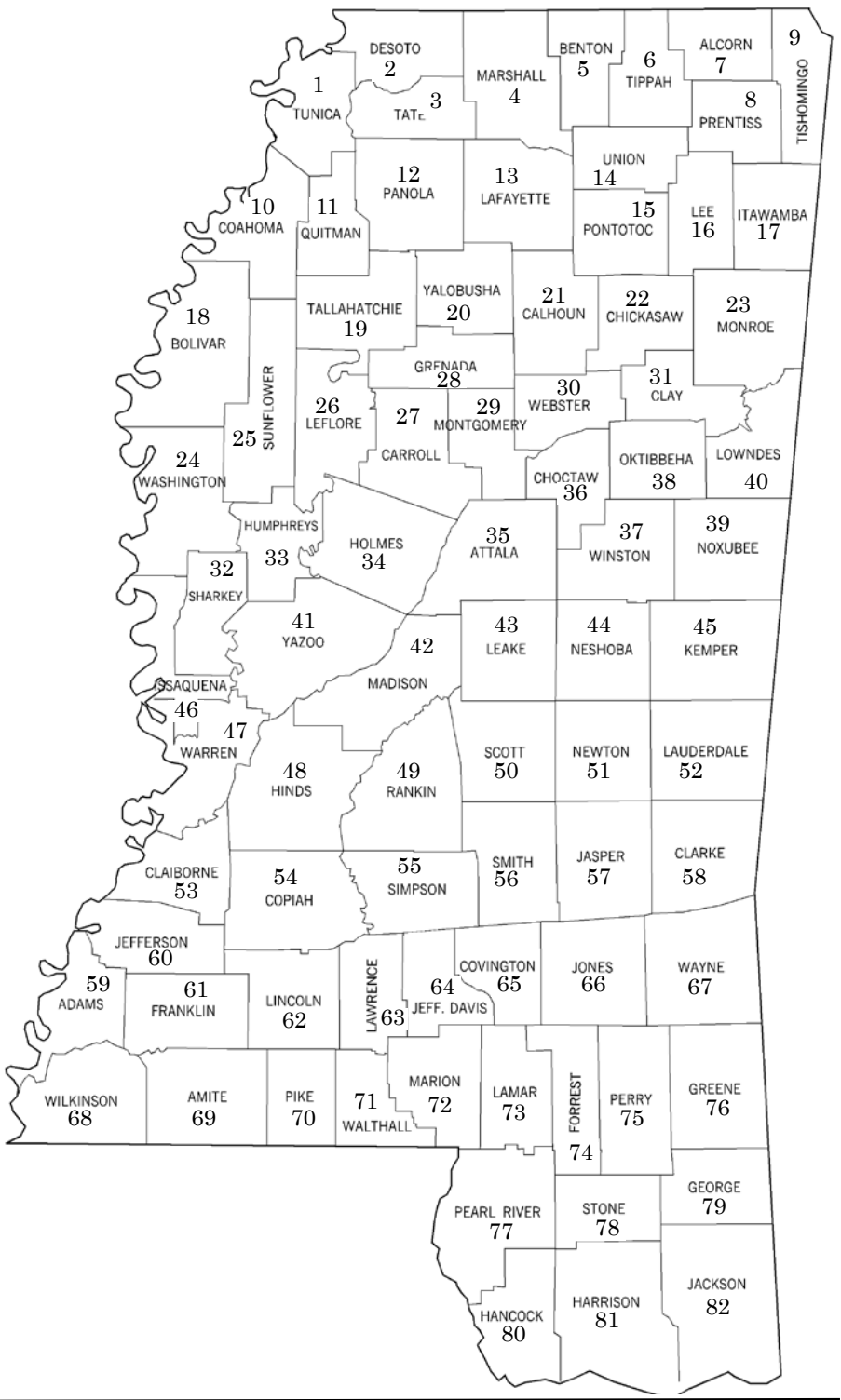



Plaintiffs Withdraw "Hogwash" Lawsuit Against Mississippi's Meat Law

Plaintiffs who filed a lawsuit regarding Mississippi's meat labeling law, which prohibits plant-based, insect-based, or cell-cultured proteins to be marketed as "meat" or "meat products" withdrew their lawsuit in federal court. Regulations for the plant-based and insect-based products went into effect November 7, 2019.

Agriculture and Commerce Commissioner Andy Gipson said, "When the 'veggie burger gang' filed a lawsuit against the State of Mississippi's meat labeling laws earlier this year, I said it was unfortunate the plaintiffs resorted to litigation without reviewing our proposed rules and offering comments to them. I said at the time Mississippi's meat labeling law is Constitutional and we would defend it and win. And I said



their lawsuit was 'hogwash.' Now, they have withdrawn their lawsuit because they did what I said they should have done, work with us on the proposed rules. The law remains intact. What they claimed in their unnecessary and frivolous lawsuit was not true. And Mississippi's meat law, passed unanimously by the Mississippi legislature, will be enforced by the Department of Agriculture as the legislature intended."

Mississippi fruit and vegetable producers, specialty foods producers and interested farmers can learn how to get their products on local store shelves and into new markets during an upcoming meeting.

Soil to Shelf: A Grower-Retailer Matchmaking Meeting will be held December 10 at the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum in Jackson.

The Soil to Shelf meeting is a partnership between Extension, Mississippi Power, the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation, the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, and the Southern Sustainable Agricultural Research and Education Center.
