Make Four Resolutions for Better Gardens in 2020

In my job with Mississippi State University, I am asked a lot of questions about problems people have with plants and ideas they have for their landscapes and gardens.

As we begin the new year, here is my list of four resolutions to help make your landscape and garden more enjoyable and productive in 2020.

1- Get those pesky landscape and lawn weeds under control.

Believe it or not, the middle of winter may be the perfect

opportunity to do this. Applying pre-emergent herbicides is an easy way to control many annual weeds that will start to germinate in our landscape and lawn early this spring. Always read and follow the label instructions.

Several different compounds will do the job. If you want to stay organic, corn gluten meal is an effective alternative to synthetics. If you are planning on doing any direct seeding of the garden or lawn, pay particular attention to application timing. Pre-emergent herbicides will also block the germination and growth of plants you may be starting in the garden from seed.

2 - If you are not already a member, join your local garden club to learn what everyone is else is doing.

It's never too late to teach an old dog new tricks, especially in



the garden and landscape. These clubs usually have guest speakers ranging from members with a particular expertise to local industry professionals. Gardeners are some of the most generous people you will ever meet.

Take the annual training and become a Master Gardener through the MSU Extension Service. You will get to know others with a mutual interest in learning, and you will meet many of MSU's specialists in entomology, plant pathology, weed and soil science, and horticulture.

The MSU Extension Service also provides other opportunities across the state for increasing your horticultural knowledge. Contact your local county Ex-

tension office for more information on regional workshops and learning events.

3 – Keep a photo journal of your garden and landscape.

With digital photography, this is not a difficult task, and sharing your accomplishments gets easier every day. Online services allow you to upload pictures and share a link to them with your friends. Or you can take the plunge and post pictures to your Facebook account, letting the whole world enjoy your garden.

4 – Grow a new vegetable this year, something you think you would not like in a million years.

One thing I've noticed about

gardeners through the years—and this includes me – is that we all have certain ideas of what our vegetables should look like. Break that mold. I'm not saying you have to take a huge leap, but if you like zucchini, try a yellow zucchini like Butterstick or a round variety like Eightball. They have the same great zucchini taste but very different appearances.

Making any kind of New Year's resolution recognizes that we could be doing better. The landscape and garden is no different than any other area of our lives. Try these resolutions I've outlined or make some of your own for a better and more enjoyable landscape and garden in 2020.

Smothered Collard Greens and Cabbage

1/2 pound bacon, chopped
1/2 large onion, chopped
5 leaves collard greens, rinsed, trimmed and chopped
Salt and ground black pepper to taste
1 teaspoon greens seasoning, divided
1 head cabbage, chopped
1 pinch white sugar

Fry the bacon with the onion in a large skillet over medium heat until the bacon is crisp, about 10 minutes. Stir in the chopped collard greens, sprinkle with salt, black pepper and 1/2 teaspoon of the greens seasoning; cook and stir for five minutes. Add the darker chopped cabbage leaves, and cook and stir until almost tender, about five minutes. Stir in the remaining cabbage; season with salt, black pepper, sugar and the remaining greens seasoning. Stir well; cover and cook until tender, stirring occasionally so that the greens do not scorch, about 10 minutes. *Source: Allrecipes.com.*

Bacon-Pork Pops

1/2 pound thin-cut bacon, minced
1 pound ground pork butt
2 cloves garlic, grated
1 tablespoon minced fresh cilantro
1 teaspoon grated peeled ginger
1 teaspoon sugar
2 tablespoons soy sauce
Salt and pepper
12 short stalks – lemongrass
Sweet chili sauce (for dipping)

Preheat the broiler. Lightly mix the bacon, ground pork, garlic, cilantro, ginger, sugar and soy sauce in a large bowl and season with salt and pepper. Form the meat into 12 balls. Thread a piece of lemongrass halfway through each ball; press the meat mixture down the stalk to form a sausage-like shape, leaving some of the stalk uncovered for the handle. Put the pops on a foil-lined broiler pan and broil until golden brown, 3-4 minutes per side. Serve with sweet chili sauce. *Source: FoodNetwork.com.*

Skillet Cornbread

2 to 3 teaspoons bacon drippings or vegetable oil
2 cups buttermilk
1 large egg
1 3/4 cups white cornmeal
1 teaspoon baking powder
1 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon salt
Butter

Coat bottom and sides of a 10-inch cast-iron skillet with bacon drippings; heat in a 450° oven for 10 minutes. Whisk together buttermilk and egg. Add cornmeal, stirring well. Stir in baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Pour batter into hot skillet. Bake at 450° for 15 minutes. Serve with butter. *Source: Southern Living.*

Southern Coffee Punch

2 cups boiling water
1 cup white sugar
1 2-ounce jar instant coffee granules
1 gallon milk
1/2 gallon vanilla ice cream
1/2 gallon chocolate ice cream

Stir boiling water, sugar, and instant coffee together in a bowl until dissolved; cool in refrigerator, 30 minutes to overnight. Pour coffee mixture into a punch bowl; add milk, vanilla ice cream, and chocolate ice cream. Stir until ice cream begins to melt. *Source: Allrecipes.com.*

Classic Pineapple Upside-Down Cake

1/3 cup butter, melted
2/3 cup packed brown sugar
1 can sliced pineapple
1/2 cup chopped pecans
3 large eggs, separated
1 cup sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
9 cherries
Whipped topping, optional

In an ungreased baking pan, combine butter and brown sugar. Drain pineapple, reserving 1/3 cup juice. Arrange 9 pineapple slices in a single layer over sugar (refrigerate any remaining slices for another use). Sprinkle pecans over pineapple; set aside. In a large bowl, beat egg yolks until thick and lemon-colored. Gradually add sugar, beating well. Blend in vanilla and reserved pineapple juice. Combine flour, baking powder and salt; add to batter, beating well. In a small bowl, beat egg whites on high speed until stiff peaks form; fold into batter. Spoon into pan. Bake at 375° for 30-35 minutes until done. Let stand 10 minutes before transferring onto serving plate. Place a cherry in the center of each pineapple slice. If desired, serve with whipped topping. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

Sparkling Raspberry Mocktail

1 12-ounce frozen raspberry lemonade concentrate
3 cups cold water
1 cup frozen or fresh raspberries
1 bottle Sparkling Grape Juice

In a small pitcher mix frozen lemonade concentrate and three cups of water. For ice-cubes sprinkle raspberries into an ice cube tray and then slowly pour the raspberry lemonade mix over them. Set the remaining drink mix aside until later. When ready to serve add ice cubes to each glass and pour about one tablespoon of the raspberry lemonade in the bottom of each glass. 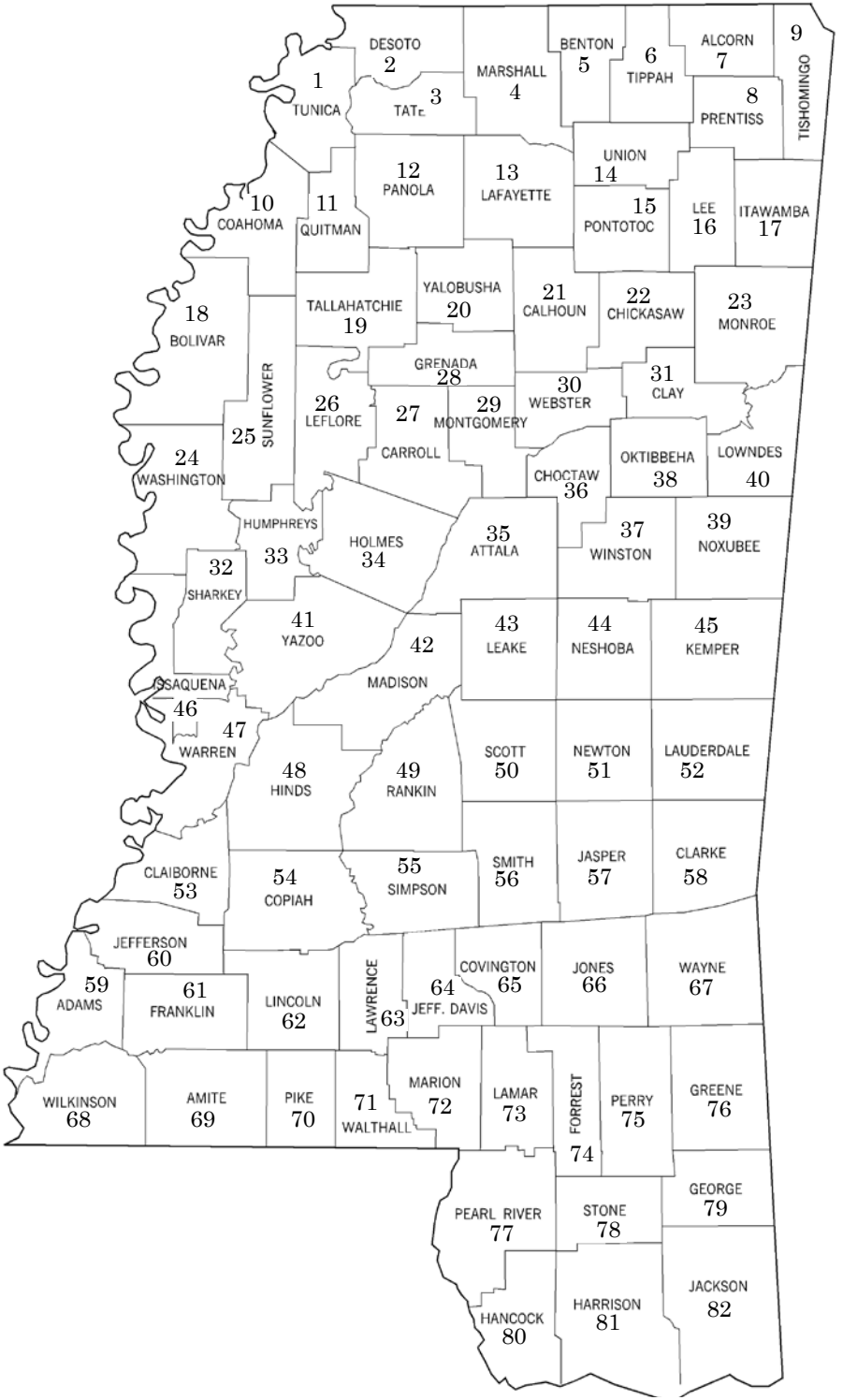



New Year's Pasture Resolutions

A new year! Each January we make New Year's resolutions with the best of intentions. Of course, we all promise to eat better and exercise more, but have you ever given any thought to making resolutions about your pastures? Let's plan now to practice better pasture management this year. Assuming a good stand of introduced forage (such as bermudagrass), most of our management decisions for pasture forage production revolve around fertilizer, weed control, and weather.

Most of us would like to spend the smallest amount of money on our pastures and get the greatest return on our investment. Therefore, let me tell you about a great, money saving secret for pasture fertilization: soil-test and fertilize your pastures according to the soil test recommendations. Rank your pastures according to productivity, and spend your fertilizer dollars on the highest yielding pastures first.

For those of you who apply a 17-17-17 or complete fertilizer each year without having a current soil test, you may be spending way too much. Why purchase nutrients if your soil is capable of supplying the necessary nutrients to the plants? Soil tests usually run around \$6 per sample, not counting your time and effort.



As an example, if your soil analysis shows adequate potassium and you've been applying a complete fertilizer all these years, you will save money by not applying this nutrient. That money can be spent on other projects around the ranch or farm.

One of the important parts of the soil test is your yield goal. If you provide a soils consultant with a realistic yield goal for your pastures, they can better determine how much fertilizer to rec-

ommend. You'll still need Mother Nature to help you out with timely rain and seasonable temperatures, but you will have done everything in your power to stack the odds in your favor. A word of advice on yield goals: If the pasture has never achieved the yield goal that you write down, you most likely will not achieve your goal no matter how much fertilizer or rain you receive.

Weed control in late January and early February is another often overlooked decision point. If you have a problem with thistles in your pastures, consider an application of about one quart per acre of 2,4-D amine formulation while the thistles are still in the rosette stage. When the thistles are in the rosette stage, they can be easily and inexpensively controlled with 2,4-D.



The rosette stage is the vegetative stage of the thistle before it "bolts" or puts up a stem and seed head in the spring. Once the thistles start to bolt, it's all over.

Weather is the most consistently uncertain factor we have in agriculture. We can only say for certain that it will be cold in winter and hot during the summer. Most of us in agriculture are optimists - we believe that we will have an average year with average rainfall. Regardless, you won't get the forage production you expect if you don't have the fertilizer on your pasture when the rain arrives.

In summary, if you haven't had a soil test on a pasture in the past three years, take one. If you have thistles, control them in the very early spring. Finally, have fertilizer on the pasture before the rains come.
