## 4-H'ers Compete in Dixie National Sale of Champions

Melissa Tolar was hopeful that her daughter, Emmy, would be featured in this year's Dixie National Sale of Champions, but she admitted to some uncertainty about her chances at first.

Emmy, a 12-year-old 4-H'er from Marion County with autism, had difficulties with communication and presenting her animals dating back to when she began showing livestock four years ago. To advance to this year's sale, one of the goats she showed had to place first in the Dixie National

Junior Round-Up.

Both of Emmy's goats placed first in the round-up. Her reserve heavyweight market goat reached the sale of champions, which was held February 6, 2020.

"I was just sitting there watching her, and I started to cry," Melissa Tolar said. "I never thought five years ago that Emmy would have been able to do this, and here she is. When that judge shook her hand, I just screamed because I was blown away that she was able to get to this point. People were hugging our necks and clapping and cheering for us."

Emmy was one of 1,619 4-H and FFA members who competed in the Junior Round-Up throughout the week. Exhibitors showed 2,221 head of livestock.

Her mother credits the Mississippi State University Extension Service, which oversees the state's 4-H programs, with assisting in her development.

"4-H has been a great program for her. I can't say enough about her Extension agents and what they've done to help her," Melissa Tolar said. "To me, this is the best program in the state for helping a child with special needs because it is inclusive. If she has had problems in the ring, there has been an agent or kid right there to help her."

This year's sale included 46 champion market animals, including 15 hogs, 12 goats, 10 lambs and nine steers. The preliminary total sale was \$404,395, which breaks the previous record set last year by more than \$20,000. Sale proceeds for hogs reached \$135,700; steers, \$98,600; goats,

\$88,870; and lambs, \$81,225.

"If you add up all the MSU Extension agents, faculty and staff along with FFA advisors and personnel with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, you have a total of 175 people who helped make this year's Junior Round-Up and Sale of Champions happen," said Dean Jousan, MSU Extension 4-H livestock specialist. "Their efforts make all the difference in this event being so successful each year."

Reuben Moore, interim vice

president of the MSU Division of Agriculture, Forestry and Veterinary Medicine, said the round-up and sale are good opportunities for Extension to contribute to the lives of young people.

"The 4-H livestock program is important to me because I am a product of it. I wouldn't be standing here today if it wasn't for the 4-H livestock program," Moore said. "So many life skills are taught. Life is full of wins and losses, and these young people who go through this program know how to face that when they

get later into life. Not all of the exhibitors make it to the sale, but they're still going to get the benefits of showing livestock, and they are going to win in life as a result."

During its 51-year run, the sale has generated \$7.68 million. A program associated with the sale has awarded \$949,700 in scholarship money to 4-H and FFA members since it began in 1993. This year, it will award a total of \$58,500 in scholarships.

Sandwiches: The Best Thing Since Sliced Bread!!

### Hot Ham & Cheese Sandwich

2 slices whole grain bread  
Butter  
2 slices Swiss cheese  
2 thin slices deli ham  
Mayonnaise  
Whole grain mustard

Preheat a skillet over medium-high heat. Spread one side of each slice of bread with butter. Place one slice, butter-side down in the hot skillet. Top with Swiss cheese and ham. Spread the unbuttered side of the second slice of bread with mayonnaise and mustard; place it, butter-side up on top of the sandwich. Cook until the sandwich is golden brown and the cheese is melted, about 3 minutes per side. *Source: AllRecipes.com.*

### Bacon & Swiss Chicken Sandwich

1/4 cup mayonnaise  
1 tablespoon Dijon mustard  
1 tablespoon honey  
4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves  
1/2 teaspoon Montreal steak seasoning  
4 slices Swiss cheese  
4 whole wheat hamburger buns, split  
2 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled  
Lettuce leaves and tomato slices (toppings, optional)

In a small bowl, mix mayonnaise, mustard and honey. Pound chicken with a meat mallet to 1/2 inch thickness. Sprinkle chicken with steak seasoning. Grill chicken, covered, over medium heat until a thermometer reads 165°, 4-6 minutes on each side. Top with cheese during the last 1 minute of cooking. Grill buns over medium heat, cut side down, until toasted. Serve chicken on buns with bacon, mayonnaise mixture and desired toppings. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

### Pulled-Pork BBQ Sandwich

1 boneless pork roast  
Salt  
2/3 cup cider vinegar  
1 1/2 cups barbecue sauce, plus more for serving  
6 hamburger buns  
2 cups prepared coleslaw

Trim excess fat from pork roast. Sprinkle with salt. Place in slow cooker and pour vinegar over roast. Cover and cook on low until roast is fork-tender and pulls apart easily, 8-10 hours. Remove roast from cooker and shred meat into small pieces. Discard cooking liquid. Return pork to slow cooker and stir in barbecue sauce. Continue to cook until warmed through, about 30 minutes. Spoon coleslaw onto bottom half of hamburger buns. Layer with pork, then top with the other half of the bun. Serve immediately with barbecue sauce. *Source: MyRecipes.com.*

### The Elvis Presley Sandwich

2 slices white bread  
2 tablespoons butter  
1 small ripe banana  
Creamy peanut butter

Place 2 pieces of white bread in the toaster on a light setting. Heat skillet over medium heat with 2 tablespoons butter. While the bread is toasting, in a small bowl, using a fork mash the ripe banana until it reaches a smooth consistency. Take both pieces of the toasted bread and spread creamy peanut butter, topping 1 side with the mashed banana. Place 1 slice of bread on top of the other forming a sandwich. Place sandwich in hot skillet browning each side, about 2 minutes per side. Take out of skillet and serve. *Source: FoodNetwork.com.*

### Sloppy Joes

1/4 cup chopped onion  
1/4 cup chopped green bell pepper  
1/2 teaspoon garlic powder  
1 teaspoon prepared yellow mustard  
3/4 cup ketchup  
3 teaspoons brown sugar  
Salt and pepper

In a skillet over medium heat, brown the ground beef, onion and green pepper; drain off liquids. Stir in the garlic powder, mustard, ketchup and brown sugar; mix thoroughly. Reduce heat, and simmer for 30 minutes. Season with salt and pepper, then serve on hamburger buns. *Source: AllRecipes.com.*

### Classic BLT Sandwich

12 slices of bacon  
8 slices white bread  
8 leaves iceberg lettuce, fresh and full  
8 slices of tomatoes  
Mayonnaise

Cook bacon until crispy, then drain on paper towels. Toast bread. Spread mayo on each slice of toasted bread. Add 1 slice of lettuce to 4 pieces of mayo-spread toast. Add 2 slices of tomato on top of lettuce. Arrange 3 slices of bacon evenly on top of tomato. Add 1 slice of lettuce on top of bacon. Place remaining 4 pieces of mayo-spread toast on top to finish the sandwiches. *Source: Food.com.*

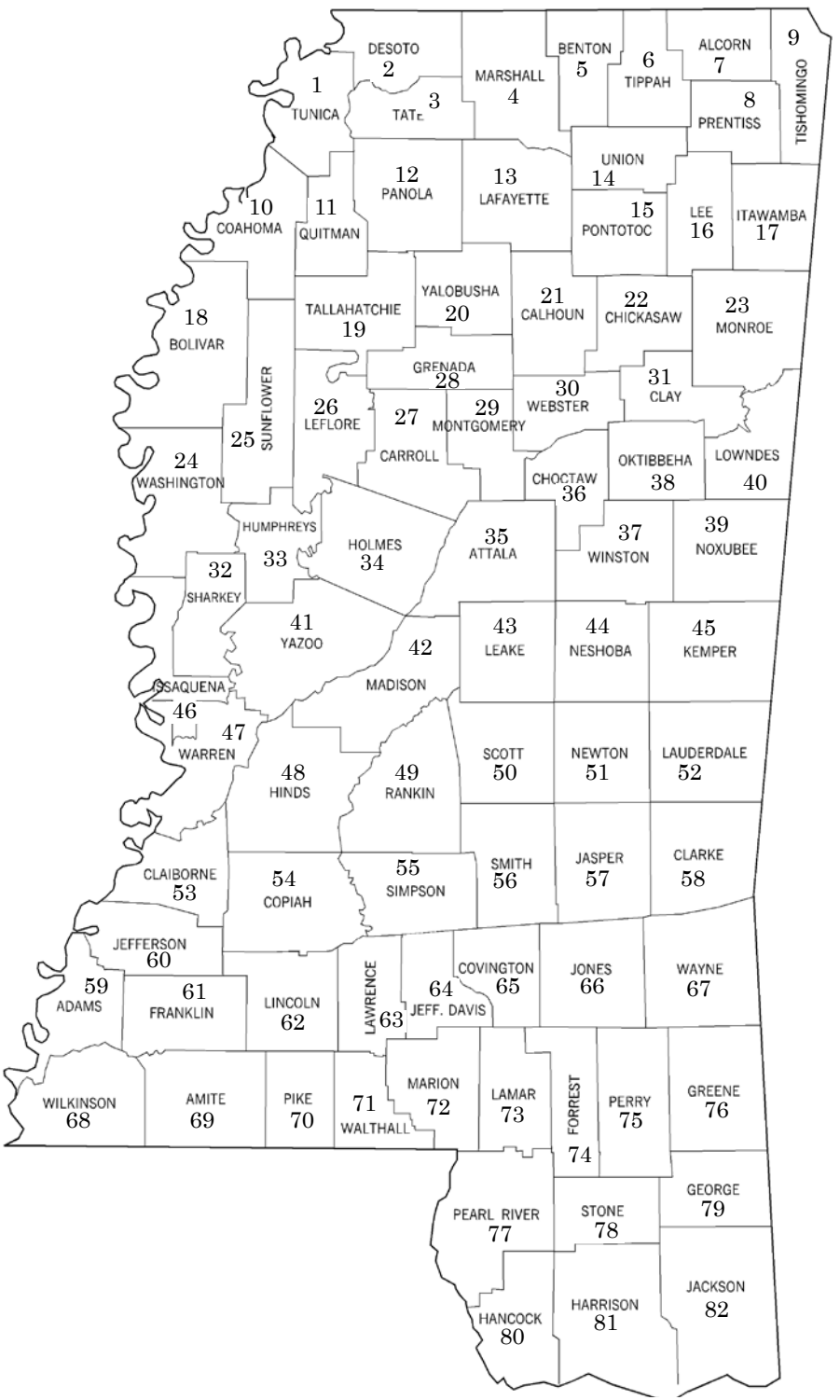



# USDA Rural Development Offers Funding for Energy Efficiency Projects

USDA Rural Development is accepting applications to assist rural farms and businesses with energy efficiency upgrades. The Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) provides loan guarantees and grants to agricultural producers and rural small businesses for renewable energy systems and energy efficiency improvements.

Last year, USDA Rural Development invested more than \$700,000 in federal grant and loan funding to support energy efficiency projects for agriculture producers and rural businesses across Mississippi. To qualify, agricultural producers must be located in rural or non-rural areas, and at least fifty percent of their gross income must be derived from agricultural operations. Rural small businesses may qualify if they are located in a town or area with a population under 50,000.

Funds can be used for renewable energy systems and alternative fuel systems, or for the purchase, installation, and construction of energy efficiency improvements and equipment. Examples include: biomass, geothermal, and hydropower projects, in addition to wind and solar generation projects.

Uses of funds for energy efficiency projects can include high-efficiency

HVAC systems, insulation and lighting improvements, cooling and refrigeration units, electric irrigation conversions, or the replacement of inefficient energy equipment.

Through the program, USDA can offer loan guarantees of up to 75% of the total cost of the project or a grant up to 25% of the total cost of the project. Grants can be combined with a loan guarantee in order to fund larger projects.

The REAP program also provides funding opportunities for energy audits and renewable energy development assistance (REDA) to eligible producers and rural small businesses. These programs help promote energy independence by increasing the supply of renewable energy and decreasing the demand for energy through energy efficiency improvements, helping to lower energy costs over time. These funds can be used for energy audits, site assessments, and technical assistance, assisting with the purchase of office space, travel associated with assessments, and other project-related equipment operating expenses.

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# Legendary Rodeo Clown Lecile Harris Dies Following The 55th Dixie National Rodeo

It is with great sadness we report the peaceful passing of Legendary Rodeo Clown Lecile Harris shortly after the final performance of the 55th annual Dixie National Rodeo Livestock Show and Rodeo at age 83.

Born in Lake Cormorant, MS, Lecile's list of achievements includes induction into numerous Halls of Fame including the Mississippi Rodeo Hall of Fame. He starred in the television classic Hee Haw for five years, has appeared in numerous movies and television shows, was nominated ten times as the PRCA Act of the Year, and another ten times as the PRCA Clown of the Year.

"All of us involved at the Dixie National are truly saddened today. Everyone from the staff here at the Fairgrounds, to the staff of Harper Morgan Rodeo Company, to our tens of thousands of loyal supporters, sponsors and fans. We all send our love and wishes to Lecile's family, friends, and adoring fans around the world." Said Steve Hutton, Executive Director of the Mississippi Fair Commission.

"While none of us ever wanted this day to come, we can't imagine a more fitting way to celebrate his storied life. God gave us Lecile one more year here at the 55th Dixie National. One more year to laugh with him and laugh at him. He's a legend. He's not just a rodeo act, he's a legend. I'll cherish my last picture taken with him during his final performance ever."

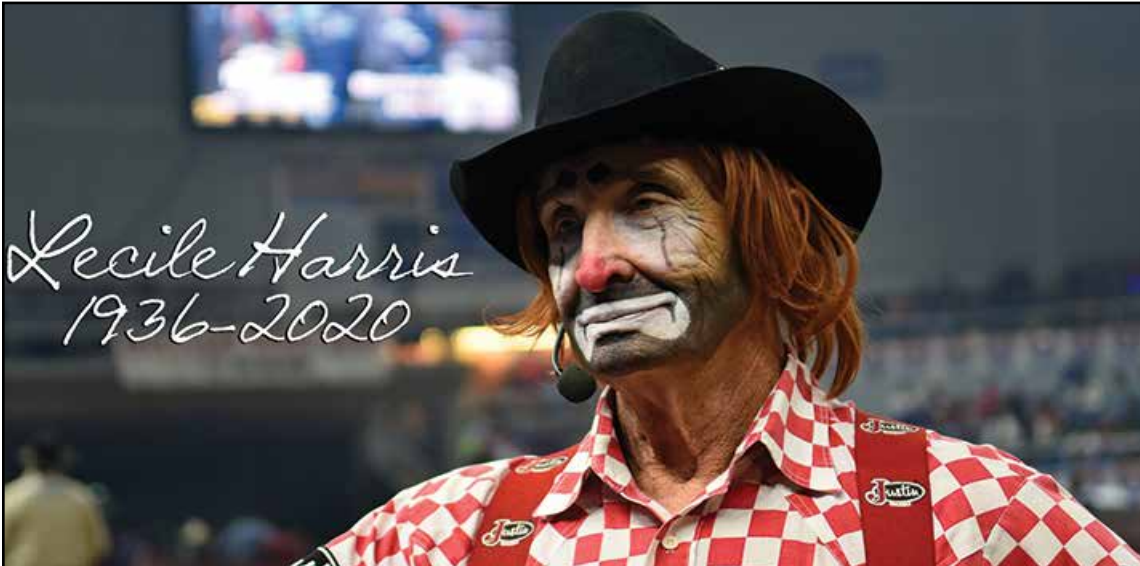
