## Many Good Reasons to Grow Your Own Vegetables

There are many good reasons for growing a vegetable garden in Mississippi. A garden offers the opportunity to enjoy vegetables at their freshest. Sometimes only minutes elapse between harvest, preparation, and eating. On the other hand, most fresh vegetables available at the grocery store travel about 1,800 miles between producer and consumer, and this travel often occurs over a period of several days. There's a lot to be said for "homegrown" freshness.

Vegetable gardens are traditional in Mississippi. When the state was more rural, most of the family's food was grown at home. Today, vegetable



gardens are often thought of as a form of family recreation. Many older Mississippians grow gardens that are much too large for their own use just to have fresh vegetables for family, friends and others who are unable to garden.

Here is what some of today's Mississippi gardeners have to say about their gardens and why they garden:

"We have enough for our family, plus some to share; what more could you ask?"

"There's no way to keep count of the people who stop to visit my garden and talk awhile since it is on the side of a field road that leads to a catfish pond. I was so proud when I was told it was the prettiest garden they had seen. I have filled three freezers and canned more than 300 jars of vegetables."

"I have always had a love for gardening. I have helped in caring for the family garden ever since I was large enough to help plant and work in a garden."

"I enjoy giving vegetables to the elderly, shut-ins, neighbors and friends."

"I enjoy people visiting my garden. Some come just to enjoy seeing it, others to learn better ways to garden."

"I have gardened over 50 years and still do my own work. The hard

work and good food keep me healthy. I save some money, but I receive other benefits that are greater and that cannot be bought."

"We give more vegetables away than we keep. We have a large family, five children, 13 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren, so you see we really enjoy a garden."

"There is a great difference in cooking fresh food from that which has been picked for several days. Watching your food grow gives you something to look forward to each week."

**Decide What You Want to Plant**  
Select vegetables and the amount

to plant by looking forward to harvest and how you will use the vegetables. There's no sense in planting something that won't be used.

When selecting vegetables to grow, consider your available garden space. Some vegetables take a lot of garden space for a long time, while others are planted and harvested in a short time period, producing a lot in a little space. Melons, pumpkins, vining types of squash and sweet potatoes are in the garden for a long time, yet the harvest period is relatively short. Okra, tomatoes, peppers, eggplant and pole beans are also in the garden a long time, but these produce a continuous supply of food.

Sweet corn is one of those vegetables you just have to plant despite how much space it takes (expect to harvest one ear per plant) because it is so good.

Vegetables to consider for small gardens (because of the space they need and the amount they produce) are bush snap and lima beans; leafy greens like lettuce, spinach, mustard, and turnips; green onions; tomatoes; sweet peppers; and eggplant. As space permits, add broccoli, cabbage, hot peppers, okra, summer squash, southern peas and

pole beans. Cucumbers, which normally take a lot of ground space, can be trellised.

Plant varieties recommended for growing in Mississippi. Don't continue to use old vegetable varieties when there are new varieties available that resist disease and give higher yields and quality. For example, fusarium wilt is still a major disease problem on tomatoes in some Mississippi gardens where the older varieties are planted. All recommended tomato varieties are resistant to this disease.

**Decide What Size Garden You Need**

To determine what size garden you need, consider your family size, the amount of vegetables you need, and whether you will preserve or use the vegetables fresh.

Most important in determining garden size are the gardener's physical ability, available time and equipment and genuine interest in gardening. Even though the rewards of gardening are great, the work is hard. It is better to start small and build on success than to become discouraged and abandon the garden because it was too large or too much work.

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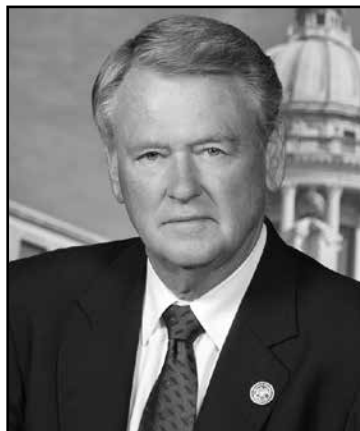
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# Commissioner's Policy Corner

State Representative Bill Pigott is a retired dairy farmer from Walthall

County. He also raised beef cattle as well as corn and soybeans before being elected to represent District 99 in 2008. He graduated from Dexter High School before attending Pearl River Community College and Mississippi State University, where he earned his B.S. degree.

Pigott was previously named Dairy Farmer of the Year by the Walthall County Chamber of Commerce and received the Friend of Agriculture Award from the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation in 2013. He currently serves as the chairman of the House of Representatives' Agriculture Committee.

"I've been in agriculture my whole life. It has been my main interest all these years and I'm very honored to serve on the Agriculture Committee now," he says.

Pigott takes agriculture seriously and understands the responsibility that comes with representing the state's largest industry. He is particularly proud of the recent house bill, The Future of Mississippi Agriculture Act of 2020 (House Bill 1566), that was passed by the House and has proceeded to the Senate for consideration. This legislation, authored by Pigott, addresses the challenges facing our farmers, ranchers and landowners.

"What's truly special about this bill (Future of Mississippi Agriculture Act) is that it makes the people of Mississippi aware of what goes on in agriculture," Pigott says. "A good bit of work went into that bill, but I believe it's very important for people to know what is available in Mississippi. One part of the bill that I really think is important and sometimes

gets overlooked, is the Ag Theft Bureau."

Pigott and his wife, Doris, currently reside in Dexter of Walthall County on their family farm. He enjoys serving the state of Mississippi while keeping in touch with his agricultural roots. Together, they have a son and daughter, Paul and Susan, and three grandchildren.

State Senator Charles Younger graduated from Heritage Academy before attending East Mississippi

Community College and Mississippi State University. In 2014, he was elected to represent District 17 and he currently serves as the chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee and vice-chairman of the County Affairs Committee.

Younger and his wife, Missy, reside on their farm in Columbus of Lowndes County, where he continues to raise cattle, soybeans and corn. Younger grew up farming and has always been involved with agriculture in some form or fashion.

### Desserts for Springtime



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#### Apple Dumpling Cobbler

- 1 can refrigerated crescent rolls
- 2 large apples, peeled and quartered
- 1 cup orange juice
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Unroll crescent rolls and separate. Wrap each apple quarter with crescent roll dough, and place in a lightly greased baking dish. Bring orange juice, 2/3 cup sugar, and butter to a boil in a saucepan. Pour over apple dumplings. Stir together 2 teaspoons sugar and 1 teaspoon cinnamon; sprinkle over dumplings. Bake at 350° for 25 minutes or until golden and bubbly. *Source: MyRecipes.com.*

#### Southern Pecan Pie

- 1 3/4 cups white sugar
- 1/4 cup dark corn syrup
- 1/4 cup butter
- 1 tablespoon cold water
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 3 eggs
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 1/4 cups chopped pecans
- 1 unbaked pie shell

In a medium saucepan, combine the sugar, corn syrup, butter, water and cornstarch. Bring to a full boil and remove from heat. In a large bowl, beat eggs until frothy. Gradually beat in cooked syrup mixture. Stir in salt, vanilla and pecans. Pour into pie shell. Bake at 350° for 45-50 minutes, or until filling is set. *Source: AllRecipes.com.*

#### Mississippi Mud Cake

- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 cup butter
- 4 ounces semisweet chocolate, chopped
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa
- 4 large eggs

1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
3/4 teaspoon salt  
1 bag miniature marshmallows  
Place pecans in a single layer on a baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 8-10 minutes or until toasted. Microwave 1 cup butter and semisweet chocolate in a large microwave-safe bowl at high 1 minute or until melted and smooth, stirring every 30 seconds. Whisk sugar

and next 5 ingredients into chocolate mixture. Pour batter into a greased jelly-roll pan. Bake at 350° for 20 minutes. Remove from oven and sprinkle evenly with miniature marshmallows; bake 8-10 more minutes or until golden brown. Drizzle warm cake with chocolate frosting and sprinkle evenly with toasted pecans. *Source: SouthernLiving.com.*

#### Old-Fashioned Bread Pudding

- 2 cups milk
- 1/4 cup butter
- 2 eggs, slightly beaten
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon or nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 6 cups soft bread cubes (about 6 slices bread)
- 1/2 cup raisins, if desired
- Whipping (heavy) cream, if desired

In a saucepan, heat milk and butter over medium heat until butter is melted and milk is hot. In large bowl, mix eggs, sugar, cinnamon and salt. Stir in bread cubes and raisins. Stir in milk mixture. Pour into ungreased deep round pan. Bake at 350° uncovered 40-45 minutes or until knife inserted 1 inch from edge comes out clean. Serve warm with whipping cream. *Source: BettyCrocker.com.*

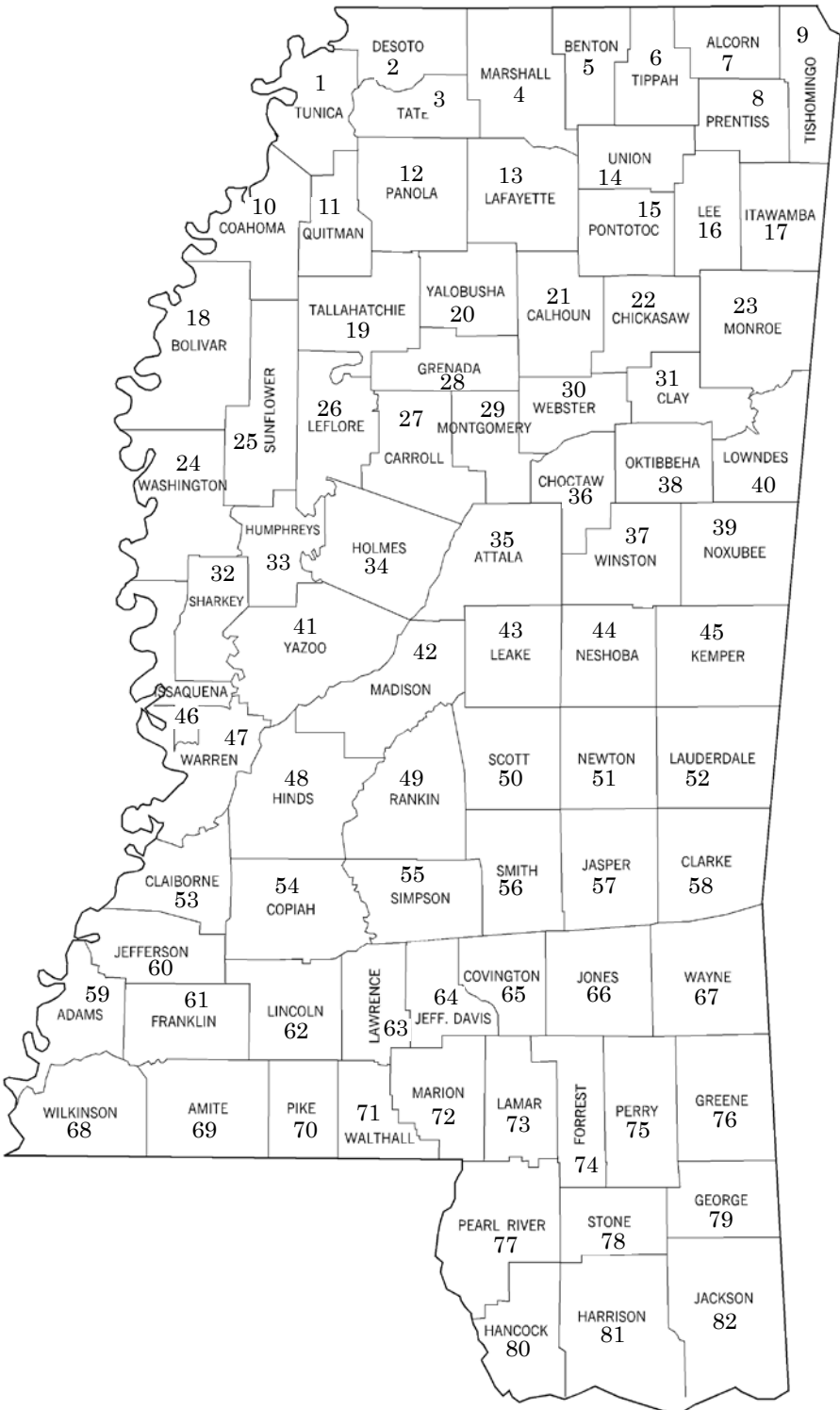

## Bovine Trichomoniasis (Trich) Control Regulation

**Effective April 1, 2020**

Every bull that is sold, exchanged, leased or transferred in ownership shall be accompanied by either:

1. Valid negative Trich test result within 90 days, or
2. Signed Virgin bull statement for bulls less than 18 months of age that have never been with breeding females. Bull age will be determined as no more than one permanent incisor tooth visible

Bulls coming into a stockyard without Virgin Bull Statement or valid negative Trich test must be consigned to slaughter

Bulls can be purchased from the slaughter pen and be Trich tested by the stockyard veterinarian the day of the sale and quarantined pending a negative test

## What does the Mississippi Trich Rule Mean to you?

Trich is a sexually transmitted disease where bulls don't show signs so control starts with eliminating positive bulls

Trich causes abortions resulting in up to 50% calf crop losses in timed breeding operations or prolonged calving intervals where bulls are left with cows year round. This results in a devastating calf loss for the year.


Any bull that tests positive for Trich must be sent directly to slaughter or sold for slaughter



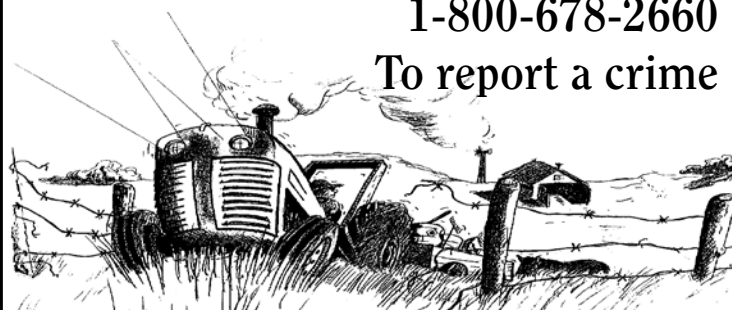

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# Be Aware of Tractors, Equipment on Roads

Mississippi farmers are gearing up for the 2020 growing season, which means everyone needs to be prepared to share the road with tractors and other equipment.

Patrick Poindexter, Alcorn County coordinator with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said being aware and patient can keep everyone safe.

"If you have never driven a piece of farm equipment, you may not understand it's simply not as easy to maneuver as a regular truck or car," Poindexter said. "In addition to traveling at slower speeds, tractors and other pieces of machinery tend to have reduced visibility. Don't assume the driver can see you."

On Mississippi's rural roads, the danger increases.

"Drivers tend to get impatient and want to pass, but this can be a recipe for disaster, especially on two-lane roads," Poindexter said. "Some farmers travel with escort vehicles, which will require additional clearance. It's better to wait until the driver can pull over than to risk an accident."

Most equipment drivers are not going incredibly long distances, and they are aware of the need to accommodate other drivers when they can.

"Everyone getting to their destination safely is the goal, so take a deep breath, slow down, and instead of being angry at the inconvenience, try to think about the hard work that



goes into growing our food, fiber and fuel," Poindexter said.

Equipment operators have rules they must follow, too. Checking to be sure all equipment, including lighting systems, brakes and tires, is in proper working order contributes to everyone's safety.

"Another key safety rule is one rider per seat at all times," said Charlie Stokes, Extension area agronomist based in Monroe County. "It's hard to say no to kids who want to ride along with a parent or grandparent,

but it's for their own safety."

Equipment should also display a slow-moving-vehicle sign.

"And when we say slow, we mean about 25 mph, compared to the 55-65 mph most people are traveling," Stokes said. "That is a big difference in speed when you come flying around a curve, talking on your phone or texting. So, stop driving with distractions, and put safety first. Your loved ones, or the loved ones of the other drivers on the road, will thank you."

# MDAC Accepting Applications for Specialty Crop Block Grant

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson announced the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) is now accepting proposals for the Specialty Crop Block Grant Program.

The Specialty Crop Block Grant Program is funded by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and authorized by the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018 (Farm Bill). The purpose of the program is to enhance the competitiveness of Mississippi's specialty crop industry by leveraging efforts to market and promote specialty crops; assisting producers with research and development relevant to specialty crops; expanding availability and access to specialty crops; and addressing local, regional and national challenges confronting specialty crop producers.

Specialty crops are defined as fruits and vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits, horticulture and nursery crops, including floriculture. Specialty crops are an important part of Mississippi's agriculture, accounting for more than \$201 million of our state's agriculture industry last year.

Past project examples include: an initiative by Farm Families of Mississippi to develop and implement a promotional campaign to educate the public on the benefits of buy-

ing and consuming locally-grown specialty crops; an initiative by Mississippi State University (MSU) to research the relationship between reniform nematodes and fungi that are associated with end rot disease of sweet potatoes; a project by MSU to compare field production of vegetables and edible flowers with two soilless culture methods and trained growers on their use; another project by MSU to conduct a tea cultivation evaluation trial and investigate the potential of tea production in Mississippi; and an initiative by the Mississippi Beekeepers Association to conduct demonstration experiments to assist beekeepers on two non-chemical techniques to control Varroa mites in beehives.

Projects funded through this program must address at least one of the following priority areas: education/extension, research and development, or promotion/marketing. Eligible applicants include producer groups and associations, non-profits and colleges and universities. Funding will not be awarded to projects that solely benefit a particular commercial product or provide a profit to a single organization, institution or individual. Applications must be submitted to MDAC by April 6, 2020.
