Weather Keeps Watermelon Production on Track

Good spring weather conditions in southeast Mississippi kept watermelon production on track.

Some growers in these southeastern counties, where most of the state's watermelons are grown, are just beginning to harvest their crops.

"It's been dry down here, so we got our fields planted on time, and the crop looks good," said Heath Steede, Mississippi State University Extension Service agent in George County. "All of my growers irrigate, so dry weather is not

a big concern. We had some cool nights early on that slowed the crop down a little, but it caught back up."

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture Crop Progress and Condition Report, 20% of Mississippi watermelons had been harvested as of May 31, compared to 1% at the same time last year. Crop quality also is favorable, with 82% in good condition, 14% in fair condition and only 4% in poor condition.

Although it is early in the season, George County producer Eddie Courtney said the weather has cooperated for him so far.

"We're just getting started with the harvest of 30 acres of an early variety, but the crop is looking pretty good," he said. "We're in good shape if the weather stays

dry. We've been getting some pretty heavy afternoon showers and are expecting more in the coming days that have us a little concerned. Too much rain will cause the melons to ruin in the field."

Excessive rainfall and rising temperatures also increase the potential for disease problems, which is something growers haven't seen much of yet.

"We've had a little disease pressure, but nothing out of the ordinary," Courtney said.

Growers in Smith County are experiencing the same good conditions as growers in George County.

"Our crop is in good shape," said Jeremy Maness, Extension agent in Smith County. "We've had a few more showers than

George County this spring, but nothing excessive."

Disease and insect pressure remain at usual levels for this time of year with harvest expected to begin in a few weeks, Maness said.

"The grower with the earliest producing crop told me the other day he won't begin harvesting until around the 18th or the 20th of the month," Maness said. "Our crop is on track. We're just really early in the season right now."

Steede and Maness said growers in their counties have not felt the impact of COVID-19 at this point.

"Labor-wise, watermelon producers haven't had any problems," Maness said. "Right now, labor consists of one worker who sprays the fields in the evenings. When harvest begins, you'll have

more workers in the fields."

Prices likely will be higher than last year, Maness said.

"We've got out-of-state watermelons on the shelves now, and they are selling really well," he said. "But they are high. That will drive our prices some, so we'll probably see the price go up from last year."

Watermelon Facts

- Watermelon is 92% water.
- Watermelons are both a fruit and a vegetable.
- The United States currently ranks 6th in worldwide production of watermelon. Many states grow watermelons with Florida, Texas, California, Georgia and Arizona consistently leading the country in production.
- A watermelon's stripes are indicators of variety, but with over 1,200 varieties grown in 96 countries worldwide, there are many, many variations. In fact, some watermelons don't even have stripes.
- A watermelon takes about 90 days to grow, from planting to harvesting.
- Once cut from the vine, a watermelon has about 3-4 weeks of shelf life.

Watermelon Cake

1/2 medium watermelon
1 container Cool Whip
Strawberries, blueberries and blackberries (for decorating)

Cut watermelon with a flat side for the bottom of the cake. Blot watermelon repeatedly with paper towels to remove excess moisture and to allow whipped topping to stick. Frost cake with cool whip. Decorate with strawberries, blueberries and blackberries as desired. Refrigerate until ready to serve. *Source: Watermelon.org.*

Grilled Watermelon

1 small seedless watermelon
3 tablespoons granulated sugar
1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
Lime zest, Tajin, and/or chili powder (for toppings)

Trim 1/2 inch from both ends of watermelon. Stand up watermelon on 1 cut end; cut lengthwise into quarters. Cut each quarter into 1-inch slices. Sprinkle slices evenly on both sides with sugar and salt. Preheat gas grill to high. Place watermelon slices on oiled grates; grill, uncovered, until grill marks appear, about 3 minutes per side. Serve with desired toppings. *Source: SouthernLiving.com.*

Watermelon Greek Salad


2 cups diced watermelon, seeded
3 cups kale, chopped fine
2 cups peeled and diced cucumber
1/2 cup diced red onion
1/2 cup Kalamata olives, cut in halves
4 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
1 teaspoon minced garlic
1 tablespoon chopped fresh mint
Serving grated pepper
1/2 cup crumbled feta cheese

In a large bowl, add kale, watermelon, cucumber, onion and olives. In a small bowl, whisk oil, vinegar, garlic, mint and pepper. Pour dressing over salad and toss thoroughly. Top with feta cheese. *Source: Watermelon.org.*



Profusion Zinnias Give Strong Color All Summer

I'm becoming increasingly optimistic about our 2020 Mississippi summer gardens and landscapes. COVID-19 is on everyone's mind, but an upside to the virus is that more homeowners are gardening than ever before.

If you're looking for summer color that will grow through the summer and beyond, then Profusion zinnia is the plant for you.

Profusion zinnias are always a great choice for annual summer color. These plants perform well in both cool and warm weather, and they have better tolerance to powdery mildew, which can plague the older Zinnia elegans. These zinnias bloom starting in spring and continuing into the fall; that long bloom period is certainly good news for our Mississippi landscapes.

Profusion zinnias are available in many colors and typically grow up to 12 inches tall and wide.

Here are some of my favorite Profusion zinnia selections.

Cherry has single, cherry-rose-colored flowers held above dark-green foliage. It was named an All-America Selections winner in 1999. Coral Pink is a bushy plant that will be covered all summer with 2-inch flowers that have bright coral-pink petals with hints of orange and salmon.

Double Golden has rich, golden-orange flower petals that seem to erupt all summer long. White has 2.5-inch, single, white flowers. I can imagine this zinnia massed in flower beds looking like a blanket of snow in July. It was an all-America Selections winner in 2001.

Profusion zinnias are compact with good, strong branching to support the numerous flowers that completely cover the plants. And the best part is that Profusion zinnias don't have to be deadheaded.

Each flower is about 1.5 to 2 inches in diameter, and the plants are available as both single- and double-flower forms. For the best flowering performance, always plant with at least 6 hours of full sun each day.

Amending your landscape beds with 3 to 4 inches of good-quality compost at the spring planting will go a long way toward having adequate fertility in the fall. I always add some controlled-released fertilizer at transplanting.

During the spring in Mississippi, planting Profusion zinnia in raised beds results in superior plant growth and flowering by increasing the soil drainage. These plants also are superstars when grown using my favorite method, containers. Always be sure to use container potting mix for superior drainage; never use reg-

ular soil in containers. Profusion zinnias tolerate droughty conditions, though once the summer temperatures arrive, the plants greatly appreciate supplemental irrigation and reward you with continuous flowering.

As we start moving into the summer season, don't neglect the feeding needs of your Profusion zinnias. Using water-soluble fertilizer is an easy way to keep the plants fed this summer through the fall.

Local garden centers still have a great selection of summer color, so take advantage of the availability of Profusion zinnia and put some color in your landscape.
