Mississippi leads the country in catfish production and has held this position since the late 1980s. The catfish industry generates an economic impact of billions of dollars and is a major source of economic activity and employment in a number of Mississippi counties.

Although there has been some decline in the number of acres in production, farmers have become more efficient by producing more fish per acre. In 2009, farmers were producing around 4,000 pounds per acre. In 2019, that production level increased to 6,700 pounds per acre,

an increase of 59%. This increase in yield can be credited to the adoption of new technologies.

Growing up in a farming family in Yazoo City, Harry Simmons looked forward to becoming a farmer himself. In the mid-70s after farming a few years, he found his perfect crop in catfish.

One of the major challenges for

The industry was able to respond with increasing sales to the retail outlets like grocery stores and fresh fish counters but did result in significant decrease in processing.

Robert Wright of Wright Fish Farms talked about his hatchery not being terribly affected other than trying to keep his employees safe during harvest season. These processing plants have put in place many safety guidelines to protect their employees from direct and indirect exposure to the point that it is sometimes hard to get the job done.

David Allen, VP at Consolidated Catfish is a physics major from Millsaps College that went to work on his cousins 600-acre farm and fell in love with the science behind catfish farming. “Fish farming is a sci-



tific operation that is continuously monitored to ensure that it meets strict standards that produce the best tasting catfish,” says Allen. One of his favorite ways to prepare the fish is panéed with a little olive oil and Tony's Chachere.

Contrary to popular belief, deep-frying is not the only way to cook catfish – just the most familiar. But who wants to deal with the heat and mess when you can get a healthier meal with less effort? According to a study published in *The Journal of the American Medical Association*, moderate fish consumption, one to two meals a week, may cut the risk of sudden cardiac death in half. The results show that any kind of fish, including Mississippi Farm-Raised Catfish can make a difference to our health.

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# Commissioner's Policy Corner

## *USDA Accepting Applications for Mississippi Hemp Production Licenses*

The Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Act (Senate Bill 2725) was signed into law on June 29, 2020. This act legalized the cultivation of hemp under a state plan to be created and implemented by the Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce. Although the act allowed for a state hemp cultivation program, the necessary funding to implement the state program was not appropriated by the Mississippi Legislature.

"I appreciate the Mississippi Leg-

islature providing farmers with access to a new agricultural commodity. However, the economic stress of COVID-19 made it difficult for the Legislature to find a way to fund the program. As a result, the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce cannot implement a state hemp program. Should the Legislature decide to fund a hemp program, MDAC will request to be the licensing agency," said Mississippi Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson.

Gipson continued, "However, I have been in constant communication with the USDA as we prepared to implement a hemp program for

Mississippi. In late June, I notified the USDA that the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Act had passed, but without funding for the program. I requested the USDA accept applications and issue hemp grower licenses for Mississippians under the USDA plan. The USDA has agreed to this plan, and Mississippians can from August 1 through October 31 submit applications for a hemp license from the USDA under the U.S. Domestic Hemp Production Program."

information-producers. Applicants must provide a copy of a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) criminal history report. An applicant will not receive a USDA hemp production license if the applicant has been convicted of a felony related to a controlled substance in the last 10 years.

Due to remote work conditions in Washington, D.C., the USDA strongly encourages all applications be sent electronically to [farmbill.hemp@usda.gov](mailto:farmbill.hemp@usda.gov) for expedited processing. Alternatively, completed applications can be mailed with a copy of the FBI criminal history report to USDA/AMS/Specialty Crops Program, Hemp Branch, 470 L'Enfant Plaza S.W., Post Office Box 23192, Washington D.C. 20026.

### Classic Fried Catfish

- 1 1/2 cups buttermilk
- 1/4 teaspoon hot sauce
- 6 U.S. farm-raised catfish fillets
- 1/3 cup plain yellow cornmeal
- 1/3 cup corn flour
- 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon ground red pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- Peanut oil

Whisk together buttermilk and hot sauce. Place catfish in a single layer in baking dish; pour buttermilk mixture over fish. Cover and chill 8 hours, turning once. Combine cornmeal and next 6 ingredients in shallow dish. Let fish stand at room temperature 10 minutes. Remove from buttermilk mixture. Dredge fish in cornmeal mixture, shaking off excess. Pour oil to depth of 2 inches into large skillet; heat to 360°. Fry fish, in batches, 2 minutes on each side or until golden brown. Transfer to paper towel-lined pan. Keep warm in oven until ready to serve. *Source: MyRecipes.com.*

### Lemon Pepper Catfish

- 2 U.S. farm-raised catfish fillets
- 2 parchment squares, folded in half
- 2 teaspoons lemon pepper seasoning
- Cooking spray

Spray parchment paper with cooking spray. Next, season with 1 teaspoon of lemon pepper seasoning, making sure to coat evenly. Lightly spray parchment again. Place catfish fillet on one side of parchment and fold the paper over. Preheat pan on medium low for 2 minutes. Add parchment-wrapped fish to hot skillet and cook for 10 minutes. Flip the fish and cook another 7 minutes. Serve immediately. *Source: USCatfish.com.*

### Cajun Catfish Supreme

- 1 1/2 pounds U.S. farm-raised catfish fillets, cut in strips
- 2 teaspoons Cajun-style blackened seasoning
- 4 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh parsley
- 1 cup sliced green onions
- 1 pound small, peeled shrimp
- 2 cans condensed cream of shrimp soup

Sprinkle catfish strips with blackened fish seasoning. Spread catfish with mayonnaise. Place in a shallow dish, cover, and refrigerate for 1 hour. In a large skillet, heat 4 tablespoons butter until it begins to sizzle. Sear the fish strips until golden, turning once. Transfer to baking dish and arrange fish in a single layer. In the same skillet, heat remaining 4 tablespoons butter over medium heat. Cook and stir mushrooms in butter until golden. Stir in parsley, green on-

ions and shrimp. Reduce heat to low and cook until shrimp are pink and tender. Stir in cream of shrimp soup and blend well. Ladle soup mixture over fish in baking dish. Bake at 375° for 30 minutes. *Source: AllRecipes.com.*

### New Orleans-Style BBQ Catfish

- 4 U.S. farm-raised catfish fillets, quartered
- 3 sticks butter, cubed
- 1/2 cup Worcestershire sauce
- 2 lemons, juiced
- Bay leaves
- Rosemary sprigs

Place butter in a microwave-safe bowl, and microwave until melted. Add remaining ingredients to the butter; stir to combine. Arrange catfish in a casserole dish and pour butter sauce over the catfish. Bake at 350° for 20 minutes. Serve with French bread for dipping. *Source: USCatfish.com.*

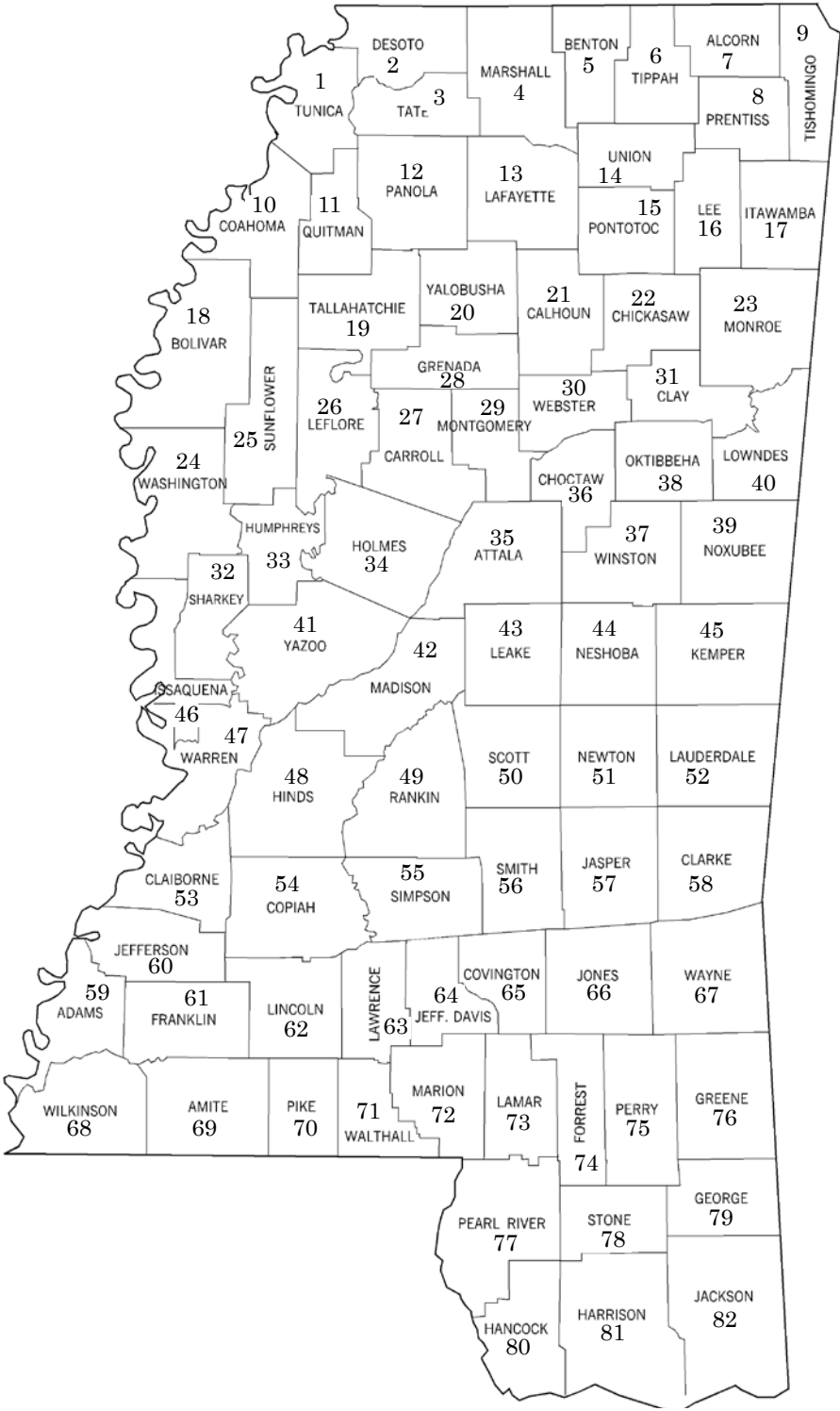



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## Alcorn Alumnus Receives Aid through U.S. Small Business Administration

Beonard Brown, a 79 year old farmer, begins his day at 6:30 a.m. every morning. Together with his twin brother Leonard, he owns and operates Brown's Farm, a commercial cow/calf operation in Bolton, Mississippi.

Like many others around the world, the Browns were forced to adapt to economic challenges brought on by the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. To help combat this crisis, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed into law on March 27, 2020. It contains over \$2 trillion in relief for American workers and small businesses. As a result of the CARES Act, Brown was able to sustain his farming operation through an Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) administered by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA).

Designed to provide economic relief to small business owners that are experiencing a loss of revenue, this aid does not have to be repaid.

"The Coronavirus affected me a whole lot," said Brown. "With the shutdown going on, I couldn't sell my calves so I was losing money. I'm very happy to have received this help from the government."

Brown recounts how his farming techniques have changed a lot since he was a young boy growing up on his family's farm. Back then, not only would he and his brothers be required to help out in the fields, but also at their family store, Brown's Grocery. Referring to his father as a "backbone of the community,"

Brown spoke fondly of some of his most cherished childhood memories.

"I used to love to help my dad run the store," he revealed. "We would sell pops, vienna sausages, canned goods, hook cheese, bologna and beer. I always looked forward to the weekend because that's when we would have buffalo fish in, and we all loved us some good ol' buffalo fish!"

As a teenager, Brown knew that he wanted to eventually attend Alcorn State University, the "Home of the Braves," as he affectionately calls it. After graduating in 1964 with a degree in physical education, he went on to work as a coach and P.E. teacher at Bolton Elementary School, where he retired after 29 years. A proud alumnus, he reminisced on his time spent on the yard playing

football during homecoming and drinking chocolate milk from the dairy farm on campus.

While his work on the farm is rewarding, Brown acknowledges how tedious and expensive it can be to maintain livestock. "You got to feed your animals, vaccinate them, deworm them, take them to the doctor, take care of them and a lot more." He shared that with the CARES Act aid, he was able to buy ample feed and other necessities to sustain his operation.

Sitting on roughly 120 acres, Brown and his two brothers inherited their farm through heir's property, which is land that is owned by two or more people who share a common ancestor that has died without leaving a will. Today, he raises and sells cattle to various markets and stockyards throughout Mississippi and Louisiana.

Delmar Stamps, alumnus and outreach consultant for Square O Consulting, described the tremendous challenge that COVID-19 presented for farmers. He cited, "the lack of knowledge regarding the availability of relief programs from the USDA and SBA," as well as "inability to apply using online applications," as significant barriers. "We used our network to make timely notification to farmers in the region," he said.

Brown credits Stamps and Gerald Jones, director of County Operations, Alcorn State University Extension Program, for being instrumental in informing him about the aid as well as assisting him throughout the application process.

## COVID-19 Put Brakes on State's Catfish Sales

Cash flow challenges are the latest struggle for Mississippi catfish producers, as product sales to their biggest consumers -- restaurants -- are way down due to COVID-19.

"Even though prices are relatively stable, it has no meaning when producers are unable to sell their products," said Ganesh Kumar, an agricultural economist at Mississippi State University's Delta Research and Extension Center in Stoneville. "Sales lost due to COVID-19 related closures are irrecoverable."

"Sales lost to restaurants has a downward effect on the supply chain. Eventually, fish inventory builds up in ponds, and producers spend more money on maintenance feeding, increasing the cost of production," he said.

Catfish packed for sales to restaurants are difficult to repackage for sales to grocery stores and other retail outlets. This problem made it difficult to quickly tap the increasing demand at the retail sector, resulting in processing sales significantly lower in April and May of 2020.

"Prices have been relatively stable at slightly above \$1 per pound for the last three to four months. However, individual producers are hurting because of reduced sales due to business closures," Kumar said.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service reports that the U.S. catfish industry generated about \$379 million in sales in 2019, of which \$226 million originated from farms in Mississippi. U.S. consumption of seafood, which includes catfish, is 16 pounds per capita annually, up from 14.7 pounds in 2016. U.S. catfish accounts for 0.56 pound of this amount.

Jimmy Avery, Extension aquaculture specialist with the MSU Thad

Cochran National Warmwater Aquaculture Center, said Mississippi continues to lead the country in catfish production, with 35,300 acres of catfish ponds as of June 30. The majority of these ponds are in the Delta, but about 8,000 water acres are in east Mississippi.

"Farmers have gotten more efficient by producing more fish per acre," Avery said. "In 2009, farmers were producing around 4,000 pounds of catfish per acre. In 2019, that production level had increased to 6,700 pounds per acre, an increase of 59 percent."

Avery said that increase can be attributed to the adoption of new technologies such as the use of hybrid catfish, more intensive production systems, increased aeration and improved vaccines.

The significant slump in sales to restaurants is contributing to another challenge facing the catfish industry: finding adequate markets for very large fish. The longer fish are held in ponds, the bigger they get. Not only does this cost money in feed, reducing profit, but it produces a fish with filets too large for traditional markets.

Imported fish products continue to erode the domestic market for catfish.

"In 2019, 62% of the catfish-like products eaten in the U.S. were imported," Avery said.

MSU continues to support the U.S. catfish industry through research and Extension from the Thad Cochran National Warmwater Aquaculture Center. Major areas of current research are fish health, water quality, production systems, economics, nutrition and genetics. Additionally, the MSU College of Veterinary Medicine operates the Aquatic Animal Diagnostic Laboratory, where producers can have their fish diagnosed and water quality checked.
