Rice Crop Looks Promising as Harvest Approaches

Rice harvest is approaching in the Mississippi Delta, and early signs point to good yields in 2020.

Bobby Golden, rice specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service and an assistant professor with the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station, said the condition of the state's estimated 150,000 acres of rice looks "very good" as growers prepare to fill their combines. With 221 rice-producing farms, Mississippi was No. 6 among U.S. states in rice production with a total value of

\$91 million last year, not No. 5.

"The first fields that were planted may start draining as soon as the second week of August. Outside of some of the early rice that flowered in high heat, the majority of the state's rice crop will flower in good heat conditions," said Golden, who is based at the Delta Research and Extension Center in Stoneville. "There is some extremely good-looking rice out there, but it's too early

to tell where our yields will be."

Rain chances forecasted in the Delta through mid-August are marginal, and rainfall or high wind shouldn't affect pollination in 2020 as it did in previous years. Insect and disease problems this year has also been limited so far.

"We may escape a lot of the issues we have had in the past with paraquat drift on a portion of the crop because the soybeans are slightly behind the rice this year," Golden said. "I expect stink bugs will pick up in the next week. We have not had a blast issue this year like years past, and sheath blight has been minimal compared to normal."

Planted rice acreage -- about 2.9 million acres -- is up 30% over last year statewide and 15% over 2019 nationally. Extension row-crop economist Will Maples said this increased production will cause a stag-

nation in market prices.

"While domestic rice consumption is projected to remain strong in the 2020–21 marketing year, the increase in production is limiting any upward price movement, as we will see an increase of rice stocks," Maples said. "The national average farm price for long-grain rice is projected down this year at \$11.60 per hundredweight from \$12 last year."

Rice fields in Mississippi feature a mix of conventional, hybrid and nonhybrid rice varieties, about half of which are tolerant to imidazolinone herbicide. One conventional variety planted in about 15% of the state's rice fields was developed at MSU. This variety is often referred to as Rex.

September marks the 30th annual celebration of Mississippi Rice Month. Established in 1991 by the U.S. Congress, National Rice Month celebrates the nation's rice industry.

MSU Extension and Delta Rice Promotions Inc. partner each year to host an annual rice tasting luncheon in support of Mississippi Rice Month. This year's installment has been canceled due to COVID-19.


Commissioner Andy Gipson Announces MDAC Wild Hog Control Program

After a full year of public education, research and outreach through the Commissioner's Wild Hog Challenge, on August 27, 2020, my office announced the launch of a first-ofits-kind state agriculture department-led invasive feral hog trapping initiative. The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) Wild Hog Control Program (WHCP), with support by the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation, will provide farmers, ranchers and landowners with the resources and training necessary to effectively combat the rise of destructive wild hogs in Mississippi. In Mississippi alone, wild hogs cause more than \$60 million in damages annually.

We are delighted to launch this first of its kind WHCP trapping system to fight the scourge of wild hogs on behalf of Mississippi farmers and ranchers. As I've said many times, we already know the problem – now we at the Mississippi Department of Agriculture are taking meaningful action to curb the invasion of hogs on farmlands. I also want to thank Mike McCormick and the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation for their indispensable support.

During the 2020 Legislative Session, MDAC was authorized to operate a program to fight nuisance species on private agricultural and forestry lands. The Department's WHCP will involve the coordinated trapping and control of feral hogs on private farm and timber land



throughout Mississippi. Working at the request of local farmers, the WHCP will include training and technical assistance to farmers on the most effective methods to trap and control destructive wild hogs on their farm property. Following training, one or more WHCP "smart" trapping systems may be set up on the farm, and farmers or their designees will be trained on the remote monitoring methods and best practices for effective trapping. The traps are powered by Mississippi-based HogEye Camera Systems which allow for remote trapping capability wherever there is cellular 3G signal.

MDAC acquired the first set of smart hog traps in August 2020, and currently these traps are being used in a 30-day beta-test program in southwest Mississippi. Following the initial testing, multiple trapping

units will be deployed and rotated throughout Mississippi, focusing initially on the "hot spots" of known wild hog populations. Rotation of the traps will occur approximately every 30-60 days and will be based on requests by participating farmers. Through a master account, MDAC will collect and monitor data of the trap location, effectiveness and number of wild hogs harvested.

Recently, the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation provided key support to the program with the acquisition of additional traps that will be deployed across the State of Mississippi. MFBF President Mike McCormick stated, "Feral hogs continue to cause tremendous damage to ag land across all regions of Mississippi. We are proud to support MDAC's effort to offer assistance to private landowners. I believe intensive trapping is necessary to truly

suppress feral hog populations."

As the WHCP program is rolled out, working very closely with other state and federal partner agencies will be critical to make this initiative as effective as possible. For the MDAC nuisance wildlife program to be successful, we must continue to work with our state and federal partners such as the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks; USDA APHIS Wildlife Services; and Mississippi State University. These partners are vital in determining where nuisance wildlife management is needed the most across the state, with agricultural damage having the highest priority in the WHCP. In addition, different regulatory authority across state and federal agencies will result in a stronger partnership than ever before.

I anticipate this first-of-its-kind collaborative program can provide a model for other states who, like Mississippi, want to put a serious dent in the population of invasive wild hogs. On behalf of MDAC, we are excited to take the lead in this important work for our farmers.

Old-Fashioned Rice Pudding

6 cups whole milk, divided

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup long grain white rice, I use a heaping half cup 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Ground cinnamon (optional)

In a large saucepan, combine 5 1/2 cups milk, sugar and salt. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Stir in rice and reduce heat to low. Stirring occasionally, cook for 50-60 minutes. 



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USDA Announces More Eligible Commodities for CFAP

Application Deadline Extended to September 11, and Producers Who Have Approved Applications to Receive Final Payments

U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Sonny Perdue announced on August 11, 2020, that additional commodities are covered by the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP) in response to public comments and data. Additionally, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is extending the deadline to apply for the program to September 11th, and producers with approved applications will receive their final payment. After reviewing over 1,700 responses, even more farmers and ranchers will have the opportunity for assistance to help keep operations afloat during these tough times.

"President Trump is standing with America's farmers and ranchers to ensure they get through this pandemic and continue to produce enough food and fiber to feed America and the world. That is why he authorized this \$16 billion of direct support in the CFAP program and today we are pleased to add additional commodities eligible to receive much needed assistance," said Secretary Perdue. "CFAP is just one of the many ways USDA is helping producers weather the impacts of the pandemic. From deferring payments on loans to adding flexibilities to crop insurance and reporting deadlines, USDA has been leveraging many tools to help producers.'

Background:

USDA collected comments and supporting data for consideration of additional commodities through June 22, 2020. The following additional commodities are now eligible for CFAP:

• Specialty Crops - aloe leaves, bananas, batatas, bok choy, carambola (star fruit), cherimoya, chervil (french parsley), citron, curry leaves, daikon, dates, dill, donqua (winter melon), dragon fruit (red pitaya), endive, escarole, filberts, frisee, horseradish, kohlrabi, kumquats, leeks, mamey sapote, maple sap (for maple syrup), mesculin microgreens, nectarines, parsley, persimmons, plantains. pomegranates, pummelos, pumpkins, rutabagas, shallots, tangelos, turnips/celeriac, turmeric, upland/ winter cress, water cress, yautia/ malanga, and yuca/cassava.

• Non-Specialty Crops and Livestock - liquid eggs, frozen eggs and



all sheep. Only lambs and yearlings (sheep less than two years old) were previously eligible.

- Aquaculture catfish, crawfish, largemouth bass and carp sold live as foodfish, hybrid striped bass, red drum, salmon, sturgeon, tilapia, trout, ornamental/tropical fish, and recreational sportfish.
- Nursery Crops and Flowers nursery crops and cut flowers.

Other changes to CFAP include:
• Seven commodities – onions (green), pistachios, peppermint, spearmint, walnuts and watermelons – are now eligible for Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Stability (CARES) Act funding for sales losses. Originally, these commodities were only eligible for payments on marketing adjustments.

• Correcting payment rates for onions (green), pistachios, peppermint, spearmint, walnuts, and watermelons.

Additional details can be found in the Federal Register in the Notice of Funding Availability and Final Rule Correction and at www. farmers.gov/cfap.

Producers Who Have Applied:

To ensure availability of funding, producers with approved applications initially received 80 percent of their payments. The Farm Service Agency (FSA) will automatically issue the remaining 20 percent of the calculated payment to eligible producers. Going forward, producers who apply for CFAP will receive 100 percent of their total payment, not to exceed the payment limit, when their applications are approved.

Applying for CFAP:

Producers, especially those who have not worked with FSA previously, are recommended to call 877-508-8364 to begin the application process. An FSA staff member can help producers start their application during the phone call.

On farmers.gov/cfap, producers can:

• Download the AD-3114 appli-

cation form and manually complete the form to submit to their local USDA Service Center by mail, electronically or by hand delivery to their local office or office drop box.

- Complete the application form using the CFAP Application Generator and Payment Calculator. This Excel workbook allows customers to input information specific to their operation to determine estimated payments and populate the application form, which can be printed, then signed and submitted to their local USDA Service Center.
- If producers have login credentials known as eAuthentication, they can use the online CFAP Application Portal to certify eligible commodities online, digitally sign applications and submit directly to the local USDA Service Center.

All other eligibility forms, such as those related to adjusted gross income and payment information, can be downloaded from farmers. gov/cfap. For existing FSA customers, these documents are likely already on file.

All USDA Service Centers are open for business, including some that are open to visitors to conduct business in person by appointment only. All Service Center visitors wishing to conduct business with FSA, Natural Resources Conservation Service or any other Service Center agency should call ahead and schedule an appointment.

Service Centers that are open for appointments will pre-screen visitors based on health concerns or recent travel, and visitors must adhere to social distancing guidelines. Visitors are also required to wear a face covering during their appointment. Our program delivery staff will be in the office, and they will be working with our producers in the office, by phone and using online tools. Ag Theft Investigation Leads to Recovery of Stolen Tractor and Disk in Clarke County

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB), the lead agency in a stolen tractor theft investigation, made an arrest and recovered a stolen Kubota tractor and Tufline disk in Clarke County. The investigation was led by MALTB investigator Jamie Taylor with assistance from investigators Jim Stone, Leon Wedgeworth and Leonard Bentz.

"I commend Director Dean Barnard, MALTB investigators and the Clarke County Sheriff's Office for their efforts in solving this case, and I am glad all the equipment was recovered and returned to the rightful owners," said Mississippi Agriculture and Commerce Commissioner Andy Gipson. "For our farmers and ranchers throughout the state, their livestock, crops and equipment are their livelihood; and we aim to protect and serve our agricultural community."

On August 3, 2020, MALTB investigators issued a search warrant at a residence in Clarke County, which led to the recovery of a stolen 2014 Cab and Air, 4x4, Kubota tractor with a front end loader along with a six foot Tufline disk that were previously reported stolen in Greene County on July 18, 2020. The value of the stolen

property was \$45,000.

During the course of the investigation, agents with MALTB, Clarke County Sheriff Todd Kemp and sheriff investigators arrested Delreco S. Strickland, age 43, of Clarke County. Strickland was charged with possession of stolen property. Strickland also had an outstanding warrant from the Mississippi Department of Corrections; the investigation is ongoing.

MALTB Director, Dean Barnard, praised MALTB investigators and Clarke County Sheriff Kemp and his department for their dedication to this case. "There has been an increase in tractor, trailer and utility vehicle thefts in the past three months. I advise people to use extra precaution in securing your property by not leaving equipment in the open, removing keys and checking your equipment daily. It's also important to take pictures of your equipment and write down the serial numbers in the instance that you become a victim of theft," Director Barnard.

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau enforces state laws pertaining to the theft of cattle, horses, swine, poultry, fish, farm equipment, chemicals, timber and all other farm or agriculture-related crimes.
