Shop Carefully for 2021 Garden Seeds

I'm in my 2021 garden planning mode right now, and along with many other intentional gardeners, I have my mind on seeds.

The intentional gardener needs to begin the new year by purchasing seeds, but be aware that the source is important. Last week, I talked about how easy it is to go overboard as garden catalogs pile up at this time of year. How the seed companies entice us to buy more than we could possibly plant!

When I want to buy seeds for

my home landscape, I like to shop the local, independent garden centers. Their seed racks are always a highlight of my gardening year.

I was shopping this weekend, and the displays of onion sets and seed potatoes had just been put out. I had to get a couple of bags of white, yellow and red onion sets and red, yellow and blue seed potatoes.

Of course I realize these were impulse buys. If you do any kind of gardening, you know that impulse buying without knowing where the plant is going to be placed is part of the game. But being an intentional gardener means you must control these impulses. I was already planning on buying these onions and potatoes, although I had not planned on doing it this weekend.

Now the thing about the display racks of seeds is that the selection is generally limited to reliable garden standbys. This is the place to buy those standard seeds. But these garden center displays can't offer the numerous specialty varieties because of the sheer numbers available.

That's where the garden catalogs fit in. You can find exactly the variety you want, including the new selections you've read about.

Be sure to order from reputable companies. My recommendation is to choose those that provide great products and even better customer service.

For example, I recently had a germination issue with a couple of varieties of lettuce I purchased from one of my favorite compa-

nies. I called, and they did some research on the lot number of the lettuce. They found there had been problems with those seeds. I had new packets of seeds in three days. That's customer service.

I strongly recommend buying seeds directly from reputable businesses with a proven history of selling high-quality products, rather than major online retailers or auction sites. You don't know where the seeds are coming from. Do you remember the mystery seeds many Americans received from China in 2020?

I have one last piece of advice for buying seeds in 2021. Plan right now what you'd like to grow in your 2021 garden.

Seed companies do not anticipate seed shortages like we saw last spring, but it's better to be safe than sorry. Don't delay thinking about your garden needs, and purchase seeds right away for the spring, summer and fall seasons.

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Commissioner's Policy Corner

The 2021 Legislative Session began on January 5, 2021 and is in full swing. Although some things feel differently and many meetings are held virtually due to Covid-19, the Session continues unabated. The session is slated to end on April 1, the 87th day.

The end of January saw many bills referred to committees and many of those bills dying there. Almost 2,300 bills and resolutions have been filed since the start of the session. The next deadline, February 15, is the deadline to dispose of motions to reconsider general bills and constitutional amendments originating in their own house.

Two bills related to agriculture and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) are still alive. SB 2076 would remove the repealer on the sections of the law that brought the Mississippi Fair Commission under MDAC, meaning the State Fairgrounds would permanently be a part of MDAC if the bill becomes law. SB 2077, and its twin bill in the House, HB 312, would abolish the old Central Market Board and transfer those functions to MDAC.

We will keep you updated on these bills and more as they continue to progress through the process and more deadlines approach. As always, if you have any questions or concerns regarding a piece of legislation, please let me know.

USDA Suspends CFAP Additional Assistance

Following direction from the Biden Administration, the USDA has suspended processing and payments under the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP).

The notice of suspension was posted to farmers.gov/cfap which is the web site providing information on CFAP. The notice announces, "In accordance with the White House memo, Regulatory Freeze Pending Review, USDA has suspended the processing and payments under the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program - Additional Assistance and has halted implementation until further notice. FSA local offices will continue to accept applications during the evaluation period."

The notice continues, "In the coming days, USDA and the Biden Administration intend to take additional steps to bring relief and

The CFAP program provides

assistance to certain agricultural producers whose operations were directly impacted by the coronavirus pandemic.

USDA had announced additional assistance on January 15, 2021 which included "expanding CFAP eligibility for some agricultural producers and commodities and updating payments to accurately compensate some producers who already applied for earlier assistance." Prior to the additional assistance, about \$23.6 billion in payments had been made available through CFAP 1 and CFAP 2.

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From Our Kitchen To Yours

Best Ever Banana Bread

3/4 cups all-purpose flour
 1/2 cups sugar
 teaspoon baking soda
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 large eggs, room temperature
 medium ripe bananas, mashed (1 cup)
 1/2 cup canola oil
 1/4 cup plus 1 tablespoon buttermilk
 teaspoon vanilla extract
 cup chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, stir together flour, sugar, baking soda and salt. In another bowl, combine the eggs, bananas, oil, buttermilk, and vanilla; add to flour mixture, stirring just until combined. Fold in nuts. Pour batter into a greased or parchment-lined 9x5-inch loaf pan. If desired, sprinkle with additional walnuts. Bake for 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 hours or until a toothpick inserted comes out clean. Cool in pan for 15 minutes before removing to a wire rack.

Cinnamon Raisin Quick Bread

4 cups all-purpose flour 2 cups sugar, divided 2 teaspoons baking soda 1 teaspoon salt 2 large eggs, room temperature
2 cups buttermilk
1/2 cup canola oil
1/2 cup raisins
3 teaspoons ground cinnamon

Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, combine flour, 1 1/2 cups sugar, soda, and salt. In a small bowl, whisk eggs, buttermilk, and oil. Stir into dry ingredients just until moistened. Fold in raisins. Combine cinnamon and remaining sugar; set aside. Spoon half the batter into two greased 8x4-inch loaf pans. Sprinkle with half of the reserved cinnamon sugar; repeat layers. Cut through batter with knife to swirl. Bake 55-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks.

Pull-Apart Garlic Bread

1/4 cup butter, melted
1 tablespoon dried parsley flakes
1 teaspoon garlic powder
1/4 teaspoon garlic salt
1 loaf (1 pound) frozen white bread dough, thawed

In a small bowl, combine the butter, parsley, garlic powder and garlic salt. Cut dough into 1-inch pieces; dip into butter mixture. Layer in a greased 9x5-inch loaf pan. Cover and let rise until doubled in size, about one hour. Bake at 350° for 30 minutes or until golden brown.

Yogurt Cornbread

cup yellow cornmeal
 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
 teaspoons baking powder
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
 large egg, lightly beaten, room temperature
 cup fat-free plain yogurt
 1/2 cup fat-free milk
 1/4 cup canola oil
 tablespoon honey

Preheat oven to 425°. Combine the first five ingredients. In a separate bowl, combine remaining wet ingredients; stir into the dry ingredients just until moistened. Pour batter into an 8-inch square baking dish coated with cooking spray. Bake 16-20 minutes or until a toothpick inserted comes out clean. *Source: Taste of Home.*

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



Commissioner Gipson Signs MOU with USDA APHIS Wildlife Services

On January 26, 2021, Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson signed a Memorandum of Understanding with USDA APHIS Wildlife Services (WS) to strengthen the cooperative relationship between WS and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC). The Memorandum of Understanding enhances the ability for MDAC and WS to work together to monitor and control threats to human health and agricultural crops such as diseases spread by wild hogs and bird depredation on aquaculture.

During the 2020 Legislative Session, legislation was passed that authorizes the Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce to provide technical guidance and outreach to landowners, farmers and producers for the management of nuisance wildlife on private agricultural and forestry lands, and to partner with state and federal agencies regarding nuisance wildlife management and to promote awareness across the state.

"The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce and USDA APHIS Wildlife Services have worked together closely for many years to implement the state's Beaver Control Program, which helps provide relief to beaver-affected landowners on private and state-

owned lands," said Commissioner Gipson. "Signing the Memorandum of Understanding expands collaborative efforts between our two agencies that will assist farmers and ranchers in managing nuisance wildlife species on their properties."

"USDA APHIS Wildlife Services is extremely pleased to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce. Our two agencies have had a long, outstanding working relationship together," said USDA APHIS Wildlife Services State Director Kris Godwin. "The signing of this document solidifies that relationship. We look forward to continuing working with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce and agriculture producers across the state."

One new collaborative effort between MDAC and WS will be expansion of wild hog disease surveillance into Southwest Mississippi through the MDAC Wild Hog Control Program (WHCP). In Mississippi alone, wild hogs cause more than \$60 million in damages annually, and they carry diseases that pose a great threat to humans and livestock. This will be a great opportunity for a state agency, federal agency and farmers to work together.
