Christmas Trees Bounce Back After Year of Severe Weather

With rising prices everywhere, families may expect to pay more for their choose-and-cut Christmas trees this year. But that may not be the case.

Mississippi Christmas tree growers faced some challenges in 2021 with weather conditions and price hikes for many of their inputs. However, many growers may decide not to pass those costs on to consumers of their choose-and-cut Christmas trees, said John Kushla, professor and forestry specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service.

"Besides crop losses from storms,

expenses have risen for equipment, parts, fuel and fertilizer," Kushla said. "But that does not mean all growers are charging more for a tree. Since the Christmas tree market is local, growers near a larger city may be able to charge more for trees, while those in rural areas may not."

Kushla said choose-and-cut trees are selling for \$9 to \$14 per foot, which is in line with 2020 prices. Trees that are 6 to 8 feet tall will sell closer to the lower end of that range, and larger trees that are over 10 feet tall will sell at the higher end of that range.

Some growers also offer pre-cut Fraser firs from Tennessee and North Carolina, which are in short supply. He said he expects prices for these trees to be closer to \$12 to \$14 per foot.

While Christmas tree varieties commonly grown in the South are resilient and usually bounce back from high winds, some growers, especially in the Gulf South, did lose

some trees to hurricanes and tropical storms. Many Christmas tree producers in Mississippi are part of the Southern Christmas Tree Association, which also includes growers from Louisiana and Alabama.

"Louisiana was particularly hard hit by Hurricane Ida, which damaged some of the crop there from wind and rain," Kushla said. "That same hurricane tracked through Mississippi, dropping a lot of rain. 2021 proved to be unseasonably wet in general. Some growers experienced disease damage to their trees from root rot related to soil wetness."

Adam and Ali Carnes encountered only minor problems associated with the severe, wet weather at their 3-year-old, one-and-a-half-acre farm in Pontotoc.

"I lost about 15 to 20 trees out of my planting stock in February when the icy weather came through," said Adam Carnes, who will sell his first choose-and-cut trees this year when Carnes Farms opens for the season

Nov. 20. "I also think I had a handful of trees that had some fungal infection, but the spraying schedule we use for that took care of it. All my trees look good, and everything is going well."

Michael Burchart, executive secretary of the Southern Christmas Tree Association, said most farms are planning to open in the next two weeks, while others are already open.

"The majority of farms open the weekend before Thanksgiving or the weekend after Thanksgiving, depending on how close Thanksgiving is to Christmas each year," he said. "Farms that offer pretagging are already open, along with farms that offer other activities, such as photo opportunities, corn mazes and pumpkin patches."

"A lot of Christmas tree farmers look at their plan and ask themselves what else can I do with this farm," Burchart said. "Christmas tree farms offer a lot of additional opportunities to bring in income throughout the

year."

Christmas tree farms are a strong and growing business with room for even more new farmers, Burchart said.

"Most Christmas tree farms in our area are small with one to two acres of trees, but those growers are going to sell 80% of their mature stock each season. People want to go to your farm and buy a real tree and have that experience," he said.

Many Christmas tree farmers, like the Carnes family, work full-time jobs.

"I'm a third-generation firefighter, and my wife is a teacher," Adam Carnes said. "The idea to open the farm really came to me out of the blue. I studied landscape management at Northeast Community College, and I mowed yards with my dad growing up. I didn't know anything about growing Christmas trees, so I did a lot of research before we decided to do it."

"We have two little girls, and I hope the farm is something we can leave them someday," he said.

Tree Trimming Party Treats

Holiday Cranberry Tea

- 1 48-ounce can cranberry juice cocktail
- 1 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1 cup orange juice
- 1 cup lemonade
- 1 cup pineapple juice
- 3 to 4 (3-inch) cinnamon sticks

Combine all ingredients in a Dutch oven over low heat. Cook, stirring occasionally, 10 minutes or until sugar dissolves. Serve warm.

Hot Roast Beef Party Sandwiches

- 1/2 cup finely chopped walnuts
- 2 9.25-ounce packages dinner rolls
- 2/3 cup peach preserves
- 1/2 cup mustard-mayonnaise blend
- 3/4 pound thinly sliced deli roast beef, chopped
- 1/2 pound thinly sliced Havarti cheese
- Salt and pepper to taste (optional)

Heat walnuts in a small nonstick skillet over medium-low heat, stirring occasionally, 5 to 6 minutes or until lightly toasted. Remove rolls from packages (do not separate rolls). Cut rolls in half horizontally, creating one top and one bottom per package. Spread preserves on cut sides of top of rolls; sprinkle with walnuts. Spread mustard-mayonnaise blend on cut sides of bottom of rolls; top with beef and cheese. Sprinkle with salt and pepper, if desired. Cover with top halves of rolls, preserve sides down, and wrap in aluminum foil. Bake at 325° for 20 to 25 minutes or until cheese is melted; slice into individual sandwiches.

Elf Biscuits

- 1 5 1/3-ounce package graham crackers (1 sleeve)
- 3/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cup chopped pecans or almonds

Arrange eleven whole graham crackers on an ungreased 15x10-inch jellyroll pan. Bring butter, sugar, and pecans to a boil in a medium saucepan; boil 2 minutes. Pour mixture on crackers, spreading quickly to cover. Bake at 300° for 12 minutes. Remove crackers to wax paper to cool. Cut with knife along perforations.

Spicy Party Meatballs

- 1 12-ounce jar cocktail sauce
- 1 10.5-ounce jar jalapeño jelly
- 1/2 small sweet onion, minced
- 1/2 3-pound package frozen cooked meatballs

Cook first 3 ingredients in a Dutch oven over medium heat, stirring until jelly melts, and mixture is smooth. Stir in meatballs. Reduce heat, and simmer, stirring occasionally, 35 to 40 minutes or until thoroughly heated.



Mrs. Claus's Dream Bars

- 2 cups gingersnap crumbs
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted
- 1 14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 6-ounce package peanut butter chips
- 3/4 cup miniature candy-coated chocolate pieces
- 1 cup sweetened flaked coconut (optional)
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans

Stir together gingersnap crumbs and melted butter in a medium bowl. Press mixture evenly into a greased 13x9-inch pan. Carefully spread condensed milk over crumb mixture. Combine peanut butter chips and remaining ingredients in a medium bowl. Sprinkle mixture evenly over condensed milk; gently press mixture down. Bake at 350° for 25 to 30 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool in pan on wire racks. Cut into squares.

Chocolate Chip Oatmeal Cookies

- 3/4 cup shortening
- 1 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1/4 cup water
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 cups quick-cooking oats, uncooked
- 1 12-ounce package semi-sweet chocolate chips

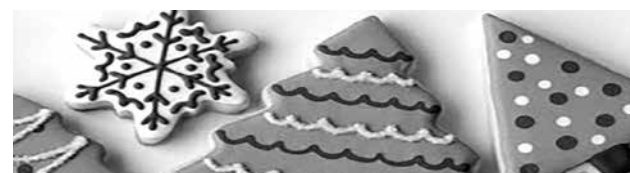
Blend together first 6 ingredients in a large bowl; add flour, salt and baking soda, blending until combined. Stir in oats and chocolate chips. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheets. Bake at 350° for 10 minutes.

Traditional Homemade Hot Chocolate

- 4 cups milk (any kind)
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 3 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa (dark cocoa is great)
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Tiny pinch of salt
- Optional toppings: marshmallows and chocolate syrup

In a medium saucepan, heat milk over medium heat until scalding but not boiling, stirring occasionally. Whisk in sugar, cocoa, vanilla extract and salt until combined. Serve hot topped with marshmallows and chocolate syrup, if desired.

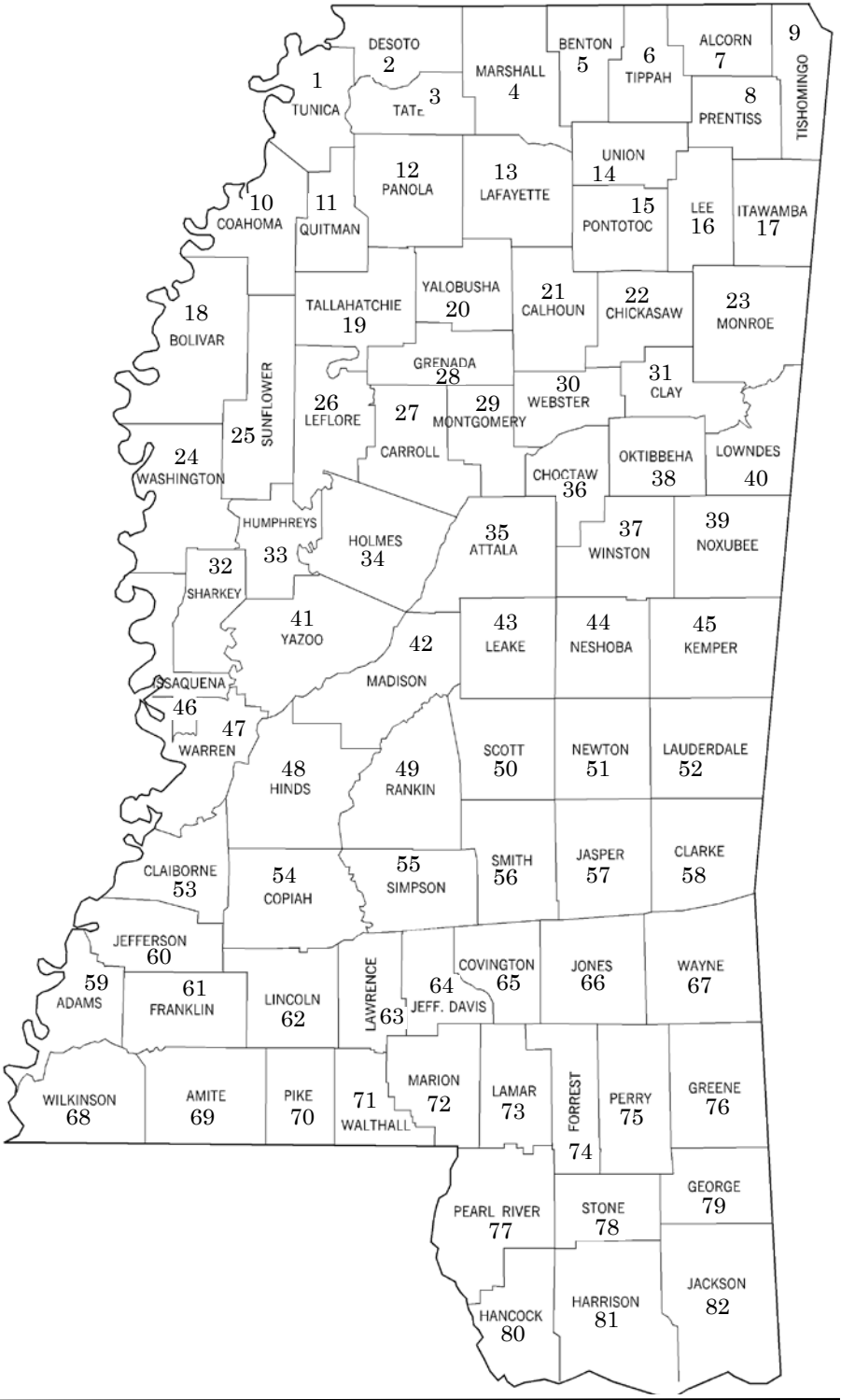



Mississippi State Fairgrounds Hosts Standing for American Freedom Event

The Mississippi State Fairgrounds will host the inaugural Standing for American Freedom event inside the Mississippi Coliseum on Sunday, December 5, at 5:30 p.m. in recognition of the 80th Anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor, which will be observed nationwide on December 7. Ornamental Peppers Have Use as Holiday Decoration

As an ornamental horticulture guy, I'm always thinking about how to expand or extend the usefulness of our landscape and garden plants. I've been toying with a nontraditional use for ornamental peppers.

This is a group of attractive plants many of us grow during the summer. They come in a colorful and wide variety of selections. I have always marveled how the colors change as the pepper fruit mature across the season.

The idea I've been playing with is growing some ornamental peppers indoors during the winter and using them in Christmas and holiday season décor.

Now, this isn't new idea. I remember a day over 30 years ago when my fellow grad students and I were kicking around ideas. One student came up with this totally out-of-bounds thought of growing peppers specifically for the holidays. We'll call them Christmas Peppers, he said.

This was one of those wild and crazy ideas -- and maybe has a touch of horticultural heresy -- because everyone knows that poinsettias are the end-all, be-all holiday plant forevermore. But still the idea stuck with me, and I'm so glad it did.

Slowly over the years, garden centers and floral designers have been adding ornamental peppers into their holiday creations. In fact, the Chili Pepper Institute at New Mexico State University has developed an entire series of ornamental peppers to celebrate the holidays, from NuMex New Year's Day to NuMex Christmas.

What I like about using ornamental peppers as holiday plants is the fact that the plants continue to produce multicolored fruit over most of the winter. Most of the ornamental peppers grown for the holidays stay small and are well mannered.

A couple of my landscape favorites

are perfect for holiday use.

Chilly Chili seems to explode in a dramatic, colorful demonstration. This 2002 All-America Selections winner holds the fruit above the foliage. Fruit starts as yellow-green and transitions to a bright orange and brilliant red.

Chilly Chili is a great choice for container planting, as the plants reach just 1 foot tall and wide. These peppers are not hot and are probably the safest to grow around curious children.

The ornamental pepper variety Sangria holds its slender fruit pointing upward boastfully as if getting ready for a party. This pretty ornamental pepper bears fruit in almost unbelievable numbers so that they resemble confetti.

Young Sangria peppers emerge greenish yellow and then march through a wonderful parade of colors from orange, lilac, purple and finally on to a glorious crimson red. Unlike Chilly Chili, Sangria peppers are hot, hot, hot!

Growing ornamental peppers for the holidays is really easy.

Find a bright window where the plant can receive about six hours of sunlight a day. Temperature-wise, if you're comfortable, the plants will be happy. To be more specific, this means daytime temperatures in the low 70s and a little cooler at night to the mid-60s. Temperatures in this range will help encourage and prolong the flowering cycle and production of the colorful fruit.

As with all indoor plants, correct watering is important. Keep the potting mix consistently moist, not waterlogged, as this condition leads to root rot issues that cause the flowers drop off.

Over the past couple of weeks, I've already seen nice selections of ornamental peppers produced for the holidays at local garden centers. Consider getting one or two to complement your poinsettias.
