Color Choices Give Poinsettias Variety

Besides the Christmas tree, the poinsettia is the plant most often associated with the Christmas season. In their native Mexico, the bright red flowers of poinsettia are known as Flores de la Noche Buena— or Flowers of the Holy Night – as they bloom each year during the Christmas season.

If you're a fan of poinsettias but like variety, you'll find the range of poinsettia colors available is truly remarkable. Poinsettia is no longer simply "that red Christmas plant." Colors range from red and white to even maroon, making it hard to choose. In addition to solid col-

ors, there are bicolor, speckled and marbled poinsettias. There are even rose-flowered selections.

And if that's not enough, growers are changing the colors even more by painting and adding sparkles. When shopping for poinsettias, be ready for the wide variety of options and take your time to select the very best. Bracts should be completely colored and fully expanded. If not, the plants were probably shipped before they were completely ready.

You can hardly go wrong with these colorful "flowers" brightening your decorations. However, what we think of as flowers are actually modified leaves called bracts. The true flowers are the yellow/green bead-like structures called cyathia. Your poinsettia will last longer if you select plants with unopened or only partially opened cyathia.

In recent years, growers and florists have been using poinsettias in combination containers. *Southern Gardening* has promoted combining poinsettia with the Mississippi Medallion winner Diamond Frost euphorbia. Both are in the euphor-

bia family and have similar growing and care characteristics. Another combination to try is snow-white chrysanthemum with a traditional

red poinsettia.

Follow a few care tips to help keep your poinsettia looking good long after the Christmas holidays. Poinsettias need at least six hours of indirect sunlight and comfortable room temperatures. When grown in the greenhouse, the temperatures are about 72 degrees during the day and 60 degrees at night. The closer you get to providing these same temperatures, the longer your poinsettia will last.

Don't let the leaves or bracts touch window glass, as the low outside temperatures are readily transferred through the glass. Also, keep poinsettias away from frequently opened doors. It might look great by the front door when guests arrive, but if you want the plant to look great later, avoid the sudden temperature changes.

Temperatures below 50 degrees can harm the foliage and colorful bracts. On the way home with your

new poinsettias, be sure to cover them carefully, taking care not to break any branches or stems. Poinsettias are fragile, and stems can break quite easily from mishandling. Not only can the paper or plastic shipping sleeves hide damage, but you should pay particular attention when removing these. Never try to slide one over the plant, but always tear or cut the sleeve off.

The absolute most important thing to remember is DO NOT over-water your poinsettia. Poinsettias are sensitive to wet feet, and root rot sets in quickly. Make sure the potting mix feels dry to the touch before you water it. Remove the decorative sleeve around the pot, and water the top of the container over the kitchen sink. Replace the decorative sleeve after the water has finished draining.

Whichever colors and combinations you choose, be sure to brighten your Christmas celebrations with your favorite poinsettias.

It's Time to Stop Pecan Theft in Mississippi

As the holidays quickly approach many of us will be eating dishes with pecans. From sweet potato casseroles to a good ole pecan pie, many holiday meals would not be the same without pecans; all thanks to our pecan growers. Now, it's no secret among my family that my favorite pie at Christmas is Mississippi pecan pie with a cup of hot coffee.

But Mississippi pecan growers are facing a real problem – pecan theft. I don't mean a problem with passers-by stopping to pick up a few handfuls of pecans to make a pie. Most farmers I know are willing to give someone a few pecans for a pie. I am referring to a theft problem that is costing pecan growers hundreds, and even thousands, of dollars each year. Growers have informed me of instances of having multiple loads of pecans stolen from their farms during harvest season, which lasts a short 8-12 weeks.

For several years, pecan growers have come together to push for laws with stronger penalties that would deter the crop theft. Basically, the current law calls for a fine of up to \$100 for those found guilty of stealing pecans. During the 2021 legislative session, a bill was introduced by State Senator Mike Seymour stiffening the penalties. The bill passed in the Senate, but it didn't make it out of the House.

It is now time that we support growers and provide them the protections they need to maintain their



livelihoods. The penalties for pecan theft must be more stringent and grab the attention of would-be thieves so that they think twice before coming onto someone's farm illegally. Along with appropriate penalties, the key to deterring crime is enforcement of the imposed penalties. Ideally, pecan growers would benefit from having laws that are uniform to those in surrounding states as many of the farms stretch over state lines.

Unless you are a grower, you are more than likely unaware of the rampant pecan theft. But know this: pecan theft is no laughing matter. It is challenging for growers to stop theft from their farms because most pecan growers do not live on the farm in the orchard itself. The price of pecans and the ease in which they are often stolen and sold for cash makes it an attractive commodity to steal. The pecan market

is fluid, with no traceability and no accountability. It is not uncommon to see *We Buy Pecans* signs at various locations when driving in pecan producing areas of the state. When the public brings in pecans to sell at these places, there is no documentation required or questions asked as to the origin on the pecans, and you get paid cash. Think about this, about \$5 worth of pecans will fit in a baseball cap. Imagine how many dollars a thief would make selling a car trunk load of pecans.

Curbing pecan theft is also an economic development issue. The pecan industry is a growing sector of our agriculture economy. Growers from other states are coming to Mississippi to plant pecan orchards. Mississippi ranks eighth in the nation in pecan acreage, and pecan acreage in our state has more than doubled since 2018. With 823 improved orchards, the pecan industry

is certain to grow even more over the next decade as the newly planted trees begin producing, and these improved orchards have more than twice the number trees per acre.

Pecan theft is not a new problem; growers have experienced it for years. Growers out west in other states have these same issues with other tree nuts such as pistachios and almonds. With the growing industry and the new marketing potential to come in the next few years as a result of increased production, it is only fair that we have measures in place to protect farmers' crops. Pecan theft is not just stealing a pie; it's about taking away from the livelihoods of our pecan producers. As you bite into your pecan pie over Christmas, take a moment and think about the hard work that went into raising those pecans. Shouldn't the farmers be the ones receiving the profits from the sales of their pecans, not low-down thieves? I'm encouraging the Legislature to get this issue addressed in 2022 and appreciate their support.

Christmas Morning Brunch Ideas!



Brunch Eggs

- 12 thin Canadian bacon slices
- 3 (4-ounce) packages shredded Swiss cheese
- 12 large eggs
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon paprika
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley

Place Canadian bacon in a single layer of a lightly greased 13x9-inch baking dish; sprinkle with Swiss cheese. Cover and chill, if desired. Break eggs over cheese, spacing evenly. Pour whipping cream over eggs, and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Bake at 425 degrees for ten minutes. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and paprika. Bake eight to ten more minutes or until set. Remove from oven; sprinkle with parsley. Let stand ten minutes before serving. Casserole may be divided into twelve portions and served on English muffins.

Cornmeal-and-Brown Sugar Crusted Bacon

- 1/4 cup plain yellow cornmeal
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons freshly ground pepper
- 16 thick bacon slices

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Combine cornmeal, brown sugar and pepper in a shallow dish. Dredge bacon slices in cornmeal mixture, shaking off excess. Place half of the bacon in a single layer on a lightly greased wire rack in a jelly-roll pan. Repeat procedure with remaining bacon, placing on another lightly greased wire rack in a second jelly-roll pan. Bake at 400 degrees for 40 to 45 minutes or until browned and crisp. Let stand five minutes.

Smoky Sausage-and-Grits Casserole

- 1 1/2 pounds smoked sausage, chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon table salt
- 1 1/2 cups uncooked quick-cooking grits
- 2 (8-ounce) blocks sharp Cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 cup milk
- 1 1/2 teaspoons chopped fresh thyme
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 4 large eggs, lightly beaten
- Vegetable cooking spray

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Brown sausage in a large skillet over medium-high heat, stirring often, seven to nine minutes or until cooked; drain on paper towels. Bring salt and 4 1/2 cups water to a boil in a large Dutch oven over high heat. Whisk in grits, and return to a boil. Cover, reduce heat to medium,

and simmer five minutes or until thickened, whisking occasionally. Remove from heat; add cheese, stirring until completely melted. Stir in milk, thyme, garlic powder, black pepper and eggs. Stir in sausage. Spoon mixture into a lightly greased (with cooking spray) 13x9-inch baking dish. Bake for 50 minutes to one hour or until golden and cooked through. Let casserole stand for five minutes before serving.

Sausage Balls

- 1 (1-pound) package ground sausage
- 3 cups baking mix
- 4 cups grated sharp Cheddar
- 1/8 tablespoon pepper

Spray a baking sheet with vegetable oil cooking spray. Combine all ingredients in a large bowl. Mix well with your fingers. The mixture will be very crumbly. Form into 1-inch balls, squeezing the mixture so it holds together, then rolling it between the palms of your hands to form balls. Place the balls on the baking sheet. Bake at 375° for 18-20 minutes or until golden brown.

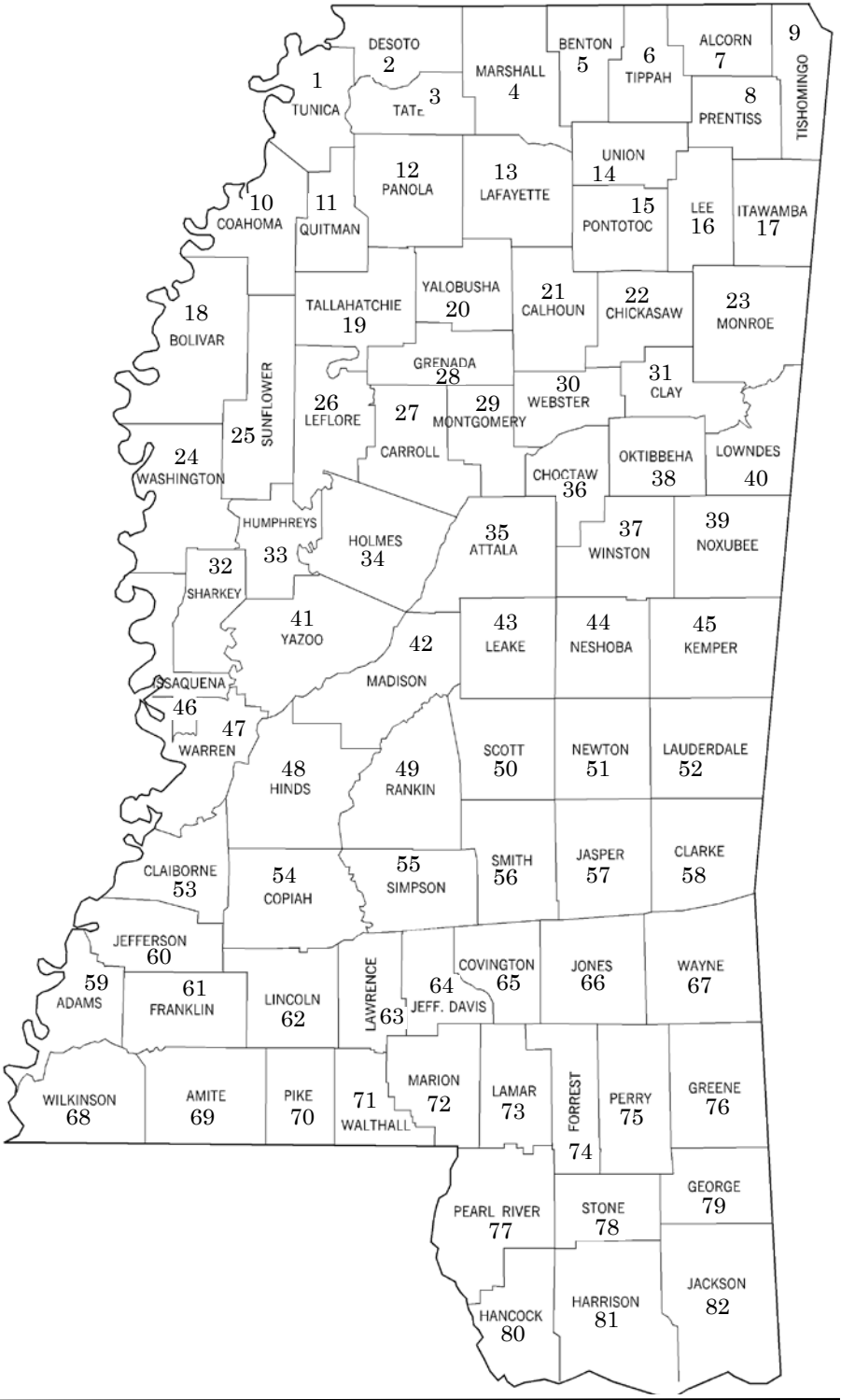



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Plant Cole Crops Now For Winter Vegetables

Even though I still have tomatoes and peppers producing in my home garden, I know these summer vegetables are on borrowed time. While I like being able to harvest tomatoes on Thanksgiving, it's the time of year to appreciate the great cool-season vegetables we can grow.

From broccoli, cauliflower, kale and collards to cabbage and Brussels sprouts, these vegetables are commonly called cruciferous or cole crops. I think they are delicious, especially after a freeze takes out my tomatoes and peppers.

The variety of shapes, sizes and colors within this group of vegetables is amazing. But what is even more amazing is that these vegetables are all closely related genetically. In fact, they have a common ancestor.

Wild cabbage is a little plant from the region around the Mediterranean. Because of its nutritious foliage, farmers grew and domesticated selected plants based on their desired traits.

Over many, many thousands of years, we have developed leafy versions -- kale and collards; buds -- cabbage and Brussels sprouts; and flowers -- broccoli and cauliflower.

As a group, they're known botanically as *Brassica oleracea*, and each has its own varietal designation: broccoli, *B. oleracea* var. *italica*; cauliflower, *B. oleracea* var. *botrytis*; kale, *B. oleracea* var. *sabellica*; collards, *B. oleracea* var. *viridis*; cabbage, *B. oleracea* var. *capitata*; and Brussels sprouts, *B. oleracea* var. *gemmifera*.

Because these vegetables are so closely related, they have similar growing needs and conditions.

The first is they don't like wet feet. Like so many of our landscape and garden plants in Mississippi, good soil drainage is a must. Raised beds are a great choice for good drainage, and adding composted materials creates an optimum planting bed.

I really like growing these plants in containers because of the superior growing media available that allows for good drainage. I never have to worry about my plants having wet feet.

While we want good soil drainage, we can't let the plants dry out. These plants need consistent

soil moisture to be productive. We're likely to have droughty weather during the winter months in Mississippi. In my Ocean Spring's garden, we have received less than two inches of rain in November.

Winter cold can rapidly deplete soil moisture. Apply mulch to help retain moisture, but be prepared to water as needed. And here's a heads up: After watering, don't leave the hose attached to the spigot. Freezing temperatures can burst pipes pretty quickly.

For best growth of cruciferous vegetables, do not neglect fertil-

izing the plants.

These vegetables are heavy feeders all through the winter crop season. I like to add slow-release fertilizer at transplanting to get the plants off to a great start. Then I use a water-soluble fertilizer on a monthly schedule to keep the plants healthy and growing strong.

Now is the time to pick up some transplants at your favorite independent garden center. Follow these tips to enjoy nutritious and tasty vegetables all through the winter gardening season.
