Sale of Champions Spotlights Persistent Competitors

Lily and Emma Grace Putnam raised their Mississippi-bred reserve champion lamb in their Sunflower County pasture, which they recently finished fencing in with the help of loans and grants.

"We have always had the land and have been pasturing it in piece by piece as we've been able to, but we needed to complete the fencing this year so we could finish breeding our ewes," said Lily Putnam, a Sunflower County 4-H'er based in Sunflower County. "The loan was helpful to me because we used it to buy equipment to get ready for lambing and start a breeding business."

This year marks her 10th and last

time to compete at the Dixie National Junior Round-Up, as well as her second appearance at the Dixie National Junior Sale of Champions.

Putnam was one of 1,538 4-H and FFA members across Mississippi at the round-up to show 2,262 head of livestock including steers, hogs, goats and lambs. Forty-six champion market animals advanced to the sale through the round-up. This year's Sale of Champions generated a preliminary total of \$448,500, breaking the previous record by more than \$40,000. The sale included 46 champion market animals, including 15 hogs, 12 goats, 10 lambs and nine steers. For photos of the 2022 Sale of Junior Champions see pages 20-26.

A freshman at Mississippi Delta Community College majoring in biology, Putnam plans to transfer to Mississippi State University in the future and major in animal and dairy sciences with a preveterinary concentration.

"I love to compete, and show day is one of my favorite days of the year, but the process leading up to it interests me because you have to work hard with your animal throughout the year if you want it to perform well at the show," she said. "I take pride in knowing my sister and I worked closely with our animals every step of the way."

MSU Extension 4-H livestock specialist Dean Jousan said the Putnams are an example of many exhibitors at the annual Dixie National Junior Round-Up who personify persistence and a strong work ethic.

"The organizations that offer youth loans and grants want to know what kinds of livestock projects the applicants are doing, how they propose to generate income and what expenses are expected," Jousan said. "The process of applying and the process of getting an animal in peak condition takes a lot of effort and responsibility and a willingness to do

whatever it takes for 4-H'ers to make their projects successful."

The sale's committee raised \$61,500 in support for 39 scholarships, including 25 \$1,500 scholarships to exhibitors who are high school seniors, six \$2,000 scholarships to premier exhibitors and eight \$1,500 scholarships to exhibitors of supreme champion livestock.


As of the completion of its 53rd event, the sale has generated more than \$8.5 million through livestock sales. Hosted at the Mississippi Trade Mart, the sale began in 1970 as an avenue to encourage young people to pursue livestock projects.

Scrumptious Sandwiches!!



Pear and Roast Beef Sandwiches

1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1 medium tomato, seeded and chopped
1/4 cup finely crumbled feta cheese
12 slices sourdough bread, toasted
1 1/2 pounds thinly sliced deli roast beef
2 medium ripe pears, thinly sliced
6 ounces Havarti cheese, thinly sliced
12 Bibb lettuce leaves or Boston lettuce leaves

In a small bowl, combine yogurt, mayonnaise, tomato, and feta. Spread over one side of the toast slices. Top 6 toasts with beef, pears, Havarti cheese and lettuce. Top with remaining toast slices, spread side down.

Ham and Swiss Sliders

1 package (12 ounces) Hawaiian sweet rolls
1/2 cup horseradish sauce
3/4 pound sliced deli ham
6 slices Swiss cheese, halved
1/2 cup butter, cubed
2 tablespoons finely chopped onion
2 tablespoons brown sugar
1 tablespoon spicy brown mustard
2 teaspoons poppy seeds
1 1/2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder

Without separating rolls, cut rolls in half horizontally. Arrange bottom halves of rolls in a greased 9 x 9-inch baking pan. Spread cut side of roll bottoms with horseradish sauce. Layer with ham and cheese; replace tops of rolls. In a small skillet, heat butter over medium-high heat. Add onion; cook and stir until tender, one to two minutes. Stir in remaining five ingredients and pour over rolls. Refrigerate, covered, several hours or overnight. Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees. Bake sliders, covered for 25 minutes. Bake, uncovered, until golden brown, five to ten minutes longer.

Dilly Turkey Melt

2 medium onions, sliced
4 tablespoons butter, divided
4 tablespoons barbecue sauce
8 slices sourdough bread
8 slices Monterey Jack cheese
8 slices Canadian bacon
8 thin slices cooked turkey
Dill pickle slices

In a large cast iron or other heavy skillet, sauté onions in one tablespoon butter until tender; remove and set aside. Spread barbecue sauce on four slices of bread. Layer each with one slice of cheese, two slices each of Canadian bacon and turkey, pickle slices, onions, and another slice of cheese. Cover with remaining slices of bread. In the same skillet over medium-low heat, melt remaining butter. Grill sandwiches on both sides until golden brown and cheese is melted. Cover the skillet during the last few minutes to help melt the cheese, if necessary.

Club Roll-Ups

3 ounces cream cheese, softened
1/2 cup ranch salad dressing
2 tablespoons ranch salad dressing mix
8 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
1/2 cup finely chopped onion
1 can (2 1/4 ounces) sliced ripe olives, drained
1 jar (2 ounces) diced pimientos, drained
1/4 cup diced canned jalapeno peppers
8 flour tortillas (10 inches), room temperature
8 thinly sliced deli ham
8 thinly sliced deli turkey
8 thinly sliced deli roast beef
2 cups shredded cheddar cheese


In a small bowl, beat the cream cheese, ranch dressing and dressing mix until well blended. In another bowl, combine the bacon, onion, olives, pimientos, and jalapenos. Spread cream cheese mixture over tortillas, layer with ham, turkey, and roast beef. Sprinkle with bacon mixture and cheddar cheese; roll up.

Toasted Reubens

4 teaspoons prepared mustard
8 slices rye bread
4 slices Swiss cheese
1 pound thinly sliced deli corned beef
1 can (8 ounces) sauerkraut, rinsed and well drained
1/2 cup mayonnaise
3 tablespoons ketchup
2 tablespoons sweet pickle relish
1 tablespoon prepared horseradish
2 tablespoons butter

Spread mustard over four slices of bread. Layer each with cheese, corned beef and sauerkraut. In a small bowl, mix mayonnaise, ketchup, relish and horseradish; spread over remaining bread and place over sauerkraut. Spread outside of sandwiches with butter. In a large cast iron or other heavy skillet, toast sandwiches over medium heat until golden brown and cheese is melted, three to four minutes on each side.

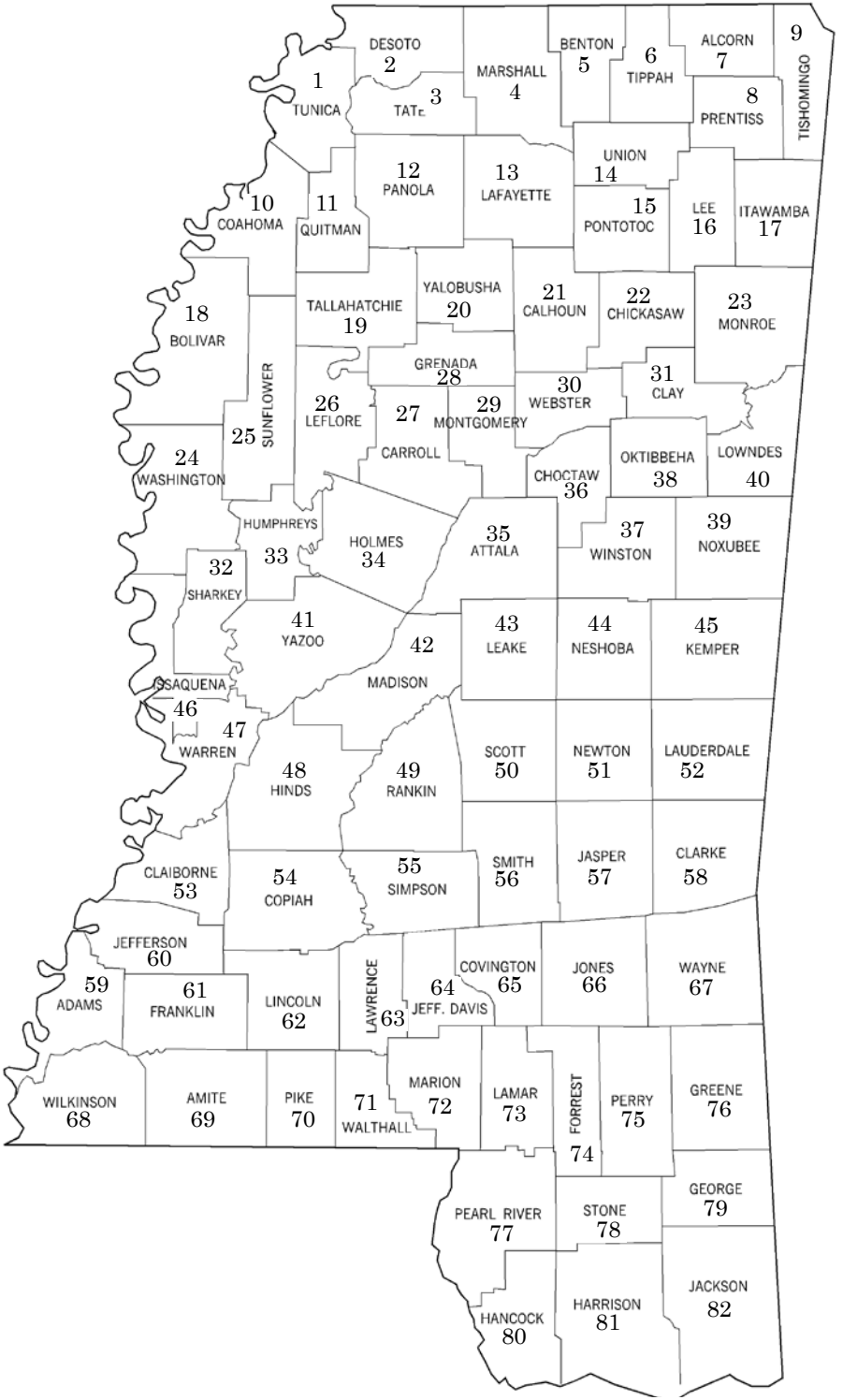

USDA To Conduct First-Ever Agroforestry Survey

By USDA-NASS

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) is conducting the first-ever National Agroforestry Survey. Data collection began February 1 and concludes April 5, 2022. NASS will mail the survey to 243 farmers and ranchers in Mississippi to gather information on the five agroforestry practices used for climate, conservation and production benefits, including windbreaks, silvopasture, riparian forest buffers, alley cropping as well as forest farming and multi-story cropping.

"In this first-ever survey, ag producers have the opportunity to share the different ways they manage valuable agroforestry resources," said Esmerelda Dickson, Mississippi State Statistician. "The data will inform programs and policy to benefit

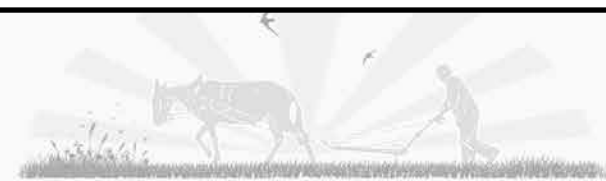

In addition, an overall best group was chosen from the 56 parade entries for the coveted Commissioner's Award.

A panel of local celebrity and distinguished judges determined this year's winners, including Donna West, former Co-coordinator of the Dixie National Parade; Billie Jade Chapman, Mississippi FFA President; celebrity Chef Nick Wallace of the Nissan Café and Nick Wallace Culinary; and Kayla Thompson, WJTV News Anchor.

For best motorized club, Crossroad Cruisers of Grenada County took home first place, and the Mississippi International Harvester Collectors Club, Chapter 44, took home second place. In marching groups, the Hinds Community College Hi-Steppers of Hinds County took home first place, and

Rankin County's McLaurin JROTC took home second place. For best decorative floats, the Mystic Wind Choctaw Dancers of Neshoba County received first place and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce's Genuine MS® program received second place. In best riding clubs, the Dixie National Rodeo Queens and Sweethearts received first place, and Judy Presley atop Brisket the Bull from Luverne, Alabama, received second place.

Eight individual wagon trains from around the state of Mississippi make up the famous Dixie National Wagon Train. Miss Mississippi Holly Brand awarded third place to the Mt. Olive Wagon Train, second place went to Wesson Wagon Train, and the Smith County Wagon Train took home first place. This year, one group in particular stood out as the best overall participant. The Mississippi Horse Rescue group was awarded the 2022 Commissioner's Award.
