Favorable Weather Produces Good Quality Watermelons

Watermelon production in Mississippi is off to a good start in the early days of harvest season.

“Right now, everything looks really good,” said Heath Steede, Mississippi State University Extension agent in George County. “They’re pulling them pretty hot and heavy right now.”

So far, weather conditions have been favorable. Fields have gotten the right mix of rain and clear skies.

Watermelons require a balance of rain, sun and warm weather to

reach peak size and sweetness. Rains early in the growing season help melons grow to the proper size, but too much rain later on can introduce disease and cause the crop to ruin. Cloudy skies also reduce melon sweetness.

“Melon quality is good,” said Steede, who works with seven commercial growers in his county. “The dry weather we’ve been having hurts other crops, but for watermelons it has been what we needed. We haven’t had any excess water, which makes them less sweet.”

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture Crop Progress and Condition Report issued June 12, watermelon quality is 67% good and 31% fair. Harvest is 10% complete compared to 7% at this time last year.

Growers have seen an average amount of disease but nothing out of the ordinary, Steede said.

“There is some disease just like

always,” he said. “But it is nothing we don’t normally see.”

As with other crops, growers need good weather at every stage of crop production. If the weather turns rainy, the crop could suffer.

“If we do start getting a lot of rain, that will increase disease and hurt melon quality,” Steede said.

Wholesale prices are not as good as in years past because of supply.

“There are a lot of watermelons across the Southeast this year,” Steede said. “No one is knocking down doors to buy this year. They are selling but for less money.”

Most of Mississippi’s watermelons are grown in the southeast portion of the state. However, north Mississippi does produce some watermelons. Reid Nevins, an Extension agent in Lowndes County who has one commercial producer in his county, said pro-

duction is on track for the area.

“What I’ve seen of his crop looks really good,” he said. “Harvest is later here in north Mississippi than in south Mississippi, but the crop is progressing like it should.”

Watermelon crops in north Mississippi will not be ready until around July 4.

“I don’t know of any problems with watermelons. I haven’t gotten any calls for that,” Nevins said.

Watermelon Varieties

Bush Charleston Gray—bush-type plant; 10- to 13-pound melons; red flesh.

Bush Jubilee—bush-type plant; 10- to 13-pound oblong fruit; red flesh.

Charleston Gray—30 pounds; oblong; light green; bright red flesh and dark seeds; some disease resistance.

Crimson Sweet—23 to 30 pounds; semi-round; distinct striping; thick, hard rind; sweet, red flesh; some disease resistance.

Jubilee—25 to 40 pounds; long; light green with dark stripes; red flesh with black seeds; some

disease resistance.

Jubilee II—22 to 30 pounds; oblong; light green with dark green stripes; open-pollinated; firm, red flesh; sweet; some disease resistance.

Royal Jubilee—hybrid Jubilee type; elongated; 25 to 30 pounds; bright red flesh; resistant to fusarium and anthracnose.

Royal Sweet—20 to 25 pounds; hybrid; oblong; medium-green stripes; bright red flesh and small dark seeds; some disease resistance.

New Law Prohibits Live Transportation of Wild Hogs

In Mississippi, wild hogs are legally classified as a “nuisance” animal. Wild hogs are non-native, nuisance animals and cause more than \$60 million dollars in property damage across the state each year. They cause substantial damage to row crops, pastures, and forestlands; carry diseases that are

harmful to humans and other animals; and eat the eggs and young of many wildlife species. Costs associated with this invasive species across the United States exceeds \$1 billion annually. Landowners, leaseholders, and their designated agents may trap and hunt wild hogs year-round in Mississippi to combat this destructive animal. During the 2022 Regular Session, the Mississippi Legislature passed House Bill 1065 as another

measure to fight wild hogs. House Bill 1065 becomes effective July 1, 2022, and states “No person may transport on public roads or off of the property of record where captured or relocate within the state any live feral hog, wild swine or Russian Boar.” The new law will prohibit all live transportation of wild hogs on public roads. A violation will be punishable by a fine not less than \$2,000 nor more than \$5,000. The violator will also

have to forfeit all hunting, trapping, and fishing privileges for a period of not less than 12 consecutive months from the date of conviction. To report a transportation violation, call the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks at 1-800-BE-SMART (1-800-237-6278).

Through its Wild Hog Control Program, the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) offers traps to land managers for the control of wild hogs on private agricultural and forestry lands in Mississippi. MDAC provides the training necessary to use the “smart” traps and technical guidance regarding the most effective methods to trap and control wild hogs on private lands. Wonderful Watermelon!



Chunky Watermelon Lemonade

2 cups water
1/3 cup raw sugar – or to taste
2 cups seedless watermelon puree
1 fresh lemon, thinly sliced
1/4 cup lemon juice
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
2 cups chopped seedless watermelon flesh – optional for the “chunky” element

In a half-gallon pitcher with lid, mix 1 cup of the water with the sugar until sugar is completely dissolved. Stir in the rest of the water, watermelon puree, sliced lemon, lemon juice, and vanilla extract. Stir to mix well and chill thoroughly. For the chunky watermelon lemonade, stir in the 2 cups of chopped watermelon at the end.

Watermelon Island Fruit Salad

2 cups watermelon, chopped
2 tablespoons sugar
2 tablespoons water
1/2 lime juiced (1 tablespoon)
1 1/2 teaspoons rum extract
2 kiwis, peeled and diced
1 orange sectioned and halved
2 teaspoons flaked, sweetened coconut

In a small bowl, add the sugar and water and microwave for 20 seconds. Stir to completely dissolve sugar. Cool. Once cool, add lime juice and extract. In a medium bowl, add kiwi, orange and watermelon. Pour rum juice over the top and thoroughly toss. Let sit for 30 minutes to allow flavors to blend. Divide fruit salad into two bowls and sprinkle with coconut.

Watermelon Kebobs

18 1-inch-cubes seedless watermelon
6 cubes smoked turkey breast
6 cubes cheddar cheese
6 coffee stirrers or beverage straws

Cut watermelon, turkey and cheese in cubes and skewer on stirrers or straws.

Watermelon Brownie Bites

Fresh watermelon, either balled or cut into 1/2-3/4” chunks
Store-bought or homemade brownie bites, about 1” in diameter
Large Marshmallows
Rainbow sprinkles
Water
Toothpicks

With your toothpick, skewer one watermelon ball.

Dip a marshmallow halfway in water and roll with sprinkles and thread on the skewer. Lastly thread a brownie bite. Repeat for as many servings as desired. Enjoy!

Roasted Watermelon Rind Parmesan

5 cups peeled and chopped watermelon rind, 1 to 1-1/2 inch pieces
2 tablespoons olive oil
1 teaspoon kosher salt
1/4 rounded teaspoon coarsely ground black pepper
1/3 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
1 tablespoon fresh lemon thyme leaves (may use regular thyme)
2 teaspoons finely chopped fresh rosemary leaves
3/4 teaspoon sherry vinegar

Preheat oven to 400 degrees Fahrenheit. Line a large baking sheet with aluminum foil. Baking sheet should have about 1-inch sides. Do not use a flat sheet as oil may drip off into oven. In a large bowl stir together watermelon rind, olive oil, Kosher salt and black pepper until rind is coated. Spread rind in a single layer onto baking sheet. Place in oven and roast 1 hour, stirring every 15 minutes until rind is bite tender (not mushy), and browning. Pour roasted rind into a medium bowl and stir together with cheese, thyme, rosemary, and vinegar. Garnish as desired. Serve warm.

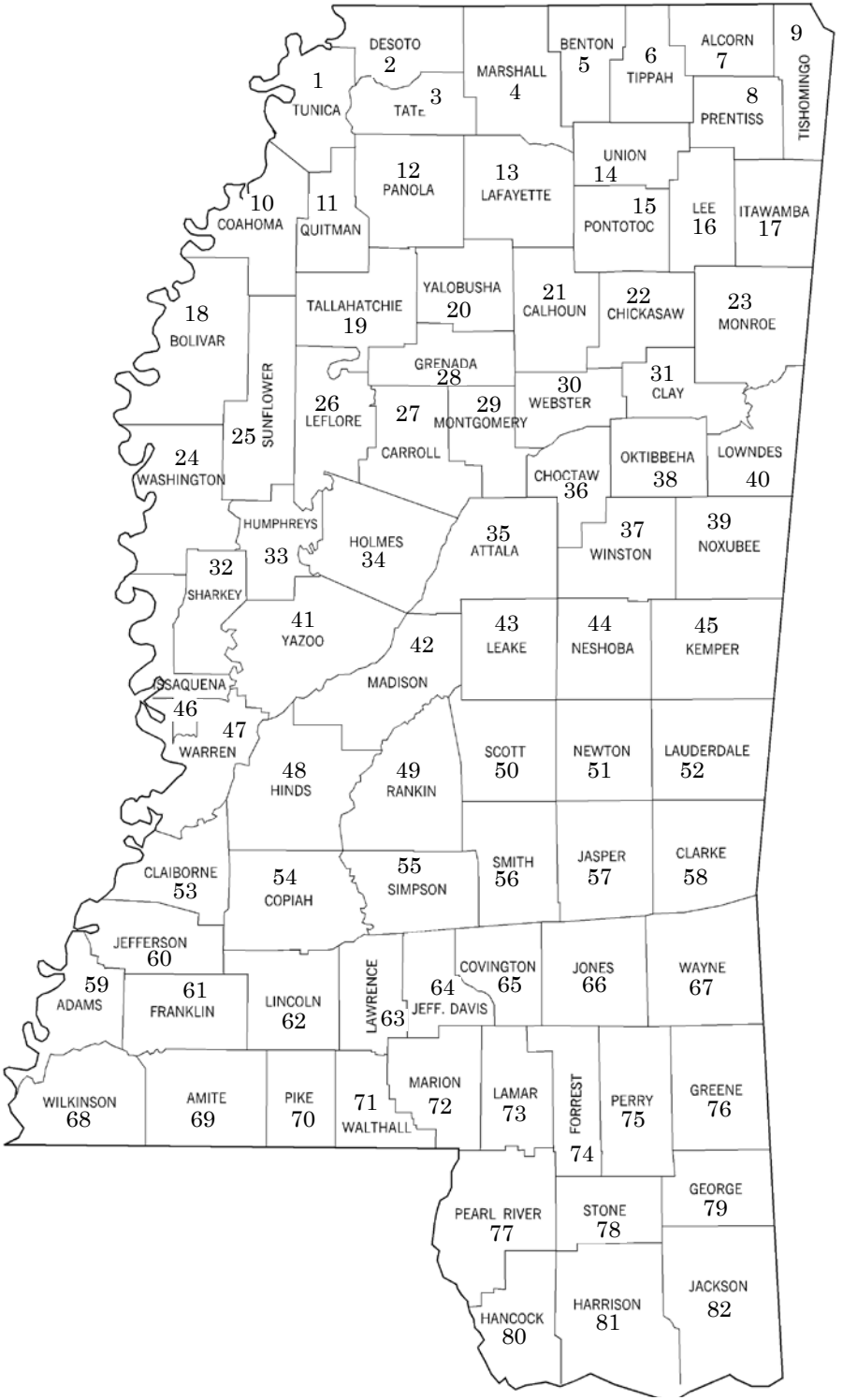



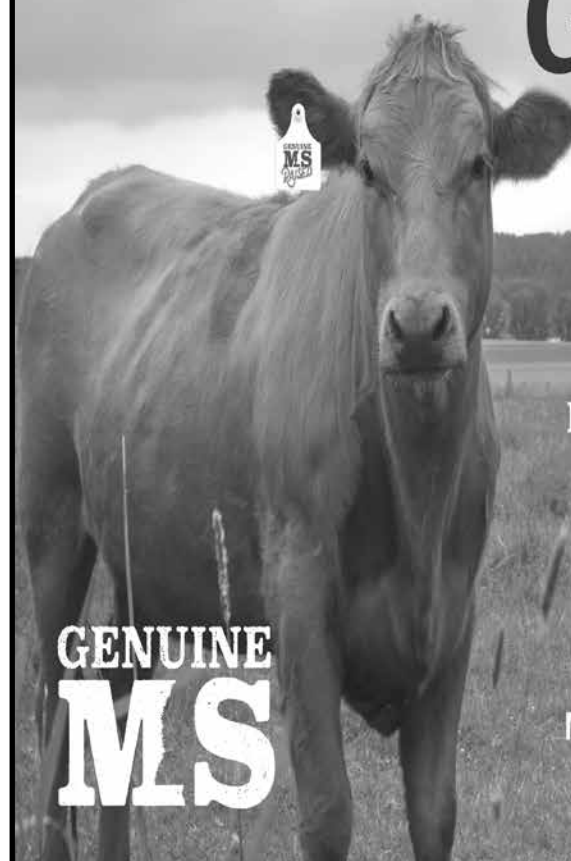

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Check Canning Equipment Before Harvest Begins

Gardeners who want to preserve their abundant harvests by canning should make their list and check it twice -- now, before it's time to begin canning.

Home canners should be sure they have the right recipes and equipment for the foods they intend to preserve. They should also make sure they inspect all their equipment.

"The canning process is a lot easier when you have the right equipment, plenty of supplies and research-based recipes," said Janet Jolley, agent with the Mississippi State University Extension Service in Marshall County. "Canning season will go a lot smoother."

First, check for all needed equipment:

- boiling-water canner
- pressure canner
- canning thermometer
- approved, threaded, home canning jars with two-piece lids
- canning lids and rings
- canning utensils
 - jar lifter for removing hot jars from a canner
 - big-mouth funnel to help pack foods into jars
 - headspace gauge to ensure the proper distance between the surface of food and underside of the jar lid
 - clean cloth or paper towels to wipe the rims of jars before putting lids on
 - narrow spatula for removing air bubbles from jars
 - magnetic lid wand to help remove metal lids from hot water

Second, inspect all equipment to ensure it is safe to use and that canned items will reach the pressure and temperature to properly seal and kill harmful bacteria that could cause food spoilage or foodborne illness.

Take these steps to check or replace equipment:

- Inspect the canner:
 - Check the gasket for cracks. Replace if cracks are present.
 - Ensure that petcocks, vents and safety valves are not clogged.
 - Have dial gauge canners tested to make sure they are accurate. Check with the local Extension office for testing availability.
- Check jars on hand for cracks, and note the sizes available to ensure there are enough.
- Buy new lids. Never reuse canning lids.

- Check ring bands for dents and rust. Replace if either or both are present.
- Check the jar lifter, bubble freer and headspace gauge to ensure they are in proper working order.
- Ensure there are enough pots and pans for blanching.
- Check other needed equipment, including knives, vegetable peelers and long-handled spoons.

Jolley points out that some equipment is an absolute necessity to preserve foods properly. Home canners cannot do without a boiling-water canner, a pressure canner, a jar lifter, jars, lids and rings, and a clean cloth or paper towels.

However, some equipment may not be necessary but does make the process easier. Nonessential items include a canning funnel, a bubble freer and a magnetic lid wand. A plastic knife can be used to release bubbles. Do not use a metal knife. It could damage the jars.

Fran Brock, Extension agent in Oktibbeha County, stressed the importance of using the correct type of canner with the right technique and research-backed recipe.

Boiling-water canners are used to process jams, jellies, preserves and high-acid foods, such as tomatoes and some fruits. A pressure canner is used when processing low-acid foods such as vegetables, meats and seafood.

"To store canned food at room temperature safely, foods must be sealed in an airtight container and must receive sufficient heat processing to kill all microorganisms that can cause spoilage and Botulism poisoning," said Brock. "You need to use the right equipment, technique and recipe together to achieve this."

"You should always use research-based home canning recipes. These recipes have been tested in a laboratory to give the correct measurements of all ingredients, jar size, measurements of pH, time, temperature and pressure. These factors com-

bined help kill bacteria," Brock said.

Processing foods for the correct amount of time and at the right temperature also inactivates enzymes in the food that negatively change color, texture, flavor and nutritional value, Brock said.

Extension recommends that people follow the instructions provided by the National Center for Home Food Preservation for preserving any food items at home to reduce microorganisms that can cause foodborne illnesses. Housed at the University of Georgia, the center uses the research-backed data supported by and gathered from USDA testing.

While electric pressure cookers, also called multicookers, are great for getting meals on the table quickly, Extension does not recommend their use in home canning. Even cookers that come with recipes and a canning and preserving function on their digital controls are not recommended.

"Food spoilage and foodborne illness are two of the dangers of using a multicooker for canning foods," Jolley said. "The National Center for Home Food Preservation makes clear that their tested canning processes are not recommended for use in electric pressure multicookers at this time. The center developed their recipes for stovetop pressure canners, which hold four or more quart-size jars standing upright."

Brock said other unsafe canning methods cooks should never use include the open kettle canning method, the oven canning method and dishwasher processing.

"None of these methods provide sufficient heat to kill harmful bacteria," she said.

Extension Publication 1152, "The Complete Guide to Home Canning," provides more detailed information about equipment, supplies and preservation techniques.

Hardy Hibiscus Provides Tropical Look each year

Those who know me know I have lots of favorite plants because I don't think anyone should be limited to just one or two choices. Today, I want to tell you about my late-spring to early-summer favorite, the hardy hibiscus.

As the name implies, hardy hibiscus selections are winter hardy, having been bred from the native hibiscus of the Gulf coast. The flowers of hardy hibiscus are HUGE, sometimes up to 12 inches across. They are often called dinner plate hibiscuses.

Flower colors include white, pinks, reds and bicolors. Like tropical hibiscus varieties, the flowers are bright, beautiful and gaudy.

The foliage of hardy hibiscus is not as glossy as the tropical varieties. Foliage colors can vary from light to medium green, with some selections even offering burgundy and dark-purple leaves.

Hardy hibiscus plants are bushy and grow from 2 to 5 feet tall. They love the sun and need moist, well-drained soil. Keep these plants watered to ensure larger flowers and lush foliage. Deadhead to improve the appearance of the plant.

For the past several years, I've grown Summerific Summer Storm and love the dark foliage and creamy white with dark pink-maroon highlights.

Last year, I added several great-looking varieties to my home gar-

den.

Spinderella has 8-inch white flowers with pink-accented edges and a dark-red eye. This plant's dark-green leaves form a tidy, dense and well-rounded bush.

Edge of Night is wonderful for late-season color. It has large, 7- to 8-inch bubblegum pink flowers that have a darker pink veining. Another outstanding feature is its large, mounding habit of jet-black foliage.

Cranberry Crush is a naturally compact selection that works well in large containers. It produces 7- to 8-inch, deep-scarlet-red flowers all over its dense, rounded clump of deep-green, leathery foliage that looks a lot like maple leaves.

In 2020, my Summer Storm set seeds for the first time. I collected them and actually got five to germinate. Each seedling had a different coloration and leaf form. Through pollination and the mixing of genes, the new plants express characteristics of the plants that went into breeding Summer Storm.

This is different than what happens when you make rooting cuttings, as these are clones with the same genetic makeup.

I can't share pictures of my new plants yet because they may have market potential, and I'm not ready for public disclosure.

Hardy hibiscus is always one of the last perennials to emerge in spring, so be patient. These plants have a vigorous growth rate that more than makes up for their late start.
