MDAC Hosts Historic Inbound Trade Mission and Timber Products Showcase

The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) and the Southern United States Trade Association (SUSTA) recently hosted timber buyers from the Dominican Republic, Mexico, United Kingdom, Spain and Vietnam.

"Forestry is Mississippi's third largest agricultural sector, and I am delighted with the efforts put forward by our agency's Timber Commerce Division to host multiple trade delegates from several countries," said Mississippi Commis-

The trade delegation toured Jones Lumber Company in Natchez, Weyerhaeuser Pearl River Nursery in Hazlehurst and Thomasson Lumber Company in Macon before attending the first-ever Mississippi Timber Products Showcase at the Mississippi Trade Mart. During the showcase, these international trade delegates held business to business meetings and visited with Mississippi timber exporters from around the state.

"It was a pleasure to represent the Port of Gulfport at the Mississippi Timber Product Showcase and highlight the role we can play in helping connect international consumers with high quality Mississippi goods. By working together with thriving Mississippi industries such as forest products, we can continue to drive growth for the state's economy and create great jobs for Mississippians," said Jon Nass, CEO & Executive Director of Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport.

"We were honored to participate in the first Mississippi state organized timber conference where we had the opportunity to connect and interact with some of our trading partners and were exposed to potential business that will expand our commercial base and increase exports. MDAC provided the visiting timber buyers with a look into the entire process of Mississippi's timber industry from seedling to sawmill. In addition to leaders in the timber industry and top logging companies, trade delegates and exporters alike met with logistics experts in transportation and international shipping ports located in the state. The tours included demonstrations from harvesting outfits, as well as translating facilities, of hardwoods and southern yellow pine softwoods, which exhibited the extensive capacity and sustainability of Mississippi timber.

Our goal has been to increase the awareness of our Mississippi timber resources globally and this mission was successful in showcasing our state and our timber in a positive way. 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Commissioner's Policy Corner MDAC Publishes Grain Slow Pay Hotline for Farmers

During the 2022 legislative session, the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) supported legislation establishing a grain indemnity fund to protect farmers when grain elevators fail. Although that legislation did not become law, MDAC is publishing a slow pay hotline to help farmers report slow pay or other issues for investigation by MDAC.

Effective July 1, 2022, ALL MDAC-licensed grain warehouse and grain dealer licenses contain Slow Pay Hotline Information at the bottom of the license. Under state law, all licenses are required to be displayed in a prominent location at each licensed facility. Farmers delivering grain to MDAC-licensed facilities should be advised they can call this hotline to report any slow pay, no pay or other suspicious activity.

The difference between a warehouse and dealer contract: If a farmer sells grain to a dealer, the grain title passes to the dealer. If the farmer enters a warehouse contract, the title stays with the farmer but the farmer must get a warehouse receipt evidencing the warehouse contract.

What is a grain dealer?

A grain dealer is a person in the business of buying grain from producers and must be licensed by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce prior to purchasing any grain in the State of Mississippi.

Who owns the grain that is delivered to the grain dealer?

Once the producer delivers grain to a "licensed" dealer, the grain becomes the property of the dealer.

When can the farmer expect payment from the grain dealer?

That depends on the terms of the agreement between the dealer and the producer and should be decided prior to the agreement being executed by both the dealer and the producer.

What if a grain dealer does not have a license and has purchased my grain?

The law requires that the license be posted in the principal office of the licensee and prohibits any person from purchasing grain for resale, milling or for processing, that does not hold a license. Penalties for operating without a license range from \$100-\$1,000 or six months in jail.

How many grain dealers are licensed in Mississippi?

There are currently 44 grain dealers licensed in the state.

What is a grain warehouse?

A grain warehouse is a facility designed to unload, elevate, store, load for shipment, dry, clean, weigh, treat, condition, or otherwise handle grain from producers and must be licensed by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce prior to purchasing any grain in the State of Mississippi. USDA also licenses some grain warehouses under federal law.

Can a grain warehouse act as a grain dealer?

Yes, the grain warehouse is acting as a grain dealer when buying grain from a producer on contract or at the time of delivery.

Who owns the grain that is delivered to the grain warehouse?

It depends, if the producer delivers grain to the "licensed" warehouse, the grain becomes the property of the warehouse. If the producer delivers grain to the "licensed" warehouse and a warehouse receipt or a non-negotiable scale ticket is issued, the grain re-


mains the property of the producer.

What if a grain warehouse does not have a license and has purchased my grain?

The law requires that the license be posted in a conspicuous place in the office of the grain warehouse and prohibits any person to operate or issue a warehouse receipt without having obtained a license. The Penalty for operating without a license is \$20,000 and imprisonment for 5 years.

How many grain warehouses are licensed in Mississippi?

There are currently 10 warehouses licensed in the state, plus several federally licensed warehouses.



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3 tablespoons butter 1/8 teaspoon salt 3/4 cup pecans, chopped 1 tablespoon plus 1/4 cup sugar, divided 1/2 cup brown sugar, packed 2 tablespoons cornstarch 1/3 cup maple syrup 2 eggs, beaten 2 1/2 cups milk 1 cup whipping cream 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Combine first butter, salt, pecans and one tablespoon sugar, and spread on a baking sheet in a single layer. Roast at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Stir and roast 15 minutes longer; cool. Combine remaining sugars, cornstarch, syrup and eggs in top of a double boiler. Gradually add milk. Cook over boiling water until mixture thickens. Remove from heat and chill two hours or overnight. Stir in toasted pecans, cream and vanilla. Place mixture in ice cream freezer and freeze according to manufacturer's directions. Allow to ripen in ice cream freezer or firm up in refrigerator freezer an hour before serving.

MISSISSIPPI FARMERS MARKET

Juice from 1 large orange Juice from 3 lemons 3 cups sugar 1 teaspoon vanilla 1 quart milk 1 pint cream

Mix together peach pulp, all juices, sugar and vanilla. Let stand at room temperature for three hours. Mix with milk and cream, and pour into an ice-cream maker. Freeze following the manufacturer's instructions.

Blueberry Ice Cream

2 pints fresh blueberries 1 1/2 cups sugar 3 tablespoons orange juice 4 cups light cream 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

In a three-quart saucepan combine blueberries, sugar and orange juice. Mash berries slightly and cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until back of a wooden spoon. Cool the mixture. In the chilled canister of ice cream maker combine blueberry mixture, cream and vanilla. Freeze according to manufacturer's directions.

Strawberry Lemonade Ice Pops

1 cup water

1 cup sugar

3 cups fresh strawberries or other berries of your choice

1/2 cup fresh lemon juice

1/2 cup fresh herbs such as mint and/or rosemary, loosely packed (optional)

In a medium saucepan, bring sugar and water to a boil, and then reduce to a simmer. Stir occasionally until slightly thickened (to the consistency of corn syrup), about 10 minutes. Set aside to cool. Place strawberries and lemon juice (and herbs, if using) in a blender or food processor. Puree until smooth. If using herbs, puree until they are well chopped. Slowly pour in simple syrup until well combined. Pour into ice pop mold, and freeze for about eight hours. Source: farmflavor.com





USDA begins 2022 Agricultural Resource Management Survey

By USDA-NASS

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) is collecting data from approximately 560 Mississippi farmers and ranchers for its annual Agricultural Resource Management Survey (ARMS). The survey looks at all aspects of U.S. agricultural production, the well-being of farm households, farm finances, chemical usage, and various farm production characteristics. The survey also collects detailed information on production practices, costs, and returns for different commodities on a rotating basis. In 2022, the survey will take a closer look at wheat production in the United States.

"The annual data from ARMS are used to gauge the financial health and resource use of today's producers," said Esmerelda Dickson, Mississippi State Statistician. "The information gives us an annual snapshot of the role of the farming industry in the U.S. economy."

The information producers provide through the survey will inform national and state policy decisions. In addition, ARMS data are used to calculate the farm sector portion of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP), which is an important measure of the U.S. economy.

The survey is conducted in three phases from June 2022 through April 2023. The current (first) phase screens participants to ensure they have the commodities of interest that are needed to accurately represent the entire U.S. farm sector. During the second phase. NASS will collect information on production practices and chemical use for specific commodities. In the final phase, NASS will survey producers on farm income and production expenditures. Mississippi will be included in the first and final phase of this survey project.

"We strongly encourage every producer contacted for ARMS to participate, as their response represents not just their own farm but many other similar operations across the country," added Dickson. "For maximum convenience, producers should complete the survey online at agcounts.usda.gov with the survey code mailed to them. Online reporting is fast and secure. Producers may also mail or fax their completed questionnaire to us."

All information from respondents is kept confidential, as required by federal law, and reported so that no individual operation or producer can be identified. For more information on how NASS protects information, visit www.nass.usda.gov/confidentiality.

Mississippi Adds Mill Capacity, Timber Moving

Mississippi has gained new timber mills over the last 18 months, and producers have seen timber prices rise since last year.

In 2021, the timber industry, which is one of the state's top five most valuable agricultural commodities, ranked third with an estimated production value of nearly \$1.29 billion.

"Other than pine pulpwood, prices for all major stumpage products are up from the first quarter of 2021," said Shaun Tanger, forestry economics specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service.

Tanger said new sawmill construction and expansions by existing mills seems to be fostering optimism despite the caution around prices. Enviva Biomass recently announced new mill construction in Bond, while Claw Forestry announced plans to build a new sawmill operation in Gloster.

"Anecdotally, several consultants have told me interest is up for timber properties in their respective regions," he said. "Several of the new mills and expansions announced in 2020 are either going full speed or are close to being at full production. We expect to see all of them running at full production by the end of the year. So, from an added capacity standpoint things look very good for the long term."

Other recently opened mills include Enviva's wood pellet production facility in Lucedale, Idaho Forest Group's Lumberton sawmill, Mission Forest Products' Corinth mill and the Biewer Lumber mill in Winona.

These mills are a welcome addition to the nearly 70 timber production facilities Mississippi had in 2021.

"Overall, supply will continue t

to build, although more slowly, through 2028 to 2030," he said. "Growth-to-drain ratios will improve dramatically, though. So, our forests will get healthier as the markets get healthier."

Growth-to-drain ratio is a calculation used to compare timber growth to timber harvest yearly to help estimate how well supply is meeting demand. It can indicate whether timberland is a good long-term investment.

Tanger said more mills and conservative price increases indicate that the next five to seven years could bring more positive changes for landowners.

"The silver lining for landowners is that wood is moving and should continue to move with all the added mill capacity," he said. "Prices are up from last year. They are also up for loggers, but so too are costs. The logging workforce is really being pinched right now due in part to high fuel costs."

Some wood mills are increasing the price they pay in some circum-

stances to help loggers with this issue. But mills may not continue to do this if fuel prices continue to rise, Tanger said.

The same may not be true for timber prices.

"I'm not sure prices are going to continue to rise for stumpage as the markets have seemed to pause in response to the recent interest rate hikes by the Federal Reserve Board," Tanger said.

Overall, prices are higher this year compared to 2021. However, stumpage prices fell in the second quarter of 2022 compared to the first quarter, said Marc Measells, Extension forestry economist.

"There are several factors that contribute to the decrease, including the increased cost of logging and trucking operations because of higher diesel fuel prices, drier weather during the second quarter, declines in new home construction in 2022, and decreased lumber prices due to fewer homes being built," Measells said.

MDAC Division Spotlight - Petroleum Products Inspection

Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) Petroleum Products Inspection Division regulates the motor fuel sold in Mississippi to ensure that those who purchase petroleum products and motor fuels get what they pay for in terms of quality and quantity. This division regulates approximately 2.3 billion gallons of fuel consumed by Mississippians and visitors to the state and conducts annual inspections of the Retail Motor-Fuel Dispensers (RMFD), commonly known as gas pumps, to ensure compliance with all laws and regulations.

In addition, all petroleum products sold in the state must be registered with MDAC's Petroleum Products Inspection Division. In FY2021 alone, the Petroleum Division conducted annual inspections of over 56,300 registered devices at retail establishments and over 45,370 individual devices. Also, division inspectors responded to 165 consumer complaints which resulted in corrective action being taken in over 28% of the complaints for non-compliance.

Today, our farmers and consumers alike are facing record high gas prices. The average farm diesel price is up 127% compared to last year and currently costs \$52,100 to fill up a 10,000-gallon tank of farm diesel fuel -- more than double the cost compared to last year.

Though some see the MDAC Petroleum Inspection stickers on gas pumps and think MDAC regulates the price of gasoline, the agency does not play a part in setting or changing fuel prices. However, in these difficult times, the public can be assured that the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce's Petroleum Division will continue to secure a fair marketplace within the petroleum industry by inspecting each motor fuel device at every gas station in the state.
