Rice Producers Expect Good 2022 Harvest

Mississippi rice producers and crop specialists are optimistic about the state's 2022 harvest despite a high population of rice stink bugs that were difficult to treat.

"Overall, it's so far, so good," said Hunter Bowman, rice specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service and researcher with the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station. "It was really hot and dry when it was heading out and pollination was happening. But hopefully, that won't have much of a detrimental effect."

According to the U.S. Depart-

ment of Agriculture Crop Progress and Condition report released Aug. 8, rice is 90% headed and 15% mature, which is slightly ahead of the 5-year average. Fifty-two percent of the crop is in good condition. Twelve percent is in excellent condition, and 33% is in fair condition.

Another worry for farmers this year was the rice stink bug, which showed up in force. Rice stink bugs feed on the rice grain, stunting plant growth and reducing yield. These pests can also transmit diseases and viruses to the plants.

To make matters worse, farmers faced poor control from pyrethroids -- the first line of defense and one of only three labeled pesticides available to treat the pest in rice.

"Tenchu and malathion are the two other labeled options in addition to pyrethroids, but those pesticides were in short supply and dealers ran out," Bowman said.

This situation led Extension crop specialists to work with the Bureau of Plant Industry to request a Section 18 crisis exemption from the Environmental Protection Agency for an additional pesticide that would help farmers control the insects while not disrupting harvest. A crisis exemption was granted for the pesticide Endigo ZC on July 28.

"We were able to get the exemption, but there was a limited supply of Endigo ZC, too," said Bowman, who is stationed at the MSU Delta Research and Extension Center in Stoneville. "We had trouble getting our hands on it."

Bowman noted that there was only enough malathion this year to treat 50,000 to 60,000 acres across the entire U.S. While malathion has been in short supply for sev-

eral years, the COVID-19 pandemic tightened supplies and raised prices on all kinds of pesticides.

"If producers were unable to get any of these alternatives, we recommended they run with extra applications of pyrethroids if they could get that," Bowman said. "That way, it would reduce the number of stink bugs to low levels and help protect yield."

Producers also face other issues each year, including rice water weevils and Italian ryegrass.

"Rice water weevils are sometimes a problem for us, but this year, we avoided any major issues," Bowman said. "Italian ryegrass in Mississippi has developed resistance to many herbicides we use for control in early spring, and herbicide options to control the weed in the fall when it emerges are limited due to plant-back restrictions in rice the following season."

Bowman said Mississippi acreage is down quite a bit compared to the 10-year average.

"We expected to plant about 100,000 acres, but we ended up

with between 88,000 and 90,000 acres," he said. "Some people decided to plant soybeans instead because of high urea prices and better soybean prices."

Will Maples, Extension agricultural economist, said supplies are down and prices are higher than in recent years.

Current projections by the USDA put the national average farm price at \$15.50 per hundredweight, which is \$1.80 higher than 2021. Since the first of August, the harvest month rough rice futures contract has averaged \$17.28 per hundredweight, Maples said.

"Even though rice producers are seeing higher prices, margins will likely be thinner than in years past due to increased input costs," he said. "The combination of higher input costs and high prices for other commodities limited rice plantings this spring. Long-grain rice supplies are currently projected 5% lower than last year with ending stocks currently 12% lower."

Consumers Take Notice Due to Inflation, High Gas Prices

With inflation at its highest levels since 1981 and drivers getting squeezed at the pump by high gas prices, consumers are not just paying more for goods and services, they're also paying more attention. We see that at the Department of Agriculture and Commerce as our consumer protection inspectors receive more requests for investigations at stores, and our petroleum inspectors field more complaints about questionable fuel. We want customers to get what they pay for, and we want businesses to succeed. Both of those depend on a fair market and that's just good business.

The state legislature designated MDAC's Consumer Protection Division to enforce retail food safety and sanitation laws in grocery and convenience stores, to ensure businesses adhere to weights and measure standards, to require compliance with food labeling requirements, and to verify UPC bar codes so customers are charged at the register the same as the price on the shelf.

MDAC inspectors routinely examine meat market sanitation, ensure food is stored at proper temperatures, confirm the availability of hot water and soap in restrooms, monitor stores for insects and rodents, and seek to keep spoiled or expired meat off the shelves. In the 2022 fiscal year, the Consumer Protection Division conducted 4,517 total inspections of businesses which included 5,842 retail scale inspections;



4,517 retail food sanitation inspections; 34,827 items for net weight; 2,762 disposition of garbage inspections; and 1,354 UPC price verification inspections.

MDAC performs these inspections routinely. As consumers feel the cost pressure of inflation, they are more aware of the prices on the shelves. When prices go up, complaints – especially about prices at the register not matching prices on the shelves (UPC) – go up as well. Once we receive a complaint, the inspector investigates and, if a violation is found, works to get the business into compliance. If the complaint is not a violation, the inspection serves as an educational opportunity for the business and the customer.

The same goes for our Petroleum Products Inspection Division which regulates 2.3 billion gallons of fuel consumed from Mississippi locations a year. All retail motor fuel – including gasoline, ethanol blended fuel, diesel, biodiesel, and kerosene – fall under this division which has samples analyzed at the Mississippi State Chemical Laboratory. The Mis-

sissippi State Chemical Lab checks for octane number, alcohol content, diesel flash point, biodiesel content, and whether water is present in the fuel. On site, inspectors check calibration as well as confirm signage to ensure the proper price is displayed and the proper fuel matches the advertised claim.

The Petroleum Products Inspection Division conducts annual inspections of all fuel pumps (Retail Motor Fuel Dispensers) in the state. Last fiscal year, that included 57,745 registered devices at 2,657 stations. In addition to the routine inspections, there were 223 consumer complaints all of which were investigated within 24 hours. About 32 percent of the complaints required corrective action for noncompliance. Between the routine inspections and consumer complaints, the Department enforced 997 "stop sales."

While the Department of Agriculture and Commerce cannot do anything about the price of gas, we can make sure you get what you pay for, and the product is what it claims. As gas prices go up, complaints in-

crease, but the violation rate stays about the same.

I suspect you're keeping an eye on costs, too. If you're in a retail grocery store and see a discrepancy between the cost on the shelf and the price at the register, or notice spoiled or unsanitary food, please reach out to the MDAC Consumer Protection Division at 601-359-1148. Likewise, if you have problems at the pump and suspect you're not getting the right fuel, the correct amount of fuel, there is water in the fuel, or you're being charged incorrectly, please contact the Petroleum Products Inspection Division at 601-359-1101.

Most businesses in Mississippi in violation of our fair market laws do so inadvertently. They want to treat their customers – their neighbors – fairly, and, when we point out noncompliance, they work quickly to remedy the situation. So, be sure to look for the "seal of approval" on all scales and pumps where you shop. You, our inspectors and Mississippi businesses working together can continue the fair standards that make our free market work.

Crispy Sesame Rice Salad

2 cups cooked and cooled jasmine rice

- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 tablespoon toasted sesame oil
- 1 tablespoon toasted sesame seeds
- 2 Persian cucumbers, thinly sliced
- 1 yellow mango, peeled and cubed
- 1/3 cup fresh cilantro leaves
- 2 tablespoons seasoned rice vinegar
- 1 teaspoon grated fresh ginger
- 1 (4 oz.) fillet hot smoked salmon, flaked

Heat olive oil and sesame oil in a large skillet over medium-high. Stir in sesame seeds and cook 1 minute. Add rice and press firmly into an even, compact layer. Cook, undisturbed, until lightly browned underneath, about 5 minutes. Meanwhile, combine cucumbers, mango, cilantro, rice vinegar, ginger, and a pinch of salt in a bowl; toss to combine. Toss rice and transfer it to a large bowl or plate. Scatter cucumber-mango mixture around rice, and top with flaked salmon. Garnish with additional toasted sesame seeds and another light drizzle of sesame oil, if desired. Enjoy warm.

Spinach Feta Rice

1 cup uncooked long grain rice 1 cup chicken broth

- 1 cup water
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 cup fresh mushrooms, sliced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- vegetable cooking spray
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano leaves
- 6 cups fresh spinach leaves, shredded
- 4 ounces feta cheese, crumbled
- ground black pepper, to taste

pimiento, chopped, for garnish

Combine rice, broth and water in medium saucepan. Bring to a boil; stir once or twice. Reduce heat; cover and simmer 15 minutes or until rice is tender and liquid is absorbed. Cook onion, mushrooms and garlic in large skillet coated with cooking spray until onion is tender. Stir in lemon juice and oregano. Add spinach, cheese and pepper to rice; toss lightly until spinach is wilted. Garnish with pimiento.

Savory Spinach & Rice Casserole

Vegetable cooking spray

- 3 cups cooked rice
- 2 cups Gruvere cheese, shredded
- 2 cups cooked ham, chopped
- 2 12-ounce packages frozen spinach soufflé, thawed
- 2 roma tomatoes, thinly sliced

Preheat oven to 400° and coat a 13x9x2-inch baking dish with cooking spray. In a large bowl, combine rice, cheese, ham, and spinach soufflé. Pour rice mixture into baking dish; top with tomato slices. Cover with foil and bake for 15 minutes; remove foil and bake an additional 15 minutes. Source: USA Rice Federation.

Tangy Lime Rice **Pudding Squares**

2 cups gingersnap, crumbled 1/3 cup butter, melted 3 cups cooked medium grain rice 2 cups milk 1 (14-ounce) can sweetened condensed milk

1/2 cup fresh lime juice

 $1\ \mathrm{cup}\ \mathrm{whipping}\ \mathrm{cream},\ \mathrm{whipped}$ lime peel (optional)

Crust: Combine gingersnap crumbs and melted butter in medium bowl; stir until blended. Press mixture along bottom and sides of 13x9x2-inch baking dish. Bake at 350° for 10 minutes. Filling: Combine rice, milk and sweetened condensed milk in 2-quart saucepan. Cook over medium heat until thick and creamy (20-25 minutes), stirring frequently. Remove from heat and stir in lime juice. Pour filling into prepared crust. Chill. Spread whipped cream over pudding. Cut into bars and garnish with lime peel, if desired. 



Commissioner Andy Gipson Announces Organic Certification Cost-Share

On August 12, 2022, Commissioner Andy Gipson announced that the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) is offering a cost-share program for Mississippi organic producers and handlers receiving certification or continuation of certification by a United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) accredited certifying agent


Funding is available for those that received the certification between October 1, 2021, and September 30, 2022. Individual organic operators are eligible for reimbursement of 50 percent of their fiscal year 2022 certification costs up to a maximum of \$500 per certification scope. The National Organic Certification Cost-Share Program currently recognizes the following certification scopes eligible for reimbursement: crops, wild crops, livestock and handling

such as processing

The following must be provided to MDAC by applicants in order to be eligible for reimbursement: proof of valid certification issued by a USDA accredited certifying agent, a reimbursement application form, an itemized receipt that identifies allowable costs paid within the qualification period, and an IRS W-9 form. Applicants must be Mississippi organic producers and handlers located within the state. Funds are available on a first-come, first-serve basis until the funds are depleted. Operations may receive one reimbursement per year. The deadline to submit applications is Tuesday, November 1, 2022.

Created in 2020, MDAC's Wild Hog Control Program provides "smart" wild hog traps to landowners and managers for the control of wild hogs on private agricultural and forestry lands in Mississippi. The Youth Trapping Corps is an expansion of WHCP and is designed to educate and professionally develop student members of agriculturebased organizations, such as FFA, on the impact of nuisance animals on agriculture and the importance of wild hog management.

The first-of-its-kind program will provide FFA students around the state the opportunity to offer wild hog trapping services while gaining valuable skills and workbased learning experiences. For this initiative, Wildlife Dominion Management, LLC is partnering with MDAC and the Mississippi FFA Association to educate, train and provide technical support for the implementation of wild hog population control. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, Wildlife Dominion Management, LLC and FFA to mark this innovative partnership.

"Youth are our future, and the new Wild Hog Control Program Youth Trapping Corps will allow FFA youth to gain knowledge

about agriculture and wildlife management through hands-on work experience. Mississippi is leading the way with the Wild Hog Control Program Youth Trapping Corps, as it is the first program of its kind in the country," said Commissioner Gipson.

Commissioner Gipson also recognized the Mississippi Pork Producers Association for their support of MDAC's Wild Hog Control Program. The Mississippi Pork Board and the National Pork Board donated two panel trap systems that include traps, HogEye Camera Systems, solar power components and custom trailers. The donated trap systems will provide years of service to landowners and farmers through the WHCP to assist in protecting against the \$60 million worth of damage caused by wild hogs in Mississippi annually.

"I want to thank each of our partners - the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks, FFA and the Mississippi Pork Producers Association. The partnerships outlined today take people from different organizations coming together to develop solutions for the problems we face," said Commissioner Gipson.
