## Prep Spring Gardens Now with Soil Tests

As you walk around the landscape this time of the year and look forward to the joy of starting a flower or vegetable garden, don't overlook what you are stepping on. Healthy, productive plants require healthy soil.

While soil may not be as eye-catching as narcissus or redbud flowers, it does require your attention. How do you know if your soil is ready for the plants you envision in your yard? One of the simplest ways to find out is to get a soil test.

The Mississippi State University Extension Service offers soil testing services through the Soil Testing Lab. Find complete cost information and instructions on how to submit a sample for testing at <http://extension.msstate.edu/agriculture/soils/soil-testing>.

Once your soil has been tested, you will receive a report with details about your soil. The most important information from a soil test report is soil pH, which measures the acidity of the sample. If soil pH is not optimal for your plants, the needed nutrients will not be as accessible to plant roots.

If your soil pH is too low for the plants you would like to grow, the soil test report will provide a recommendation to add lime. Pelletized lime is readily available from your county co-op or big-box store.

The soil test report tells you the amount of lime your garden needs. You can spread lime over the top of the soil and water it in, but it is more effective if the liming material is worked into the soil.

The chemical process of raising pH by adding lime to the soil takes time, so get your test done now. If your soil test calls for lime, adding it in January or early February gives your garden enough time for the liming material to raise your soil pH to optimal levels by March or April.

This is a positive step toward successful spring planting.

The soil test report you get back also provides a fertilizer recommendation. The most effective fertilizer programs follow the "four Rs"—right rate, right time, right placement and right source.

The right rate means you apply

an amount of fertilizer appropriate for the plant's needs. The idea that "if a little is good, more is better" does not apply to fertilizer.

There is a right time to apply fertilizer, and that is during the growing season and at appropriate intervals. The soil test report will tell you when to apply fertilizer and how often to reapply.

The right placement of fertilizer means you make sure it is within reach of the plant roots. If you broadcast fertilizer across your yard and some lands on sidewalks or the driveway, be sure to sweep it back into the landscape.

The right source of fertilizer depends on your situation. Decide whether you prefer using organic fertilizer, such as composted animal manure, or synthetic, which includes those labeled, for example, 13-13-13.

If you enjoy investing in plants, do the plants a favor and invest in learning more about your soil.

Following soil test recommendations will maximize your ability to provide needed nutrients to your plants while minimizing potentially negative environmental impacts. The four Rs limit excess fertilizer application, which saves money and minimizes fertilizer runoff when it rains.

Take the opportunity here at the beginning of the year to measure soil pH and adjust it if needed, and then you will be ready to grow your best plants. Don't guess; soil test!

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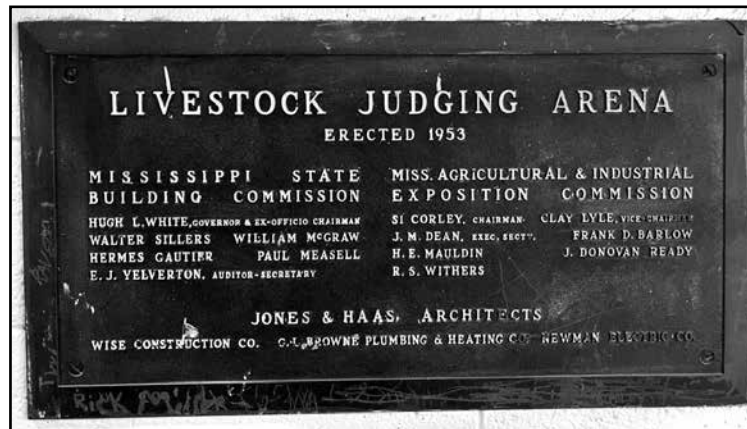
# Commissioner's Policy Corner

## 2023 Legislative Session Presents Generational Opportunity for Mississippi Livestock and Equine Facilities

The photo to the right may be familiar to all our statewide livestock and horse show families who, for decades, have participated in exhibiting livestock at the Mississippi State Fair and the Dixie National Livestock Show. This very year our State of Mississippi's Livestock and Equine Facilities turn 70 years old! Located on the State Fairgrounds, these multipurpose show facilities have driven decades of family memories, character building of our 4-H and FFA youth, as well as economic development for the State of Mississippi. Just last year, we had nearly 2,000 youth exhibitors and their families from every corner of Mississippi at the Dixie National. Then, following the Sale of Champions, we hosted the state of Mississippi's Dixie National Open Show which annually draws exhibitors from 42 different states, resulting in a huge economic impact for our state.

Many Mississippians may not be aware of the generational impact these livestock and horse facilities have for the betterment of our state agriculture and livestock, and even more importantly the growth and development of our next generation



leaders of Mississippi, our youth.

Seventy years ago, with the vision of then Commissioner Si Corley, the Livestock Judging Arena became the cornerstone of what would become generations of livestock shows and agricultural improvements throughout Mississippi. These state multipurpose facilities were built nearly a decade before the Mississippi Coliseum which was completed in 1962. Over the years, the facilities have served their purpose well. I believe the time has come for us as a state to look ahead and act to implement a greater vision for what I call the "Next 70 Years."

Two years ago at the request of the Mississippi Legislature, our Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce worked with specialists to conduct a strategic needs as-

essment, with the goal of framing a master plan for the improvement of our state multipurpose facilities. The end result was the clear recognition of what we already knew – that in order to strengthen our existing programs and to make the state of Mississippi competitive again for the regional and national shows we want and need to attract, our multipurpose facilities are in desperate need of rebuilding. In other words, we have outgrown the 1953 vision of our state Livestock Shows.

To be competitive regionally, Mississippi needs newer facilities under one roof – roughly 200,000 square feet of livestock facilities and stalls and another 200,000 square feet of equine facilities and stalls, with a covered practice and staging area. And, as any contractor knows, it is

far more cost efficient to build new facilities than to attempt to renovate existing structures, which were built in 1953 with inadequate drainage, plumbing and infrastructure.

Working with the Legislature, we have submitted several very good options to key decisionmakers who have the power and funding to help shape the future – the "Next 70 Years" of our state of Mississippi Livestock and Equine Programs. These options will allow us to grow our programs and to conduct economic development for our state. So, whenever you have the opportunity, please thank our Legislators for their favorable consideration of this worthy project as they work to conclude the Legislative session in early April, 2023. Thanks for your support of our Mississippi youth and the Next 70 Years of the state of Mississippi!

## Cozy Winter Casseroles!

### Easy Cheesy Loaded Grits

- 1 pound mild or spicy bulk pork sausage
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 4 cups water
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup quick-cooking grits
- 3 cans (4 ounces each) chopped green chiles
- 1 1/2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese, divided
- 1 1/2 cups shredded Monterey Jack cheese, divided
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1/4 teaspoon hot pepper sauce
- 2 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 1/4 teaspoon paprika
- Chopped fresh cilantro

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. In a large skillet, cook sausage and onion over medium heat for 6-8 minutes or until sausage is no longer pink, breaking it into crumbles; drain. In a large saucepan, bring water and salt to a boil. Slowly stir in grits. Reduce heat to medium-low; cook, covered about 5 minutes or until thickened, stirring occasionally. Remove from heat. Add green chiles, 3/4 cup cheddar cheese, 3/4 cup Monterey Jack cheese, butter and pepper sauce; stir until cheese is melted. Stir in eggs, then sausage mixture. Transfer to a greased 13x9-inch baking dish. Top with remaining cheeses; sprinkle with paprika. Bake, uncovered, until golden brown and set, 50-60 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before serving. Sprinkle with cilantro.

### Crescent Beef Casserole

- 1 pound lean ground beef (90% lean)
- 2 teaspoons olive oil
- 1 cup diced zucchini
- 1/4 cup chopped onion
- 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
- 1 cup tomato puree
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1 1/2 cups mashed potatoes
- 1 cup (4 ounces) crumbled feta cheese
- 1 tube (8 ounces) refrigerated crescent rolls
- 1 large egg, beaten, optional


Preheat oven to 374 degrees. In a large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink, crumble beef; drain and set aside. In the same skillet, heat oil over medium-high heat. Add zucchini, onion and green pepper; cook and stir until crisp-tender, 4-5 minutes. Stir in beef, tomato puree, oregano, salt and pepper; heat through. Spread mashed potatoes in an 11x7-inch baking dish coated with cooking spray. Top with beef mixture; sprinkle with feta cheese. Unroll crescent dough. Separate into 4 rectangles, arrange 3 rectangles over the casserole; of desired, brushed with egg wash. Bake until top is browned, 12-15 minutes. Roll remaining dough into 2 crescent rolls; bake for another use.

### Potato Sausage Casserole

- 1 pound bulk pork sausage
- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) condensed cream of mushroom soup, undiluted
- 3/4 cup 2% milk
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 3 cups sliced peeled potatoes
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- Minced fresh parsley, optional

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large skillet, cook sausage over medium heat until no longer pink, breaking it into crumbles; drain and set aside. Combine soup, milk, onion, salt and pepper. In a greased 2-quart baking dish, layer half the potatoes, soup mixture, and sausage. Repeat layers. Cover and bake until potatoes are tender, 60-65 minutes. Sprinkle with cheese; bake, uncovered, until cheese is melted, 2-3 minutes. If desired, garnish with parsley.

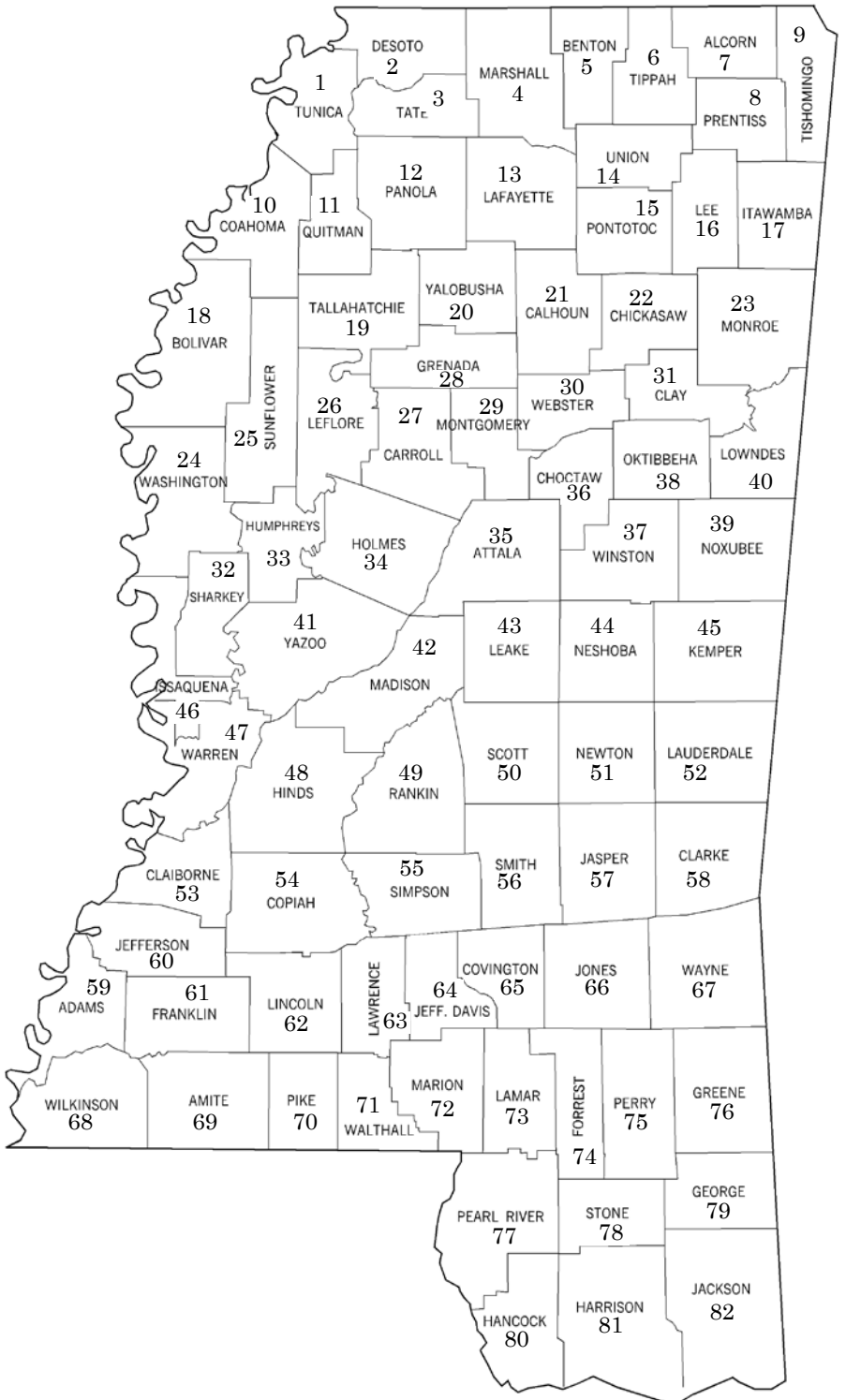

# Native Warm-Season Grasses in Mississippi

Native warm-season grasses (NWSG) are perennial species that are characterized predominantly by their bunch-type growth, drought tolerance and their ability to provide wildlife cover and structure for ground nesting birds, small mammals and an extensive number of insects. Examples of NWSG include big and little bluestem, Indiangrass, switchgrass, eastern gamagrass and broomsedge.

Historically, NWSG were once dominant components in major land resource areas across Mississippi including the Black Belt and Jackson Prairie in central and north-eastern parts of the state. These crescent-shaped land masses were originally characterized by its dark, shallow soils and extensive prairies which were interspersed with chalk out-crops, oak lowlands and cedar groves.

The southern half of the state was part of the historical range of the longleaf pine. This ecosystem was comprised of some of the most biologically diverse plant communities in the entire world, stretching from east Texas to Virginia and the Carolinas. Within both the prairies and longleaf pine ecosystems in Mississippi, NWSG were a major component in their respective plant communities and provided excellent habitat for game species such as bobwhite quail and wild turkey, among others.

Unfortunately, in the late 1800s and early 1900s, a majority of the native prairies in Mississippi were over-grazed and replaced with row crop production, while the longleaf pines were harvested and replaced with more productive loblolly plantations over time. This transformation of some of our state's natural areas has led to declines in wildlife populations, most notably the bobwhite quail, along with the absence of disturbance, such as wildfires.

Fire was not only a more frequent natural occurrence but was also a tool used by Native Americans in clearing land and for use in driving prey for hunting. Fire set back plant succession and allowed for fire-tolerant species, such as grasses like big bluestem and Indiangrass, to thrive and provide quality nesting habitat for grassland birds.

Over the past 30 years, however, a growing awareness for the importance these plant com-

munities provide for wildlife, in particular pollinator species, has grown. Federal policies regarding invasive species control, conservation plantings and cost-share farm programs have generated enthusiasm in converting old pastures and timber cut-over into renovated wildlife habitat comprised of NWSG. These species have also garnered some interest as a dual-purpose species by providing both quality forage for beef cattle and small ruminants and wildlife habitat when managed appropriately.

There are several considerations that must be taken into account when establishing NWSG on your property. These include site preparation, weed control, establishment method, species and variety selection and management implementation. Extensive planning and attention to detail is required before planting. These species are notoriously slow to establish, often resulting in unsuccessful stands. Stand failures can be caused by several factors including low germination percentages, poor seedling vigor, inadequate weed control, planting too deep and impatience.

However, to ensure a successful planting, these factors should be addressed well in advance prior to sowing. Site preparation can take up to a year or more to effectively remove existing vegetation (i.e. bahiagrass or bermudagrass) or impediments (i.e. stumps, fence rows, etc.).

Previous experiences in establishing NWSG remind me of a saying a former coach used frequently: "Do it right, do it light; do it wrong, do it long." In other words, it paid off to take care of the little things first to save me from having to do more work (and spend more money!) after not paying attention to the details in the beginning.

Establishing and managing native plant species on your property is a sure way to increase the natural beauty and capacity for your property to provide quality wildlife habitat for game and non-game species alike for many years to come.

If you are interested in establishing NWSG on your property to enhance wildlife habitat or to create another source of forage for your livestock, start off on the right track by contacting your local MSU Extension office for more information.

After one year and seven months, Commissioner Andy Gipson had successfully established a native warm-season grass habitat. The Gipson family has already harvested deer and have seen plenty more deer, turkeys, birds, butterflies and other wildlife.
