## MDAC Launches New Online Resource for Mississippi Timber Industry

One June 5, 2023, Commissioner Andy Gipson announced that the Mississippi Department of Agriculture of Commerce (MDAC) is launching a website dedicated to marketing Mississippi's abundant timber and forest products. The site is now live and can be accessed at <https://timber.mdac.ms.gov/>.

"Some time ago, our agency saw a need to create a useful, verified resource to promote Mississippi timber, which is one of our state's largest industries," said Commissioner



Gipson. "Before, this kind of valuable information was not readily available. This timber website will be an asset to economic developers and logistics coordinators, as well as timber and forest product producers, sellers

and buyers around the state. We hope everyone will use this one-of-a-kind tool and helpful resource by visiting <https://timber.mdac.ms.gov/>."

Forestry is Mississippi's third largest industry, earning \$1.3 billion in

2022. Currently, the state is home to 19,235,186 acres of forestland and provides 64,544 timber-related jobs. MDAC's new online portal:

- Showcases Mississippi's timber resources, including a general overview of the economic impact of timber to the state;
- Allows timber buyers, sellers and producers to complete a profile for inquiries for the buying or selling of timber;
- Includes a trade section featuring MDAC's upcoming international inbound trade mission for 2024;
- Provides logistics information and an overview of the state's infrastructure;
- Provides data, including a wealth of information in maps and tables on Mississippi's rich forestland.

"We are delighted to present this site as a tool for both the general public and those within the timber industry," said Ginger Williamson, Deputy Bureau Director of MDAC's Timber

Commerce Division. "This site has been several years in the making. We wanted to do our due diligence by researching data, vetting resources, hosting international timber trade missions and building relationships with ports, rail, trucking and logistics experts. We are excited about the potential of Mississippi's wood industry and believe that the future is bright because of the positive collaboration the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce has enjoyed with these entities and many others throughout this process."

## Harvest Permits - New Weight Tolerance, New Over-Weight Fines

Beginning July 1, 2023, Mississippi has a new law that allows a higher weight tolerance for the Harvest Permit. Legal users of the Harvest Permit will be allowed to haul an extra 10% tolerance over the 80,000 pounds legal state weight limit up to 88,000 pounds on state highways and state roads.

Every permit-holder should check with the supervisors in the county they are working in to make sure of a route to safely haul to a state highway or state road. It is very important to make sure to stay within the allowed weight tolerance. The Harvest Permit repealer bill comes up for review in the 2025 state legislative session. This means that the possibil-

ity of the weight limit being reduced is very likely if there is a pattern of numerous overweight violations. We must be good stewards of what has been given to us to prevent losing the PRIVILEGE that we worked so long and hard to get.

The owner and/or operator of a vehicle may apply to the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) for authorization to receive

a Harvest Permit. The permit will entitle the vehicle to haul sand, gravel, fill dirt, agricultural products, or unprocessed forestry products to an authorized maximum gross weight not to exceed 88,000 pounds (80,000 pounds legal weight limit + 10% tolerance = 88,000 pounds). If you have an existing Harvest Permit, it will remain effective until its expi-



ration date. However, the 88,000 pounds tolerance went into effect July 1, 2023.

Applications for authorization for a Harvest Permit are subject to approval by MDOT. Visit the MDOT Express Pass permitting website at [permits.mdot.ms.gov](http://permits.mdot.ms.gov) for information on how to register and instantly receive on oversize/overweight or legal trip permit. The cost of the permit is \$25.00 per vehicle, and payment must be submitted with the application for authorization. Applications that are not approved for any reason will be returned to the applicant for correction.

The fines will be higher for overweight trucks and the loss of Harvest Permit for those that haul over 100,000 pounds more than once.

*Commissioner Andy Gipson Announces  
WHCP Equipment Cost Share*

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson announced that the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) is offering a cost share opportunity to Mississippi private land managers that are battling wild hogs on their property. The cost-share opportunity was

made possible by a time-limited, federal appropriation to MDAC for expansion and support for its Wild Hog Control Program. The most effective equipment used for the trapping of wild hogs will be the focus of this effort to remove these nuisance animals from private lands across the state.

Through the cost share program, MDAC will provide technical guid-

ance and monetary assistance for the most effective equipment and methods to trap wild hogs on private lands across Mississippi. “Our goal is to provide one complete, remotely triggered trap for applicants within limits of the federal appropriation,” said Commissioner Gipson. “This type of trap has been vital to the success of our existing Wild Hog Control Program which

began in 2020. In addition to complete trap systems, trap components such as cameras, gates, and panels will be eligible for funding.”

The cost share application period will be July 17 – August 15, 2023. Private landowners and leaseholders in Mississippi will be eligible to apply. Applications will be evaluated and ranked by MDAC based on property use, past and current wild hog damage, past trapping efforts, and the type of trapping equipment requested. For selected applications, MDAC will reimburse the landowner or leaseholder for a percentage of the cost for purchasing trapping equipment. Reimbursement payments will be provided on a 50% cost share basis and will be the lesser of either 50% of the applicant’s expenditure or a maximum of \$5,000.

## From Our Kitchen To Yours

Summer Sides That Will Complete Any Meal

### Peach and Tomato Salad

1/2 cup balsamic vinegar  
1/4 cup olive oil  
1 tablespoon honey  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon black pepper  
6 medium ripe peaches (about 2 pounds), pitted and cut into wedges  
2 pounds tomatoes cut into wedges (about 4 medium tomatoes), and/or  
cherry tomatoes, halved  
1 cup thinly sliced red onion  
1 cup crumbled feta cheese  
1 cup pecan halves, toasted  
1/2 cup torn fresh basil

In an extra-large bowl, whisk together vinegar, oil, honey, salt and black pepper. Add peaches, tomatoes, red onion, cheese, and pecans; toss to coat. Top with basil. Serve immediately.

### Spicy Broccoli Slaw

1/2 cup mayonnaise  
1/2 sliced red onion  
1 fresh jalapeño pepper, seeded and sliced  
4 whole small dill gherkins, chopped (1/4 cup)  
Dash hot pepper sauce  
1 12-ounce package shredded broccoli slaw mix

In a large bowl combine mayonnaise, onion, jalapeño pepper, gherkins, and hot pepper sauce. Fold in broccoli slaw. Chill for at least one hour before serving.

### Five-Bean Bake

1 cup chopped onion (1 large)  
6 slices bacon, cut up  
1 clove garlic, minced  
1 15.5 – 16 ounce can red kidney beans (rinsed and drained)  
1 15.25 – 16 can lima beans (rinsed and drained)  
1 15- 16 ounce can pork and beans in tomato sauce  
1 15-16 ounce can garbanzo beans (chickpeas), rinsed and drained  
1 15 ounce can butter beans (rinsed and drained).  
3/4 cup ketchup  
1/2 cup molasses  
1/4 cup packaged brown sugar  
1 tablespoon yellow mustard  
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

Preheat oven to 375° F. In a large skillet, cook the onion, bacon, and garlic until the bacon is crisp and onion is tender; drain. In a large bowl combine the sauteed onion mixture, assorted beans, ketchup, molasses, brown sugar, mustard and Worcestershire sauce. Mix well to combine. Transfer the bean mixture to an ungreased 3-quart casserole dish. Bake the beans covered for one hour or until bubbly around the edges. The baked beans can be served immediately or at room temperature.

### Herbed Potato Salad

3 pounds small red potatoes, unpeeled and cut into 1 1/2 -inch chunks  
3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil  
2 tablespoons cider vinegar  
1 tablespoon fresh herbs (such as snipped tarragon, dill weed or parsley)  
2 tablespoons sour cream  
2 tablespoons mayonnaise  
2 teaspoons Dijon-style mustard  
1 green onion, chopped  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper  
1/4 teaspoon celery seed (optional)

For the potatoes, place steamer basket in a large saucepan. Add water to reach just below bottom of the basket; heat until simmering and then add the potatoes. Cover; reduce to medium heat. Steam 15 to 18 minutes or until potatoes are fork tender. Remove from heat and let cool slightly. Meanwhile, in a large bowl combine remaining ingredients. Add slightly cooled potatoes; toss gently to combine. Let stand for 20 minutes at room temperature before serving. To make ahead cover and chill up to 4 hours. Let stand for 20 minutes at room temperature before serving.

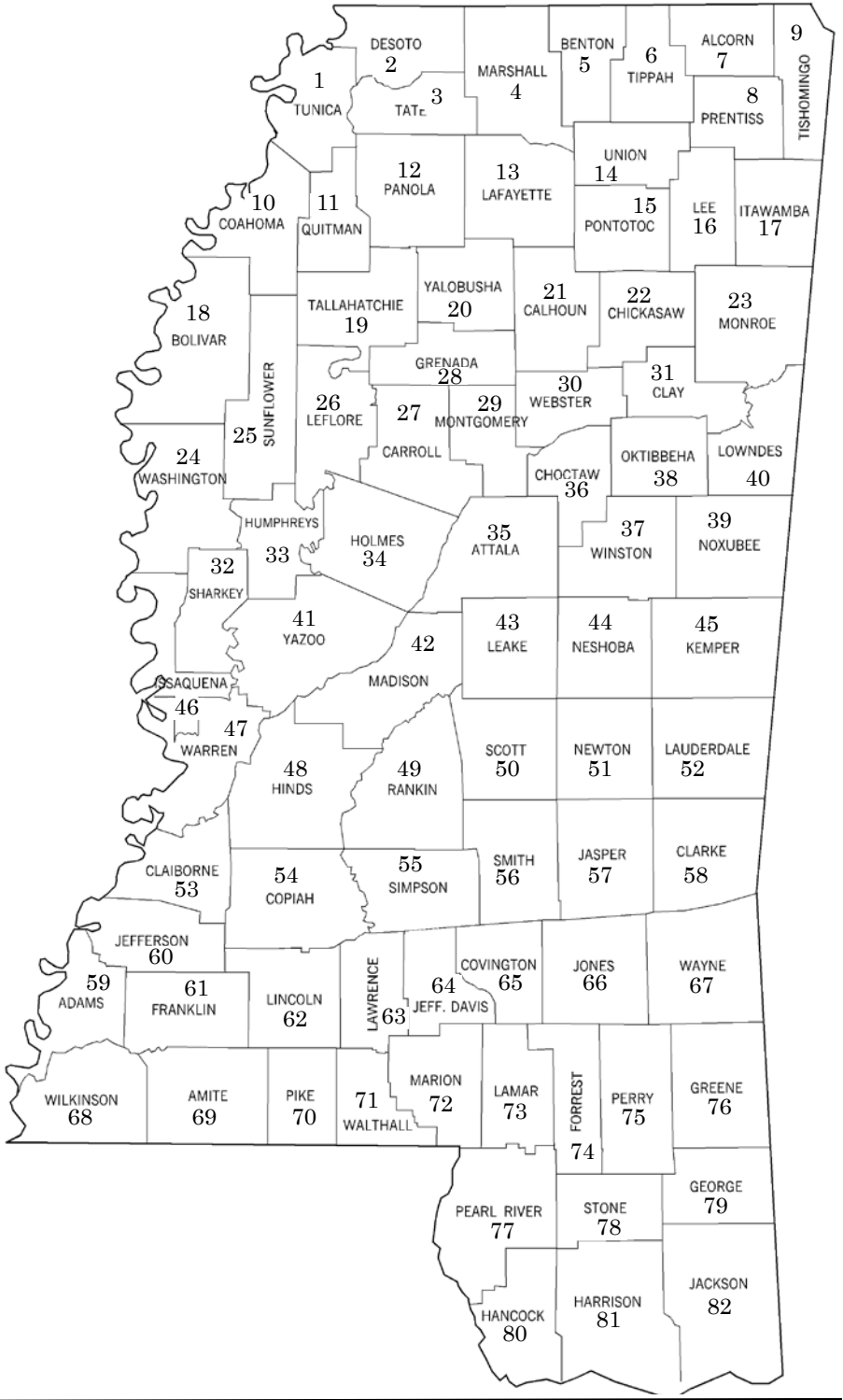

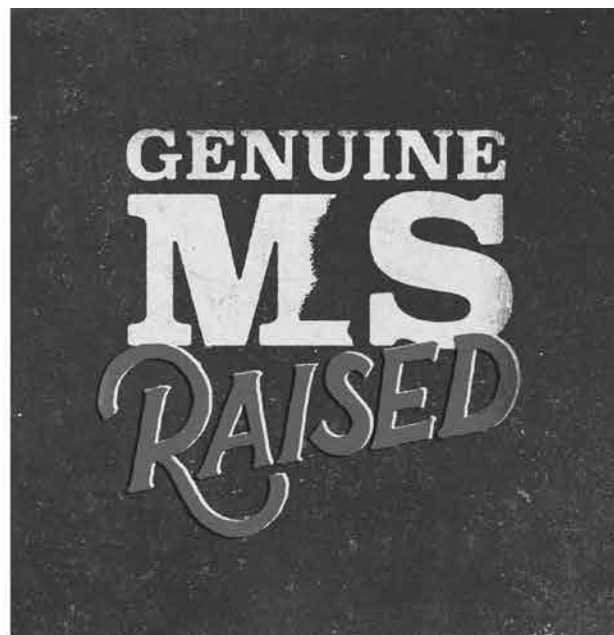
