Celebrate National Catfish Month!

Each August since 1984, when President Ronald Reagan declared it as such, the nation rolls up its sleeves to celebrate National Catfish Month. And there is plenty of reason to celebrate, particularly here in Mississippi, where, along with Alabama, Arkansas and Louisiana, the majority of the nation's catfish farms are located.

The Catfish Institute (TCI), the Jackson-based marketing arm of the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish industry, works throughout the year to promote the good work of the farmers it

represents and the impact they have on local economy.

"The catfish industry is fairly unique among agriculture industries with respect to its economic impact," says Roger Barlow, TCI president and executive director of Catfish Farmers of America. "Every element of our industry has an economic return that benefits the areas where the fish are grown, as well as the entire region. The fingerlings are hatched locally; the feed is produced and fed locally; the fish are seined and hauled by rural small business owners; they are processed and packaged locally; and they are sold locally to family-owned restaurants and grocery stores, as well as shipped to larger markets across the country. This kind of economic multiplier is almost unprecedented."

As the national marketing organization for U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish, TCI works tirelessly to promote awareness and consumption of America's largest aquaculture product. One element of its annual marketing campaigns involves utilizing the industry's "Catfish Farmers of the Year" from Alabama, Arkansas and Mississippi.

"Each year, farmers from the three main producing states are asked to select from their membership a deserving producer to be named as their state's Catfish Farmer of the Year," said TCI president, Roger Barlow. "This honor is a great opportunity to give leading producers national recognition for their contributions to our industry, and we are proud to feature these outstanding American farmers in our annual lineup of industry promotions."

The 2023 Catfish Farmers of the Year are Bobby Jones of Glen Allan, Mississippi; Wallace Drury, of Greensboro, Alabama; and Dick

Baxter of Kelso, Arkansas.

"These farmers are chosen from a large field of many deserving catfish growers in the industry," said Jeremy Robbins, TCI vice president. "Although it is difficult to select just one farmer from each of these states, those who are selected embody the true, selfless spirit of the American


Farmer."

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Commissioner's Policy Corner

"Expensing" Gives Mississippi Farmers a Tax Break

As your Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce, I know when Mississippi farmers thrive, so does our state's economy. It is vital for farmers and our economy that we reduce the tax burden on production and instead encourage investment in growing our farm economy. During this past legislative session, I supported efforts by the legislature to provide tax relief to the agricultural and manufacturing communities.

This year the legislature approved and Governor Tate Reeves signed House Bill 1733. It wasn't legislation that made a bunch of headlines, but it can make a big difference on farmers' bottom line.

Based on President Donald Trump's Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, Mississippi legislators voted to make permanent provisions known as "full expensing and bonus depreciation." Now, purchases made by farmers in the course of normal business – from feed to four-wheelers – can immedi-

ately be deducted from their state tax liability.

This legislation has a broad impact on Mississippi's economy, giving producers an incentive to reinvest in their business. In today's inflationary environment, farmers might be hesitant to replace aging equipment due to the substantial cost and the long period of time required to recover tax relief for that asset. However, with immediate expensing, the purchase becomes less financially daunting, allowing farmers to make the investment while retaining more of their hard-earned tax dollars.

The bottom line? Farmers can use expensing to reduce operating costs and invest in capital equipment to enhance operations and boost revenues.

Because agriculture is a heavy equipment industry, this law change particularly benefits our agriculture community. The independent non-profit Tax Foundation estimated the federal relief when made permanent provides a 25 percent reduction in tax liabilities for agricultural producers. I expect similar results here in Mississippi as farmers pay less in state

taxes and invest more in their operations. I encourage our farm families to consult with their tax professionals or accountants to make sure they take full advantage of this tax reform on the state level.

President Trump endorsed this tax reform and the legislation passed with an overwhelming bipartisan support at the Mississippi Capitol. The conservative National Review publication called it a "new tax model" that can work for America: "State and federal budget writers should take note of Mississippi's full-expensing program," as it is the "sort of tax reform that America's stagnating economy needs."

A pro-farmer bill that grows the economy without taxpayer subsidies is just the type of smart policy Mississippians expect. I applaud lawmakers for their strong support of this legislation, with special recognition to House Ways and Means Chairman Tray Lamar, Senate Finance Chairman Josh Harkins, and Senate Finance Vice Chairman Chris Johnson, as well as organizations like Empower Mississippi who pushed

for the bill's passage.

Since taking office in 2018, I've visited with farmers in each of Mississippi's 82 counties. I know firsthand our farmers, ranchers, and landowners work tirelessly to make ends meet while providing food on the table for Mississippi families, and families across the country and around the world. Cutting taxes on these producers makes economic sense and encourages growth in agriculture. From Desoto to D'Iberville, every Mississippi community relies on our agricultural industry and this reform provides some needed relief to our farmers.

From Our Kitchen To Yours

U.S. Farm - Raised Catfish Appetizers!



Smoked Catfish Dip

- 4 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish fillets
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 teaspoons chipotle powder
- 1 tablespoon smoked paprika
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1 tablespoon Tony Chachere's Original Creole Seasoning
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce
- 1/4 cup green onion, chopped

Preheat oven to 375° F. Place the catfish on a sheet tray, drizzle oil on each side of the fillets, and season with chipotle powder and smoked paprika. Bake for 12 minutes, remove from oven and allow to cool slightly before breaking apart into chunks. In a medium-size mixing bowl, combine remaining ingredients; stir in the catfish. Cover, and chill before serving.

Catfish and Crawfish Toast

- 4 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish fillets, seasoned, cooked and flaked
- 1 cup crawfish tails
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1 clove minced garlic
- 1/4 cup green onions
- 1 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese, shredded
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

- 1 tablespoon kosher salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 2 small loaves of French bread, cut in half lengthwise
- 1/2 cup cheddar cheese, shredded
- Green onions for garnish

Preheat oven to 350° F. Mix the first nine ingredients together in a bowl. Place the bread on a sheet tray and spoon the mixture onto the slices of French bread. Bake for 10 minutes. Remove from oven and top with cheddar cheese. Continue to bake for five minutes or until golden brown. Let cool slightly before slicing into individual portions. Garnish with green onions and serve on a platter, warm.

Catfish Deviled Eggs

- 2 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish fillets
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 teaspoon blackening spice
- 1 dozen eggs, boiled, peeled and halved with yolks separated
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon Creole mustard
- 2 tablespoons gherkins, finely diced
- 1 tablespoon capers
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Fresh dill for garnish.

Drizzle both sides of catfish fillets with olive oil, and sprinkle with blackening spice. Place fillets on grill rack or broiler pan rack. Grill or broil fillets about four inches

from heat source for two to three minutes on each side, or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork. Allow to cool to room temperature. Remove the darkest edges of fillets for garnish. Flake remaining catfish into a bowl. Add cooked egg yolks, mayonnaise, mustards, gherkins and capers to flaked catfish. Stir well, and season with salt and pepper to taste. Fill each egg with catfish mixture, and garnish with small pieces of catfish and fresh dill.

Catfish Salad Sandwich

- 4 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish fillets
- 2 ribs celery, finely diced
- 2 tablespoons shallot, finely diced
- 2 tablespoons capers
- 2 tablespoons fresh dill, finely chopped
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons Creole mustard
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce
- 8 slices brioche bread

Preheat oven to 350°F. Place catfish fillets in a small baking dish. Lightly oil fillets, season with salt and pepper, and cook for 15 minutes, or until cooked through. Place catfish in refrigerator. Flake when chilled, and set aside. Combine remaining ingredients in a bowl. Stir in flaked catfish. Spoon onto 4 slices of brioche, and top with remaining slices.



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



Ag Commissioner Andy Gipson Announces August 2023 Wild Hog Control Program Application Period

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson announced that the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) will begin accepting a new round of applications for its Wild Hog Control Program (WHCP) on August 1. The application period will close on August 15. All Mississippi counties are eligible for the application period.

Through the WHCP, MDAC provides "smart" wild hog traps to landowners and managers for the control of wild hogs on private agricultural and forestry lands in Mississippi. MDAC provides the training necessary to use the "smart" traps and technical guidance regarding the most effective methods to trap and control wild hogs on private lands. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.mdac.ms.gov/whcp. Submitted applications will be evaluated based on the number of acres available for trapping, historical agricultural losses caused by wild hogs on the property and current trapping efforts on the property. A cooperative application is encouraged for small acreage (i.e., adjoining land managers of small parcels should work together to submit one application). Traps will be available for one-month intervals, dependent upon use



and success. One trap per 500 acres is recommended, depending on landscape and land use.

In addition to its established trapping program, MDAC is currently taking applications for a cost share opportunity provided to Mississippi private land managers that are battling wild hogs on their property. The cost share opportunity was made possible by a time-limited, federal appropriation to MDAC for expansion and support for its Wild Hog Control Program. The most effective equipment used for the trapping of wild hogs

will be the focus of the cost share program. The cost share application period will end on August 15.

For selected applications, MDAC will reimburse the landowner or leaseholder for a percentage of the cost for purchasing trapping equipment. Reimbursement payments will be provided on a 50 percent cost share basis and will be the lesser of either 50 percent of the applicant's expenditure or a maximum of \$5,000. MALTB Investigation Leads to Recovery of Stolen Property in Rankin County

The Mississippi Agriculture and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB), the law enforcement division of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, assisted in a recent investigation that led to the recovery of multiple items of stolen property including agricultural equipment in Rankin County.

MALTB assisted in the investigation of a stolen 2021 T-66 Bobcat skid steer reported stolen from Hinds County in the city of Jackson. During the investigation, information surfaced that led investigators to Rankin County, off Shell Oil Road, where MALTB investigators located and recovered the skid steer along with other stolen equipment.

Further investigation resulted in the recovery of an additional skid steer. The investigation and recovery of over \$198,000 in equipment was a collaborative effort between several law enforcement agencies. MALTB Director Dean Barnard commended

MALTB investigators, the Rankin County Sheriff's Office and the Jackson Police Department for their continued efforts in the recovery of stolen agricultural property. This is an open and ongoing criminal investigation; arrests are forthcoming.

"I am proud of the work our law enforcement team here with the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce have accomplished," said Commissioner Gipson. "They work diligently every day to protect our ag communities around the state. I would like to thank all our MALTB investigators, as well as our partners in state and local law enforcement who assisted with this investigation."
