Celebrating 40 Years of Agricultural Heritage

In 1969, Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Jim Buck Ross, recognizing a need for the preservation of Mississippi's culture and heritage as an agriculture state, began collecting artifacts, organizing scholars and laying the groundwork for what would become the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum.

"I dream, see, and my ignorance makes me believe my dreams can come true," remarked Ross.

His dream would finally come to fruition years later, when the state legislature allotted funding for construction of a museum complex and the city of Jackson donated a valuable 39-acre site for the grounds. Funds to construct permanent exhibits, a

living-history farm, an entire crossroads town and a forest study area were raised by the newly formed, non-profit Agriculture and Forestry Museum Foundation. And so, the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum was officially dedicated on September 20, 1983. Mississippi's rich agricultural history finally had a tangible place of acknowledgement that generations to come would learn from and enjoy.

Over the years, Mississippians have contributed various artifacts, materials and services to the museum. Ross himself gathered agricultural, forestry and ag-aviation equipment from around the nation to ensure this project would become one of the finest agricultural museums in the world. To this day, the majority of display equipment located on the museum grounds was directly obtained by Commissioner Jim Buck Ross.

The Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum is home to the National Agricultural Aviation Museum, which covers more than 5,000 square feet and features planes that once flew over southern farms and plantations. The museum also houses the oldest operating cotton gin in

the United States, as well as 'Small Town, Mississippi,' a replica of a typical crossroads town from the 1920s which includes a general store, chapel, blacksmith shop, print shop, filling station, offices and more. In addition, the museum boasts of extensive displays; historical centers; award-winning gardens; working grist mill and sawmill; Children's Barnyard; farm animals; antique farm equipment and heavy machinery; and other ag collections.

In its early days, the museum was originally treated as a functioning small farm, in which employees worked the land, harvested crops and tended to livestock, all on the grounds. Today, employees continue to bring historical agriculture to life with similar educational demonstrations and reenactments during countless events each year.

The museum now hosts 125,000 visitors annually, who experience Mississippi's rich agricultural heritage thanks to one determined man with a big dream.

"The Ag Museum is a tradition like no other, and I personally have so many positive childhood memories there. I remember my first visit, walking across that bridge at the Ag Mu-

seum, during a class field trip when I was 6 years old," said Commissioner Andy Gipson. "The variety of exhibits, live demonstrations and carefully preserved history offers visitors the unique opportunity to learn about our state's rich agricultural heritage and its importance. It's humbling to walk these grounds and see the very same tools and equipment that our ancestors used every day to sustain their livelihoods and provide food, fiber and shelter for all."

In honor of the museum's upcoming 40-year milestone, and to pay homage to the dedication and efforts of its staff over the years, the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum will host a celebratory event on Saturday, September 9, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The museum has partnered with several organizations who will assist in providing 40 unique experiences across the museum grounds for visitors to enjoy. Living History Presenters from around the country will be dressed in period clothing and interacting with visitors.

And in addition to all the usual exhibits, festivities for this event will feature the Dixieland Old Engine and Agricultural Club's display of antique engines, agricultural tools and much more. Admission is \$4 for all ages.

"Our main purpose is always to educate the public, particularly the next generation, on the rich, agricultural history of our state, and since 1983, we have proudly done so," said Theresa Love, Executive Director of the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum and employee of 26 years. "We are so excited to host this birthday celebration to commemorate 40 years of service to Mississippi's ag community, and we hope you all will join us on September 9th."

From Our Kitchen To Yours

A Southern Style Picnic at the MS Ag Museum



Mama's Fried Chicken

1 (3-4 pound) whole chicken, cut into pieces
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon pepper
2 cups buttermilk
Self-rising flour
Vegetable oil

Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. Place chicken in a shallow dish or zip-top plastic bag and add buttermilk. Cover or seal, and chill for at least 2 hours. Remove chicken from buttermilk, discarding buttermilk. Dredge chicken in flour. Pour oil to a depth of 1 1/2 inches in a deep skillet or Dutch oven; heat to 360 degrees. Add chicken, a few pieces at a time; cover and cook for 6 minutes. Uncover chicken and cook for 9 minutes. Turn chicken; cover and cook 6 minutes. Uncover chicken and cook 5 to 9 minutes, turning chicken the last 3 minutes for even browning, if necessary. Drain on paper towels.

Scratch-made Gravy

4 tablespoons butter or pan drippings
4 tablespoon all-purpose flour
1/4 - 1/2 cup water
1 (15-ounce) can beef broth or beef stock – or
1 (15-ounce) can chicken or turkey stock
1/2 teaspoon each garlic powder and onion powder
Salt and pepper to taste

Add butter or pan drippings to a hot skillet and melt. Add flour and seasonings and whisk allowing it to brown into a roux. This should take about 5 minutes or so until it turns golden brown. Slowly pour in stock or broth while whisking vigorously. This will prevent lumps. Once smooth and lump-free, add the water. Let the gravy boil until thick and smooth, about 3 minutes. Taste and season more if desired.

Southern Style Green Beans

3 slices bacon – cut into 1/2 -inch pieces
1 1/2 pounds green beans – washed, trimmed and snapped into about 2-inch lengths
1 1/2 cups vegetable or chicken stock
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Cook bacon pieces in a heavy bottom pan until done. Remove the bacon from the pan and place on a paper towel to drain. Set it aside. Add green beans to the pan and cook on medium-high heat. Toss beans in bacon drippings to coat. Continue to cook until beans turn bright green. Carefully pour in the stock and add garlic powder, salt and pepper. Stir to incorporate. Add bacon pieces back to the pot with beans. Turn burner to low, cover beans with lid – slightly off center, and cook for about one hour until beans are tender, stirring every 15 minutes. Taste and adjust seasoning. Serve immediately.

Southern Skillet Cornbread

1/4 cup bacon drippings
2 cups self-rising cornmeal mix
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
2 large eggs, lightly beaten
1 1/2 cups buttermilk
Butter

Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Place bacon drippings in a 9-inch cast-iron skillet; heat in oven 5 minutes. Combine cornmeal mix and baking soda; make a well in the center of mixture. Stir together eggs and buttermilk; add to dry mixture, stirring until moistened. Remove skillet from the oven; tilt skillet in all directions to coat bottom. Pour hot drippings into batter, whisking to blend. Pour batter into the hot skillet. Bake at 425 degrees for 27 minutes or until golden brown. Invert cornbread onto a serving plate; cut into wedges. Serve with butter.

Fresh Peach Cobbler

1/2 cup unsalted butter
1 cup all-purpose flour
2 cups sugar, divided
1 tablespoon baking powder
Pinch of salt
1 cup milk
4 cups fresh peach slices
1 tablespoon lemon juice
Ground cinnamon or nutmeg (optional)

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Melt butter in a 13 x 9-inch baking dish. Combine flour, 1 cup sugar, baking powder, and salt; add milk, stirring just until dry ingredients are moistened. Pour batter over butter (do not stir). Bring the remaining 1 cup sugar, peach slices, and lemon juice to a boil over high heat, stirring constantly. Pour peach mixture over batter (do not stir). Sprinkle with cinnamon, if desired. Bake at 375 degrees for 40 to 45 minutes or until golden brown. Serve cobbler with vanilla ice cream if desired.

Homemade Mashed Potatoes

3 pounds Yukon gold potatoes
2 teaspoons salt, divided
5 tablespoons butter
1/3 cup half-and-half
1/2 cup (4 ounces) softened cream cheese
3/4 teaspoon coarsely ground pepper

Peel potatoes and cut into 1-inch pieces. Bring cold water, potatoes, and 1 teaspoon salt to a boil in a medium-size Dutch oven over medium-high heat. Reduce heat to medium low. Cook potatoes for 16 to 20 minutes or until fork-tender and drain. Bring potatoes back to the Dutch oven. Cook in Dutch oven until water evaporates and potatoes look dry. Mound potatoes on one side; add butter, half-and-half, cream cheese, ground pepper, and remaining teaspoon of salt to opposite side of Dutch oven. Cook for 1 to 2 minutes or until butter is melted and mixture boils. After removing potatoes from heat, beat at medium speed with a hand-held electric mixer 30 seconds to 1 minute or to desired degree of smoothness. Do not overbeat. Serve warm.

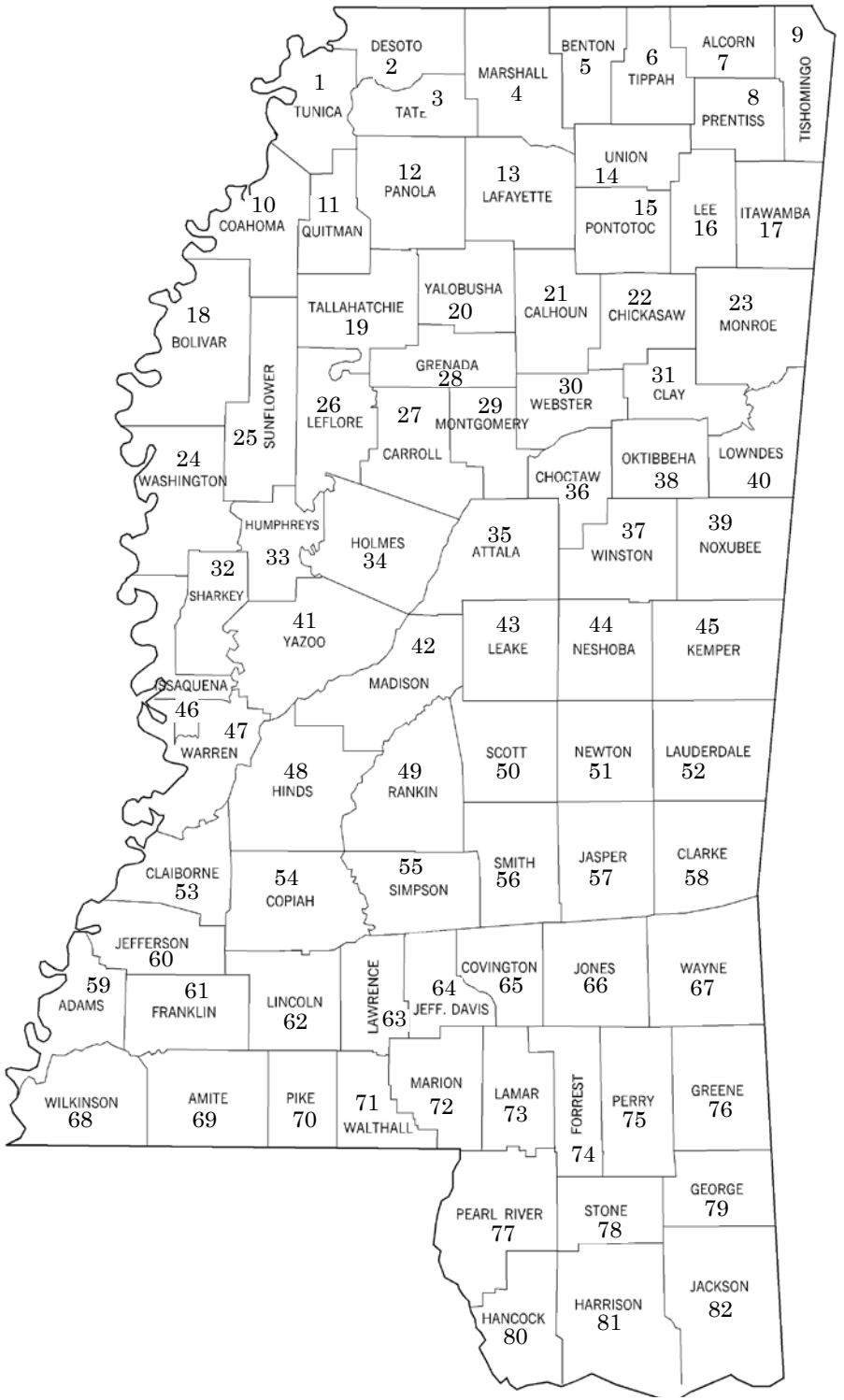

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Spotlighting Unique Agriculture in Mississippi

Commissioner Andy Gipson Visits Unique Ag Operation in Simpson County

Recently, Commissioner Andy Gipson visited Walker Ridge Farms in Magee, a family owned and operated farm that raises cattle, chickens, pigs and the unique and distinctive, Fallow deer.

The Walkers of Simpson County have farmed and raised cattle for generations, dating back to the 1800s. It wasn't until 2019, following a hunting trip in Tennessee, that 22-year-old Brandon Walker added Fallow deer to the family farm in Mississippi. An avid hunter and beginning farmer, Brandon independently researched the advantages, regulations and fundamentals of raising Fallow deer before purchasing their first few bucks from a farm in Crystal Springs.

In order to raise Fallow deer, the Walker family had to apply for a permit from the Mississippi Board of Animal Health, the state agency charged with protecting the health of Mississippi's livestock and poultry. Once they received the proper certification specific to the enclosure and management of Fallow deer, they awaited their new arrivals in a cleared 5-acre pasture equipped with high fences.

Fallow deer are considered to be exotic livestock, or agricultural commodities, in Mississippi. And the Walkers quickly found their deer were in high demand, with markets for the Fallow deer's unique hides,

antlers and tasty meat products. Common color variations in Fallow deer include chocolate, spotted and white. But perhaps the most apparent difference between Fallow deer and Mississippi's native White-tailed deer is their antlers. Fallow deer have flat, palmate antlers, which can reach up to 20-30 inches, or just over two feet, in length. Once shed, artisans and craftsmen will often engrave scenes on these antlers for home décor and ornaments. In addition to these by-products, the Fallow deer breed is sought after for safari and petting zoo operations around the state, such as the McClain Lodge and Resort in Rankin County.

"Most people know that agriculture is Mississippi's largest industry, but a lot of folks don't know about all the unique and rare agricultural opportunities that our state offers," said Commissioner Gipson. "Nobody does agriculture like Mississippi, and it's such a pleasure to see the next generation taking up the mantle of working local farms that provide the food, fiber and shelter needed by all. I applaud the legacy set forth by the Walker family and young Brandon's vision to expand and modernize his family's agricultural presence."

While still in high school, Brandon decided he wanted to buy into the family cattle business and begin his own farm. He bought his very first cow, a bred heifer, from his pe-paw, Tommy Loyd. Over the years, he and his parents have continued to build

up their herd, which now numbers 30 head. During this time, Brandon continued to branch out by adding chickens, pigs and eventually, Fallow deer, to the family operation. But he didn't stop there.

Taking advantage of today's technology and its potential influence, Brandon created a social media presence for the family's farm. Utilizing these modern advantages, the Walkers can directly convey ag-related information to the public, while promoting one of Mississippi's most unique ag operations. The public can stay up-to-date by following Walker Ridge Farms on Facebook, Instagram and YouTube.

Since beginning with just a few buck and doe pairs in 2019, the Walkers now run approximately 20 Fallow deer each year. Brandon, along with his parents, Jeffrey and Linda, (gran-paw) Charlene, and (pe-paw) Tommy, collectively raise their F1 Tiger-striped cattle, chickens, KuneKune pigs and Fallow deer.

"Originally, the job I was working toward would have taken me around the country," said Brandon. "But I realized I wanted to be here, raising livestock and working on my farm in Mississippi. This is home."
