Helpful Tips for Your Thanksgiving Turkey

The Thanksgiving turkey is usually the center of all Thanksgiving meals. Even though cooks have been preparing these birds for years, each year there is still question as to is it done, how long can we store leftovers, what about the stuffing, etc., etc., etc. Listed below is information from the National Turkey Federation that may serve as a guide to help with any turkey cooking dilemmas or questions that may arise during this holiday season.

Turkey is available in many different forms; everything from cutlets, deli meats, sausage or the whole birds. Traditionally, we think of using the whole birds for most feasts. Turkey is a low-fat, high-protein, nutrient-dense food; so in addition to being an excellent dinner choice, it is a healthy choice.

Is it better to buy a fresh or frozen turkey?

There is no quality difference between a fresh or frozen turkey. Frozen turkeys are flash frozen immediately after packaging to 0°F or below and are held at that temperature until purchased. Once the birds are defrosted, the meat is practically as fresh as the day it was processed. Fresh turkeys are deep-chilled and have shorter shelf lives. Also, fresh turkeys are perishable and require special handling and merchandising, so they may be a little more expensive than frozen turkeys. Purchasing a frozen turkey allows you to get it in advance and take advantage of special sales. Fresh turkeys are convenient because they do not require thawing.

What size turkey do I need to buy?

Purchase at least one pound of uncooked turkey per person when purchasing a whole turkey. You will have enough for the feast and for leftovers.

How do you properly thaw a turkey?

Turkey can be thawed in the refrigerator, in cold water, or in the microwave. A whole turkey takes about 24 hours per five pounds to thaw in the refrigerator. In cold water, changed every 30 minutes, turkey takes about 30 minutes per pound to thaw. When using a microwave to thaw a turkey,



follow the manufacturer's instructions for the size turkey that will fit in your oven, the minutes per pound, and the power level to use. Never defrost turkey on the counter. Once thawed, keep turkey refrigerated at 40°F or below until it is ready to be cooked. Thawed turkey in the microwave should be cooked immediately.

What are the steps to safely stuff a turkey?

Stuffing should be prepared and stuffed into the turkey immediately before it is placed in the oven for cooking. If preparing the stuffing ahead of time, wet and dry ingredients should be refrigerated separately and combined right before stuffing the turkey. Stuff the turkey loosely, about 3/4 cup per pound of turkey. Use a two-step test for turkey doneness: first insert a meat thermometer into the deepest portion of the thigh, not touching the bone, and allow it to come to temperature for an accurate reading. Second, once the thigh has reached 180°F move the thermometer to the center of the stuffing. Once the stuffing has reached 160 to 165°F the

turkey should be removed from the oven.

How should leftovers be stored and how long will they keep?

Leftovers should be stored in shallow containers and refrigerated or frozen within two hours of cooking. Remove the stuffing and carve the extra turkey meat from the bones. Use cooked turkey and stuffing within 3-4 days and gravy within 1-2 days. Cooked turkey keeps 3-4 months in the freezer. When using leftovers, reheat the foods thoroughly to 165°F until hot and steaming; bring gravy to a boil before serving.

Follow these five easy steps to a perfectly roasted turkey:

1. Thaw the turkey and remove the neck and giblets from the neck and body cavities.

2. Preheat the oven to 325°F. for conventional or 300°F. for convection ovens.

3. Place turkey breast side up on a rack in a shallow roasting pan. If cooking stuffing inside the turkey, fill the body cavity with stuffing now.

4. Insert a meat thermometer into

the thickest part of the thigh, not touching bone.

5. Roast the turkey, uncovered, until the meat thermometer registers 180°F. Use the roasting timetable to estimate approximate cooking time. If stuffed, make sure the temperature of the stuffing has reached 160 to 165°F before removing the turkey from the oven.

Thermal/Conventional Oven Pan Method Timetable for Roasting a Turkey at 325°F.

8 to 12 pounds - 2 3/4 to 3 hours
12 to 14 pounds - 3 to 3 3/4 hours
14 to 18 pounds - 3 3/4 to 4 1/4 hours
18 to 20 pounds - 4 1/4 to 4 1/2 hours
20 to 24 pounds - 4 1/2 to 5 hours

Stuffed Turkey

8 to 12 pounds - 3 to 3 1/2 hours
12 to 14 pounds - 3 1/2 to 4 hours
14 to 18 pounds - 4 to 4 1/4 hours
18 to 20 pounds - 4 1/4 to 4 3/4 hours
20 to 24 pounds - 4 3/4 to 5 1/4 hours

Convection Oven Open Pan Method Roasting Guidelines for a Fresh-Thawed Turkey at 300°F.

Unstuffed Turkey

14 to 18 pounds - 2 1/4 to 2 1/2 hours
18 to 22 pounds - 2 1/2 to 3 hours

Stuffed Turkey

14 to 18 pounds - 2 1/2 to 3 hours
18 to 22 pounds - 3 to 3 1/2 hours

Foreign Purchase of Farmland Study Committee Holds Third Meeting

The Study Committee on Foreign Purchase of Farmland in Mississippi held its third meeting at the State Capitol on October 19. The Mississippi Legislature created this Study Committee through House Bill 280, 2023 Legislative Session, for the purpose of studying the purchasing, acquiring, leasing or holding an interest in agricultural land by foreign governments.

"We've covered a lot of ground in this Committee, and I want to com-

mend all committee members for your involvement and participation. Foreign ownership of land is a very important topic, and there are many things we must consider. Some good questions have been posed, and we have had information from various viewpoints submitted. I am looking forward to compiling this information into a report for the Legislature," said Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson.

The Study Committee welcomed Arkansas Secretary of Agriculture Wes Ward by phone to discuss recent developments with the Arkansas

Act 636. Representative Becky Currie also provided input. Testimonies were heard from Mississippi Forestry Association Executive Director Casey Anderson, American First Policy Institute Director for the China Policy Initiative Adam Savit and Mississippi Realtor Owen McIntosh. The Committee also reviewed comments submitted by the public.

The final meeting for the Committee was November 9, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 113 in the Capitol.

Maple and Cider Turkey Breast

1 6-8-pound bone-in-turkey breast, fresh or thawed if frozen
1 tablespoon canola oil
1 tablespoon grainy country-style mustard
Salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste
1 medium apple, cored & thinly sliced (unpeeled)
1/4 cup maple syrup
2 tablespoons cider vinegar
Dash Worcestershire sauce

Pat turkey breast dry with paper towels. In small bowl, mix oil and mustard; rub over breast and under skin from neck end. Do not detach skin at base. Season with salt and pepper. Slide apple slices between skin and meat. Place breast on a rack in shallow roasting pan. Roast, uncovered, and in a preheated 350° oven for about 1 1/2 to 1 3/4 hours or until a food thermometer inserted in thickest part of breast registers 170°. Meanwhile, combine syrup, vinegar, and Worcestershire sauce; set aside. During last 20 minutes of roasting, baste breast with mixture. If skin is browning too quickly, tent with foil. Remove breast to serving platter and let rest 10 to 15 minutes before carving.

Gourmet Sweet Potato Classic

5 sweet potatoes
1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 cup butter
2 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/2 cup white sugar
2 tablespoons heavy cream
1/4 cup butter, softened
3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
3/4 cup packed light brown sugar
1/2 cup chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350° F. Lightly grease a 9x13-inch baking dish. Bake sweet potatoes 35 minutes in the preheated oven, or until they begin to soften. Cool slightly, peel, and mash. In a large bowl, mix the mashed sweet potatoes, salt, 1/4 cup butter, eggs, vanilla extract, cinnamon, sugar, and heavy cream. Transfer to the prepared baking dish. In a medium bowl, combine 1/4 cup butter, flour, brown sugar, and chopped pecans. Mix with a pastry blender or your fingers to the consistency of course meal. Sprinkle over the sweet potato mixture. Bake 30 minutes in the preheated oven, until topping is crisp and lightly browned.

Cornbread Salad

2 9-inch pans cornbread – cooked, cooled & crumbled
8 slices bacon – cooked & crumbled
1 bell pepper – chopped
1 purple onion – chopped

2 tomatoes – diced
1 rib celery – diced
1 pint mayonnaise
Mix together all ingredients and put in large salad bowl; cover and refrigerate. Note: This salad keeps several days in refrigerator. It is even better after 2 days. Serves 8-12.

Pumpkin Cake

3 1/2 cups flour
2 cups sugar
1 1/2 cups pumpkin
1 1/2 cups chocolate chips
1 1/2 cups walnuts
1 cup butter
4 medium eggs
2 teaspoons soda
2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon nutmeg
1/2 teaspoon ginger
1/2 teaspoon cloves

Preheat oven to 375°. In a large bowl, cream together the butter, sugar, and eggs. Add cinnamon, salt, nutmeg, ginger, and cloves; add flour and pumpkin. Stir in chocolate chips and walnuts; mix well. Grease bottom of two 9x5-inch loaf pans. Transfer cake mixture into prepared pans and bake for about 1 hour or until the toothpick trick works.



Dry Conditions Mix Up Sweet Potato Sizes

Most of Mississippi's sweet potatoes are grown far northeast of the state's worst drought conditions, but that did not keep excessive heat and dryness from factoring in this year's crop.

Lorin Harvey, sweet potato specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said dry weather affected production more than most growers anticipated. Because of the drought, irrigated acres performed better than potatoes on dryland.

"Those in the Delta who utilized irrigation fared better than many of the growers around Vardaman who were at the mercy of soil moisture at planting and sparse rainfall throughout the growing season," Harvey said. "We had sparse popup showers around the growing region, but nothing substantial. Several fields went 45 days without a drop of rain during peak root bulking from July to August."

The lack of precipitation has caused variability in the size of potatoes between fields and increased chances of skinning, making it hard to plan for harvest.

"Harvest started about 10 days earlier than last year, but growers slowed down to allow for deveining, skin to set, and for sweet potatoes to continue to size up," Harvey said. "That put the remainder of the harvest at about a week behind where we were last year in mid-October."

Caleb Englert, Mississippi Sweet Potato Council president, said potatoes planted by mid-May received a couple of significant rainfalls before the dry spell and have had good yields. Later planted acreage faced a tougher battle. A "fair-to-average" crop, which he anticipates, should

be enough for most growers to turn a profit.

"If we could sell dust, we'd retire tomorrow," Englert said. "It's been hot and dry with some ground cracking. We are seeing some smaller product than normal. With it being this dry, there could be some rot on weight."

About 65 commercial growers in Mississippi planted about 28,000 acres of sweet potatoes this year. In terms of quality, Harvey said, early harvested potatoes appeared promising.

"Quality is something Mississippi has been pretty consistent with due to careful management practices and field selections," he said. "We've seen some growth cracks in roots that were dry and quickly sucked up water when it did rain, but that is to be expected. This year's crop will likely come out to be lower than average due to the lack of rainfall."

Overall U.S. sweet potato production is down this year due to a 20 percent acreage reduction in North Carolina, which is the top producing state. Mississippi ranks second.

MSU Extension is offering free soil sample testing for nematodes to sweet potato growers until the end of 2024. Samples can be submitted in nematode bags available at local county MSU Extension offices. Samples are also accepted in quart-sized, sealed plastic bags. Bags must be labeled and accompanied by the nematode sample submission form F448, available at <https://extension.msstate.edu/lab>.

MALTB Investigators Recover Stolen Property in Hinds County

The Mississippi Agriculture and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB) recovered a stolen skid steer, with an estimated value of \$50,000, in Hinds County. On October 15, 2023, MALTB investigators started an investigation after receiving anonymous information of possible stolen equipment. Three days later, investigators located and recovered a stolen 2018 Model 289D Caterpillar Skid Steer. The skid steer had been reported stolen from Hinds County in the City of Jackson in July 2022. The property recovered was valued at an estimated \$50,000. MALTB Director Dean Barnard praised investigators for their quick action and recovery of the equipment and thanked the anonymous caller for providing the information. “We encourage anyone who might have information of stolen agricultural

equipment to please contact your local law enforcement, Crime Stoppers at 601-355-TIPS, or our MALTB tip line at 1-800-678-2660. All callers can remain anonymous,” said Barnard. Commissioner Andy Gipson said, “I applaud our investigators’ swift response and hard work to recover the valuable property in this case. Our investigators are the first line of defense when it comes to thefts in Mississippi’s ag community, and we are dedicated to protecting and serving our producers throughout the state.” The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau, the law enforcement division of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, enforces state laws pertaining to the theft of cattle, horses, swine, poultry, fish, farm equipment, chemicals, timber and all other farm or agriculture-related crimes.
