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Unwrapping the History and Heart of Mississippi's Christmas Tree Tradition

Mahala Roach's neighbors on Depot Street in Vicksburg, MS, probably wondered what was going on when they saw an evergreen tree being taken into her home on a December day in 1851. It is believed that the tree displayed in her parlor was the first Christmas tree in Mississippi. *Source: Mississippi Today*

While Christmas trees had cemented themselves as symbolic pillars of the winter season long before in ancient cultures, it



took a little longer for the German practice to take root as an American tradition. As late as the 1840s, Christmas trees were seen as pagan symbols and not accepted by most Americans.

However, once the popular royals, Queen Victoria and her German Prince, Albert, were shown in a magazine in 1846 standing with their children around a Christmas tree, the tradition became a fashionable custom. Americans and Mississippians, such as Mahala Roach, followed suit and by the 1890s Christmas ornaments were arriving from Germany and Christmas tree popularity was on the rise around the United States.

Homemade Gingerbread

3 eggs
1 cup sugar
1 cup molasses
1 1/2 teaspoons ginger
1 1/2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 teaspoon cloves
1 cup vegetable oil
2 cups all-purpose flour
2 teaspoons baking soda
2 tablespoons warm water
1 cup boiling water

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease a 9x13 cake pan or line with parchment paper. Mix eggs, sugar, molasses, spices, and oil with a hand mixer until well combined. Sift in flour. Combine baking soda and 2 tablespoons water. Add to the batter and mix well. Stir in boiling water until fully combined. Pour the batter (it will seem thin) into the prepared pan. Bake 40- 45 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean. Cool completely and serve with whipped cream.

Pecan Pie Bars

2 cups all-purpose flour
2/3 cup powdered sugar
3/4 cup butter, softened
1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar
1/2 cup honey
2/3 cup butter
3 tablespoon whipping cream
3 1/2 cups coarsely chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350°F. Lightly grease a 13- x 9-inch baking dish with cooking spray. Sift together 2 cups flour and 2/3 cup powdered sugar. Cut in 3/4 cup softened butter using a pastry blender or fork just until mixture resembles coarse meal. Pat mixture on bottom and 1 1/2 inches up sides of a lightly greased 13- x 9-inch baking dish. Bake at 350°F for 20 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Cool. Bring brown sugar, honey, 2/3 cup butter, and whipping cream to a boil in a saucepan over medium-high heat. Stir in pecans. Pour hot filling into prepared crust. Bake at 350°F for 25 to 30 minutes or until golden and bubbly. Cool completely before cutting into 2-inch squares.

Cornflake Wreath Christmas Cookies


4 cups mini marshmallows
1/2 cup salted butter
1 teaspoon green food coloring
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/2 teaspoon almond extract
4 cups cornflake cereal
2 1/4 oz. cinnamon candies (such as Red Hots)

Place the marshmallows and butter in a large bowl. Microwave on high for 2 minutes. Remove from microwave and stir. Microwave on high for 2 additional minutes or until completely melted. Add the green food coloring, vanilla, and almond extract; stir until the marshmallow mixture is smooth. Add the cornflakes to the bowl, and gently stir to coat the cereal evenly with the marshmallow mixture. Shape the Christmas cookie wreaths around a round cutter on a baking sheet. Remove round cutter, and place candy. Let cool.

Mamma's Homemade Hot Chocolate

8 packets of instant dry milk (each packet makes one quart when mixed, and boxes typically come with 10 packets total)
16 ounces (or 1 pound) of Nestle Nesquik Chocolate Powder
2/3 cup powdered sugar
6 ounces Coffeemate Original Powdered Creamer

Sift all ingredients together into a large tupperware container until no lumps remain and mixture is fully cohesive. To serve, mix equal parts hot water and hot chocolate mix. You can do this in a mug, large insulated pitcher, or on the stovetop according to your preference.

2 teaspoons flaky sea salt (such as Maldon)

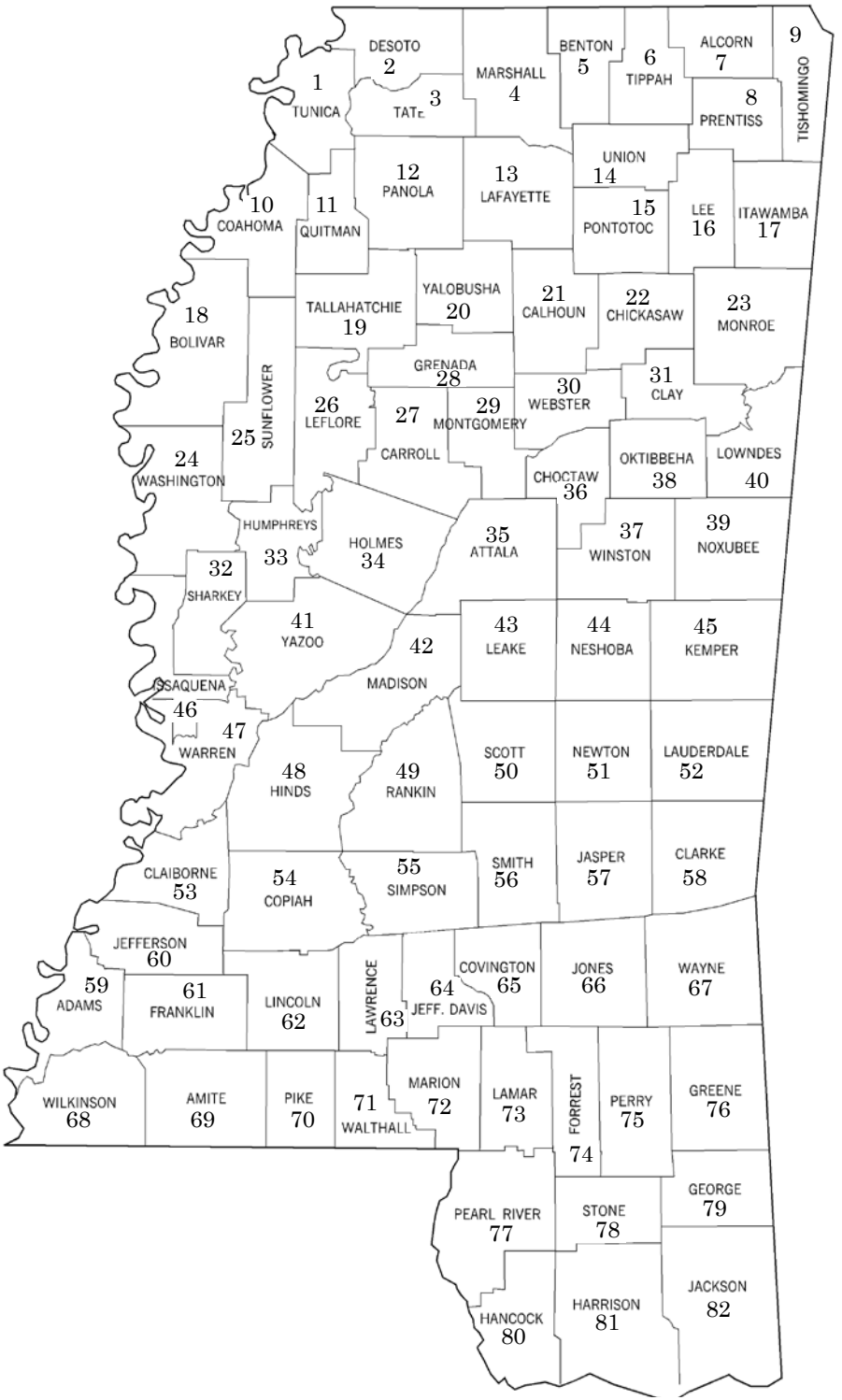

“Blessing of the Hunt” Mississippi Outdoors and Wildlife Enthusiasts Make a Difference in Their Community

The blessing of the hunt is a time-honored tradition performed in the hopes of ensuring a safe and bountiful hunting season. This ritual to spread good fortune upon hunters and hounds originated in the Middle Ages with Saint Hubert, the patron saint of hunters.

Recently, Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson participated in a Blessing of the Hunt benefit at Corinth Baptist Church in Magee. As part of the blessing ceremony, a benefit was held for Adley Sanders, a local child diagnosed with a form of cancer. The proceeds went to support the Sanders family and treatment for Adley.

“This event is an important tradition to hold at the beginning of hunting season, asking the Lord to bless our land, our hunt and our families,” said Commissioner Gipson. “The community really came together to make this happen, and it means so much to support our fellow Mississippians while also recognizing the outdoors. I want to personally thank Executive Director Lynn Posey for being here with us at the Blessing of the Hunt. Agriculture and the outdoors are a way of life for our people in this state.”

In the state of Mississippi, deer season opens in November each year. According to the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks (MDWFP), Mississippi’s deer population is estimated to be 1.75 million, with hunters harvesting approximately 280,000 deer annually. MDWFP Executive Director Lynn Posey said, “Statewide, as a general rule, our deer populations need to be lowered. We’re encouraging hunters to maximize their bag limit this season.”

Each year, white-tailed deer cause damage to agricultural crops and smaller areas such as gardens in residential settings. The preferred method of controlling deer depredation problems, according to the MDWFP’s Deer Program Report, is adequate hunter harvest during deer season. This lowers the deer population to levels that are in balance with the environmental carrying capacity of the habitat.

In particular, the MDWFP is working to engage the next generation of hunters and outdoorsmen. “About 30 years ago, we had an idea to try and get our youth more involved in hunting and the outdoors, and with a lot of help, we passed the first youth weekend,” said Posey. Scholastic shooting and archery programs are also cur-

rently available to Mississippi youth. These unique programs teach hunting skills through the safe use of hunting equipment and their relationship to hunting situations.

However, hunting not only serves to control wildlife populations, it also provides the opportunity to feed and clothe Mississippi families. White-tailed deer can be harvested for their meat, hides and antlers. And venison is a dependable source of protein that is also low in fat. Mississippi is currently home to over 80 facilities that process deer meat, in addition to more common livestock meats like beef, pork and poultry. The benefits of hunting, whether it be dove,

turkey, deer or any other season, are endless. From conservation and wildlife management to promoting a healthier lifestyle, hunting plays an important role in Mississippi culture.

“We pray that we enjoy the great outdoors,” continued Posey. “We do so with great reverence and respect for God’s creation. Hunting is a cherished tradition deeply rooted in our culture. And with that tradition comes a profound responsibility – we must respect our fellow hunters, the animals we pursue and the world around us, even unto the wilderness that sustains us.”

May God bless this year’s hunt.

Weather Stacked Odds Against 2023 Mississippi Pecan Crop

A late freeze, high summertime temperatures and a devastating drought mean a poor pecan crop for Mississippi in 2023.

Eric Stafne, fruit and nut specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said weather stacked the odds against a good crop this year.

“Despite the late freeze, some trees still set a decent crop, but the heat and drought caused poor nut fill and dropped immature nuts during the summer,” Stafne said. “The drought could have carryover effects into next year, too, by reducing development of fruiting buds.”

Max Draughn, president of the Mississippi Pecan Growers Association and owner of Bass Pecan Nursery and Pecan Hill Farms in Raymond, said the late freeze in March destroyed any blooms that were on the trees.

“This affected the middle part of the state the most and resulted in a short crop for those areas,” Draughn said. “Overall, the quantity of nuts is there but quality is lacking.”

Although rains were abundant early in the year, the drought from July on caused problems throughout the state.

“The drought caused trees to abort and drop nuts in July, August and September, further reducing our crop in Mississippi. Some pecans will not fill out and produce good kernels due to lack of water,” Draughn said. “Some kernels will be shriveled to a wafer-like state, kernel color will be dark, and some nuts will have what looks like fuzz on the top of the ker-

nel in trees that are starved for water.”

About 10% of the state’s pecan orchards are irrigated and were better able to deal with the drought, he said, but the high temperatures that accompanied the drought caused other problems.

“The high heat caused a darkening of the pecan kernels and an appearance of vein lines in the kernels,” Draughn said. “There was too much heat for too long in August this year.”

Art Sanders, owner of Lindy’s Pecans in Clay County, said his 800 trees are struggling because of this year’s environmental factors.

“It looks like I will lose 60% of my little crop, and I know of one other grower who will not have any,” Sanders said.

In 1999, Sanders bought the orchard that was planted in 1987 but neglected. Six years ago, he began rehabilitating the orchard, adding fertilizer to the soil, spraying for diseases and maintaining the plants. Irrigation is on his wish list.

“When that hot spell came through with no rain, my trees were suffering with a lot of stress on them,” Sanders said. “This is probably going to be one of my worst years.”

Draughn said Mississippi has 800 pecan orchards, totaling 17,000 acres of pecan trees. Orchard sizes range from 2 acres to about 600 acres. The last 10 years has seen a renewed interest in planting pecan orchards.

“The majority of these new orchards are small, being 50 acres or less,” Draughn said. “New orchards are embracing advancement in the pecan industry by planting newer disease-resistant, low-input orchards and adding practices such as irrigation to their orchards to enhance production and quality of the pecans.”
