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Raising Backyard Birds Requires Planning, Time

In response to the increasing popularity of raising chickens for eggs and meat, Mississippi State University Extension experts are offering tips for people interested in starting their own flock of backyard birds.

Tom Tabler, MSU Extension Service poultry specialist, said chickens are a great project, as long as everyone involved understands what they are signing on for.

"I like to talk about poultry as a livestock, and if you're going to raise livestock, it's a good starter project," he said. "You have lower start-up costs and easier care. It's not a cakewalk, but kids can learn responsi-

bility and how to care for animals properly."

In addition to learning about costs and time involved, Tabler said people should research chicken breeds, because different breeds are suited to different purposes.

For example, someone interested in egg production would not need any roosters, and might consider Leghorns, which are productive layers. If meat production is the goal, other breeds, such as Cornish, are better suited for that purpose. Cochins and some Bantam breeds are considered more docile and thus better for small children interested in having a pet. Ameraucana hens lay colorful eggs but do not lay abundantly.

Jessica Wells, Extension instructor at MSU's Department of Poultry Science, said Mississippians interested in buying eggs to hatch or chicks to raise can find them locally, but they need to consider disease issues before bringing the birds home.

"I recommend contacting the poultry section of the Board of Animal Health," Wells said. "They keep a list of all of the flocks that are Mississippi Poultry Improvement Plancertified through their office, which means the flocks have been tested for diseases."

Wells said backyard bird enthusiasts who do not purchase from statecertified growers should buy from a reputable hatchery that is National Poultry Improvement Plan certified.

"This route may be more expensive than buying from your neighbor or at the flea market, but it will pay off in the long run by yielding a happy, healthy flock," she said.

Chickens are vulnerable to predators, such as wild animals and family pets, and a pen is needed to keep them safe. A pen is the largest investment backyard birds require,

but they don't have to be expensive, just secure.

"Cats, dogs, raccoons, coyotes, possums, foxes, hawks, and other flying predators will see your chickens as an easy and free meal if you don't have a proper structure that provides protection from every angle," Wells said. "Remember that animals can come in from the sides, top or bottom of the pen, and predators come in all sizes."

Wells said growers can find a variety of poultry pen plans online, but ready-made options exist too.

"If you don't want to construct your own pen, a simple chain-link dog pen can be used, as long as the top is secured. This can be something as simple as a tarp," she said. "Nest boxes should be built out of a solid material on the pen's back side."

Keeping the pens clean will help keep chickens healthy.


"Regular maintenance keeps fecal material low, fly populations down, and feed from being spilled and spoiling, which in turn cuts down on rodents," Wells said.

Chickens may snack on insects that wander through the yard, but they must have a nutritious feed to keep up their weight and regularly produce eggs.

"I don't recommend trying to mix your own feed," Wells said. "Premixed feeds have all the ingredients the birds need, at the right levels. People think they can feed food scraps or chicken scratch and save money on feed costs, but if the birds fill up on scraps and scratch before being fed normal chicken feed, they don't benefit from the feed's nutrition."

The bottom line is that raising chickens is work, but if done correctly from the beginning, it can be fun and fulfilling.

"If you don't provide proper care and management, neither you nor your birds will be happy," Tabler said.

When Chicken and Eggs Come to Roost



Chicken Florentine Strata

 $1\,1/2$ pounds boneless, skinless chicken breast halves, sliced into thin strips

2 tablespoons olive oil

2 shallots, minced

1 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon black pepper

1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper

1 package (16-ounce) frozen spinach, thawed and well-drained

1 cup sundried tomatoes, drained and chopped

10 slices white bread, cut into cubes

2 cups grated Monterey jack cheese

6 eggs

2 cups whole milk

2 teaspoons Dijon mustard

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

Lightly grease a three-quart casserole dish. In a large skillet over medium-high heat, warm oil. Add shallots to skillet and sauté one minute. Add chicken strips and cook five minutes more, or until cooked through. Season chicken with salt, black pepper and cayenne pepper. Place a layer of bread cubes in the bottom of the dish. In alternating layers, place chicken, spinach, sundried tomatoes, cheese and bread, ending with a sprinkling of bread on top. In a large bowl, combine eggs, milk, mustard and nutmeg with a whisk. Pour mixture over the casserole, cover and refrigerate four hours or overnight. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. While oven heats, remove casserole from refrigerator and warm to room temperature. Place casserole in oven and bake 35-40 minutes, until golden brown on top. Remove from oven and cool five minutes before serving. Serve hot or at room temperature.

Eggs Ricotta Rustica

1 pound ripe tomatoes

2 medium jalapeno peppers, seeded and minced

1/4 cup olive oil

2 tablespoons fresh lime juice

Sea salt, to taste

Fresh ground pepper, to taste

2 tablespoons fresh cilantro or basil, minced

Olive oil, as needed

12 rustic leavened bread slices (2 ounces each)

1/4 cup butter

12 large eggs, beaten

1/4 cup cold water

Sea salt and pepper, to taste

1 pound, 8 ounces fresh ricotta or soft fresh mozzarella cheese

Cut a shallow small "X" on the bottom of tomatoes. Blanch tomatoes for 30 seconds; plunge in ice bath. Peel when cool and then seed and dice; add minced jalapeno. Whisk together oil and lime juice. Pour over tomatoes. Sprinkle on sea salt and pepper to taste. Stir in cilantro. Cover and reserve. Lightly brush bread with oil. Grill until well toasted on both sides. Keep warm. Melt butter in skillet. Blend eggs, water and salt and pepper, to taste. Cook and scramble eggs until firm throughout, with no visible liquid egg remaining. For each serving, spread two tablespoons cheese onto grilled bread. Top with approximately 1/3 cup scrambled egg and two tablespoons salsa. Serve immediately.

Chicken Sandwiches with Lemon-Basil Zucchini and Boursin

3 cups rotisserie chicken, shredded

1 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil

1 lemon, zested and juiced

3 tablespoons chopped fresh basil

2 medium zucchini, sliced very thinly lengthwise

1/2 cup thinly sliced red bell pepper

15-ounce package Boursin cheese

8 slices crusty bread, toasted

In a bowl, combine salt, pepper, olive oil, lemon zest and juice, and basil. Whisk to combine. Add zucchini ribbons and red bell pepper and gently toss to coat with dressing. Spread one quarter of Boursin cheese onto one half of each sandwich. Divide shredded chicken among the four sandwiches, placing on top of cheese. Top chicken with red bell pepper and zucchini ribbons, drizzling any remaining dressing over the vegetables. Cut each sandwich on the diagonal and serve.

Corned Beef Hash with Poached Egg

Corned Beef Hash with Poached Egg 2 pounds, 8 ounces Yukon Gold potatoes, steamed

Oil, as needed Vinegar

1 pound, 8 ounces corned beef

2 tablespoons fresh rosemary, chopped

1 tablespoon fresh chives, chopped

2 tablespoons fresh thyme, chopped

1 cup unsalted butter

Salt and pepper, to taste

12 large eggs

2 tablespoons chopped chives

Dice potatoes. Deep fry or sauté potatoes in oil until crisp. Remove and reserve. Julienne the corned beef into 1/4-inch wide strips; reserve. In a large skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Stir in potatoes and herbs; sauté two minutes. Stir in beef; sauté additional two minutes. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Remove from the heat but keep warm. Poach eggs in small batches in acidified water (one teaspoon vinegar to one quart water) until whites are set (completely coagulated and firm) and yolks begin to thicken (no longer runny, but not hard). Remove and keep warm. To serve, portion about 1/2 cup hash on small plate. Top with a poached egg. Sprinkle on one teaspoon chives. Serve immediately.



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



USDA Launches New Biosecurity Campaign Asking All Poultry Owners, Workers and Hobbyists to Protect the Health of Live Poultry

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service is launching a new outreach campaign focused on preventing the spread of infectious poultry diseases in both commercial and backyard poultry. Considering the devastating impact of the highly pathogenic avian influenza outbreak in 2014-2015, as well as this year's outbreak of virulent Newcastle disease, the timing is right for everyone in the poultry community to work together to protect the health of our nation's flocks.

The "Defend the Flock" campaign to promote biosecurity combines and updates two previous campaigns that were each targeted at a specific segment of the poultry population. "While each of the previous campaigns were successful, by combining them and emphasizing shared responsibility, USDA will improve its ability to promote biosecurity and protect avian health across the country," said Dr. Jack Shere, USDA's Chief Veterinary Officer and a poultry veterinarian himself.

Having experienced several poultry health issues over the last couple of years, the poultry community knows how important biosecurity is to protecting the nation's flocks. "We've seen great strides in biosecurity since 2015, but biosecurity is an everyday, every time effort," said Dr. Shere. "To sustain good practices takes awareness, training and reminders – which this campaign is poised to do.

Let's all work together to defend our nation's flocks."

USDA launched a new web page for the campaign at www.aphis.usda. gov/animalhealth/defendtheflock where anyone can find important information about protecting their flocks from disease. The site also has a resource section, including a series of checklists each covering specific biosecurity principles. Producers, growers, workers and enthusiasts alike can use these as regular reminders or cues for maintaining a high level of biosecurity. These resources will be available in both English and Spanish at the launch, with additional languages coming in the next year.

Checklist: Tips To Help Keep Your Flocks Healthy

This checklist is a general guide to practicing good biosecurity, but if you have a site-specific biosecurity plan, please follow it. Commercial growers should be sure their site-specific plans follow the National Poultry Improvement Plan biosecurity principles.

- Wear personal protective equipment or clothing and shoes that you only use when caring for your poultry. This includes boot covers or boots that can be disinfected. Change into fresh protective gear between poultry houses or coops.
 Enclosures must be empty for a thorough
- cleaning. If you have a poultry house, wait until the house is empty to start the cleaning process. If you have a coop or other type of enclosure, move the birds to a separate area before cleaning.
- Remove all litter, manure, and other debris.
- "Dry" clean all areas—brush, scrape, and shovel off manure, feathers, and other materials. Disinfectant will not penetrate organic matter or caked-on dirt.
- "Wet" clean all surfaces—scrub with water and detergent. Work from top to bottom and back to front.

- Rinse all surfaces carefully with water.
- Apply disinfectant according to the directions on the label. Be sure to use a disinfectant that is registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and indicates that it is effective against avian influenza and other poultry diseases.
- Leave the enclosure empty until it is completely dry. Use fans and/or open doors and windows to help speed the drying process. Wet surfaces can be harmful to poultry.
- When you're done, remove and discard your protective gear. If using dedicated clothing and boots, change clothing and clean and disinfect your boots.
- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.
 Wash and dry your dedicated clothing.

USDA Announces Sign-Up Period for Updated Conservation Stewardship Program

next deadline Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) applications to be considered for funding in fiscal year (FY) 2019 is May 10, 2019. USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) plans to invest up to \$700 million for new enrollments and contract extensions in fiscal year 2019. The 2018 Farm Bill made several changes to this critical conservation program, which helps agricultural producers take the conservation activities on their farm or ranch to the next level.

"CSP continues to be a very effective tool for private landowners working to achieve their conservation and management goals," said Kurt Readus, NRCS state conservationist in Mississippi. "It is the largest conservation program in the United States with more than 70 million

acres of productive agricultural and forest land enrolled."

While applications are accepted throughout the year, interested producers should submit applications to their local NRCS office by **May 10, 2019**, to ensure their applications are considered for 2019 funding.

Changes to the Program

The 2018 Farm Bill authorizes NRCS to accept new CSP enrollments from now until 2023, and it makes some important improvements to the program. These updates include:

- NRCS now enrolls eligible, high ranking applications based on dollars rather than acres. For fiscal 2019, NRCS can spend up to \$700 million in the program, which covers part of the cost for producers implementing new conservation activities and maintaining their existing activities.
- Higher payment rates are now available for certain conservation

activities, including cover crops and resource conserving crop rotations.

• CSP now provides specific support for organic and for transitioning to organic production activities and a special grassland conservation initiative for certain producers who have maintained cropland base acres.

About the Program

CSP is offered in Mississippi through continuous sign-ups. The program provides many benefits including increased crop yields, decreased inputs, wildlife habitat improvements and increased resilience to weather extremes. CSP is for working lands including cropland, pastureland, rangeland, nonindustrial private forest land and agricultural land under the jurisdiction of a tribe.




