Horse Programs Unite Mississippi Generations

Horsemanship clinics, camps and competitions are uniting young horse enthusiasts with mature, experienced riders across the state as interest booms in the sometimes athletic and always fun equine activities.

Clay Cavinder, equine specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said horseback riding is a great way to bridge generation gaps.

"Adults who grew up with horses enjoy passing that love to young riders," he said. "County



Through 4-H, young people with a passion for horses can participate in educational contests related to the equine industry regardless of whether they even own a horse. These educational programs enhance members' knowledge of horse health, breed characteristics, management and feeding.

Extension offices help bring generations together, sometimes as they learn together."

Cavinder said counties use Extension programs, such as Horse Management 101 and Horse Tales, to educate beginner and intermediate riders. Other county offices host barrel racing and cow-horse clinics, which are often for the more experienced riders.

Lee County Extension agent Brandon Alberson brought Horse Tales to third-graders in Saltillo as an introduction to horses and 4-H programs.

"Horse Tales gives the students a hands-on overview of horses, teaching them about breeds, uses, behavior and care considerations," Alberson said. "We also wanted to teach them about safety considerations to help future experiences with horses be positive ones."

Yazoo County Extension agent Katrina Owens said past summer horsemanship camps have been

popular in her county.

"These two-day camps strengthen every participant's foundation. Just like our horses, many of us have picked up some

bad habits along the way, and we need to unlearn some of our methods," Owens said. "Experienced clinicians demonstrate the importance of patience and consistent practice for safe and successful riding experiences."

Montgomery County Extension agent Amy Ware said her county was the first in the state to host Horse Management 101, a nine-week program with classroom and clinic time.

"Montgomery County 4-H has a strong horse program. Members take part in horsemanship events as well as equine-oriented photography and public speaking projects," Ware said. "Hippology and horse bowl (trivia) competitions help participants learn facts they need to know. Judging competitions are especially good at pushing 4-H'ers beyond their comfort zones, but that comes

with a great deal of satisfaction from what they learn."

Ware said children as young as 5 to 7 years of age join the 4-H Cloverbud program to learn more about horses.

Chickasaw County Extension program associate Angie Abrams said people of all ages enjoy regular weekend competitions in her county.

"We have something almost every weekend in Houston. They are making lifelong friends, and they have the whole year together with families from around the area," she said. "They inspire each other to work harder, but friendships are preserved no matter who places first. They are always willing to help each other."

Super Simple Memorial Day Recipes



Iced Raspberry Tea

- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 4 quarts water
- 1 12-ounce package frozen unsweetened raspberries
- 10 tea bags
- 1/4 cup lemon juice
- Fresh raspberries and lemon slices, optional

In a Dutch oven over high heat, bring sugar and water to a boil. Remove from heat; stir until sugar is dissolved. Add raspberries, tea bags and lemon juice. Steep, covered, for three minutes. Strain; discard berries and tea bags. Transfer tea to a large container or pitcher. Refrigerate until chilled. Serve over ice. If desired, serve with fresh raspberries and lemon slices. This tea is fruity tasting and lovely looking!

Grilled Nectarine & Cheese Crostini

- 1/2 cup balsamic vinegar
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 12 slices Fresh bread baguette (1/4 inch thick)
- 2 medium nectarines, halved
- 1/4 cup fresh goat cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup loosely packed basil leaves, thinly sliced

In a small saucepan, bring vinegar to a boil; cook 10-15 minutes or until liquid is reduced to three tablespoons. Remove from heat. Brush oil over both sides of baguette slices. Grill, uncovered, over medium heat until golden brown on both sides. Grill nectarines 45-60 seconds on each side or until tender and lightly browned. Cool slightly. Spread goat cheese over toasts. Cut nectarines into thick slices; arrange over cheese. Drizzle with balsamic syrup; sprinkle with basil. Serve immediately.

Bacon-Wrapped Hot Dogs

- 12 bacon strips
- 8 cheese beef hot dogs
- 8 bakery hot dog buns, split and toasted
- 1/4 cup chopped red onion
- 2 cups sauerkraut, rinsed and well drained
- Optional condiments: mayonnaise, ketchup or Dijon mustard

In a large skillet, cook bacon over medium heat until partially cooked but not crisp. Remove to paper towels to drain; cool slightly. Wrap 1 1/2 strips of bacon around each hot dog, securing with water soaked toothpicks as needed (do not wrap tightly, or bacon may tear during grilling). Grill, covered, over medium heat or broil four inches from heat six to eight minutes or until bacon is crisp and hot dogs are heated through, turning frequently. Discard toothpicks. Serve hot dogs in buns with onion and sauerkraut; top with condiments of your choice.

Grilled Sweet Corn

- 8 large ears sweet corn in husks
- 6 tablespoons butter, softened
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh parsley
- 1 to 2 teaspoons chili powder
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt
- 1/2 to 1 teaspoon ground cumin

Place corn in a stockpot; cover with cold water. Soak 20 minutes. Mix remaining ingredients. Drain corn; carefully peel back husks to within 1 in. of bottoms and remove silk. Spread corn with butter mixture; rewrap in husks and secure with kitchen string.

Grill corn, covered, over medium heat until tender, 25-30 minutes, turning often. To serve, cut string and peel back husks

Fresh Cucumber Salad

- 3 medium cucumbers, sliced
- 1 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup water
- 1/2 cup white vinegar
- 3 tablespoons minced fresh dill or parsley

Place cucumbers in a 1 1/2 - to-2-quart glass container. In a jar with a tight-fitting lid, shake remaining ingredients until combined. Pour over cucumbers. Cover and refrigerate overnight. Serve with a slotted spoon.

Grilled Angel Food Cake with Strawberries

- 2 cups sliced fresh strawberries
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 3 tablespoons butter, melted
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 8 slices angel food cake (about 1 ounce each)
- Optional: Reduced-fat vanilla ice cream and blueberry syrup

In a small bowl, toss strawberries with sugar. In another bowl, mix butter and vinegar; brush over cut sides of cake. On a greased rack, grill cake, uncovered, over medium heat until golden brown, one to two minutes on each side. Serve cake with strawberries and, if desired, ice cream and blueberry syrup.

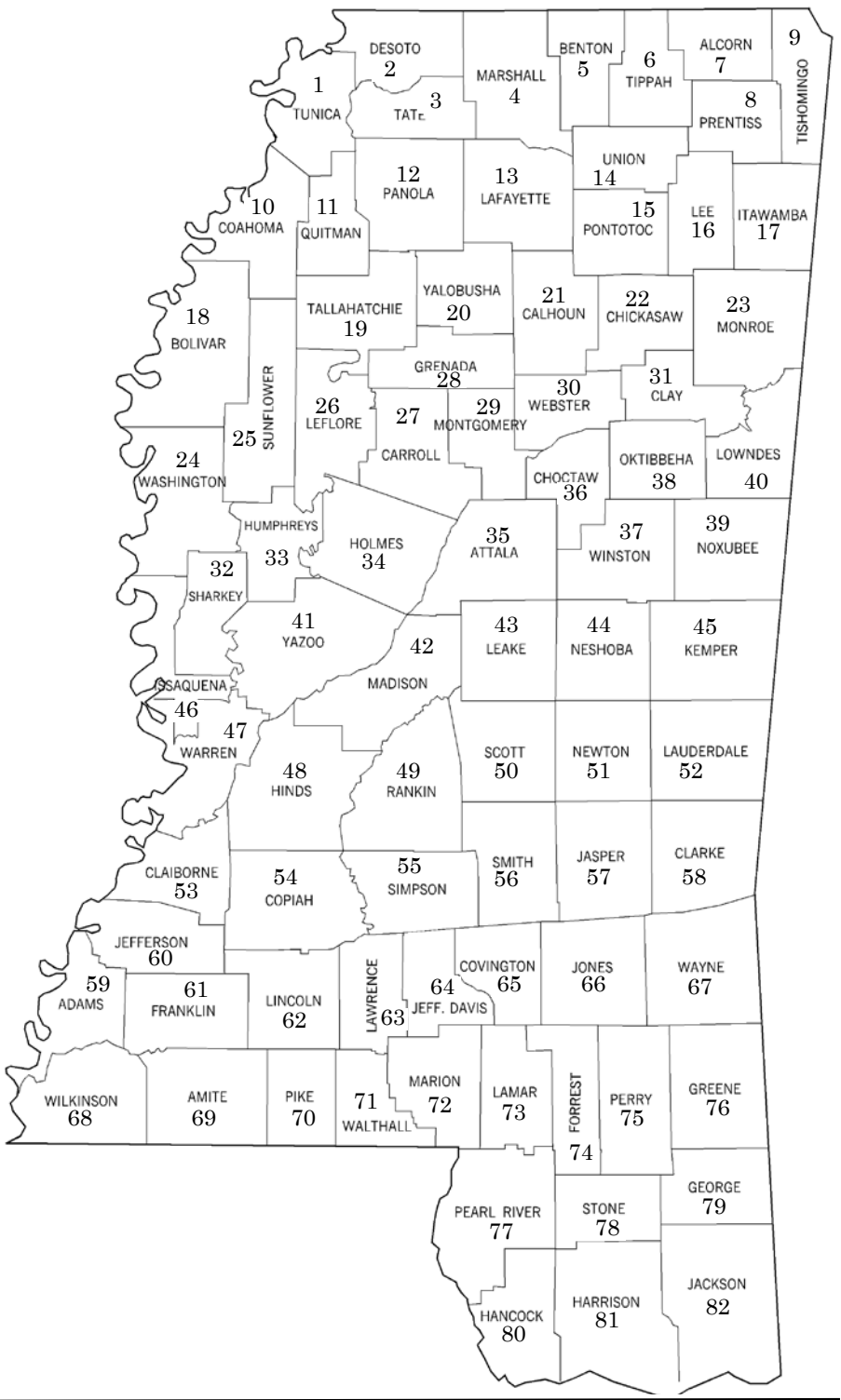

Agriculture Commissioner Gipson to Chair Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force

In accordance with House Bill 1547 enacted during the 2019 Regular Legislative Session, Mississippi's Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson announced the planned framework and first meeting of the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force. Cultivation of industrial hemp was legalized under federal law in December 2018 pursuant to Section 10113 of the 2018 Farm Bill. However, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has not yet implemented new Farm Bill regulations for the 2019 growing season. Cultivation of industrial hemp is still prohibited under state law in Mississippi.

On February 27, 2019, USDA announced it had begun the process of gathering information to initiate rulemaking required to implement the federal hemp cultivation program. USDA's stated goal is to issue federal regulations in the fall of 2019 to accommodate the 2020 planting season. Meanwhile, the Mississippi Legislature established the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force during the 2019 Regular Legislative Session to consider the potential of hemp cultivation, market potential, and potential job creation in Mississippi.

With the enactment of House Bill 1547, the Mississippi Legislature specified that Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson serve as Chairman of the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force. Commissioner Gipson noted, "This is a responsibility I take seriously in accepting this unique assignment from the Mississippi Legislature. I look forward to leading a thoughtful, evidence-based discussion with the other members of the Task Force as we examine all the issues surrounding the cultivation of hemp in Mississippi."

He added, "In all our considerations, we will keep a keen focus on the interests of Mississippians, including our farmers, law enforcement and other stakeholders, as well as the general public. We will thoroughly explore the potential as well as the challenges experienced by other states."

Under the legislation, the members of the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force are as follows:



ation Task Force are as follows:

- The Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce or a designee;
- The President of Mississippi State University or a designee;
- The President of Alcorn State University or a designee;
- A director of the University of Mississippi School of Pharmacy National Center for Natural Products Research or a designee;
- The President of the Delta Council or a designee;
- A representative of the Mississippi Secretary of State's office;
- A representative of the Mississippi Attorney General's office;
- The Director of Pharmacy, Mississippi State Department of Health or a designee;
- A member of the Mississippi House of Representatives designated by the Speaker of the House;
- A member of the Mississippi Senate designated by the Lieutenant Governor;
- The Commissioner of Public Safety or a designee;
- The President of the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation or a designee; and
- A designee of the Governor.

In order to meet the early December deadline for reporting to the Legislature, Commissioner Gipson is asking each member of the Task Force for early submission of their ideas and concerns. This will provide time for initial research by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce in advance of the first Task Force meeting in early July.

Commissioner Gipson announced that meetings of the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force will be held in Room 113 of the Mississippi State Capitol and will be open to the public. The first meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 8, 2019, at 10:00 a.m.
