## Pecans Yields Good, Demand Strong

Despite the weather challenges this year, most Mississippi pecan producers expect a good yield.

However, a wet spring and late-summer drought could mean nut loss and lessened nut quality for some growers.

“High moisture in the early season led to pecan scab fungus, so unsprayed orchards will have the most loss,” said Eric Stafne, fruit and nut specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service. “I’ve also seen a lot of wafery pecans, which means those pecans did not get enough water during nut filling from late July into early September. Pecans demand lots of water during

this time period, as much as 2 inches per week.”

Max Draughn, president of the Mississippi Pecan Growers Association, said he expects Mississippi

growers to have a good yield but nut quality could be diminished because of the late-summer drought and high temperatures.

“The crop volume-wise looks

good. Most of the varieties are in an on-year,” Draughn said, explaining that pecan trees produce in alternating years. “We’ll have a heavy crop, but quality could be hurting to some degree, especially for producers whose orchards aren’t irrigated. We had 90-degree weather all the way into October. When it’s dry and hot like that late in the season, pecans won’t progress like they should.”

Demand is strong this year with very little crop in cold storage. Most of Mississippi’s crop is sold to out-of-state and overseas buyers, including China. Although increased tariffs have prices depressed, prices are similar to last year.

“In the last two years, tariffs have increased from 7% to 47%,” said Draughn, who owns and operates Bass Pecan Company in Raymond. “We’re not getting a great price, but it’s still good. The buyers are there, and we could see demand increase

a little with few pecans in storage.”

Stafne said the tariff situation creates some challenges, but opportunity is still available for growth of the industry.

“While the U.S. is not the only producer of pecans anymore, it still produces the highest quality fruit,” said Stafne, who also is a researcher with the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station. “If China starts buying a lot of pecans again from the U.S., the outlook will be rosier. It is somewhat murky right now. However, I think the long-term outlook is good as other countries continue to discover pecans and get a taste for them.”

The average price paid by wholesale buyers in the Atlanta market for the improved Stuart variety is \$157.50 per 50-pound sack, or \$3.15 per pound, said Alba Collart, Extension agricultural economist.

Pecans – A Southerner's Healthy Snack

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### Candied Pecans

- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg white
- 1 tablespoon water
- 1 pound pecan halves

Preheat oven to 250°. Mix sugar, cinnamon, and salt together in a bowl. Whisk egg white and water together in a separate bowl until frothy. Toss pecans in the egg white mixture. Mix sugar mixture into pecan mixture until pecans are evenly coated. Spread coated pecans onto a baking sheet. Bake in the preheated oven, stirring every 15 minutes, until pecans are evenly browned, 1 hour. *Source: Allrecipes.com.*

### Honey Pecan Pie

- 4 large eggs
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 cup light corn syrup
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 unbaked pastry shell
- 3 tablespoons butter (for topping)
- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar (for topping)
- 3 tablespoons honey (for topping)
- 1-1/2 cups pecan halves (for topping)

In a large bowl, combine the eggs, pecans, corn syrup, sugars, butter, vanilla and salt. Pour into pastry shell. Bake at 350° for 30 minutes. In a small saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Stir in brown sugar and honey until combined. Stir in pecan halves until coated. Spoon over pie. Bake 15-20 minutes longer or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool completely. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

### Maple-Pecan Pork Chops

- 2 tablespoons spicy brown mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup maple syrup, divided
- 4 bone-in pork loin chops
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1/2 cup unsweetened apple juice
- 1 cup pecan halves

Mix mustard, pepper and 2 teaspoons syrup. Lightly drizzle over both sides of pork chops. In a skillet, heat butter over medium heat. Brown pork chops 2-3 minutes on each side. Add apple juice. Reduce heat; simmer, covered, for 15-20 minutes. Remove chops; let stand 5 minutes, keeping them warm. Add pecans and remaining syrup to skillet; cook and stir until blended, 1-2 minutes. Serve with pork chops. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

### Salted Pecan Shortbread Squares

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup confectioners' sugar
- 1/2 cup cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- 1 cup cold unsalted butter, cubed
- 3/4 cup unsalted butter, cubed (for filling)
- 1 1/2 cups packed brown sugar (for filling)
- 1/2 cup dark corn syrup (for filling)
- 1/2 teaspoon sea salt (for filling)
- 1/2 cup chocolate chips (for filling)
- 1/4 cup heavy whipping cream (for filling)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract (for filling)
- 4 cups chopped pecans, toasted (for filling)

Preheat oven to 350°. Line two baking pans with foil, letting ends extend up sides of pan. Place flour, confectioners' sugar, cornstarch and salt in a food processor; pulse until blended. Add butter; pulse until butter is the size of peas. Divide mixture between prepared pans; press onto bottom of pans. Bake 10-12 minutes or until light brown. Cool. For filling, melt butter in a large saucepan. Stir in brown sugar, corn syrup and salt; bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium; cook and stir until sugar is completely dissolved, about 3 minutes. Remove from heat; stir in chocolate chips, cream and vanilla until smooth. Stir in pecans. Spread over crusts. Bake 12-15 minutes or until filling is bubbly. Cool completely in pans. Using foil, lift the shortbread out of pans and cut into bars. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

### Butter Pecan Fudge

- 1 teaspoon plus 1/2 cup butter, cubed
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups sifted confectioners' sugar
- 1 cup coarsely chopped pecans, toasted

Line a square pan with foil; grease foil with 1 teaspoon butter. In a large heavy saucepan, combine remaining butter, granulated and brown sugars, cream and salt. Bring to a rapid boil over medium heat, stirring constantly. Cook, without stirring, until a candy thermometer reads 234°. Remove from heat. Add vanilla to pan (do not stir). Cool, without stirring, to 110°, about 30 minutes. Beat with a spoon until fudge just begins to thicken. Gradually stir in confectioners' sugar until smooth; add nuts and continue stirring until fudge becomes very thick and just begins to lose its sheen. Immediately spread into prepared pan. Cool. Using foil, lift fudge out of pan and cut into squares. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*





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# Commissioner Gipson Presents Mannsdale Upper Elementary with School Garden Grant

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson visited Mannsdale Upper Elementary School (MUES) in Madison to present faculty and students with a *Growing Lunch* School Garden Grant. The program was developed by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce to provide financial assistance to schools to encourage the creation or expansion of school gardens.

"The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce is proud to assist Mannsdale Upper Elementary with plans to expand and incorporate conservation practices into their outstanding school garden. I commend Principal Houghton and Coach Roman for incorporating agriculture into their curriculum in this manner," said Commissioner Gipson. "Not only are these students sharpening their academic skills and learning many life-long lessons, they are getting to see first-hand the importance of agriculture. My hope is that through this experience, these students will gain an interest in agriculture and take advantage of the many career opportunities in agriculture in their future."

MUES's expansive garden contains a chicken coop, green house, compost bins and 39 raised beds. As part of their conservation efforts, they plan to purchase 20 Olla pots to assist with irrigating the garden beds and avoid water waste. These clay pots are first buried in the ground or neck deep then filled with water to supply water to surrounding plants. The roots will grow towards and around the pot. This project is part

of MUES's cross-curriculum initiative to incorporate math, science, and conservation as part of its new Junior Master Gardener Program.

"Mannsdale Upper Elementary School is committed to 'Growing Citizens of Excellence.' As we strive to achieve this goal, we offer many different opportunities for students to prepare for the world around them. Our gardening program is one of the many opportunities we offer. This program teaches students the importance of agriculture and the many benefits of growing their own food. Mannsdale Upper's gardening curriculum incorporates principles that not only involve planting seeds but nurturing those seeds into becoming plants that produce food for our students and staff. Our program is designed to help students connect agriculture to the grocery store and to their own dinner table," said Principal Debra Houghton.

Through the *Growing Lunch* pro-

gram, eligible schools can receive a grant of up to \$500 to purchase supplies needed to develop a school garden or to further enhance an existing school garden. All schools, K-12, and pre-schools providing appropriate documentation, in the State of Mississippi are eligible to apply. This school garden grant program is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Only one grant can be awarded per school. Schools that have received a *Growing Lunch* grant from MDAC in the past are not eligible to apply for additional funds at this time.

This program is funded by the Specialty Crop Block Grant Program through the United States Department of Agriculture. # Ag Theft Investigation Leads to Recovery of Stolen Cattle in Benton County

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB), the lead agency in a cattle theft investigation, made arrests and recovered cattle stolen from two Benton County farms. The investigation was led by MALTB Investigator Alan Thompson.

"I commend the efforts of the Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau and the Union County Sheriff's Office in solving this case, and I am glad the cattle taken were recovered and returned to their rightful owners," said Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson. "For our cattle farmers and ranchers, their cattle are their livelihood. We aim to make sure modern day cattle rustlers are tracked down, arrested and prosecuted," Gipson continued.

On October 9, 2019, a Benton County cattleman contacted MALTB, the law enforcement division of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, to report a lock had been cut from his gate and an undetermined number of cattle were stolen from his pasture in the northern area of the county during the night. On October 13, 2019, at least four expensive show cows were stolen from another farm located near Hickory Flat in southern Benton County.

During the course of the investigation, agents with MALTB and Union County Sheriff Jimmy Edwards and sheriff deputies learned the identity of two suspects, which led to an arrest. The suspects were identified, arrested and charged in Benton County. Wyatt Lyn Abbott, age 23, of Myrtle, Miss., and DeJames Bolden, age 24, of Ashland, Miss., were charged with thefts on both farms.

Each suspect posted a \$20,000 bond and has been assigned a court date. Bolden is currently on parole



from the Mississippi Department of Corrections for previous charges. The investigation is ongoing to determine if additional suspects were involved in the crimes.

The suspects had no connection or association with the two victims. The cattle appeared to be randomly selected by the suspects. Three of the cows were recovered from a farm in Tennessee, and the other four were recovered from a Union County farm.

The suspects are charged with cattle theft and grand larceny, a felony in Mississippi, and if found guilty will be subject to up to ten years in the custody of Mississippi Department of Corrections and up to a \$10,000 fine. Also, restitution to the victims can be ordered.

MALTB Director, Dean Barnard, praised Investigator Thompson and local law enforcement officials for their dedication to this case. "I appreciate the relentless efforts of Investigator Thompson and the assistance of the Union County Sheriff's Office in investigating this case," said Barnard.

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau enforces state laws pertaining to the theft of cattle, horses, swine, poultry, fish, farm equipment, chemicals, timber and all other farm or agriculturerelated crimes.
