Poinsettia Choices Are Ready for Christmas

The appearance of the poinsettia means we are in the full swing of the Christmas season. Traditionally, the red poinsettia is the first choice of many holiday gardeners.

The color possibilities of poinsettias are truly remarkable. Colors range from red to white and even maroon for Bulldog fans, making it hard to choose which ones to bring home. There are bicolored, speckled and marbled poinsettias, and if that's not enough, some greenhouses are even changing colors by painting them and adding sparkles.

When shopping for poinsettias, be aware of the wide variety that is available. Take your time to select

the very best.

Now I need to point out that the colorful "flowers" that we love so much are not flowers at all. They are actually modified leaves, called bracts. Poinsettias naturally change color in the short days of winter in their native Mexico, but to get the poinsettias ready for garden centers, greenhouses trick the plants by using shade cloth to block light. As we get closer to Christmas, more color will be showing, finally becoming a sea of radiant hues.

While their leaves provide the real color, poinsettias do have true flowers: the yellow/green bead-like structures called cyathia. Your poinsettia will last longer if you select a plant with unopened or only partially open cyathia. You can carefully remove these structures for longer lasting color.

Do not overwater poinsettias, as these plants are sensitive to wet feet. Make sure the potting mix feels dry to the touch before watering. If you don't remove the decorative sleeve that covers the pot, be

sure there are drainage holes.

Contrary to widely reported information, poinsettias are not poisonous to our pets. But as with all ornamentals and houseplants, they are not meant for our animals to eat. If you want to be on the safe side, keep poinsettias out of reach

of your pets.

A more likely scenario is that poinsettias can cause a skin rash or contact dermatitis in people with sensitive skin. Contact dermatitis is caused by the plant's milky sap, which is actually closely related to latex. Always wash your hands after

handling your poinsettia.

While we enjoy poinsettias during the holidays, many don't know some of the history of this beautiful plant. The Aztecs in Mexico and Central America cultivated this plant to produce dyes and a fever medication. In the 1820s, John Poinsett, the ambassador to Mexico and a hobby botanist, saw these native plants with their brilliant red "flowers" naturally blooming during the Christmas season.

In Mexico, poinsettias are known as Flores de la Noche Buena, or Flowers of the Holy Night, because of their bloom period. Poinsett sent some cuttings home, and these became the Christmas poinsettias we now enjoy. Poinsett died on December 12; this day is now celebrated as National Poinsettia Day in honor of his discovery and its importance to the Christmas holidays.

Old-Fashioned Holiday Glazed Ham

- 1 spiral-sliced half ham
- 1 can pineapple slices, juice reserved
- 15-20 whole cloves (optional)
- 1 small jar maraschino cherries
- 3/4 cup packed light brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons yellow mustard

Follow instructions on package for baking the ham. Remove ham from oven 30 minutes before end of the warming time. Decoratively arrange the pineapple slices on top of the ham, securing them with whole cloves, if using, or toothpicks. Place a cherry in the center of each pineapple ring and secure with a clove or toothpick. In a small bowl, combine the brown sugar, mustard and just enough of the reserved pineapple juice to make a thick glaze. Spoon the glaze over the ham and bake for the remaining 30 minutes. Remove the ham from the oven, carve and serve. Source: *FoodNetwork.com*.

Cheesy Twice-Baked Potatoes

- Baked Potatoes
- 1/2 cup sour cream or plain yogurt
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic salt
- 1/8 teaspoon black pepper
- Milk (optional)
- 3/4 cup finely shredded cheddar cheese

Bake potatoes and let stand about 10 minutes. Cut a lengthwise slice off the top of each baked potato; discard skin from slices and place pulp in a bowl. Scoop out potato pulp; add to the bowl. Mash the potato pulp with a potato masher or an electric mixer. Add sour cream, garlic salt, and pepper; beat until smooth. If necessary, stir in 1-2 tablespoons milk to reach desired consistency. Season with salt and black pepper. Stir in 1/2 cup of the cheddar cheese. Spoon the mashed potato mixture into the potato shells. Place in a baking dish. Bake, uncovered, at 425° for 20-25 minutes or until light brown. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake for 2-3 minutes more or until cheese melts. Source: *BHG.com*.

Sausage Balls

- 1 (1-pound) package ground sausage
- 3 cups baking mix
- 4 cups grated sharp Cheddar
- 1/8 tablespoon pepper

Spray a baking sheet with vegetable oil cooking spray. Combine all ingredients in a large bowl. Mix well with your fingers. The mixture will be very crumbly. Form into 1-inch balls, squeezing the mixture so it holds together, then rolling it between the palms of your hands to form balls. Place the balls on the baking sheet. Bake at 375° for 18-20 minutes or until golden brown. Source: *FoodNetwork.com*.

Eggnog Snickerdoodle Cookies

- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1 3/4 cups sugar, divided
- 2 eggs
- 2-3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons cream of tartar
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons ground nutmeg

In a large bowl, cream the butter, shortening and 1 1/2 cups sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs. Combine the flour, cream of tartar, baking soda and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. In a shallow bowl, combine the nutmeg and remaining sugar. Roll dough into balls; roll in sugar mixture. Place 2 inches apart on ungreased baking sheets. Bake at 400° for 10-12 minutes or until lightly browned. Source: *TasteofHome.com*.

Candy-Cane Sugar Cookies

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1 cup sifted confectioners' sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 1/2 teaspoons almond extract
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 1/2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon red food coloring

Mix the shortening and butter, sugar, egg, almond and vanilla. In a separate bowl, mix flour and salt and add to shortening mixture. Divide dough in half. Blend red food coloring into one half. Roll 1 teaspoon of the red dough and 1 teaspoon of the white dough on lightly floured board into 4-inch strips. Place strips side by side and press lightly together and twist like a rope. Curve top of rope down to look like the handle of a candy cane. Bake at 350° for 9 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove while still warm. Sprinkle with 1/2 cup crushed peppermint stick candy and 1/2 cup sugar (optional). Source: *Allrecipes.com*.

White Chocolate Fudge

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 4 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 12 ounces white baking chocolate
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans

In a bowl, beat cream cheese, sugar and vanilla until smooth. In a double boiler, melt chocolate. Fold into cream cheese mixture with pecans. Spread into a greased 8-inch square pan. Chill until serving. Cut into squares. Source: *TasteofHome.com*.





Rural Mississippi is More Valuable Than Ever

Hunting, fishing, wildlife watching, enjoying nature and other outdoor activities put dollars in Mississippi's coffers. In fact, wildlife-related recreation generates economic impact of about \$2.9 million per year in the state.

A portion of the money spent on wildlife-related recreation ends up in small, rural Mississippi communities that would not see these expenditures otherwise.

To enjoy wildlife-related recreation, you need access to public or private land or water. Oftentimes, individuals will buy land for hunting, fishing or just to build a house on their own piece of "the great outdoors" in Mississippi. This trend has influenced the value of rural lands, particularly properties with ponds to fish, beautiful sites to build homes, and productive habitats for game and nongame wildlife species.

MSU scientists conducted a survey with representatives of the Federal Land Bank of Mississippi and Mossy Oak Properties. The researchers found that individuals purchased property in Mississippi specifically for wildlife-related recreation. In fact, one-third of the dollar value of rural lands (or \$634 per acre, on average) was due to outdoor recreational potential, as reported on 800 Mississippi properties in our survey.

Most of the properties were forested with a mixture of stands that included bottomland hardwood trees, mixed pine-hardwood forests, upland hardwood forests and pine stands. Tracts also included agricultural lands predominately in row crops, as well as lands that were fallow, comprised of roads or contained supplemental plantings for wildlife.

Based on the survey, buyers look for specific attributes when purchasing recreational properties.

For example, forests with hardwood trees provide excellent habitats for a diversity of wildlife species, both game and nongame. Forested tracts provide excellent cover and produce food as hard mast, such as oak acorns or hickory nuts. Hunters value these land types because of the prevalence of game species, such as white-tailed deer and wild turkey.

Additionally, some amenities increased land sales prices, particularly roads and cabins. Only about 14% of properties sold for wildlife recreation had been leased for hunting in the past. However, these tracts leased for \$21 per acre as compared to \$12 per acre, on average, for Sixteenth Section lands across Mississippi.

The higher value for leases on these study tracts was due to the prominence of mature hardwood forests, habitat management practices conducted for wildlife and amenities present on the land. Land-

owners who own similar lands in Mississippi more often can lease or sell these properties for significantly higher values.

So, here is the take-home message: Quality private lands that are mostly forested with a mix of open spaces and pastures that support diverse wildlife and ponds for fishing are often golden for wildlife-related recreation. Keep this in mind if you're considering selling your land or purchasing property.

I foresee that having your own piece of rural Mississippi will only become more valuable in the future. I'm often reminded of a quote by Gerald O'Hara in speaking to his daughter Katie Scarlett in the movie "Gone With The Wind" about his love for Tara: "Why, land is the only thing in the world worth workin' for because it's the only thing that lasts."

It is hard to argue with such wisdom.

USDA Announces Funding to Control Feral Swine in Mississippi

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced on November 21, 2019, it is awarding \$1.5 million to fund a pilot project to control feral swine in Mississippi and nine other states across the country.

These projects are part of the Feral Swine Eradication and Control Pilot Program (FSCP) – a joint effort between USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) to help address the threat that feral swine pose to agriculture, ecosystems and human and animal health.

"Feral swine cause significant damage to crop and grazing lands, while also impacting the health of our natural resources," said NRCS State Conservationist Kurt Readus. "By collaborating with our partners nationally and here in Mississippi our hope is to control and eradicate this invasive species – improving operations for farmers while also protecting our natural resources for the future."

NRCS and APHIS are working with Delta Wildlife, Inc., on one pilot project in Mississippi to deliver NRCS funded assistance to producers for eradication and control activities. Collaboration in the pilot area will provide outreach, training opportunities, trap distribution, monitoring and evaluation. Activities will also allow efforts to focus on their eradication and control of feral swine by educating landowners and providing tools/equipment that can be used after the project



has ended.

NRCS, APHIS, and the Mississippi State Technical Agriculture Committee worked together to define the critical areas to be considered for projects within the state. The Mississippi pilot project runs from 2020 to 2022. Participating counties will consist of Issaquena, Sharkey, Warren, and Yazoo.

NRCS is awarding more than \$16.7 million this year for feral swine pilot projects in select areas of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, and Texas. The funding limit for a single award is \$1.5 million. Awardees are required to provide at least 25 percent of the partnership agreement budget as a match to NRCS funding. APHIS is providing \$23.3 million this year to the Wildlife Services programs located in the pilot project states.

The 2018 Farm Bill provides \$75 million for the Feral Swine Eradication and Control Pilot Program. These funds are for the life of the farm bill and divided evenly between NRCS and APHIS.

Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force Holds Final Meeting

The Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force convened at the State Capitol on November 20, 2019, for its final scheduled meeting. Members of the Task Force discussed and approved its final report, which will be submitted to the Mississippi Legislature on December 2, 2019.

The Task Force, chaired by Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson, was established by the Mississippi Legislature to consider the potential of hemp cultivation, market poten-

tial and potential job creation in Mississippi.

"The Task Force has developed a fact-based, balanced report that examines all of the issues surrounding the cultivation of hemp in Mississippi. The report presents findings that indicate both the positive potential as well as the significant risks of hemp cultivation," said Commissioner Gipson.

"We have been transparent through this process, and I feel that we are providing the members of the Legislature with the necessary information they can use to craft meaningful hemp pol-

icies in the future."

The meeting was available for viewing through livestreaming on the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce's Facebook page.
