Farmers Markets are Essential During COVID-19

Mississippi enjoys many active farmers markets across its five regions. Although a number of these markets remain open year-round, most launch the new season in the spring and run through the summer, with some of the markets continuing into the fall.

Late winter and early spring, typically a time of anticipation of and eagerness for the fresh, locally grown fruits and vegetables that begin appearing at farmers markets across the state, instead became a period of dampened spirits – literally. Endless rain caused widespread flooding

throughout the state which not only threatened the harvesting of earlier crops, it delayed the planting of new ones putting the entire season at risk.

While Mississippi began drying out, the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) had arrived, already moving across the globe creating a pandemic. Mississippi, along with every other state in the nation eventually became infected with the virus. Many of the country's city and state governments instituted guidelines for staying safe and well by self-isolating, sheltering-in-place and practicing social distancing, working from home if possible, home schooling, and going out only for essential needs.

At the outset some of the businesses regarded as essential included grocery stores, pharmacies, banks, gas stations, mail and delivery stores to name just a few, but initially not farmers markets. To date nationally, not every state has deemed farmers markets as essential, however, on March 24, 2020, Mississippi Governor Tate Reeves signed Mississippi Executive Order 1463 which considers agriculture, farms and farmers markets as an "essential business or operation."

Andy Gipson, Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) urges everyone to safely support local communities and farmers markets as the coronavirus outbreak continues. "The good news during the COVID-19 emergency is that our food supply is plentiful, and our food supply chain remains operational. You can thank a farmer for that. So, while it is taking longer than normal for some grocery stores to get their shelves re-stocked, there are plenty of farmers willing to sell direct to consumers," said Commissioner Gipson. Adding "Mississippians who don't already routinely buy di-



rect farm-to-table meat and produce might want to give locally-grown and raised products a try."

Farmers markets are very adaptable. Open-air markets can easily allow for social distancing and flexibility to accommodate best practices. Those markets occupying a building or structure can do the same by being innovative. For instance, the Mississippi Farmers Market, a facility of 18,000 square feet located in Jackson and run by MDAC has crafted a modified setup for its market days. It is sort of an inside-out format which accommodates both vendors and shoppers as they practice social distancing while enjoying a more outdoor feel.

At the Mississippi Farmers Market all vendors are still inside but are set up so they are facing the outside of

the building. This allows customers to shop around the perimeter of the building without having to come inside very far. Most, if not all vendors extend their stalls by setting up small open-air tents to shield shoppers from the elements and to easily allow social distancing.

Additionally, management at the Mississippi Farmers Market, following CDC recommendations has established certain precautions to keep vendors and customers safe. Vendors wear gloves and facemasks, many pre-bag much of the produce and handle products for the customers. Customers can also place orders in advance from many of the growers, bakers and canners who will then have it ready for pickup upon their arrival.

The Farmer's Table located inside

of the market offers only to-go meals or curbside pickup. And because the inside of the market is pretty much unoccupied the restrooms can be utilized safely and hygienically.

Currently there are more than 8,600 farmers markets recognized across the nation. Mississippi is proud to be home to approximately 100 of that total. Big or small, new or long established, housed inside a structure or set up outside, Mississippians embrace their local farmers markets. Why not add them to your list of favorite and essential places to shop.

USDA Announces Direct Payments to Farmers in Response to COVID-19

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Department of Agriculture is providing direct payments to farmers and ranchers through the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP). CFAP will provide up to \$16 billion in direct payments to producers impacted by COVID-19. The application process for payments will begin on May 26. Applications must be submitted through local Farm Service Agency (FSA) offices. To apply for CFAP, producers must schedule an appointment with their FSA office by phone.

In general, to be eligible for a payment, a producer must have suffered a 5-percent-or-greater price loss over a specified time resulting from the COVID-19 outbreak or face additional significant marketing costs for inventories. Additionally, producers will have to certify that they meet the Adjusted Gross Income limitation of \$900,000 unless at least 75 percent or more of their income is derived from farming, ranching, or forestry-related activities. Producers must also be in compliance with Highly Erodible Land and Wetland Conservation provisions. There is a payment limitation of \$250,000 per person or entity for all commodities combined. Applicants who are corporations, limited liability companies, or limited partnerships may qualify for additional payment lim-

its where members actively provide personal labor or personal management for the farming operation.

To ensure the availability of funding throughout the application period, producers will receive 80 percent of their maximum total payment upon approval of the application. The remaining portion of the payment, not to exceed the payment limit, will be paid at a later date as funds remain available. For more information regarding CFAP, visit www.farmers.gov/cfap.

Non-Specialty Crops

Malting barley; canola; corn; upland cotton; millet; oats; sorghum; soybeans; sunflowers; durum wheat; hard red spring wheat.

Producers will be paid based on inventory subject to price risk held as of January 15, 2020. A payment will be made based 50 percent of a producer's 2019 total production or the 2019 inventory as of January 15, 2020, whichever is smaller, multiplied by the commodity's applicable payment rates.

Specialty Crops

Almonds; apples; artichokes; asparagus; avocados; beans; blueberries; broccoli; cabbage; cantaloupe; carrots; cauliflower; celery; corn, sweet; cucumbers, eggplant; garlic; grapefruit; kiwifruit; lemons; lettuce, iceberg; lettuce, romaine; mushrooms; onions, dry; onions, green; oranges; papayas;

peaches; pears; pecans; peppers, bell type; peppers, other; potatoes; raspberries; rhubarb; spinach; squash; strawberries; sweet potatoes; tangerines; taro; tomatoes; walnuts; watermelons.

For eligible specialty crops, the total payment will be based on the volume of production sold between January 15 and April 15, 2020; the volume of production shipped, but unpaid; and the number of acres for which harvested production did not leave the farm or mature product destroyed or not harvested during that same time period, and which have not and will not be sold.

Livestock

Slaughter cattle—mature cattle; slaughter cattle—fed cattle; feeder cattle less than 600 pounds; feeder cattle 600 pounds or more; dairy; pigs and hogs; lambs, yearlings and wool.

For cattle, lambs, yearlings and hogs, the total payment will be calculated using the sum of the producer's number of livestock sold between January 15 and April 15, 2020, multiplied by the payment rates per head, and the highest inventory number of livestock between April 16 and May 14, 2020, multiplied by the payment rate per head.

For dairy, the total payment will be calculated based on a producer's

certification of milk production for the first quarter of calendar year 2020 multiplied by a national price decline during the same quarter. The second part of the payment is based a national adjustment to each producer's production in the first quarter.

For wool, producers will be paid based on inventory subject to price risk held as of January 15, 2020. A payment will be made based 50 percent of a producer's 2019 total production or the 2019 inventory as of January 15, 2020, whichever is smaller, multiplied by the commodity's applicable payment rates.

Southern-Style Collard Greens

12 hickory-smoked bacon slices, finely chopped
2 sweet onions, finely chopped
3/4 pound smoked ham, chopped
6 garlic cloves, finely chopped
3 containers chicken broth
3 packages fresh collard greens, washed and trimmed
1/3 cup apple cider vinegar
1 tablespoon sugar
1 teaspoon salt
3/4 teaspoon pepper

Cook bacon over medium heat in stockpot for 10-12 minutes or until almost crisp. Add onion to stockpot, and sauté 8 minutes. Add garlic and ham, and sauté 1 minute. Stir in broth, collard greens, apple cider vinegar, sugar, salt and pepper. Cook 2 hours or until desired degree of tenderness. *Source: SouthernLiving.com.*

Creamy Corn Casserole

1/2 cup butter, melted
2 eggs, beaten
1 package dry corn bread mix
1 can whole kernel corn, drained
1 can creamed corn
1 cup sour cream

Lightly grease a baking dish. In a medium bowl, com-

bine butter, eggs, corn bread mix, whole and creamed corn and sour cream. Spoon mixture into prepared dish. Bake at 350° for 45 minutes, or until the top is golden brown. *Source: AllRecipes.com.*

Summer Squash Frittata

3 tablespoons butter
2 small zucchini, chopped into cubes
2 small summer squash, chopped into cubes
1 small onion, coarsely chopped
12 eggs, lightly beaten
1/2 cup sour cream
1 teaspoon salt
3/4 teaspoon ground pepper

Melt 3 tablespoons butter in a skillet over medium-high heat; add chopped zucchini, squash, and onion, and sauté 12-14 minutes or until onion is tender. Remove skillet from heat. Whisk together eggs and next 3 ingredients until well blended. Pour over vegetable mixture in skillet. Bake at 350° for 33-35 minutes or until edges are lightly browned and center is set. *Source: MyRecipes.com.*

Oven-Fried Okra

1 quart fresh okra, sliced 1/4 - 1/2 -inch thick
1 cup cornmeal
Butter-flavored nonstick cooking spray
Salt and pepper, to taste

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a large bowl, sprinkle okra with cornmeal, tossing to coat. Spread on a baking sheet that has been coated with nonstick spray. Lightly coat okra with nonstick spray, and season with salt and pepper. Bake for 45-50 minutes, stirring occasionally, until golden brown. *Source: farmflavor.com.*

Roasted Eggplant Spread

1 (1-pound) eggplant, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch-thick slices
Olive oil-flavored cooking spray
1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, divided
1/2 cup plain low-fat yogurt
1 garlic clove, crushed
1 tablespoon tahini (sesame-seed paste)
2 teaspoons lemon juice
1/2 teaspoon hot sauce

Preheat oven to 400°. Place eggplant slices on a baking sheet coated with cooking spray. Coat both sides of eggplant with cooking spray, and sprinkle evenly with 1/4 teaspoon salt. Bake at 400° for 20 minutes or until browned, turning once. Place cooked slices on a cutting board, and let stand until cool. Finely dice eggplant, and place in a medium bowl. Stir in remaining 1/4 teaspoon salt, yogurt, and remaining ingredients. Serve immediately, or cover and chill until ready to serve. Bring to room temperature before serving. *Source: myrecipes.com.*

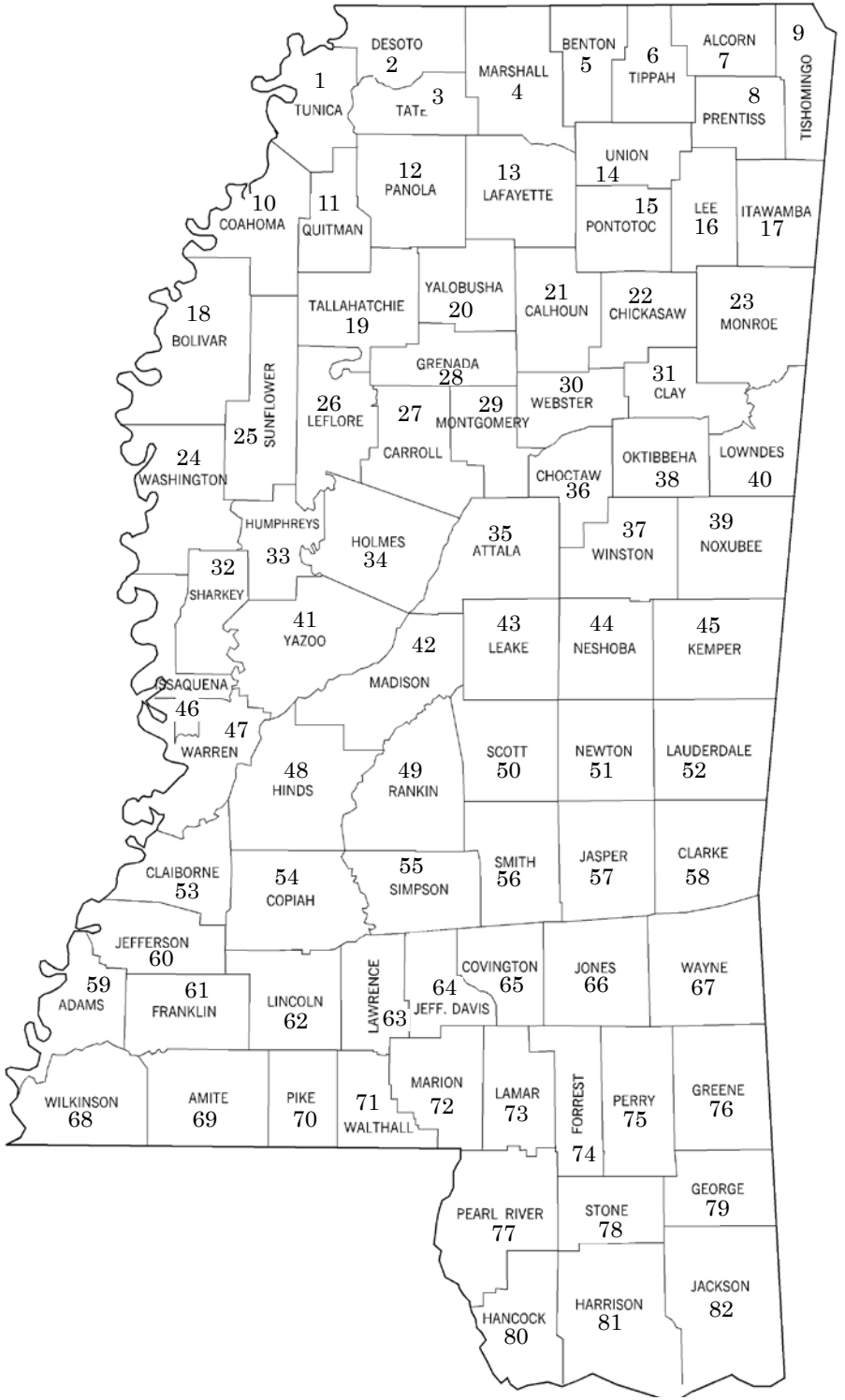

The Mississippi Small Farm and Agribusiness Center (MSFAC), an entity of Alcorn State University's School of Agriculture and Applied Sciences, is currently recruiting new applicants for its Farm Management Educational Program (FMEP). The goal of the program, which is in its second year of implementation, is to recruit, train, and provide 300 New/Beginning Farmers and Ranch-

ers (NBFRs) with the necessary resources to generate and implement a feasible farm plan, thereby equipping them to become sustainable in vegetable and meat goat production.

The FMEP provides educational training and hands-on demonstration in basic crop and livestock production; as well as assists NBFRs in developing and implementing a viable farm plan. 

Commissioner Gipson Accepts Donation of 100,000 Medical Face Masks from Taiwan

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Andy Gipson accepted a donation of medical face masks from Taiwan on behalf of the State of Mississippi. Director General Peter Chen of the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Houston, Texas, presented Commissioner Gipson with a box of medical face masks to represent the 100,000 masks that Taiwan has donated to the state to defend against COVID-19. The donated masks have been delivered to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) and are currently in the supply chain. Taiwan is sending an additional 10,000 N95 masks. Mississippi is one of the first states to receive the additional contribution of N95 masks from Taiwan.

"On behalf of the State Mississippi, I want to thank Taiwan for its generosity in providing 100,000 face masks so that our citizens and frontline workers have increased access to PPE to help protect against COVID-19. During this time, we continue to hear stories of how neighbors are helping neighbors. The State of Mississippi appreciates our 'neighbors' across the globe," said Commissioner Gipson. "We are grateful for the masks as well as information on Taiwan's response to COVID-19."

Commissioner Gipson spoke of the mutually beneficial relationship between Mississippi and Taiwan. For the past year, the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce has collaborated with the Mississippi Development
