SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans Available in Mississippi Following Secretary of Agriculture Disaster Declaration

The U.S. Small Business Administration announced on Friday, November 13, 2020, that Economic Injury Disaster Loans are available to small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and private nonprofit organizations in Jackson, George, Harrison and Stone counties in Mississippi as a result of high winds, excessive rainfall and Hurricane Sally on September 15-17, 2020.

"When the Secretary of Agriculture issues a disaster declaration to help farmers recover from damages and losses to crops, the Small Business Administration issues a declaration to eligible entities, affected by the same disaster," said Michael

Lampton, acting director of SBA's Field Operations Center East.

Under this declaration, the SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loan program is available to eligible farm-related and nonfarm-related entities that suffered financial losses as a direct result of this disaster. Except for aquaculture enterprises, SBA cannot provide disaster loans to agricultural producers, farmers and ranchers. Nurseries are eligible to apply for economic injury disaster loans for losses caused by drought conditions.

The loan amount can be up to \$2 million with interest rates of 3 percent for small businesses and 2.75 percent for private nonprofit organizations of all sizes, with terms up to 30 years. The SBA determines eligibility based on the size of the applicant, type of activity and its financial resources. Loan amounts and terms

are set by the SBA and are based on each applicant's financial condition. These working capital loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable, and other bills that could have been paid had the disaster not occurred. The loans are not intended to replace lost sales or profits.

Applicants may apply online using the Electronic Loan Application (ELA) via SBA's secure website at DisasterLoan.sba.gov and should apply under SBA declaration # 16778, not for the COVID-19 incident.

Disaster loan information and application forms may also be obtained by calling the SBA's Customer Service Center at 800-659-2955 (800-877-8339 for the deaf and hard-of-hearing) or by sending an email to DisasterCustomerService@sba.gov. Loan applications can be download-

Tree Trimming Treats

Peppermint Hot Chocolate

- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 6 ounces bittersweet chocolate, chopped
- 3 drops peppermint oil
- Sweetened whipped cream & chocolate shavings (for garnish)

In a saucepan, combine the cream, milk, sugar, and salt and heat over medium-low heat. When the cream mixture just begins to steam, add the chopped chocolate, and stir, until melted. Stir in the peppermint oil. Divide the hot chocolate among mugs and top with whipped cream and chocolate shavings. *Source: FoodNetwork.com.*

Elf Biscuits

- 1 5 1/3-ounce package graham crackers (1 sleeve)
- 3/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cup chopped pecans or almonds

Arrange eleven whole graham crackers on an ungreased 15x10-inch jellyroll pan. Bring butter, sugar, and pecans to a boil in a medium saucepan; boil 2 minutes. Pour mixture on crackers, spreading

quickly to cover. Bake at 300° for 12 minutes. Remove crackers to wax paper to cool. Cut with knife along perforations. *Source: Southern Living.*

Cranberry Crisps

- 1 cup butter flavored shortening
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 1/2 cups old-fashioned oats
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 1/3 cups dried cranberries
- 1 cup coarsely chopped walnuts

In a large bowl, cream shortening and sugars until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in vanilla. Combine the oats, flour, baking soda, cinnamon, salt and baking powder; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Stir in the cranberries and walnuts. Drop by tablespoonful's two inches apart onto lightly greased baking sheets. Bake at 350° for 12-14 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove to wire racks to cool. Yield: 5 dozen. *Source: TasteofHome.com.*

Holiday Candy Popcorn

- 8 cups air-popped popcorn
- 1 cup water
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 cup white corn syrup
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup dried cranberries
- 3/4 cup white chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup pistachios, shelled and roasted

Place popcorn in a large mixing bowl. Combine the water, sugar, corn syrup and butter in a heavy saucepan. Cook over moderate heat to 280 degrees (measure with a candy thermometer). Remove from heat and add the vanilla. Stir well and pour over the popped corn. Coat completely. Add the cranberries, chocolate chips and pistachios. Toss again. Cool completely. Break into pieces and store in an airtight container. *Source: FarmFlavor.com.*





Growing Wood and Wildlife

Many Mississippians share a close kinship with the forest. From the oak flats of the Delta to the Piney Woods of the coastal plain, few would deny a childhood spent in "the woods" is a precious birthright of rural living. More than 60% of Mississippi's land base is forested with 77% the forested acres maintained in private, non-industrial ownership. Forestland is important to Mississippi's economy as well, sustaining a \$12.8 billion industry, impacting thousands of workers and landowners. But of course, a forest is more than fiber and straw.

Indeed, for a growing number of landowners outdoor recreation, including hunting, fishing, and wildlife watching, drives a great deal of their decision making when it comes to land management. Forest stewards committed to balancing profitable forestry and productive habitat for a variety for fish and wildlife species may find the challenge daunting, but the rewards can last for generations to come.

Although Mississippi is home to a variety of forest types, the most common wood-production model throughout most of the state is the management of Southern yellow pine in plantations. The forest landowner's first opportunity to interject positive habitat components in a pine plantation occurs before the first tree is planted. Landowners, especially those interested in wild turkey management, may wish to retain portions of existing hardwood stands prior to clearcutting and establishment of a new forest.

When planning a new plantation with habitat in mind, consider leaving openings for potential trails, fire breaks, and food plantings as well as unplanted areas to manage for grassy, weedy cover between future timber harvests. Finally, consider the species and planting density of

the new forest. Some sites may be better suited to pine species, like longleaf or shortleaf, that offer different habitat management opportunities than the standard loblolly pine plantation.

It is an unavoidable fact that there are periods during the progression of a pine plantation, particularly when young trees are very dense, when habitat for many species of wildlife is limited. However, landowners have a great opportunity to balance timber production and habitat once the plantation grows to a point when the young trees are merchantable. Thinning, the removal of lesser quality or competing trees to promote growing stock, can improve wood production in much the same way weeding a garden improves vegetable production.

Build a team of professionals, such as a Registered Forester, Wildlife Biologist, or other natural resource specialists, to discuss tradeoffs in wood density and wildlife habitat. In general, removing more trees opens the forest canopy, which results in increased sunlight reaching the forest floor and improves habitat for many species of wildlife.

Of course, retaining fewer trees in a stand means less wood production later when timber reaches a potentially more valuable product class. Management practices including prescribed burning, selective herbicide applications, and mechanical brush control, may also be used to improve wildlife habitat on tree farms.

The Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks (MDWFP) provides free, on-site help to landowners with wildlife management objectives.
