## Celebrate National Catfish Month!

August is National Catfish Month, as it has been each year since 1984, when President Reagan declared it as such. With the vast majority of the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish industry centered across the deep south states of Mississippi, Alabama, and Arkansas, there is plenty of reason to celebrate.

The Catfish Institute (TCI), the Jackson-based marketing arm of the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish industry, works throughout the year to promote

the good work of the farmers it represents and the impact they have on local economy.

"The catfish industry is unique among agriculture industries with respect to its economic impact," said Roger Barlow, TCI president and executive vice-president of Catfish Farmers of America.

"Every element of our industry has an economic return that benefits the areas where the fish are grown, as well as the entire region," Barlow continued. "The fingerlings are hatched locally; the feed is produced and fed locally; they are processed and packaged locally; and they are sold locally to family-owned restaurants and grocery stores, as well as shipped to large markets across the country. "Each year, farmers from these three main producing states are asked to select from their membership a deserving producer to be named as their state's Catfish Farmer of the Year," said Barlow. "This honor is a great opportunity to give leading producers national

recognition for their contributions to our industry, and we are proud to feature these outstanding American farmers in our annual lineup of industry promotions."

The 2020-2021 Catfish Farmers of the Year are Will Nobile of Moorhead, Miss.; Luke Smelley, of Greensboro, Ala.; and Terry Kruse of Paragould, Ark.

"These farmers are chosen from a large field of many deserving catfish growers in the industry," said Jeremy Robbins, TCI vice president. "Although it is difficult to select just one farmer from each of these states, those who are selected embody the true, selfless spirit of the American Farmer."

"All of the Catfish Farmers of the Year have made significant contributions to the U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish Industry," said Barlow. "Congratulations to each of them."

The Catfish Farmers of the Year are used by The Catfish Institute in various promotional campaigns throughout the year, including on social media, television, radio, outdoor billboards, magazine advertisements, events such as Boston's Seafood Expo North America; special features during National Catfish Month; and in their very own brochure to highlight each farmer's favorite catfish recipe.

# Commissioner's Policy Corner

## *MDAC Accepting Wild Hog Control Program Applications*



The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) will begin accepting the next round of online applications for its Wild Hog Control Program (WHCP) on July 26, 2021. The application period will close on August 9, 2021. Through the WHCP, MDAC provides "smart" wild hog traps to landowners and managers for the control of wild hogs on private agricultural and forestry lands in Mississippi. MDAC also provides the training necessary to use the "smart" traps and technical guidance regarding the most effective methods to trap and control wild hogs on private lands. ## *Mississippi Black Vulture Depredation Program*

The Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation has a statewide depredation permit that allows for a limited number of black vulture "takes" where black vultures are depredating on livestock. Livestock producers who are experiencing depredation may apply for a Livestock Protection Depredation Sub-Permit that, if approved, will allow producers to protect livestock against black vulture attacks. This program allows for "takes" of black vultures or incidental "takes" of turkey vultures only. Federal regulations for the taking of migratory birds must be followed. No other protected migratory bird species is authorized to be taken under this program.

The Public Policy Department manages the statewide depredation permit and sub-permit program. All applications and reports will be made directly to the Public Policy Department. Because of the limited number of "takes" MFBF is issued, a maximum of three "takes" will be issued to an approved applicant. Interested livestock producers may fill out the sub-permit application below and return it to the Public Policy Department for



consideration. To be considered, applicants must do the following:

ALL applications must be fully completed, signed and dated with the applicant agreeing to the terms and conditions of the original statewide depredation permit.

ALL approved applicants are required to report the date and number of birds killed under their approved sub-permit by the end of the calendar year. Applicants are not allowed to kill any birds in excess of the number approved in the sub-permit, or of any other migratory bird species. Livestock producers may apply to amend their original sub-permit to include additional "takings," but must first receive official approval before "taking"

additional black vultures. The sub-permit contains an area at the bottom of the page to record approved "takings" of black vultures.

Any livestock producer experiencing severe depredation from black vultures is encouraged to apply for an individual migratory bird depredation permit from U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and/or work with USDA APHIS Wildlife Services to address their specific situation. Producers cannot be issued a depredation permit by USFWS and apply for and be approved for a MFBF depredation sub-permit. MFBF will assist livestock producers experiencing severe depredation in applying, and receiving approval for a USFWS migratory bird

depredation permit.

The Migratory Bird Depredation Permit is a federal permit, and all livestock producers applying for and receiving approval of a MFBF Livestock Protection Depredation Sub-Permit will be required to follow ALL USFWS Migratory Bird Depredation Permit rules and regulations. Failure to do so could result in federal citations and fines.

## Southern-Style Catfish Menu Ideas

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### Catfish and Biscuits

- 2 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish Fillets
- 1 1/2 tablespoons Cajun seasoning
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/2 red onion, finely diced
- 1/2 cup celery, thinly sliced
- 1/2 red bell pepper, finely diced
- 1/2 green bell pepper, finely diced
- 4 large button mushrooms, sliced
- 1 large garlic clove, minced
- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 8 biscuits, cooked as directed

Sprinkle catfish with Cajun seasoning. Place large skillet over medium high heat. Add butter and olive oil. When butter is melted and hot, add catfish. Cook four minutes, turn and cook another four minutes. Remove from skillet and set aside. Add onion, celery, bell peppers and mushrooms to skillet; cook four minutes. Add garlic; cook two more minutes. Add heavy cream, stirring to combine. Cook four minutes or until cream mixture has reduced by half. Season with hot sauce, salt and pepper. Split biscuits and place on serving plate. Cut fillets in half; place one half on each split biscuit and spoon sauce over each. Serves 4 (2 catfish biscuits per serving).

### Classic Catfish Chowder

- 4 U.S. Farm-Raised catfish fillets, cut into bite-size pieces
- 6 slices thick-cut bacon
- 3 cups yellow onion, diced
- 1 1/2 cups celery diced
- 3/4 cup flour
- 2 tablespoons Old Bay® seasoning
- 6 cups chicken stock
- 2 large baking potatoes, cut into bite-size pieces, boiled, and drained
- 1 15-ounce can whole kernel sweet corn, drained
- 1/4 cup fresh parsley, finely chopped
- 1 cup thinly sliced green onion, divided
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1/2 teaspoon hot sauce
- Salt and pepper to taste

In large stock pot over medium high heat, cook bacon until nicely browned. Remove bacon strips and set aside. Add onion and celery to pot, cook 5 minutes. In a small bowl, combine flour and Old Bay seasoning. Sprinkle flour mixture evenly over onion and celery, stirring to absorb all oil. Cook 3 more minutes. Add chicken stock; stir to combine vegetables. Stir in potatoes, corn, parsley and 3/4 cup of green onions; cook 5 minutes. Add the catfish; cook for 5 more minutes or until catfish is cooked through. Mix in cream, hot sauce, and salt and pepper to taste. Garnish with remaining green onions and diced bacon pieces. Serve with crusty bread. *Source: The Catfish Institute.*

### Classic Catfish Po'boy with Homemade Slaw

- 2 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish Fillets
- 4 ounces fish breading
- 2 tablespoons Cajun seasoning
- 1 to 1 1/2 cups frying oil
- 2 6-inch French rolls
- 1 ripe tomato, sliced
- 1 pound slaw mix
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1/4 cup cider vinegar
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons Creole mustard
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Hot sauce to taste

To make slaw, combine the last 7 ingredients and season to taste; cover and refrigerate. In a shallow dish, mix breading and seasoning. Coat fillets in mixture, shaking off any excess breading. Heat oil in large skillet over medium-high heat. Add fillets; cook until golden brown, approximately 4 minutes. Turn once, remove catfish, and let drain on paper towels. Split French rolls and spoon in slaw mix, place fried catfish on top of the slaw, and add sliced tomatoes. *Source: The Catfish Institute.*



# Labor Shortages Limit Catfish Supplies, Raise Prices

Many Mississippi restaurants that serve catfish have had to pay their distributors more to keep the popular Southern dish on the menu this year or go without, but pond inventory is not the primary issue.

Instead, labor shortages at processing plants are more to blame, said Jimmy Avery, Extension aquaculture professor at the Mississippi State University Delta Research and Extension Center in Stoneville. Industry data, he said, show processing is down 9% for the first five months of 2021 when compared to the same period in 2020.

"I think labor shortage is the big driver in this number. Although there is some talk about tight fish supply, there are no numbers to support it," Avery said. "When supply gets tight either due to low pond inventories or processing shortages, processors shift available product types and volume to long-time customers with high volume and price."

May fish prices for premium sized fish to farmers was \$1.25 per pound, according to the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce -- 9 cents more than the annual average of \$1.16 in 2020 and 4 cents more than the 2016 average.

MSU aquacultural economist Ganesh Kumar said the slow recovery in the industry's processing phase can be attributed to several factors related to COVID-19. These include limits on how many people could work during the same shift while maintaining social distancing, as well as processors finding enough workers willing to work for pay comparable to stimulus checks and unemployment benefits. Still, he said he is optimistic about the industry's prospects as it shakes off the pandemic's effects.

"A lot of us are surprised by how quickly the catfish industry came back," he said. "The restaurant clos-

ings last year were a problem, but a lot of product usually sent to the restaurants in large bags were repackaged, refurbished and made available to other retailers."

Even though production was hampered in 2020 due to the pandemic, Mississippi produced 317 million pounds of catfish, which was only 0.6% lower than the 2016 production.

"Our lowest production in several decades was 300 million pounds in 2012," Avery said. "In 2018, domestic production rose to 341 million, an increase of 12%."

2016 was the year U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) took over inspection of imported catfish. Under FSIS oversight, 100% of catfish is inspected, and FSIS requires foreign countries to demonstrate that their inspection systems are at least equivalent to the U.S. inspection system.

According to a USDA quantitative risk assessment on the public health outcomes associated with chemical

hazards in aquaculture, applying the FSIS program to catfish yielded a reduction of approximately 175,000 lifetime cancers, as well as 95 million exposures to antimicrobials and 23.7 million exposures to heavy metal that constitute health risks. Just this year, FSIS has rejected more than 100,000 pounds of catfish from China for failed lab analyses.

"The FSIS regulations are doing what they are supposed to do. The price hikes consumers are seeing are likely because of the supply issues, slight demand rise, as well as general inflation in consumer goods," Kumar said. "The key point is that FSIS regulations are not for protecting the domestic industry but for ensuring consumers' safety. This regulation is critically addressing the issue of equality of food safety standards between domestic catfish and imported pangasius products, curtailing the amount of contaminated fish coming into the US seafood market."




