## Christmas Tree Crop Fared Well Despite The Drought

Mississippi's 2022 Christmas tree crop looks good despite the drought conditions the state experienced.

"Most growers have fared well," said Jeff Wilson, horticulture specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service. "Most of the crop is looking good, especially if growers had irrigation."

Drought is a concern for trees up to 2 years old. More mature trees can withstand drought much better.

Wilson said that some growers dealt with fungal disease in early spring, but it was nothing unex-

pected. Because of Mississippi's humid climate, preventive spraying is part of the Christmas tree business.

Larry Haley, who has run Holly Berry Christmas Tree Farm in Saucier along with his family since 2005, said he has not had any major issues with disease or losses from drought.

"We use a spray program from March to September that takes care of any disease we may see," Haley said. "So far, the drought hasn't affected us. We haven't lost any trees."

Mike Buchart, executive secretary of the Southern Christmas Tree Association, which includes members from Mississippi, Alabama and Louisiana, pointed out that wet conditions are more of a problem

for growers than drought.

"Fungal disease is the No. 1 challenge for Christmas tree growers," Buchart said. "If I had a choice between too much rain and drought, I'd choose drought every time."

Don Kazery, who has operated Kazery Farm for more than 20 years, said his trees look good overall. However, Kazery said he lost about three dozen small trees after his Jackson farm went through weeks without significant rainfall beginning in September.

"Up until about two months ago, my young trees looked really good," Kazery said. "I was impressed with how well they looked. But the drought has taken a toll on them."

Kazery said that he has ordered nursery stock to replenish his tree

farm, but nurseries are short on supply. The supply is also tight for pre-cut trees grown in other states, which some choose-and-cut farms offer in addition to their own trees.

Average cost for a choose-and-cut Christmas tree is \$10 to \$16 per foot, or about \$60 for a 6-foot tree. Those prices are in line with recent years. Larger trees and certain varieties sell for more because of the inputs, including labor and materials.

"Families may expect that choose-and-cut farmers will charge more for their trees this year because of inflation," Buchart said. "But even though inputs have been higher for the last few years, growers have not increased their prices."

"You will pay a little bit more for a tree from a choose-and-cut tree farm than you will if you buy a pre-cut, real tree from a big box retailer. But people go to choose-and-cut farms for the experience and the tradition, and they are willing to pay more for that and the locally

grown product," he said.

Although real trees pose less of a fire risk than artificial trees, when cared for properly, they do require diligence. Keep the tree watered, use LED light strands, and keep the tree away from heat sources, including televisions, heat vents, fireplaces and sunny windows.

"Since we've had drought conditions, trees will drink even more water in the first several days once people get them home," Kazery said. "So, it's important to check the water level in the stand when you get up in the mornings and before you go to bed at night."

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# Commissioner's Policy Corner

*Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau,  
Protecting and Serving the Agricultural Community*

For farmers and ranchers, their equipment and commodities are their livelihoods, and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce's Mississippi Agricultural & Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB) aims to protect and serve our agriculture community and their belongings. The MALTB enforces the laws of the State in preventing the theft of livestock, agricultural, and aquacultural products. In addition, the Bureau enforces transportation laws of livestock and also handles the registration of all livestock brands in the State.

The MALTB has eleven (11) investigators across the state to investigate agricultural related crimes. MALTB investigators are often called upon by local law enforcement to assist with investigations. The most common cases investigated by the Bureau involve livestock theft, the shooting of livestock, timber theft, farm equipment theft, saddle and tack theft, and agricultural chemical theft.

The MALTB investigators stay busy helping farmers, ranchers, and landowners. In FY2022, the Bureau investigated 222 cases with a reported value of \$1,215,838 and recovered \$604,750 in stolen property. In the past two months, the MALTB has made multiple arrests in various theft cases. I commend Director Dean Barnard, Ag Theft investigators, and local law enforcement officials for their efforts in these

ongoing investigations. These are examples of multiple law enforcement agencies working together to quickly and successfully resolve cases.

On October 26, MALTB agents and the Panola County Sheriff's Department executed search warrants at two properties, simultaneously. Authorities recovered several dual axle utility trailers, a horse trailer, two (2) boats with missing VIN plates, a 500-gallon fuel tank, saddles, cement mixer, night vision scope, cameras and numerous other valuable items stolen from a farm in Yalobusha County and a timber operation in Panola County.

This is an ongoing investigation of farm and logging business-related theft involving property valued into the thousands of dollars. To date, one arrest has been made in connection with the operation. Christopher Lamar Morris, age 32, of Batesville, Miss., has been charged with Grand

Larceny in Panola County.

It appears conspirators were attempting to possibly place the items on eBay and Facebook marketplace and black-market avenues for sale. Agents and deputies expect additional arrests and charges to be coming against Morris and others that have been identified as involved, but not yet arrested. According to agents and deputies, once they go through the inventory of stolen items, they will attempt to reach out to any other owners as the case moves forward.

On November 4, an airplane engine stored in a crop-duster hanger was stolen in Valley Park in Issaquena County. The theft of the plane engine was reported to the Issaquena Sheriff's Office. The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau was asked to assist in the theft investigation.

During the investigation, information surfaced that led investigators to Sunflower County. Agents

with MALTB, Issaquena County Sheriff's Office, Sunflower County Sheriff's Office and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) executed a search warrant on several locations in Sunflower County on November 10.

As a result of the search, numerous stolen items were recovered including the stolen plane engine, a John Deere tractor, trailers, four-wheelers, ATV's, lawn mowers, welding machine, ditch witch trencher, fuel tanks and a commercial grade bush hog, along with other additional items. One arrest was made during the search warrant execution. This is an ongoing investigation, with additional arrests expected.

### Tree Trimming Party Treats!!

#### Elf Biscuits

- 1 5 1/3-ounce package graham crackers (1 sleeve)
- 3/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cup chopped pecans or almonds

Arrange eleven whole graham crackers on an ungreased 15x10-inch jellyroll pan. Bring butter, sugar, and pecans to a boil in a medium saucepan; boil 2 minutes. Pour mixture on crackers, spreading quickly to cover. Bake at 300° for 12 minutes. Remove crackers to wax paper to cool. Cut with knife along perforations.

#### Bacon-Cheese Dip

- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1 (4-ounce) package crumbled blue cheese
- 1 (3-ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1/8 teaspoon hot sauce
- 2 tablespoons diced onion
- 4 bacon slices, cooked and crumbled

Process first 5 ingredients in a blender or food processor until smooth, stopping to scrape down sides. Stir in half of bacon. Cover and chill 2 hours. Sprinkle with remaining bacon. Serve with crackers, raw vegetables, or potato chips.

#### Mrs. Claus's Dream Bars

- 2 cups gingersnap crumbs
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted
- 1 14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 6-ounce package peanut butter chips
- 3/4 cup miniature candy-coated chocolate pieces
- 1 cup sweetened flaked coconut (optional)
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans

Stir together gingersnap crumbs and melted butter in a medium bowl. Press mixture evenly into a greased 13x9-inch pan. Carefully spread condensed milk over crumb mixture. Combine peanut butter chips and remaining ingredients in a medium bowl. Sprinkle mixture evenly over condensed milk; gently press mixture down. Bake at 350° for 25 to 30 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool in pan on wire racks. Cut into squares.

#### Chocolate Chip Oatmeal Cookies

- 3/4 cup shortening
- 1 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1/4 cup water
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt

- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 cups quick-cooking oats, uncooked
- 1 (12-oz.) pkg. semi-sweet chocolate chips

Blend together first 6 ingredients in a large bowl; add flour, salt and baking soda, blending until combined. Stir in oats and chocolate chips. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheets. Bake at 350° for 10 minutes.

#### Spicy Party Meatballs

- 1 (12-ounce) jar cocktail sauce
- 1 (10.5-ounce) jar jalapeño jelly
- 1/2 small sweet onion, minced
- 1/2 (3-pound) package frozen cooked meatballs

Cook first 3 ingredients in a Dutch oven over medium heat, stirring until jelly melts, and mixture is smooth. Stir in meatballs. Reduce heat, and simmer, stirring occasionally, 35 to 40 minutes or until thoroughly heated.

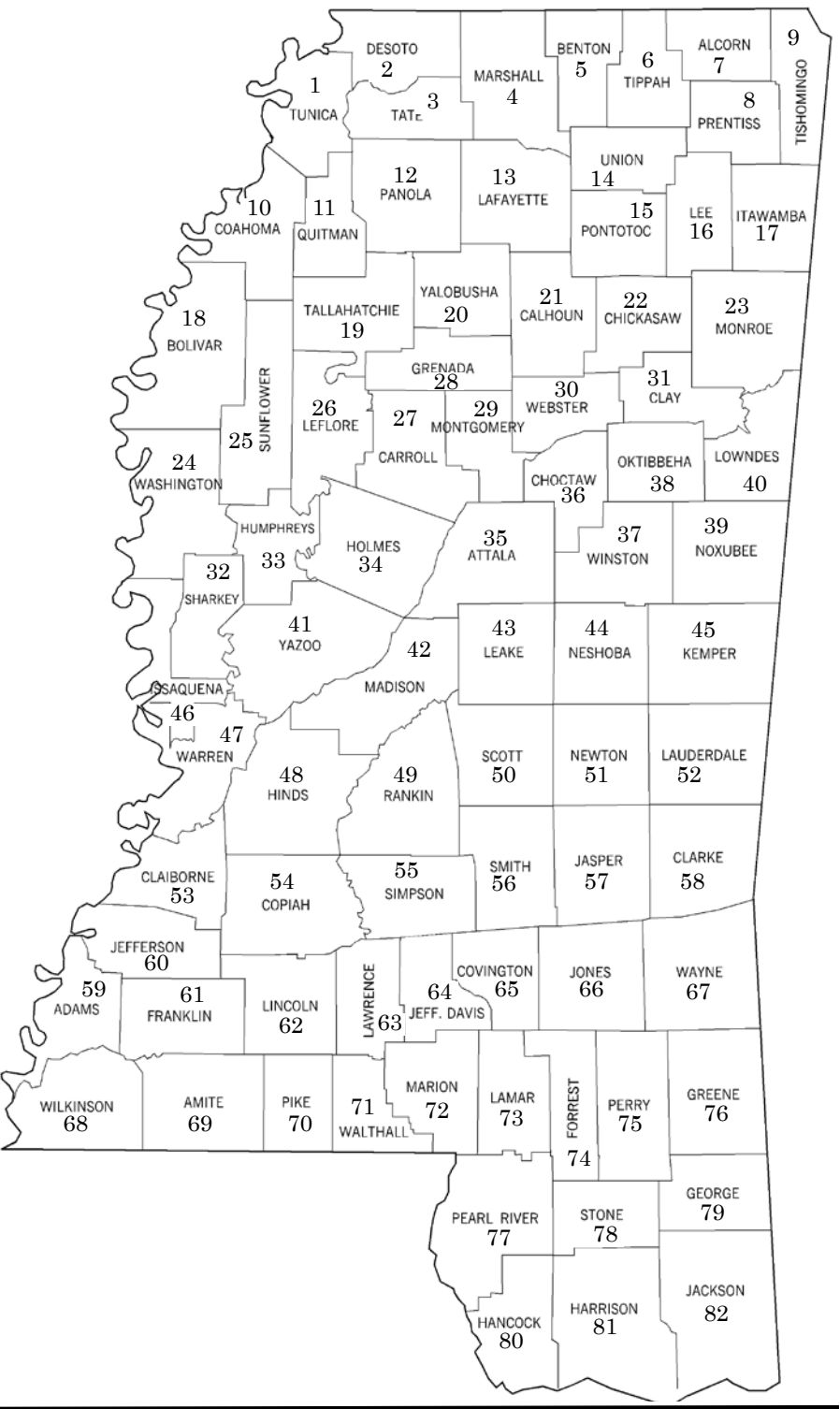



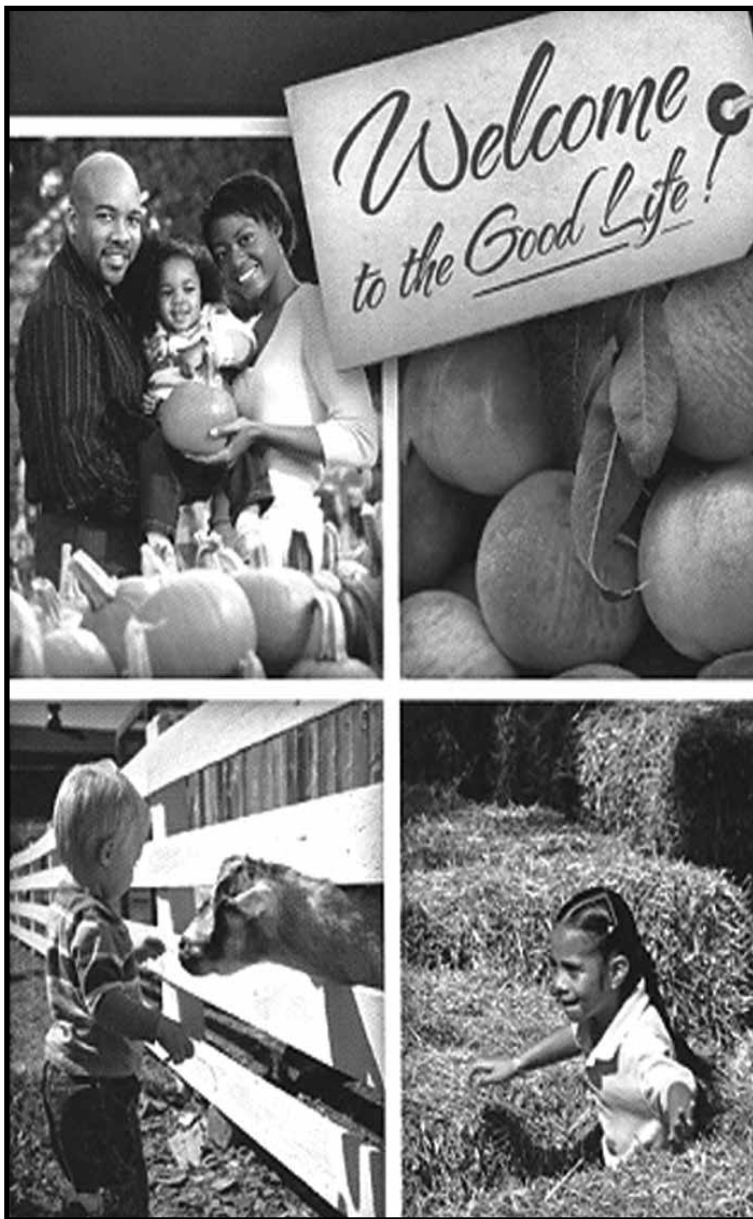

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# State's Pecan Yield is Down, but Quality is High in 2022

Mississippi pecan producers faced a particularly challenging year with drought and then rain at the wrong time, but irrigated orchards are making a good crop.

Eric Stafne, fruit and nut crop specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said the dry summer did one very good thing: It helped control pecan scab, a disease that is often a problem for the state's pecan trees.

"One issue this year for nonirrigated trees will be nut fill at harvest, and also return bloom for next season," Stafne said. "Drought can reduce both of these factors, so next year we may be looking at a crop reduction due to this year's drought conditions."

Trees that were irrigated received the moisture they needed, and the dry conditions kept typical pecan diseases at bay.

Mississippi's pecan crop is scattered across the entire state, and there seems to be a recent increase in acreage, particularly in the Delta, said Stafne, who is also a researcher with the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station.

"It is a popular crop," he said.

This year's crop is estimated at about 3 million pounds. There is tremendous variability in pecan yield each year, with the state's crop ranging from as few as 2 million pounds to as many as 8 or 9 million.

"Weather, including freezes, drought, excess rain, hurricanes and ice storms, is one reason why crops vary so much, but also pecans have a tendency toward alternate bearing," Stafne said. "What controls this in the tree is still unknown, but it may be related to factors like carbohydrate storage and hormone production."

"There is also a genetic factor, as some varieties are more prone to

have on and off years in terms of crop load. It can be managed somewhat through proper nutrition, irrigation, pest control and crop load management," Stafne said.

Max Draughn is owner of Bass Pecan Nursery and Pecan Hill Farms in Raymond and president of the Mississippi Pecan Growers Association. He said the state has about 8,500 acres of actively managed pecan orchards, and more acres are being added each year.

"Since 2018, Mississippi has been the second fastest growing state in terms of percentage of acres planted," Draughn said.

Draughn said the weather has been an issue this year, specifically the severe drought that negatively impacted the nonirrigated crop for most of the growing season.

"Lack of water has caused a large number of nuts to abort or not fill out well," he said. "Pecans require large amounts of water to produce a good crop."

When the drought broke in August, the state experienced too much

rain and clouds and not enough sun. September saw a return to drought.

Another challenge in north Mississippi was a late-spring freeze that caused orchards there to lose a portion of their crop.

At Pecan Hill Farms, Draughn said he expects a good yield from his irrigated orchards of about 1,800 pounds per acre on mature orchards. The nut quality is excellent this year, but the drought did delay by about a month the shuck splitting to release the nuts.

Input costs for fertilizer, fuel, chemicals and labor were much higher than normal this year, and pecan prices will reflect those increased expenses, as well as the small crop size.

"Prices will vary based on the variety and quality of the pecans," he said. "Large pecans with thin shells grown with adequate fertilizer and irrigation will bring the highest price."

Draughn said prices range from \$3-\$6 a pound in the shell when bought directly from growers. Mammoth shelled halves sell for \$12-\$16 a pound.

"Growers who retail their nuts directly to the public set the prices on that portion of their crop," Draughn said. "Wholesale sales to accumulators and shellers are determined by the shelling market and what the market price is for the edible meat portion of the pecan."

Mississippi pecans are always in high demand, and growers typically have no problem selling all their crop for reasonable prices.

"We have seen growth in the Mississippi pecan crop over the last few years," he said. "We are encouraging our growers to market as much as of their crop as they can directly to the consumer or retail market to attain the highest price for their pecans and provide consumers with the freshest product possible."

# Poultry Producers Are Extra Cautious After HPAI Case

The Mississippi Board of Animal Health (MBAH) is asking backyard bird owners to be vigilant in their biosecurity procedures after a commercial breeder chicken flock in Lawrence County tested positive for highly pathogenic avian influenza, or HPAI.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture National Veterinary Services Laboratory confirmed the case to the Mississippi Board of Animal Health, or MBAH, November 5. Samples from the flock were tested at the Mississippi Veterinary Research and Diagnostic Laboratory in Pearl and confirmed at the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service National Veterinary Services Laboratories in Ames, Iowa.

HPAI is a highly contagious form of avian influenza that can kill entire flocks of infected poultry. The virus can occur naturally in wild aquatic birds and can be spread to poultry.

The virus does not pose a food safety risk; poultry products cooked to an internal temperature of at least 165 degrees are still safe to eat. However, rapid spread can shut down commercial and backyard operations.

MBAH State Veterinarian Jim Watson said his agency has quarantined the affected site and is working with the poultry industry to increase surveillance of flocks across the state.

"Birds on the property have been depopulated to prevent the spread of the disease and will not enter the food system," Watson said. "Anyone involved with poultry production from the small backyard to the large commercial producer should review their biosecurity activities to assure the health of their birds."

MBAH lists the following symptoms for infected birds: coughing, sneezing, incoordination, diarrhea, nasal discharge, sudden death, decreased egg production, lack of en-

ergy or appetite, soft-shelled or misshapen eggs, and swelling or purple discoloration of head, eyelids, comb or hocks.

Jessica Wells, a poultry specialist with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said biosecurity is the key to preventing the disease's spread. There are several steps producers should take, including washing hands before and after leaving chicken areas. Do not recycle any litter or feed from a suspected site for use as fertilizer or for any other purpose.

"Once avian influenza has entered a poultry flock, it can spread rapidly on the farm by both the fecal-oral route and the respiratory route due to the proximity of the birds," Wells said. "Objects like clothes, shoes and equipment also transmit the disease, so footwear designated exclusively for the chicken area and changing clothes before entering are imperative."

Do not handle dead birds with bare hands. To remove dead birds from a poultry area, turn two plastic bags inside out, pick up the bird and invert and seal the doubled bag with the bird inside.

"To dispose of the bird, place the bag in a household trash can or bury it using a shovel without touching it," Watson said. "To store a dead bird for testing, use clear plastic bags to pick up and store the animal, and place it on cold packs until it can be refrigerated."
